Aztecs Head to Loaded Mary Nutter Collegiate Classic in Palm Springs Area

Riding the momentum of a five-game winning streak and matching their best 12-game start since 2008, the San Diego State softball team heads to the always competitive Mary Nutter Collegiate Classic this weekend in Cathedral City, Calif.

The Aztecs (9-3), who won the 30th annual Campbell/Cartier Classic last weekend at SDSU Softball Stadium with a 4-1 record, plays Idaho State (3:30 p.m. PT) and Notre Dame (6 p.m. PT) on Thursday, No. 5/5 Arizona (10 a.m. PT) and Wisconsin (8:30 p.m. PT) on Friday, and rv/No. 24 Mississippi State at 7 p.m. PT Saturday.

SDSU is receiving eight votes in the latest ESPN.com/USA Softball poll and four of its five games this weekend will be against teams who are ranked or receiving votes in one of the two main national polls (Notre Dame and Wisconsin are also receiving votes).

San Diego State leads the Mountain West with a .321 average through 12 games, while owning an impressive 2.13 team

Alexa Schultz leads the Aztecs with a .389 batting average, while Riley Thies (.375), Kelsey Munoz (.357, 1 HR, 4 2B, 9 RBI, 8 R), Kiera Wright (.348, 5 R, 4 SB), Shelby Thompson (.342, 3 HR, 12 RBI, 12 R) and Taylor Adams (.325, 10 R, 4 SB) all are hitting at least .325.

Hannah Johnson (3-1, 1.31 ERA, 21.1 IP, 14 K, .158 opp. avg.), Maggie Balint (2-2, 2 SV, 1.95 ERA, 32.1 IP, 46 K, .167 opp. avg.) and Marissa Moreno (3-0, 3.62 ERA, 19.1 IP, 22 K, .263 opp. avg.) have done the bulk of the pitching for SDSU.

On Tuesday night, San Diego State downed Lovola Marymount, 8-1, at SDSU Softball Stadium for its fifth consecutive victory. The Aztecs are outscoring the opposition, 29-7, over its five-game winning streak.

KATHY VAN WYK HEAD COACH | 24th SEASON | CAL STATE FULLERTON, 1983

- As a player, Van Wyk earned All-America honors and won the Broderick Award, given to the best player in the nation, in 1982 after going 35-1 with a 0.18 ERA. The victories remain a school single-season record and .972 winning percentage was an NCAA Division I record until 2001. Her phenomenal season included four no-hitters, six one-hitters, back-to-back perfect games, 26 shutouts and 270 strikeouts.
- Is the school's all-time winningest coach with 770 career victories, including a program-best 44 wins in 2008
- Earned her fifth Mountain West Coach of the Year award in 2014 after leading the Aztecs to a 16-8 mark in league play. She also won the award in 2002, 2006, 2008 and 2013.
- Has led SDSU to 11 NCAA tournament appearances (2001, 2003, 2006, 2008, 2009, 2010, 2011, 2012, 2013, 2014 and 2015)
- Guided San Diego State to its seventh MW regular season title in 2014 with a 16-8 record. The team's other championships came in 2002, 2003, 2006, 2008, 2012 and 2013.
- Coached her eighth All-American in 2017 when Jenavee Peres was named a second-team NFCA All-American. Peres became the Aztecs' first-ever second-team NFCA All-American (SDSU's three other NFCA All-Americans were on the third team).
- Has coached 78 all-conference selections, 40 NFCA all-West Region selections, nine MW Pitchers of the Year, nine MW Freshmen of the Year, four MW Players of the Year, one MW Defensive Player of the Year and 138 conference player/pitcher of the week winners

Mary Nutter Collegiate Classic Information

Riding the momentum of a five-game winning streak, the Aztecs head to the always competitive Mary Nutter Collegiate Classic in Cathedral City, Calif. (Palm Springs area).

The Mary Nutter Collegiate Classic, formerly the Cathedral City Classic, is one of the largest and most competitive Division I softball tournaments outside of the NCAA tournament. This year's tourney features 30 teams, including five of the eight Women's College World Series teams from last year and the U.S. Olympic team. The entire tournament is held at Big League Dreams park across five fields.

The tournament is named after Mary Nutter, who started the National Sports Clinics (NSC) more than 25 years ago to provide softball coaches at all levels access to the highest quality instruction. Nutter passed away from a heart attack on July 24, 2012, and the tournament was renamed in her honor for the 2013 edition.

Tournament passes are available for \$80, while single-day tickets for Thursday, Friday, Saturday and Sunday are \$32 for adults, \$12 for seniors (65 or older) or students (U17), and \$6 for children between the age of 3-10.

The Aziecs play games against Idaho State (3:30 p.m. PT) and Notre Dame (6 p.m. PT) on Thursday, No. 5/5 Arizona (10 a.m. PT) and Wisconsin (8:30 p.m. PT) on Friday, and rv/No. 24 Mississippi State at 7 p.m. PT Saturday.

All five games will be broadcast live on FloSoftball (shortened link - http://bit.ly/3atBDnl) and all are expected to have live stats. Below is a look at SDSU's five opponents at the Mary Nutter Collegiate Classic.

SDSU Wins the 30th Annual Campbell/Cartier Classic

For just the fifth time in the 30 years of the Campbell/Cartier Classic, San Diego State captured the tournament title.

The Aztecs secured the tourney title for the second straight year after going 4-1, including wins over their final four games (5-4 vs. Southern Utah and 3-2 in eight innings vs. Cal State Fullerton on Friday, and 3-0 vs. Brigham Young and 10-0 in five innings vs. Southern Utah on Saturday). SDSU's lone setback was a 3-0 effort against BYU on Thursday.

Following the Aztecs (4-1) were Brigham Young (3-2), Cal State Fullerton (2-2) and Southern Utah (0-2).

San Diego State's five Campbell/Cartier Classic titles are tied with Long Beach State for the most in the history of the tournament. Below is a look at the past winners:

Aztecs Excel in Lid-Lifters

San Diego State has excelled in season-opening games since Kathy Van Wyk took over the reigns of the program in 1997.

After a 5-2 win at Jacksonville on Thursday, the Aztecs have now won seven of eight season-opening games, 18 of their last 20 and 21 of 24 lid-lifters in Van Wyk's 24-year tenure.

SDSU's only blemishes in the past 24 season-openers under Van Wyk came in 2018 (lost to No. 25/25 Georgia, 23-2), 2012 (lost to Texas Tech, 5-4) and in 2000 (lost to UIC, 5-3).

Over the 24 years under Van Wyk, SDSU has outscored its opponent, 138-80, or 5.8-3.3 per game in lid-lifters. Since records were first kept in 1980, San Diego State is 30-11 (.732) in their opening games.

Aztecs Picked Second in the Mountain West

The San Diego State softball team received the most first-place votes and is picked to finish second in the Mountain West in a preseason poll voted on by the league's nine head coaches, the conference announced Jan. 29. The Aztecs have won a MW-record seven regular-season titles.

SDSU totaled 50 points in the preseason poll, trailing San José State's 53 points and two first-place votes. Colorado State and UNLV both tied for third with 45 points and a first-place vote apiece, while Fresno State (44) and Boise State (41) were picked fifth and sixth, respectively, each with the other first-place votes. In all, 12 points separated the top six spots in the poll. Nevada (23), Utah State (15) and New Mexico (8) rounded out the poll.

Softball America Names SDSU Fourth-Best Transfer Class

San Diego State's 2020 transfer class has been deemed the fourth-best in the country, Softball America announced in October.

In an article written by Maren Angus on Tuesday, Oct. 1, the Aztec transfer class of juniors Maggie Balint (Oregon), Riley Thies (Towson Univ.), Alexa Schultz (Oklahoma) and Sara Lillie (Oregon State), and sophomores Summer Hargett (Northwestern) and Hannah Johnson (Cal State Fullerton) only trails No. 1 Oklahoma State, No. 2 Louisiana and No. 3 Oregon. SDSU is also ahead of such national powers Missouri (10), Oklahoma (11), Washington (12) and Arizona State (15), among others.

Balint spent two seasons at Oregon from 2017-18, going a remarkable 28-4 in the circle with a 1.51 ERA. In 185 2/3 innings, the right-hander finished with 13 complete games, five shutouts and three saves, striking out 214 with just 53 walks, while limiting the opposition to a .189 average.

Thies, meanwhile, batted .302 (74-for-245) with 23 RBIs, 61 runs, seven doubles, a triple and a walk over two seasons at Towson from 2018-19, while Schultz (60 GP, 7 R, 1 HR, 3 RBI) and Lillie (11 starts, 6 RBI, 1.000 fielding pct.) each spent the last two years at NCAA tournament teams Oklahoma and Oregon State, respectively.

Hargett comes to The Mesa after playing the 2018 season at Northwestern, appearing in 17 games with three starts, while Johnson redshirted last year with the Aztecs after pitching for Cal State Fullerton in 2018.

Aztecs to Play USA Softball National Team

San Diego State will play the 2020 USA Softball Women's National Team in an exhibition game on March 10, 2020, Team USA announced in December.

The March 10 game will start at approximately 7 p.m. PT in the nearby Sportsplex USA Santee in Santee, Calif., following an earlier game between Team USA and Cal State Northridge at 5 p.m. PT.

The exhibition game is part of Team USA's "Stand Beside Her" tour in preparation for the Tokyo 2020 Olympic Games where softball returns for the first time since 2008.

"We are thrilled with the opportunity to play the U.S. Olympic Team," Aztec head coach Kathy Van Wyk said. "These are not only the elite softball players in the United States, but in the world. It will be an amazing experience for our team and the San Diego community."

"It's an honor, pleasure and true privilege to again host a USA Women's Olympic Softball team in Southern California, where softball is played at every level all year," USA Softball of Southern California Commissioner Phil Gutierrez said. "We look forward to witnessing the unequaled athleticism and sportsmanship of the greatest women's softball players in the world as the team prepares to compete at

The game comes two weeks before SDSU plays host to the Mexican National Team on March 24 at 7 p.m. PT at SDSU Softball Stadium.

San Diego State Releases 2020 Schedule

San Diego State softball head coach Kathy Van Wyk has announced a 54-game schedule for the 2020 season, highlighted by two home tournaments, a neutral matchup with the US National Team on March 10 and a home exhibition contest against the Mexican Olympic Team on March 24.

The Aztecs, who have won a league-best seven Mountain West titles in the 20-year history of the league, are scheduled to play 17 contests against teams that made last year's NCAA tournament, including a Feb. 29 home game against defending national champion UCLA. Additionally, SDSU will play nine games against conference champions.

San Diego State begins its season on the road for the 13th straight year, playing at Jacksonville's River City Leadoff Tournament from Feb. 6-8 in Jacksonville, Fla. The Aztecs open with host Jacksonville on Thursday, and play doubleheaders against Villanova and Nicholls on both Friday and Saturday.

Following a road game at UC Riverside on Wednesday, Feb. 12, SDSU opens its home portion of the 2020 slate with the 30th annual Campbell/Cartier Classic from Feb. 13-15. San Diego State will play NCAA tournament teams and conference champions Brigham Young twice (Thursday and Saturday) and Cal State Fullerton on Friday. The Aztecs also will meet Southern Utah on Friday and Saturday.

Before heading to the always competitive Mary Nutter Collegiate Classic from Feb. 20-22, SDSU welcomes Loyola Marymount on Tuesday, Feb. 18. At the MNCC, San Diego State is slated to play four teams that made the NCAA tournament, including Notre Dame on Thursday, Women's College World Series qualifier Arizona and Wisconsin on Friday, and Mississippi State on Saturday. The Aztecs also play Idaho State on Thursday.

After a visit to California Baptist on Wednesday, Feb. 26, SDSU co-hosts the San Diego Classic. On the docket for San Diego State in the classic is NCAA tournament qualifier Weber State on Friday, St. John's and defending NCAA champion UCLA on Saturday, and CSUN on Sunday.

The Aztecs wrap up their five-game homestand on Wednesday, March 4 against Villanova before heading to the Louisville Slugger Classic, co-hosted by Long Beach State and UCLA. SDSU will play Cal State Fullerton for a second time on the season on Friday, Cal Poly and NCAA tournament qualifier Boston Univ. on Saturday, and UCF and host Long Beach State on Sunday.

San Diego State kicks off Mountain West play at home from March 13-15 against defending MW champion Colorado State before traveling to Fresno State for a weekend series from March 20-22.

Breaking up the beginning of league play is an exhibition game against the Mexican Olympic Team on Tuesday, March 24 at 7 p.m. at SDSU Softball Stadium. Mexico, which features former Aztec Stefania Aradillas, is one of six teams to qualify for the 2020 Tokyo Olympics along with USA, host Japan, Italy, Canada and Australia.

SDSU returns to action from March 27-29 with a home series against Nevada, followed by a road trip to UNLV from April 3-5.

Next up for San Diego State is a weekend home series with Boise State from April 9-11 and its final non-conference game of the season on Wednesday, April 22 against San Diego at home.

The Aztecs finish the MW regular season with a road series at San Jose State from April 24-26, a home series with Utah State from May 1-3 and a road series at New Mexico from May 7-9.

The NCAA Regional kicks off postseason play from May 14-17 at 16 campus sites.

SDSU is coming off a 25-26 season, but welcomes the fourth-best transfer recruiting class in the country, according to Softball America.

Three Aztecs Named NFCA All-America Scholar-Athletes

San Diego State softball players Paige Barth, Katie Byrd and Marissa Moreno each earned NFCA All-America Scholar-Athlete honors for the 2018-19 academic year, the National Fastpitch Coaches Association (NFCA) announced in October. To be considered for the award, the student-athletes must have earned a 3.5 grade-point average or higher for the academic year.

In her first season last year, Barth appeared in 12 games, starting seven times, posting a .056 average (1-for-18) with an RBI and

Byrd, who graduated last May, ended her final season with a .290 average (42-for-145), 11 RBIs, 22 runs, eight doubles, a triple, 11 walks and a .352 on-base percentage, while starting all 46 appearances at second base.

Moreno, meanwhile, was named a second-team all-Mountain West selection as a junior last year after posting a 6-8 record in league play with a 2.80 ERA, three saves and two solo shutouts in 80 innings, striking out 62 and holding the opposition to a .217 average. Overall, she was 12-12 with a 3.01 ERA, four saves, four shutouts and 120 strikeouts in 151 1/3 innings.
