NOTES

San Diego State improves to 5-4 lifetime in the NCAA Tournament and advances to the second round for the second consecutive year... The Aztecs have won their last four first-round matches in the NCAA Tournament... USD is 2-3 in NCAA Tournament history... The Aztecs will play the championship's 16th-seed Washington on Sunday at noon... USD's top singles player Pierrick Ysern was unable to go forcing every player in the Torero lineup to play up a position... The Aztecs have won a season-best six straight matches and 11 of 12 dating back to March 12... The Aztecs did not drop a singles set at any of the six positions... This is the second consecutive match in which SDSU has avenged an earlier defeat (USD defeated SDSU 4-3 on March 5)... Felix Hardt won his 11th consecutive match... San Diego State has outscored its opponents 29-6 during the current six-match winning streak... SDSU won 5-0 because Maiberger's match at number one ended before officials could stop it.
