AZTECS WRAP UP 2015 SEASON AWAY AT SAN JOSE STATE & HOME TO NEVADA

- San Diego State will conclude it 2015 campaign with a match on the road this weekend followed by a home contest next week.
- ◆ SDSU will be on the road for a trip to northern California where it will face San Jose State on Saturday, Nov. 21, at 1:00 p.m. (PT) in Spartan Gym.
- The Aztecs will then conclude their season next Tuesday (Nov. 24) with a home match against Nevada at 6:00 p.m. on Aztec court.
- Live stats will be available for both matches this weekend with links located at GoAztecs.com.
- \blacklozenge In addition, live video streaming of the two contests will be available at the SDSU web site.

SERIES RECORDS

- ◆ The Aztecs have a mark of 18-8 against San Jose State in a series that dates back to 1977. The teams have not yet met this season. Last year the Aztec swept a pair of contests from the Spartans after each team won on its home floors during the 2013 campaign. Prior to that the teams had last met in 2009 at The Invitational in Seattle and prior to that had not squared off since the 1998 campaign. SDSU has a record of 10-2 vs. the Spartans in San Diego, 5-6 in San Jose and 3-0 on neutral courts.
- ◆ San Diego State all-time record vs. Nevada is 4-3 with the teams having met on only seven previous occasions. This will be the lone meeting between the teams in 2015. In each of the past two seasons the Aztecs split matches with the Wolf Pack, winning on Aztec Court and falling in Reno. SDSU also split contests with Nevada during the 2012 season. The Aztecs' other victory in the series came in three sets during the 2011 Aztec Invitational in San Diego.

HEAD COACH DEITRE COLLINS-PARKER

- San Diego State Head Coach Deitre Collins-Parker is in her seventh season with the Aztecs after being named the fourth head coach in program history prior to the 2009 campaign. Her record at SDSU is 111-97 (.534).
- ◆ She previously served as head coach at UNLV for eight seasons (1996-2003) and at Cornell for five years (2004-2008). Her 19-year career record stands at 273-288 (.487).
- ◆ A three-time All-American as a player at the University of Hawai'i, she led the Rainbow Wahine to consecutive national titles (1983-84) and was named the national player of the year twice.
- She was a member of the U.S. Olympic Team and competed at the Goodwill Games and Pan Am Games prior to playing professionally in Europe for four years.
- She is one of six players named to the NCAA Division I Women's Volleyball 25th Anniversary Team in October 2005 and was inducted into the AVCA Hall of Fame in the fall of 2008.

SCOUTING THE OPPOSITION

- San Jose State comes into the week with a record of 13-16 (5-11 Mountain West). The Spartans have dropped five of their last six matches and they will be at Nevada Wednesday evening prior to hosting SDSU on Saturday. SJSU is led by outside hitter Tyanna Roy (2.69 kps, 0.50 dps) and middle blocker Nandyala Gama (2.38 kps, 0.88 bps). The San Jose State roster features four players from Brazil, one from the Czech Republic and one from Puerto Rico.
- Nevada's record stands at 11-17 overall and 6-10 in the Mountain West. The Wolfpack will host San Jose State on Wednesday evening in its lone match prior to visiting SDSU. Top players for Nevada include outside hitters Madison Morell (3.96 kps, 2.69 dps) and Madison Foley (3.24 kps, 2.82 dps). Morell's average of 4.50 kills per set in league matches leads the conference entering the week.

SENIOR NIGHT

- The match against Nevada on Nov. 24 has been designated as Senior Night when the volleyball program will honor a pair of athletes playing their final match for the Red and Black.
- That duo includes middle blocker Kaja Sandberg and outside hitter Ciara Brown.
- Brown is a fourth-year senior for the Aztecs while Brown has been a member of the team for two seasons following her transfer from South Florida in 2014.

CAGE COMING ON

- Alexis Cage recorded her second doubledouble of the season (and second in three matches) with 10 kills and 14 digs in the win at Utah State on Nov. 14.
- It was the sixth time in double figures in digs this season for the sophomore outside hitter.
- ♦ Her first double-double came vs. UNLV (10 kills-10 digs) on Nov. 7.
- In the contest vs. Fresno State on Nov. 5 she led the Aztecs with 11 kills and recorded a career-high .611 hitting percentage in the match.
- She registered a career-high 16 digs vs. Air Force on Oct. 22.
- Cage's mark of 2.29 digs per set in league matches ranks second on the team behind libero Devyn Pritchard.
- She turned in a career-high five blocks in the match vs. Boise State on Oct. 17.

LITTLE ATTACKS

- Baylee Little led the Aztec with 16 kills in the five-set win at Utah State on Nov. 14.
- She hit .375 in that contest, the 11th time this season she has been above the .300 mark in attack percentage in a match.
- She recorded a team-high 11 kills in the win over UNLV on Nov. 7.
- Little set a career high with 17 kills in the win over New Mexico on Oct. 24.
- Her 18.5 points in that match was also a career best.
- She tied her season high with five total blocks in the match vs. Air Force last week (Oct. 22).

She leads the team in kills in conference matches (2.31 per set) and ranks second overall (2.30 per set).

SABA FOR THE DEFENSE

- Alexa Saba made her first start at the libero position since late September in the win over UNLV on Nov. 7.
- In that match she registered 19 digs, an assist and a service ace.
- The dig total was her second-highest in a match this season.
- In the win over CSU Bakersfield on Aug.
 29 she recorded a career-high 29 digs.
- Saba set a career best with eight assists in the win over Eastern Washington on Sept. 11.

PRITCHARD AT LIBERO

- Sophomore libero Devyn Pritchard recorded a career-high seven assists in the win over Utah State on Nov. 14.
- She also tallied 13 digs in that contest, her highest total in the past five matches.
- She had a streak of 13 matches in which she recorded at least one assist end in the contest vs. UNLV on Nov. 7 when she appeared in only one set.
- She registered a season-high two service aces in the matches against Utah State and Boise State (Oct. 15 and 17).
- She set a career high with 31 digs in the win at Fresno State on Oct. 10.
- Her 3.89 digs per set average in league matches ranks eighth in the conference this week.

BOLDEN ON THE OFFENSIVE

- Defensive specialist Dani Bolden set a career high with 12 digs in the victory at Utah State on Nov. 14.
- She had tied her previous high a week earlier with 11 digs vs. Fresno State (Nov. 5) and also had a pair of service aces.
- She led the Aztecs with 10 kills in the contest at Colorado State on Oct. 29.
- Bolden, who missed the Oct. 22 match vs. Air Force with a sprained ankle, returned for the New Mexico contest on Oct. 24 and recorded her second career double-double with 12 kills and 10 digs.
- She had recorded her first career doubledouble in the match against Boise State on Oct. 17 when she finished with 19 kills and 11 digs.
- The 19 kills vs. Boise State represented a career high and tied for the most by an Aztec this season.
- She also recorded a season-best four service aces in that match and her 24.0 points was a career high as well.

PSOMA AMONG THE LEADERS

- Freshman Alexandra Psoma recorded the final two kills of the match in the five-set win at Utah State on Nov. 14.
- In that match she set a career high with five blocks and also added eight kills, two assists, two service aces and three digs.
- She had a career-high 13 digs along with 14 kills vs. New Mexico on Oct. 24 to record her second double-double of the season.
- Her 19 points in the match vs. Air Force on Oct 22 were a career best.
- She recorded the second-most kills in match by an Aztec this season when she had 18 vs. Denver on Saturday, Aug. 29.
- She also registered a dozen digs in that contest for her first career double-double as an Aztec.
- Psoma currently leads the team with an overall average of 2.37 kills per set.

HARRIS SOLID AT THE NET

- Redshirt freshman Deja Harris had a career-best nine block assists in the win at Utah State on Nov. 14.
- She also had 12 kills in that match to just miss her first career double-double.
- ◆ Harris has averaged 1.65 blocks over SDSU's past five matches.
- She has recorded at least one block in 28 of the Aztecs' 29 matches this season.
- She ranks 10th in the Mountain West in league matches with a .300 hitting percentage.
- She is the only freshman to rank among the league's top 10 in that category.
- She had a career-high 19 kills in the victory at Fresno State on Oct. 10, the most kills in a match by an Aztec this season.

JONES SETTING IT UP

- Junior setter Hailey Jones set her SDSU career high with three kills at Utah State on Nov. 14.
- She has averaged 2.00 digs per set over SDSU's last four contests.
- She recorded her fourth double-double of the season with 26 assists and 10 digs in the contest at UNLV on Oct. 8.
- Her mark of 7.07 assists per set ranks ninth in the Mountain West this week.
- Jones' 57 assists in the match vs. CSU Bakersfield were the most by an Aztec since Johnna Fouch recorded 61 against Fresno State on Nov. 3, 2012.

SANDBERG CONTRIBUTES

- Senior middle blocker Kaja Sandberg contributed six kills, three blocks and two digs with a .312 hitting percentage in the win over UNLV (Nov. 7).
- She led the Aztecs with nine kills in the match at University of San Diego on Oct. 20.
- Her .471 hitting percentage and 9.5 points in that contest were both personal season highs.
- That came three days after she had a season-high 12 kills vs. Boise State on Oct. 17.
- Sandberg turned in a season-high seven blocks in that match vs. Boise State as well.

ALL-TOURNAMENT AZTEC I

- Sophomore libero Alexa Saba was named to the all-tournament team at San Francisco Invitational during the opening weekend of the season (Aug. 28-29).
- ◆ Over SDSU's three matches, Saba averaged 4.50 digs per set and also had five assists and three service aces.

ALL-TOURNAMENT AZTEC II

- Junior outside hitter Baylee Little was named to the all-tournament team at last weekend's Outrigger Resorts Volleyball Challenge in Honolulu.
- Over SDSU's three matches she averaged 2.00 kills, 0.78 digs and 0.33 blocks per set.
- She also recorded four service aces in the Aztecs' win over Eastern Washington and hit .588 with 11 kills in that match.

AZTEC VETERANS

- SDSU returns three starters and the libero from a team that compiled a mark of 14-15 overall and 9-9 in Mountain West play (tie-6th).
- Those starters include outside hitters Alexis Cage and Ciara Brown plus middle blocker Kaja Sandberg and libero Alexa Saba.
- Cage and Brown finished one-two in kills for the Aztecs at 3.00 and 2.75 per set respectively.

- Sandberg hit .284 and averaged 1.91 kills and 0.99 blocks per set while Saba had 2.86 digs per set from the back line.
- Other returnees who saw significant playing time include outside hitter Baylee Little (1.96 kps) and middle blocker Cassie O'Hara (1.35 kps, 0.81 bps) along with defensive specialists Danielle Bolden (1.80 dps) and Devyn Pritchard (2.97 dps).

THE REDSHIRT

- Also back is redshirt freshman middle blocker Deja Harris.
- Harris played briefly in two matches early in the 2014 campaign before missing the remainder of the season due to injury.
- In the three sets in which she appeared she totaled one kill, one service ace and a block.

FIVE FRESHMEN

- Among the eight new players on the roster this season are five true freshmen.
- Outside hitter Alexandra is a member of the Greek national team who was named Rookie of the Year in the Greek national league's top division.
- Outside hitter Alexis Harris was a second-team all-state selection in Nevada and is the younger sister of middle blocker Deja Harris.
- Outsider hitter Bailey Osborn was an allstate selection by *MaxPreps* and was her league's Player of the Year last season.
- Setter Lauren Utchen was an all-league honoree and league player of the year as senior in 2014.
- Outside hitter Alyssa Mathis was an allarea honoree the past two seasons at her high school in Florida.

TRANSFERS ADDED

- The Aztecs have also added one fouryear transfer and a pair of junior college athletes to their 2015 roster.
- Emma Fuzie comes to SDSU after two seasons as a middle blocker at Pepperdine.
- Setter Hailey Jones was a two-time allstate selection at Irvine Valley JC where she led her team to the state championship last season.
