Senior Tonye McCorkle was a welcomed addition to the Aztecs in 2008, leading the squad in at-bats (197) and triples (4), which ranked sixth and tied for third in program history, respectively. The Syracuse transfer also batted .310 with 37 runs, 61 hits, 12 stolen bases and a team-best 20 multiple-hit games.

2008 SEASON REVIEW

A RECORD-BREAKING SEASON FOR THE 2008 AZTEC SOFTBALL TEAM

The 2008 season was certainly one for the ages for San Diego State softball. The Aztecs finished with a 44-17 record, their best mark in school history, and won the Mountain West Conference regular season title for the fourth time in the past seven years with a 15-5 mark in league action. SDSU made its fourth trip to the NCAA tournament in eight years, despite playing arguably its toughest schedule in program history.

Other win-loss records set by the 2008 squad included most victories (44), best overall winning percentage (.721), fewest home losses (five), best home winning percentage (.821), fewest road losses (four, tied), best road winning percentage (.692, tied) and most Mountain West Conference victories (15, tied).

AZTECS IN THE NATIONAL POLLS AND NATIONAL MEDIA

The Aztecs' spectacular season didn't go unnoticed by the rest of the country as they spent 13 of the 16 weeks ranked among the top 25 in the nation in two polls and 15 of the 16 weeks either ranked or receiving votes. After a weekend at the Palm Springs Classic in late February, SDSU even garnered the attention of ESPN.com when it was featured in the web article entitled "San Diego State among weekend's surprises at Palm Springs." The Aztecs played five ranked teams in less than 48 hours, going 2-3 with their wins coming against two-time defending national champion Arizona and second-ranked Northwestern.

Following the successful weekend, SDSU bolted to No. 20 by ESPN.com/USA Softball and No. 21 by USA Today/NFCA and never looked back the rest of the way. San Diego State ended up as high as No. 17 in the ESPN.com poll and No. 19 in the NFCA poll, while racking up 10 wins against nationally ranked teams throughout the rest of the campaign.

SDSU AND THE RPI

To see how good the Aztecs really were last season, one would only have to look at the final NFCA RPI ratings, where SDSU finished at No. 23 of 282 schools. According to the rankings, SDSU had the 23rd-best winning percentage in the nation (.721) while playing the 46th toughest schedule. Aztecs opponents combined for .548 winning percentage.

SDSU ended the season with a 9-12 record against top 50 RPI schools, 19-1 against teams rated between 51 and 100 and 16-4 against the rest of the schools.

TO BE THE BEST, YOU'VE GOT TO BEAT THE BEST

As former professional wrestler Ric Flair used to say, "To be the best, you've got to beat the best." The Aztecs are certainly making their case of being the best.

On the season, SDSU went 44-17 (.721), including a 16-13 (.552) record against 2007 NCAA tournament teams and 5-2 (.714) mark against 2007 Women's College World Series squads. San Diego State beat 2007 NCAA squads Cal Poly (3-0), California (7-0), UC Santa Barbara (4-1), Fresno State (3-2), Arizona (2-1), Northwestern (3-2), Eastern Michigan (3-0 and 4-3), Harvard (10-1 (5)), Oregon (3-2), Pacific (3-2), Cal State Fullerton (2-1 (9)), Texas A&M (3-0 (6)), Washington (9-5 (12)), DePaul (1-0 (8)) and BYU (4-0). SDSU also picked up 11 wins against teams who made the 2008 NCAA tournament.

SO CLOSE...

Through 61 games in 2008, the Aztecs went 44-17, their best record in school history. Sure, who wouldn't be happy with a 44-17 record? SDSU, however, could easily be in the single-digits in losses had a couple of bounces gone its way.

Consider the following when looking at San Diego State's 17 losses:

- * 13 were by two or less runs (three others were three-run losses)
- * 13 came against 2007 NCAA tournament teams
- * 12 came against 2008 NCAA tournament teams
- * Nine came against nationally-ranked squads
- * Eight were by one run
- * Six came in extra innings
- * Two of the six extra-inning losses were against top-5 programs in No. 1, National Champion and Pac-10 champion Arizona State (lost, 3-1, in eight innings) and No. 4 UCLA (lost, 2-1, in nine innings)

PITCHING WINS CHAMPIONSHIPS

One of the question marks going into the season was the stability of the SDSU pitching staff, with a proven player in two-time all-Mountain West Conference performer Christina Ross, and two unproven freshmen in Brooke Petty and Samantha Beasley. It looks like the pitching staff will no longer be a concern.

Despite playing 29 of its 61 games against 2007 NCAA opponents, the Aztec pitching staff ranked No. 9 in the nation with a 1.27 team ERA. In addition, SDSU's .722 win-loss percentage was 22nd in the nation.

The Aztecs was by far the best pitching team in the Mountain West Conference. San Diego State was first in ERA (1.27), wins (44, tied), win-loss percentage (.721), innings pitched (428.1), strikeout-to-walk ratio (4.02), and WHIP (walks + hits/IP (1.01)). In addition, SDSU was second in opponents batting average (.212) and strikeouts (394).

Individually, Ross was first in ERA (1.00), innings pitched (293.2), strikeouts (275), wins (30), appearances (52) and games started (38). For her efforts, Ross was named the Mountain West Conference Pitcher of the Year for the second time. She also garnered all-West Region second-team accolades for the second time and was an all-league pick for the third occasion.

Despite being freshmen, both Petty (1.72) and Beasley (1.94) posted sub 2.00 ERA's.

HERE BATTER, BATTER, BATTER, BATTER

Not all SDSU's records were set in the circle. Despite boasting a fairly young lineup, the Aztecs set school records in runs (243) and walks (169), while hitting .275 for the season.

Senior Tamani Wells closed her career out in style, leading the team in batting average (.330), hits (64), sacrifice bunts (23) and stolen bases (25). Syracuse transfer Tonye McCorkle (.310, 37 R, 35 RBI), sophomore sensation Brittany Knudsen (.297, 39 R, 27 BB), junior All-American Erin Floros (.291, 39 RBI) and senior captain Megan McDonald (.284, 5 HR, 22 BB) also added offensive stability.

Wells, Floros and McDonald joined Ross on the all-Mountain West team.

IN ROSS WE TRUST

To say that senior Christina Ross (Santa Clarita, Calif.) had one of the best seasons in the circle in school history is an understatement.

Ross finished the season ranked 15th in the nation in ERA (1.00), 16th in victories (30) and tied for 85th with two saves. She also led the Mountain West in ERA, innings pitched (293.2), strikeouts (275), wins, appearances (52) and games started (38).

On the single-season list, Ross ranked among the top-10 in all 18 pitching categories, including first in wins (tied), appearances, total shutouts (14), and strikeouts, second in games started, complete games (31), solo shutouts (9, tied), and innings pitched, fourth in winning percentage (.682), and fifth in saves (2, tied) and opponents average (.206).

What might even be more impressive was Ross' climb up the career charts despite playing in just her third year at SDSU. Ross, who played her freshman year at Kansas before transferring to The Mesa, finished ranked among the top 10 in all 18 categories, including strikeouts (first, 612), solo shutouts (first, 23), total shutouts (tied-first, 28), victories (second, 70), win percentage (second, .660), innings pitched (second, 691.2), games started (second, 96), complete games (second, 72), strikeouts-per-seven innings (third, 6.19), saves (third, 6), strikeout-to-walk ratio (fourth, 3.97), opponents average (fourth, .218) and appearances (tied-fourth, 129).

Ross also put together a pair of impressive streaks in the 2008 season. The first was a streak of 30 scoreless innings from March 20-April 6 and a streak of 35 innings without giving up an earned run over the same period. The second, which ended in the sixth inning of game one at New Mexico on April 18, was a streak of 39 innings without issuing a walk that began on April 6.

Ross was picked as the MWC Pitcher of the Week a league-record nine times in 2008, while her 12 career weekly awards edged former teammate Celena Velasquez' 11 for the most in conference history.

VAN WYK CLOSING IN PASSES WIN NO. 400

With a 4-0 shutout over Brigham Young in the second game of a doubleheader on April 24, SDSU 12th-year head coach Kathy Van Wyk picked up her 400th career victory. Eight wins later, Van Wyk is sitting at 408.

Under Van Wyk's leadership, the Aztecs have won four of the last eight (2002, 2003, 2006, 2008) Mountain West Conference regular-season titles, advanced to the NCAA tournament four times in the past eight seasons, including regional runner-up finishes in 2001 and 2006, and compiled a .600 or higher winning percentage in six of the last eight campaigns. SDSU has improved its winning percentage in seven of the last 10 seasons and has been .500 or better in 10 of Van Wyk's 12 years.

For her efforts in 2008, Van Wyk was selected the Mountain West Conference Coach of the Year for the third time.
