SDSU Men's Golf Set for MW Championships

The San Diego State men's golf team will be aiming for its third conference title in the last four years this weekend when it travels to the desert for the Mountain West Championship, April 25-27, in Tucson, Ariz. For the eighth straight season, the 54-hole event will be contested on the par-71, 7,144-yard Catalina Course at the OMNI Tucson National Golf Club.

The 11-team field will play 18 holes on each of the three days, following a practice round on Thursday. The Aztecs, who have been idle since April 13, earned the No. 3 seed are slated to tee off with No. 4 Nevada and No. 5 Colorado State in the second group on Friday, starting at 7:50 a.m. PT, while the pairings for the final two rounds with be based on team standings. A live scoring link will be available courtesy of Golfstat on GoAztecs.com.

SDSU, which received a No. 37 national ranking in the latest Golfstat ratings, will be returning to the Catalina Course for the second time this season after tying for fourth place at the University of Arizona's National Invitational Tournament, March 14-16.

Aztec Lineup for the Week

San Diego State head coach Ryan Donovan has adjusted his starting lineup this week to include junior James Holley (Atascadero, Calif.), who will join the usual mix of junior Xander Schauffele (San Diego, Calif.), freshman Ricky DeSantis (Carlsbad, Calif.), sophomore Riccardo Michelini (Carpi, Italy) and freshman Nahum Mendoza III (San Diego, Calif.) The combination comprised five-sixths of the SDSU delegation in the regular-season finale at the Western Intercollegiate.

Schauffele, Michelini and Holley will be appearing at the MW Championship for the second year in a row, joining first-time competitors DeSantis and Mendoza.

Schauffele, who ranks fourth in the conference with a team-best 71.77 scoring average, landed in the 42nd position nationally in this week's Golfstat Cup standings.

The Competition

Three of SDSU's opponents this week find themselves among the top 100 in the latest Golfstat rankings released April 23. New Mexico is the highest rated team, checking in at No. 23, followed by UNLV (29th) and Nevada (88th), while Colorado State (102nd) remains just outside the group. The Aztecs will also battle San José State (129th), Air Force (145th), Fresno State (155th), Wyoming (174th), Utah State (177th) and Boise State (178th).

SDSU owns a 10-5-1 record in head-to-head results against six conference adversaries during the 2013-14 campaign, including undefeated marks vs. San José State (4-0) and Wyoming (2-0). The Aztecs have also maintained the upper hand against Colorado State (2-1) this year and have split their encounters with New Mexico (1-1) and Fresno State (1-1). However, SDSU has come up empty this season vs. UNLV, posting an 0-2-1 ledger in three clashes with the Rebels. Ironically, the two sides tied for fourth place at the National Invitational Tournament held last month on the same Catalina Course. In addition, the Scarlet and Black will have their first look at Air Force, Boise State, Nevada and Utah State.

Individually, six of the top-10 finishers return from last year's conference championship, including the Aztecs' own Riccardo Michelini (4th) and Xander Schauffele (T-10th), along with Gavin Green of New Mexico (3rd), Air Force's Kyle Westmoreland (T-8th) and Kurt Kitiyama (T-8th) and Carl Jonson (T-10th) of UNLV.

San José State's Cody Blick, who owns a league-best 70.62 stroke average is expected to contend as well, along with Seokwon Jeon from

another conference newcomer Utah State, New Mexico's Victor Perez, Ty Travis of Boise State, Colorado State's Cameron Harrell and Ricky DeSantis of SDSU, all of whom find themselves among the top 11 in the Mountain West rankings.

Aztecs At The Mountain West Championships

In the 14-year history of the Mountain West, San Diego State has won two team championships, capturing back-to-back titles in 2011 and 2012. The Aztecs also tied for the top spot in 2009, but lost in a team playoff to TCU after rallying from a five-stroke deficit in regulation.

In addition, SDSU has finished second six times (2013, 2010, 2009, 2006, 2003, 2001), placed fourth on three occasions (2005, 2004, 2002), came in fifth twice (2007, 2000) and ended up in the seventh position once (2008).

The Aztecs' best individual finish was recorded in 2001 when John Lepak posted a 3-over 219 to win by one stroke at Sunriver Resort in Oregon. SDSU's Adam Porzak also tied for first place in regulation in 2007, but came up just short in a one-hole playoff loss to Robby Ormand of TCU.

The Aztecs have routinely fared well individually at the MW tournament, placing one player among the top four in each of the last eight seasons and 13 times overall.

Backspin: 2013 MW Championships

San Diego State fell short in its quest for a third straight conference title, tying for second place at the 2013 Mountain West Championships at the OMNI Tucson National Golf Club. The Aztecs carded a 289 during the final round to finish at even-par 852 for the tournament.

SDSU had three golfers finish among the top 10 individually, led by Riccardo Michelini, who placed fourth at 3-under 210. The Aztec freshman began the day in a three-way tie for first, but slipped three spots after carding a 71 over the final 18 holes. Despite the stumble, Michelini's performance gave SDSU a top-four finisher at the MW Championships for the eighth straight season.

Tom Berry ended the tournament two strokes in back of Michelini, tying for sixth at 1-under 212 after posting a final-round 72, which featured four birdies. The Aztec senior was just one shot off the pace in fourth place entering the day; however, five bogeys thwarted his advance up the leaderboard. Still, Berry came away with his third top-10 finish at the MW Championships in four appearances.

Xander Schauffele, who began the day in fourth along with Berry, was unable to generate any momentum either, dropping into a tie for the 10th spot at 1-over 214 after shooting a 74 over the final 18 holes. Despite draining a team-high six birdies, the SDSU sophomore had his progress derailed by six bogeys and a pair of double bogeys.

Meanwhile, James Holley finished three strokes behind Schauffele at 3-over 216 following a final-round 72. The Aztec junior managed to offset three bogeys and a double-bogey with four birdies to wind up in a tie for the 13th position.

Rounding out the SDSU contingent was junior Austin Kaiser, who tied for 19th at 8-over 221 after posting his second straight 74 on Sunday. New Mexico (-8) ended the Aztecs' two-year reign atop the conference, winning by eight strokes over SDSU and UNLV, which tied for the runner-up spot, while Air Force (+23) and Colorado State (+24) finished a distant fourth and fifth, respectively.

A Look At the Course

For the eighth straight year, the Mountain West Championship will be held on the Catalina Course at the OMNI Tucson National Golf Resort & Spa. Designed by Robert Van Hagge and Bruce Devlin, the Catalina Course is known for its magnificent views, traditional parkland-style layout and tree-lined fairways. Nestled in the foothills of the Santa Catalina Mountains, the course also includes eight sparkling lakes and 80 bunkers, while the 18th hole is considered to be one of the finest and most challenging finishing holes on the PGA Tour. Home to over 30 PGA events, including the prestigious Chrysler Classic of Tucson from 1997-2006, as well as several NCAA tournaments, the Tucson National has been selected as one of Golf Digest magazine's "75 Best Golf Resorts in North America."

Mountain West History 101

- Six schools have won at least one Mountain West title with just two, San Diego State and New Mexico, claiming consecutive championships. UNLV finished atop the standings in two of the first three MW championships in 2000 and 2002, BYU placed first in 2001 and 2007, UNM won four in a row from 2003-06, while TCU earned its lone title in 2009. Three teams have combined to win the four most recent tournaments, with Colorado State doing so twice during that span in 2008 and 2010.
- Six different schools have had a player win the individual title, including SDSU (2001), UNLV (2000, 2004, 2008, 2011, 2013), New Mexico (2003, 2009), Colorado State (2002, 2010), BYU (2005) and TCU (2007).
- The inaugural MW Championships took place on the Nicklaus Tournament Course at the PGA West complex in La Quinta, Calif., before moving to the Crosswater Course at Sunriver Resort in Sunriver, Ore., for six straight years from 2001-06. The tournament has since been played in Arizona on the Catalina Course at the OMNI Tucson National Resort.

2013-14 Highlights

- San Diego State is enjoying another successful campaign, finishing among the top 10 as a team in nine out of 10 tournaments played during the regular season.
- The Aztecs captured the team title at Pepperdine University's Jones Invitational on Feb. 25, as four golfers finished sixth or better on the individual leaderboard. SDSU was led by Riccardo Michelini, who ended in the runner-up position, one shot out of forcing a playoff with USC's Anthony Paolucci, followed by Xander Schauffele (4th), Ricky DeSantis (T-6th) and Austin Kaiser (T-6th).
- Two weeks later, Schauffele captured medalist honors for the first time as an Aztec with a two-stroke victory over Rico Hoey of USC at the Lamkin Grips San Diego Classic on March 11. In addition, Nahum Mendoza III posted the highest finish of his young career with a fifth-place effort.
- Schauffele's win at San Diego Country Club is just one of a team-leading seven top-10 finishes for the Scripps Ranch High alumnus so far this year. Recently, he recorded a pair of sixth-place performances at the National Invitational Tournament (March 16) and Western Intercollegiate (April 13), sandwiched around a fifthplace showing at the highly competitive Aggie Invitational at Texas A&M (April 6).
- With his strong play of late, Schauffele has garnered three Mountain West Men's Golfer of the Week accolades in the past month, including a shared honor with teammate Ricky DeSantis after the Western Intercollegiate.
- DeSantis also tied for sixth at the aforementioned event and was one of just eight competitors to post consecutive scores in the 60s after firing a 68 and 69 in the second and third rounds, respectively.
 In addition, the Carlsbad High product tied Schauffele with 11 birdies overall to help match the highest finish of his young collegiate career.
- DeSantis is in prime position to grab the league's top freshman award after maintaining a 72.70 stroke average thus far, which ranks first among his fellow classmates in the MW. Michelini received the conference's freshman honor a year ago, while Matt Hoffenberg was recognized in 2008.

- Schauffele and DeSantis have each fired seven rounds in the 60s this season, with the latter posting a team season-low of 65 during the opening 18 holes at The Goodwin on March 28.
- James Holley also logged his first collegiate victory this season, emerging triumphant as an individual competitor at the Western Illinois Invitational on Feb. 11, held at Carleton Oaks Country Club in nearby Santee, Calif.

Just A Chip Shot Away

The winner of this week's Mountain West Conference championship earns an automatic bid to the NCAA regional tournament, May 15-17. This year's six regional sites include just one course located in the Pacific time zone, Eugene Country Club in Eugene, Ore., The Aztecs could also be sent to Auburn University Golf Course in Auburn, Ala., Rich Harvest Farms in Sugar Grove, Ill., Lonnie Poole Golf Course in Raleigh, N.C., Briggs Ranch Golf Club in San Antonio, Texas, or The Club at Old Hawthorne in Columbia, Mo.

In all, 81 teams and 45 individuals not on those squads will be divided up among the six regional tournaments. The participants will be selected by the NCAA men's golf committee and are scheduled to be announced on Monday, May 5 at 10 a.m. ET (7 a.m. PT) on The Golf Channel.

A total of 30 schools and two individuals (not on those qualifying teams) will advance to the NCAA championships, May 23-28, at Prairie Dunces Golf Club in Hutchinson, Kan. The Aztecs have made the national championships 22 times in school history, including six times (1999, 2003, 2005, 2008, 2011, 2012) since the regional format made its debut.

Aztecs Add Two For 2014-15

Last fall, SDSU head coach Ryan Donovan announced the signing of PJ Samiere (Kailua, Hawaii/Punahou HS) and Blake Abercrombie (Rocklin, Calif./Rocklin HS) to National Letters of Intent. The two talented high school seniors will join the Aztecs in August and will be eligible to compete in time for the 2014-15 campaign.

Samiere brings a strong résumé with him to Montezuma Mesa, highlighted by quarterfinal appearance at the U.S. Junior Amateur Championship last July at Martis Camp Club in Truckee, Calif., just one week after he advanced to the round of 32 during the U.S. Amateur Public Links at Laurel Hill Golf Club in Lorton, Va.

Earlier in the summer, Samiere captured first place at qualifiers for both tournaments, carding a collective 134 (66-68) at Ala Wai Golf Club in Honolulu to secure a spot in the U.S. Amateur Public Links, while emerging victorious in a playoff for the U.S. Junior Amateur after recording a combined 140 (68-72) at Waikoloa Resort in Waikoloa. Hawaii.

Abercrombie competed at the 2013 U.S. Amateur as well after finishing third in the qualifying tournament at Yolo Fliers Club in Woodland, Calif., with a collective score of 143.

In 2012, Abercrombie captured the NGCA Sacramento Valley match play title and logged a third-place effort at the Sacramento Junior Easter Championship (147), which featured a tournament-low round of 71 over the final 18 holes. He also competed at the California State Amateur in Santa Barbara, where he shot a 153 (74-79) during stroke play.

Head Coach Ryan Donovan

Ryan Donovan is in his 11th season at the helm of the SDSU men's golf program after serving as an assistant in 2003. Since taking the reins, he has directed the Aztecs to 25 tournament titles and five NCAA national championship appearances. In both 2011 and 2012, he received Mountain West Coach of the Year honors and was named a finalist for the Dave Williams Award, which is handed out annually to the national coach of the year in Division I men's golf. Donovan was also was tabbed the Eaton Golf Pride West Region Division I Men's Coach of the Year by the GCAA following the 2010-11 campaign. A native of Yorba Linda, Calif., Donovan was a four-year member of the Aztec golf squad before graduating in 2001.
