Aztec Men's Golf Looks to Punch its Ticket to NCAA Championship at NCAA West Lafayette Regional

Fresh off winning its third straight Mountain West Championship, the San Diego State men's golf team continues postseason play Monday at the NCAA West Lafayette Regional in West Lafayette, Indiana. The Aztecs, who are making their 24th regional appearance in the last 25 tournaments, will be among the field vying for a spot in the NCAA Championships, slated for May 24-29, at Omni La Costa Resort & Spa in nearby Carlsbad, California, hosted by Texas.

SDSU received the No. 6 seed out of 13 teams in the West Lafayette Regional after earning an automatic bid into the regional for winning the Mountain West Championship last weekend in Creswell, Oregon. The Aztecs became the first team to win three straight MW titles since UNLV from 2016-18 and just the third program overall (New Mexico won four straight from 2003-06).

West Lafayette, Indiana (Purdue) is one of six regional tournaments that will also be played concurrently in Austin, Texas (Texas), Baton Rouge, Louisiana (LSU), Chapel Hill, North Carolina (UNC), Rancho Santa Fe, California (USD) and Stanford, California (Stanford).

SDSU is ranked 35th in the latest Scoreboard ratings powered by Clippd (May 9). Joining San Diego State on the par-72, 7,465-yard Kampen-Cosler Course will be seven others in the top 50, including No.

2 Vanderbilt, No. 11 Arizona, No. 15 Florida, No. 23 New Mexico, No. 30 Purdue, No. 37 Mississippi State and No. 47 Indiana. Others in the field include College of Charleston (52), Stetson (62), Colorado State (66), Southern Illinois (130) and Tennessee Tech (203). The top-five squads and lowest individual not on those teams from the West Lafayette Regional will advance to Carlsbad.

Teams will complete 18 holes (54 total) of stroke play each of the three days following a practice round on Sunday. SDSU is paired with New Mexico and Purdue for Monday's first round and Tuesday's second round, each set to begin on the 10th tee at 8:30 a.m. ET (5:30 a.m. PT). Wednesday's final round will be determined by team finishes from the first two days.

Live hole-by-hole results courtesy of Golfstat will be available for all three rounds on GoAztecs.com.

San Diego State head coach Ryan Donovan will take the same six golfers he took for the MW Championship, including junior Justin Hastings (Grand Cayman, Cayman Islands), sophomore Tyler Kowack (San Diego/Canyon Crest Academy), sophomore Chanachon Chokprajakchat (Bangkok, Thailand), junior Shea Lague (Jamul, Calif./Steele Canyon

HS) and senior Jackson Moss (San Diego/Point Loma HS). Senior Skyler Ngo (Las Vegas, Nev.) will once again serve as an alternate.

Out of 11 tournament this season, the Aztecs have one win, three third-place finishes, five in the top 5 and eight in the top 10. SDSU's 283.97 team scoring average is its second lowest in program history, only trailing last year's 282.65.

Out of San Diego State's starting 5, only Hastings and Lague have completed 54 holes at a NCAA Regional. Hastings, who along with Kowack were named to the 10-man all-Mountain West team on Wednesday, tied for 17th in at the Norman Regional in 2022 at 1-under-par 215 as the top Aztec finisher and then tied for 23rd at year's regional in Salem, South Carolina at 6-under 210. Lague tied for 39th last season in Salem at 3-under 213. Kowack opened with a 78 at Salem last year before being replaced by Chokprajakchat, who finished with a 67 and 71.

Kowack paces SDSU with a 70.88 stroke average through 32 rounds, just ahead of Hastings' 70.97 in 30 rounds. Chokprajakchat (71.55), Lague (72.03), Ngo (72.40) and Moss (73.50) round out San Diego State's six travelers. Kowack and Hastings are also 1-2 on the team in rounds in the 60s (12 and 8), and rounds below par (19 and 14), while Chokprajakchat's seven even-par rounds lead the squad.

Since the NCAA regional format was adopted in 1989, San Diego State has received a bid on 27 occasions, including a streak of 20 straight from 1999 to 2018. This season marks the second straight trip to the Eastern Time Zone after not competing there since 2015 at The Course at Yale in New Haven, Connecticut. The Aztecs took second in the regional that year led by current PGA Tour star Xander Schauffele, who tied for fifth at 3-under 207. That result qualified SDSU for the NCAA Championship in Bradenton, Florida, where it came in 15th place.

Last year in Salem, San Diego State put up a furious rally down the stretch but came up one shot short of making a playoff. The Aztecs fired a 16-under-par 272 in the final round with their four counting players going a combined 8-under over the final three holes. Lague had a chance to put SDSU into the playoff for the final spot for the NCAA Championship, but was unable to birdie the par-5, 546-yard 18th

hole and settled for a par. Texas A&M's Sam Bennett, meanwhile, birdied the hole to move the Aggies into a team playoff with host Clemson.

The Aztecs have advanced through regional competition into the national championship series on nine occasions, highlighted by a team title at OMNI Tucson National Golf Club in 2011, where the Scarlet and Black posted the program's lowest combined score in regional play with a 19-under 833 en route to a seven-stroke victory.

The following season at Stanford Golf Course in 2012, SDSU turned in a second-place finish, with two-time All-American J.J. Spaun setting three team regional records, including lowest score (12-under 198), lowest round (7-under 63) and best individual finish (2nd).

In 2016, SDSU added one of the most dramatic performances to the program's postseason lore after defeating Texas A&M on the first hole of a sudden-death playoff to secure the Albuquerque Regional's fifth and final spot at the NCAA Championships. On the first playoff hole, former U.S. Amateur champion Gunn Yang holed out for a double-eagle with a 7-iron from 218 yards away, while Ryann Ree made an eagle of his own as San Diego State topped the Aggies by three strokes (-5 to -2) on the par-5, 544-yard No. 1.

In 2022, Aztecs came in eighth and did not advance to the NCAA Championships, although a third-place finish the year before (2021) in Kingston, Tennessee, advanced SDSU to Scottsdale where it finished 25th.

SDSU is 6-7 on the season against teams in the NCAA West Lafayette Regional, including 3-0 record against fellow MW foe Colorado State, a 3-3 mark against league opponent New Mexico and an 0-1 mark against defending NCAA champion Florida.

The Kampen-Cosler Course, a Pete Dye design, is an 18-hole, links-style, par-72 championship golf course featuring large bent-grass greens, fairways and tees. The layout presents a challenge for golfers of all abilities with vast sand bunkers, native grasslands, ponds and a natural celery bog. Kampen-Cosler is rated one of the top collegiate courses in the nation and has been awarded 4.5 stars on Golf Digest's "Places to Play." Kampen-Cosler receives high marks as it is ranked as one of the most difficult golf courses in Indiana.

The course has also played host to a number of prestigious collegiate and public tournaments, including the 2008 NCAA Championship, where the Aztecs came in 14th at +70. Kampen-Cosler has also hosted the 2003 women's NCAA Championship, two men's regionals, one women's regional and multiple Big Ten Championships, not to mention numerous state and regional competitions. The course is named in honor of Emerson Kampen and his support of Purdue Athletics. Mr. Kampen's statue overlooks the first tee.

Two Aztecs Named to All-Mountain West Team

San Diego State junior Justin Hastings (Grand Cayman, Cayman Islands) and sophomore Tyler Kowack (San Diego/Canyon Crest Academy) each were named to the 2023-24 All-Mountain West Team, the league announced Wednesday. It is the second consecutive all-conference award for Hastings and first for Kowack.

The conference awards and all-conference team are voted on by the league's 11 head coaches.

Hastings, who is 77th in the nation in the latest Scoreboard powered by Clippd computer ratings, ranks second on the team this season with a 70.97 stroke average (-13) through 30 rounds. Hastings opened the season with a wire-to-wire victory at the Maui Jim Intercollegiate (Sept. 8-10) with an 18-under 195, the best 54-hole score in program history. In 10 tournaments for the season, he has a win, three top-5 finishes and five top-10 efforts. Hastings, who earlier this month tied for seventh at the Mountain West Championship at 3-under-par 213, helping SDSU to its third consecutive MW title, also ranks second on the team in rounds below par (14) and rounds in the 60s (8).

Kowack, meanwhile, leads the team with a 70.88 stroke average (-18) through 33 rounds. Ranked 106th in the latest Scoreboard powered by Clippd computer ratings, Kowack captured the William H. Tucker Intercollegiate, Sept. 25-26, at 11-under 205. Out of 11 tournaments this season, Kowack has one victory, two top-5s, four top-10s and five top-20 finishes. He also tops San Diego State in rounds below par (19) and rounds in the 60s (12).

The Aztecs will compete in the 2024 West Lafayette Regional, May 13-15, at the par-72, 7,465-yard Kampen-Cosler Course in West Lafayette, Indiana. Seeded sixth out of 13 teams, the top-five squads and lowest individual not on those teams from the West Lafayette Regional will advance to the NCAA Championships, slated for May 24-29, at Omni La Costa Resort & Spa in nearby Carlsbad, California, hosted by Texas.

A Look Back: Aztecs Win Third Straight MW Title

The San Diego State men's golf team captured its third consecutive Mountain West Championship, defeating New Mexico in a one-hole playoff on the par-72, 7,210-yard Emerald Valley Golf Club in Creswell, Oregon. The Aztecs, who pulled even with the Lobos with one group to play in regulation, became the first team to win three straight MW titles since UNLV from 2016-18 and just the third program overall (UNM won four straight from 2003-06).

SDSU, which entered the tournament 31st in the latest Scoreboard powered by Clippd team rankings (April 24), now has six MW crowns, passing UNLV into solo second in league history, only trailing New Mexico's eight titles. San Diego State also picked up the league's guaranteed spot in an NCAA regional.

The Aztecs entered the final day of the tournament tied for second with San Jose State and two shots behind Colorado State but shot a 3-under-par 285 on Sunday and finished tied with the Lobos at -11 after regulation.

SDSU sophomore Chanachon Chokprajakchat (Bangkok, Thailand) and junior Justin Hastings (Grand Cayman, Cayman Islands), both birdied the par-5, 577-yard 18th hole to draw San Diego State even, but tournament runner-up junior Shea Lague (Jamul, Calif./Steele Canyon HS) saw his birdie attempt lip out on 18, forcing a one-hole playoff. Both teams went back to the 18 tee box to play the hole again, with No. 20 UNM exiting the first fivesome with a one-stroke lead thanks to Oliver Cage's birdie. With the Aztecs needing a two-stroke swing from the second fivesome, sophomore Tyler Kowack (San Diego/Canyon Crest Academy) and Hastings both birdied to secure another SDSU title.

Colorado State finished third at -8, while San Jose State was the only other team under par at -2. Fresno State and Nevada each tied for fifth at +1.

Lague fired a final-round 2-under 70 to finish regulation at 6-under 210, one stroke behind Boise State's Cole Rueck (-7). Lague was at 3-under with three birdies and no bogeys through 14 holes, but bogeyed the par-4, 390-yard 15th and parred out to sign for a 70. UNLV's Caden Fioroni and Fresno State's Matthew Sutherland finished a shot behind Lague in third at -5, while New Mexico's Albert Boneta and Colorado State's Connor Jones each tied for fifth at -4.

Hastings, meanwhile, tied for seventh out of the 55 golfers at 3-under 213 following a 1-under 71 on Sunday. Hastings notched four birdies on the day, including two over the final four holes, which offset three bogeys.

Chokprajakchat carded a 1-under 71 to finish tied for 13th at even-par 216. Chokprajakchat sank third birdies on the day with two bogeys (none over the final 13 holes, moving up 15 spots for the round).

Senior Jackson Moss (San Diego/Point Loma HS) tied for 32nd at +4 with a 1-over 73 on Sunday. Moss had two birdies and three bogeys in his final round.

Kowack tied for 36th overall at +5 with a 5-over 77 today. Kowack opened with a 2-over 74 on Friday and got back to even-par with a 70 on Saturday, but unfortunately went 5-over over his final five holes, dropping from even-par to +5 for the tournament before making the big birdie in the playoff.



RYAN DONOVAN HEAD COACH 21ST SEASON SAN DIEGO STATE (2001)

Ryan Donovan is in his 21st season as head coach at San Diego State, having elevated his alma mater into a perennial contender on the national stage.

Donovan has coached the Aztecs to 219 top-10 overall tournament finishes, 147 top-five performances, 39 team titles and seven NCAA championship appearances, highlighted by a fifth-place tie at nationals in 2012. During his tenure, SDSU has advanced to the NCAA regionals in 19 of 20 campaigns (2020 NCAA championships were canceled) and have also finished no worse than second at the Mountain West championships in nine of the last 14 seasons SDSU competed (2020 MW championships were canceled), winning team titles in 2011, 2012, 2015, 2022, 2023 and 2024.

Under Donovan's guidance, Aztec golfers have garnered 40 all-Mountain West accolades and 18 all-region honors, while seven of his pupils have been named to 14 All-America teams. In addition, Donovan has mentored four MW player of the year winners in Puwit Anupansuebsai (2020), Nahum Mendoza III (2016), J.J. Spaun (2012) and Aaron Goldberg (2008), as well as the trio of Ricky DeSantis (2014), Riccardo Michelini (2013), Matt Hoffenberg (2008) and Dylan Oyama (2023), who were each named conference freshman of the year in their respective rookie seasons.

The 2022-23 season was one of the best in program history. San Diego State finished with three team championships last year, claiming New Mexico's William H. Tucker Intercollegiate (Sept. 23-24, 2022) at 16-under 848, the Wyoming Cowboy Classic (April 3-4, 2023) title for a third straight year at 7-under 857 and the MW Championship (April 28-30, 2023) for a second straight year at 60-under 804. According to Golfstat, the Aztecs' 281.85 stroke average last season was the best in program history, while at the MW Championship SDSU set program lows for a 54-hole score (804) and 18-hole score (260 in the final round), winning the title by 25 strokes over runner-up New Mexico. Both Justin Hastings and Shea Lague earned PING All-Region honors and All-Mountain West accolades for the first time, while Oyama was named the MW Freshman of the Year. SDSU tied for seventh at the NCAA Salem Regional after entering as the No. 4 seed.

The 2021-22 season was another good one for Donovan and the Aztecs. SDSU played its best down the stretch, winning a pair of team titles, including repeating at the Wyoming Cowboy Classic (April 4-5) and the Mountain West Championship (April 29-May 1). San Diego State's season came to an end with an eighth-place showing at the NCAA Norman Regional, 13 spots behind Utah for fifth place and the region's final spot into the NCAA Championships. Anupansuebsai became SDSU's first four-time all-Mountain West selection, while Zihao Jin was recognized on the all-conference team for the first time of his career. Hastings won the UC San Diego Invitational for SDSU's lone individual title.

Despite losing its No. 2 and No. 3 golfers from in 2020, SDSU had a great season in 2021 (fall 2020 was canceled), recording two team victories (Southwestern Invitational and Wyoming Cowboy Classic), seven top-5 finishes and three individual titles. Additionally, the Aztecs made their first NCAA tournament since 2016, ultimately tying for 25th. Anupansuebsai led the way for SDSU, being named a Golfweek Honorable Mention All-American, a PING All-West Region selection and a all-Mountain West pick. Anupansuebsai won a pair of tournaments, including the NCAA Kingston Springs Regional (May 17-19) and a playoff victory at the MW Championship (April 29-May 1). Steve Sugimoto also earned all-league accolades, while Liam Koeneke won an individual tournament.

The Aztecs were poised for a rebound season in 2019-20 before the outbreak of the Coronavirus disease (COVID-19) cut the season short. SDSU had won the Bill Cullum Invitational going away in the fall with a tournament-record total of 40-under-par 824, and were off to a solid start in the spring before the virus ultimately ended the season. In the spring, San Diego State came in third at a loaded field at The Prestige and then tied for second of 19 teams at the Lamkin Grips San Diego Classic, moving up to No. 28 in the final rankings. Anupansuebsai (Bill Cullum Invite), Steve Sugimoto (CSUSM Fujikura Invitational) and Leo Oyo (The Prestige) all had individual wins for the Aztecs.

The 2018-19 season evolved into another transition year for the Scarlet and Black, as Donovan attempted to overcome the graduation of two-time all-region honoree PJ Samiere and all-conference selection Blake Abercrombie with the infusion of six newcomers to the lineup. In all, eight different players led the Aztecs during the regular-season tournament schedule, including Anupansuebsai, who gave the Scarlet and Black an all-MW selection for the 18th consecutive year.

Forced to compensate for the loss of three-time all-MW selection and 2016 third-team All-American Nahum Mendoza III, San Diego State witnessed a rebuilding year during the 2017-18 campaign, as four freshmen made at least two varsity starts. Despite the influx of youth, the Aztecs produced another successful season, recording top-10 finishes in 12 of 13 tournaments, including four in the top five. Individually, Samiere capped off his collegiate career by meriting PING All-West Region honors for the second year in a row after earning all-MW recognition along with fellow senior Abercrombie.

SDSU weathered some nagging injuries during the 2016-17 campaign before clinching another post-season berth. With Donovan at the controls, the Aztecs recorded two tournament victories to go with eight additional top-10 placements, while five different golfers paced the squad in 12 events. Individually, Samiere garnered PING All-West Region accolades and received all-league distinction, along with Mendoza and Abercrombie, giving Donovan three all-MW picks for the fourth year in row.

Donovan also fielded a deep squad in 2015-16 as five different players led the Scarlet and Black in 12 events. Overall, the Aztecs captured two team crowns and finished among the top five in nine of the 10 remaining tournaments, including five in the top three. Along the way, SDSU compiled an impressive 125-30-1 record in head-to-head competition (.804) and maintained a top-30 ranking for most of the year. Not to be outdone, the Aztecs secured their fourth trip to the NCAA Championships in six seasons after a thrilling sudden-death playoff victory over Texas A&M to claim the Albuquerque Regional's fifth and final berth. Meanwhile, Mendoza (second team) and Ryan Ree (honorable mention) each received All-America honors by the GCAA while earning a spot on the all-conference team along with Michelini.

In 2014-15, Donovan collected his third MW Coach of the Year honor after leading the Aztecs to their third league title over a five-year helm. With Donovan at the helm, SDSU logged top-five finishes in eight additional tournaments, including a runner-up showing at the NCAA New Haven Regional to clinch a trip to the national championships for the first time since 2012. Individually, Xander Schaufele capped off his brilliant career on The Mesa, earning third-team All-America honors by PING and Golfweek after collecting his second straight all-region accolade. In addition, Schaufele received all-MW recognition for the third consecutive season, joining first-time honorees Mendoza and Ree.

In 2013-14, Donovan coaxed a youthful squad to the program's 16th straight NCAA regional ap-

pearance, following a second-place showing at the MW Championship. Despite a challenging schedule, the Aztecs recorded five top-five finishes on the season, highlighted by the team title at the Jones Invitational in the spring. Individually, Schaufele received all-region distinction and was named to the all-MW team, along with DeSantis and Michelini.

Despite the loss of four regulars from the previous year, Donovan guided SDSU to the brink another NCAA championship berth in 2012-13, before falling in a sudden-death playoff in the regional round. With one senior in the starting lineup, the Aztecs still managed seven top-five team finishes on the season including the championship at their own Lamkin Grips San Diego Classic. Individually, he oversaw the development of Tom Berry, who earned all-region recognition and landed on the all-MW squad, along with fellow teammate Schaufele.

With Donovan at the controls, San Diego State soared to new heights in 2011-12, as the Aztecs posted their highest finish ever at the Division I level with a fifth-place tie at the NCAA Championships. SDSU, which was one of just eight squads to advance to the match-play phase of the tournament, staged an incredible rally during the final 18 holes of medal play, catapulting from 15th all the way into a tie for fourth after carding the low round of the event. The 2011-12 Aztecs maintained a top-20 ranking throughout the campaign, winning five tournament titles, including four straight, while boasting a combined head-to-head record of 174-27-3 (.860). Donovan helped the team earn consecutive MW crowns, becoming the first league school to accomplish the feat since 2005-06. For his efforts, he was named MW Coach of the Year for the second straight season and was one of just seven finalists for the Dave Williams Award, which is presented annually to the national coach of the year in Division I men's golf.

In 2010-11, Donovan led the program to its first MW and NCAA regional championships. In addition, the Aztecs claimed five other tournament titles, including their own Barona Collegiate Cup at Barona Greek Golf Club. The seven titles ranked second nationally, trailing only consensus No. 1 Oklahoma State. He also helped the 2010-11 squad to a high No. 4 national ranking by Golfstat.com, 13 top-five finishes, including 12 in the top three, while boasting a combined head-to-head record of 168-31-1 (.843). SDSU did not finish lower than seventh at any 2010-11 outing prior to the NCAA national championships and twice was named the national team of the week by Golfweek.

Under Donovan's tutelage, J.J. Spaun was named a third-team All-American and first team all-conference honoree, while Todd Baek picked up honorable mention All-America and national all-freshman accolades. Both Spaun (1-3rd) and Baek (1-10th) finished in the top 10 at the NCAA championships and were joined by Alex Kang on the all-region squad.

Donovan was rewarded for the team's success, becoming the first Aztec named MW Men's Golf Coach of the Year in the league history. He was also honored on the national stage as one of 12 finalists for the Dave Williams Award. In addition, Donovan was tabbed region coach of the year by the GCAA for the second time in his career.

In 2009-10, Donovan helped San Diego State to seven top-five finishes, including victories at the Turtle Bay Resort College Invite in Hawaii and the Barona Collegiate Cup in March. The Aztecs were also runners-up at the MW championships and prestigious U.S. Intercollegiate, attaining a final No. 24 national ranking in the Golfweek/Sagarin.

Individually, four different SDSU players won or shared an individual tournament title. Tyler Morris kicked off the year by placing first at the Firestone Grill College Invite in October, before Andrew Cooley and Kang shared medalist honors at the Hawaii event in November. In the spring, Spaun, who later was named all-MW, beat out 88 other golfers to win the Thunderbird Invitational in a playoff in Arizona.

The 2008-09 campaign saw Donovan lead the program to 10 top-five finishes, bolstered by six runner-up performances, en route to its 11th consecutive and 14th overall NCAA regional appearance. The Aztecs ended the season ranked 21st nationally by Golfstat.com, and narrowly lost in a playoff to TCU for the 2009 league crown. Three players finished as tournament runners-up, including then sophomore Johan Carlsson, who received conference player-of-the-month honors in November 2008, and was later named all-conference.

Under Donovan's direction in 2007-08, San Diego State placed in the top 14 in all 15 outings with the 15th tournament of the campaign being a 14th-place finish at the NCAA Championships, the school's best placing in 26 years. Just getting to the national stage took a great leadership from Donovan, as he helped the Aztecs vault 11 places from 20th into a tie for ninth to force a three-way playoff during the final round of the NCAA West Regionals. SDSU posted a tournament-low tying 5-under-par 283 over the final 18 holes of regulation, then shot a combined 2-under par along with Texas in a shotgun sudden-death format to advance to nationals.

Individually, Donovan tutored a pair of athletes, Aaron Goldberg and David Palm, to All-America accolades. Goldberg became the first Aztec to gain All-America status in consecutive seasons since 1983-84 after he was awarded with third-team honors. Palm, meanwhile, was named to the honorable mention squad. Additionally, both were all-MW and all-Southwest Region selections. Other players to earn season-ending recognition under Donovan were Matt Hoffenberg (MWC Freshman of the Year, all-MW, all-Southwest Region) and Carlsson (all-Southwest Region). For his team's performances, Donovan, himself, was named the Eaton Golf Pride Division I Coach of the Year for the Southwest region.

In 2006-07, SDSU secured three team tournament titles and reached the NCAA Regionals for the team's ninth straight appearance. Goldberg had one of the program's finest seasons, finishing with a scoring average of 70.71, seven top-10 finishes and medalist honors at the District 7 Fall Shootout on his way to being named an honorable mention PING All-American, the program's first such honor since 2001.

The 2005-06 season was equally impressive as Donovan guided SDSU to three team tournament victories en route to its eighth consecutive NCAA regional appearance. Three Aztec golfers - seniors Andrew Scott and Josh Warthen and sophomore Palm - also claimed individual titles during the season, while Scott and Goldberg garnered all-Mountain West Conference accolades.

In 2004-05, Donovan led SDSU to its second NCAA championship appearance in three years, while the Aztecs posted 12, top-10 individual finishes to go along with six straight top-five team performances during the regular season.

Donovan returned to Montezuma Mesa as an assistant coach under former head coach Dale Walker, but was later promoted to interim head coach after the conclusion of the 2003 fall season and guided SDSU through the entire 2004 spring campaign.

Donovan completed his first season as head coach with four of his players combining for eight top-five individual finishes and two tournament wins.

Prior to coaching at SDSU, Donovan was a four-year member of the Aztec golf squad from 1997-2001 and went on to join the professional ranks. His most successful season came as a junior when he posted five, top-30 finishes. During his senior year, he shot a career-best 4-under 212 at the Aztec Invitational, placing second overall and helping SDSU to the tournament title.

Donovan also has national experience on his playing resumé. He qualified for the U.S. Amateur in 1996 and 1999, and played in the British Amateur in 2001 before turning pro. He then competed on the Golden State Tour in 2001 and the Gateway Tour in 2002.

A native of Yorba Linda, Calif., Donovan was a four-time all-Sunset League performer at Esperanza High School and was named first-team all-Orange County his senior season. Donovan graduated with a degree in public administration and currently resides in San Diego with his daughter Raegan.

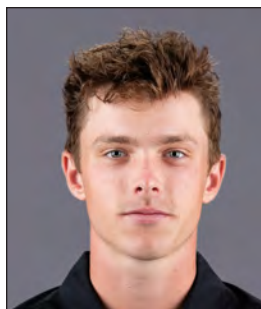
