SDSU OPENS THREE-MATCH HOME STAND VS. AIR FORCE THURSDAY

- ◆ After a pair of road wins against the third- and fourth-place teams in the Mountain West on Nov. 1 and Nov. 3 (UNLV and Fresno State), San Diego State will begin a three-match home stand later this week.
- ◆ On Thursday, Nov. 8, the Aztecs will take on Air Force at 7:00 p.m. (PT) on Aztec Court in Peterson Gym.
- ◆ Two days later (Saturday, Nov. 10) the SDSU will return to Aztec Court to face Boise State at 7:00 p.m.
- ◆ The home stand will conclude with a match vs. University of San Diego next Wednesday (Nov. 14).
- ◆ San Diego State (9-3 MW) enters the week in first place in the Mountain West, a half-game ahead of both Colorado State (8-3 MW) and UNLV (8-3 MW). Those teams face each other Thursday evening in Fort Collins.

SENIOR NIGHT

- ◆ Saturday's contest against Boise State has been designated Senior Night since it is SDSU's final weekend home match of the season
- Prior to that evening's match, the Aztecs will honor a pair of seniors for their accomplishments during their four-year careers at San Diego State: middle blocker Andrea Hannasch and libero Kristi Jackels.

STREAKING

- ◆ San Diego State has won its last seven straight matches and nine of its last 10.
- ◆ SDSU's last loss came at Boise State on Oct. 11.
- ◆ The seven-match winning streak is the Aztecs longest since the 1996 campaign when they also won seven in a row.
- ◆ That year SDSU finished with a record of 22-13 overall and 13-3 in the Western Athletic Conference.
- ◆ That was the last season in which San Diego State won as many as 20 matches. They enter the week with a record of 18-7 with five regular-season contests remaining.

SERIES RECORDS

- ◆ San Diego State holds a 30-2 mark in its previous 31 meetings with Air Force including five-set win in Colorado Springs earlier this season. The teams first met in 1996 while both were members of the Western Athletic Conference. Air Force's wins over SDSU came in Colorado Springs in 1999 and 2010. The Aztecs are 16-0 vs. the Falcons in San Diego, 13-2 in Colorado Springs and 1-0 at neutral sites.
- ◆ The Aztecs and Boise State have met just four times previously with SDSU winning on three of those four occasions. The Broncos defeated San Diego State in four sets in Boise in mid-October. The first meeting between the teams occurred at the Red Raider Classic in Lubbock, Texas, during the 2005 season with SDSU taking a three-set win. The Aztecs won both meeting with the Broncos in 2011.

HEAD COACH DEITRE COLLINS-PARKER

- ◆ San Diego State head coach Deitre Collins-Parker enters her fourth season with the Aztecs after being named the fourth head coach in program history prior to the 2009 campaign. Her record at SDSU is 66-48 (.579).
- ◆ She previously served as head coach at UNLV for eight seasons (1996-2003) and at Cornell for five years (2004-2008). Her career record stands at 228-239 (.488).
- ◆ A three-time All-American as a player at the University of Hawai'i, she led the Rainbow Wahine to consecutive national titles (1983-84) and was named the national player of the year twice.
- She was a member of the U.S. Olympic Team and competed at the Goodwill Games and Pan Am Games prior to playing professionally in Europe for four years.
- She is one of six players named to the NCAA Division I Women's Volleyball 25th Anniversary Team in October 2005 and was inducted into the AVCA Hall of Fame in the fall of 2008.

SCOUTING THE OPPONENTS

- ◆ Air Force enters the week with a record of 8-16 overall and 2-8 in the Mountain West. The Falcons are led by Cami Richan (3.02 kills, 0.47 digs per set) and Felicia Clement (2.51 kills, 0.54 digs per set). Libero Maiya Perich is second in the conference in digs with an average of 4.46 per set. Air Force is on a five-match losing streak that began with a five-set loss to the Aztecs in Colorado Springs on Oct. 13.
- ◆ Boise State's record stands at 15-8 overall and 6-3 in the Mountain West. The Broncos will visit Nevada Thursday evening prior to facing the Aztecs on Saturday. BSU's top players include Alyssa Gammel (3.39 kills, 2.50 digs per

set) and Liz Hardin (3.47 kills, 0.85 digs per set. Boise utilizes two setters (Sarah Baugh and Casey Rose) in its rotation and leads the conference in assists at 13.02 per set.

NASH NAMED MW PLAYER OF THE WEEK

- ◆ Summer Nash was named the Mountain West Player of the Week on Nov. 5. She came off the bench in both matches last week while helping the Aztecs to a pair of 3-1 road wins over UNLV and Fresno State as San Diego State moved into first place in the Conference.
- ◆ On Thursday, she entered the match in the fourth set and recorded a kill that ended the Rebels' 5-0 run to start the contest. With the score tied at 13-13, she added a kill that began a three-point SDSU run and gave the Aztecs the lead for good en route to the set and match win. Nash finished the set with three kills and one error in seven attempts.
- At Fresno State on Friday, she came off the bench in the second set and played in each of the final three sets, leading the Aztecs in the match with 16 kills. Her .600 hitting percentage and two solo blocks against the Bulldogs were both career highs.
- ◆ For the week, Nash averaged 4.75 kills, 0.75 blocks and 0.25 digs per set, while hitting at a .531 clip. She averaged 5.38 points per set over four total sets.

HANNASCH LEADS OFFENSE

- Andrea Hannasch has averaged 3.14 kills, 1.19 blocks and 1.86 digs per set over the Aztecs' last five matches.
- ◆ She has reached double figures in kills in each of those five contests and 11 of the last 12.
- ◆ Hannasch notched her first doubledouble of the season with 11 kills and 10 assists in the Aztecs' win at Fresno State on Nov. 3.
- ◆ She recorded a season-high nine total blocks (1 unassisted, 8 assists) in the win over Wyoming on Oct. 27.
- ◆ The eight assists tied her personal season high as well.
- ◆ Her season average of 3.58 points per set leads the Aztecs.
- ◆ She tied her season high with 19 kills in the win over New Mexico on Oct. 1.
- Hannasch is one of two Aztecs (along with Emily Harris) to have recorded at least one block in every match this season.

JACKELS DIGGIN' IT

- Libero Kristi Jackels has averaged 5.63 digs per set over SDSU's last four matches.
- She has recorded 20 or more digs in a match on seven occasions during the 2012 season.
- She set her season high with 28 digs in the four-set win over Colorado State on Oct. 25.
- Jackels tied her season high with three points in the win at UNLV on Nov. 1 with a kill and a pair of service aces.

WABER ON THE OFFENSIVE

- Over SDSU's last four matches, Michelle Waber has averaged 4.06 kills and 4.59 points per set.
- ◆ She has been in double figures in kills in each of the last five contests.
- Her 18 kills against Wyoming (Oct. 27) was her second-highest output of the season.
- She totaled 21.0 points and had three service aces in that match to equal her personal season bests in each category.

FOUCH'S BEST EFFORTS

- Setter Johnna Fouch recorded a seasonhigh 61 assists in the win at Fresno State on Nov. 3.
- Her four blocks assists and four total blocks were both her season highs.
- She completed her seventh double-double of the year with 14 digs in that match as well.
- ◆ She has recorded double-doubles in each of SDSU's last three matches.
- ◆ Fouch set career-highs with six kills and 8.5 points in the three-set victory at UC Irvine on Oct. 16.
- ◆ Her three blocks vs. New Mexico two days later Oct. 18 tied her 2012 season best.
- She is hitting .421 from her setter position with only two attack errors in 57 attempts.
- She set personal season highs with 55 assists and 16 digs in the win over UNLV on Oct. 7.
- ◆ Fouch also had a career-high five service aces in that match vs. the Rebels.

HARRIS ON THE BLOCK

- ◆ Emily Harris has emerged as the team's leading blocker averaging 1.28 per set.
- With 126 blocks assists she is tied for the tenth spot on the SDSU top 10 list for block assists in a season.
- ◆ She notched a career-high 10 block assists at Air Force on Oct. 13.
- Harris turned in a personal season high
 12 kills in the win at Fresno State on Nov.
 3
- ◆ Her .600 hitting percentage in that match was her second highest of the year.
- ◆ Harris leads the squad in hitting percentage at .325.

SHELTON ON THE OFFENSIVE

- ◆ Raegan Shelton had a string of eight straight games with 14 or more kills end in the win at UNLV on Nov. 1
- ◆ The previous week she averaged 3.75 kills per set in SDSU's matches against Colorado State (Oct. 27) and vs. Wyoming (Oct. 27).
- In league matches she ranks eighth at 3.24 kills per set and 10th with a mark of 3.72 points per set.
- ◆ Her 20 kills against Air Force on Oct. 13 matched her season high that she

- Her five blocks in the contest vs.
 Wyoming (Oct. 27) was her career best in that category.

WORKING OVERTIME

- ◆ San Diego State has played nine five-set matches this season and has a record of 7-2 in those contests.
- ◆ The Aztecs' mark for most five-set contests in a season is 11 during the 1989 campaign.
- ◆ The last time SDSU had as many as nine five-set matches in a season was in 1988 and this is the seventh time in program history that they have reached that figure.
- ◆ The Aztecs have now gone six contests without having to play a five-set match, their longest such streak of the season.

AMONG THE MW LEADERS

- Several Aztecs ranks among the top 10 in various categories in the Mountain West statistics.
- Emily Harris is fourth in hitting percentage (.325) and fifth in blocks (1.28/set).
- Andrea Hannasch is seventh in blocks (1.08/set), ninth in hitting percentage (.287) and 10th in points (3.58/set).
- ◆ Johnna Fouch is sixth is assists (8.66/set).
- ◆ Kristi Jackels is seventh in digs (4.11/set).
- ◆ Summer Nash is 10th in kills (3.04/set).

MOVING UP THE CHARTS

- ◆ Three current Aztecs moved into the top 10 on the SDSU career lists in various categories last season and continue to move up the charts.
- Andrea Hannasch's three-year total of 458 block assists moves her into the numbertwo spot on the SDSU all-time list. The all-time leader is Jennifer Miller (1989-92) with 480 block assists.
- Kristi Jackels has compiled 1,781 digs during her time as an Aztec to rank second in that category. Aime Cordeiro (2004-07) is the all-time leader with 1,974 career digs.
- ◆ Setter Johnna Fouch's mark of 3,262 career assists place her third. The second spot is held by Melissa Wright (2000-02) with 3,865 assists.

ALL-TOURNAMENT AZTEC

- ◆ Junior outside hitter Raegan Shelton was named to the all-tournament team at the Fullerton Classic (Sept. 14-15).
- ◆ Shelton average 2.88 kills while hitting at a .272 clip.
- ♦ She also had 1.69 digs per set and 0.56 blocks per set to earn the honor.
- ◆ Her 15 kills against Oregon State was her season high and she also set a career best with 12 digs.
- ◆ She recorded her first double-double of the season in that contest against OSU.

ALL-TOURNEY PART II

- Andrea Hannasch and Michelle Waber earned all-tournament honors at the season-opening Aztec Invitational (Aug. 24-25).
- Over SDSU's two matches that weekend, Hannasch average 3.75 kills, 1.38 digs, 1.12 blocks and 4.62 points per set while hitting .545.
- Waber, meanwhile, averaged 4.50 kills, 4.94 points and 1.13 digs per set en route to being named tourney MVP.

ALL-TOURNEY PART III

- ◆ Sophomore outside hitter Michelle Waber and junior middle blocker Emily Harris were named to the all-tournament team at the Aztec Challenge (Aug. 31-Sept. 1).
- Waber averaged 3.22 kills, 2.00 digs and .056 blocks per set while hitting .309 over the Aztecs three matches.
- ♦ Harris recorded a .417 hitting percentage and averaged 1.80 kills and 1.50 blocks.

ALL-TOURNEY PART IV

- Senior libero Kristi Jackels was named to the all-tournament team at the Verizon Volleyball Challenge in Honolulu (Sept. 7-9).
- Over SDSU's three matches she averaged 3.58 digs per set and turned in a seasonhigh 23 in the contest against Hawai'i.
- Jackels also had 12 assists (1.00 per set) and a service ace during the weekend competition.

PLAYER OF THE WEEK

- Senior middle blocker Andrea Hannasch was named the Mountain West Player of the Week for her performance at the Aztec Invitational during the weekend of Aug. 31-Sept. 1.
- ◆ Against Delaware, she recorded a .643 attack percentage on 11 kills to go along with four digs and six block assists.
- ♦ Her 19 kills in the win over Cal was one shy of her career high as an Aztec.
- ◆ For the week, Hannasch averaged 3.75 kills, 1.38 digs and 1.12 blocks per set, while hitting .545. She averaged 4.62 points per set over eight total sets.

PLAYER OF THE WEEK AGAIN

- Middle blocker Andrea Hannasch earned Mountain West Women's Volleyball Player of the Week honors on Oct. 8 after leading the Aztecs to victories over Fresno State and UNLV.
- ◆ In the win over Fresno State, Hannasch recorded 14 kills, nine digs and five blocks while amassing a .370 hitting percentage. She also tied her season- and career-high of three assists and served up two aces, including one on match point in the fifth set that gave SDSU the win.
- Her 19 kills in the victory over UNLV were a season-best and one shy of her career-high. She also tallied eight digs and five blocks in the match while posting a .385 hitting percentage.
- ◆ For the week, Hannasch averaged 3.30 kills, 1.70 digs and 1.00 blocks per set, while hitting .379. She averaged 4.00 points per set over 10 total sets.

AZTEC NOTES

- ◆ The Aztecs have lost back-to-back matches only once this season.
- ◆ Halle Aiken tied her career best with 11 digs in the win at UNLV on Nov. 1.
- ◆ The team's .333 hitting percentage in the victory at Fresno State on Nov. 3 was its second-highest of the 2012 campaign.
- ◆ The win over Colorado State on Oct. 25 ended a string of 22 straight losses to the Rams dating back to the 2002 season.
- ◆ Defensive specialist Courtney Vaccarello has averaged 2.50 digs per set over the last three matches.
- ◆ Setter Johnna Fouch (assists-digs) has recorded seven double-doubles this season to lead the team. Outside hitter Michelle Waber (kills-digs) has three and Chloe Mathis (assists-digs) has two while Raegan Shelton and Andrea Hannasch have one (kills-digs).
- Andrea Hannasch and Emily Harris are the only two Aztecs to have started every match this season. Senior Kristi Jackels has also been the starting libero for every match in 2012. They are the only three Aztecs to appear in all 102 sets in 2012.
