2021-22 Record: 22-7 (H: 14-1; A: 5-5; N: 3-1); 13-4 MW
 14-Time MW Champions, 13 Postseason Berths in Last 15 Years

- SDSU has won at least 19 games in 17 straight seasons.
- SDSU has advanced to the postseason in 13 of the last 15 seasons in which a champions was crowned (2006 NCAA, 2007-09 NIT, 2010-15 NCAA, 2016 NIT, 2018 NCAA, 2021 NCAA).
- SDSU is 36-1 last 37x when outrebounding its opp.
- SDSU is 34-1 last 35x when leading at the half.
- SDSU is 73-3 last 76x it has had a higher FG pct.
- SDSU is 3rd nationally in win percentage (84.3) since start of '19-20 season and 8th in win percentage (75.6) since start of the '09-10 season.
- Since its founding in 1999, no men's basketball program has won more Mountain West championships (regular-season and tournament) than San Diego State's 14.
- SDSU's 17 MW wins in 2019-20 are the most in MW history.
