LOBOS HOST #22 SAN DIEGO STATE IN SOLD OUT PIT

- UNM hosts No. 22 San Diego State on Saturday night as the first ranked foe visits this year
- New Mexico will be looking to win both home/away against an opponent ranked in both games for the first time since 2010-11 when the Lobos won twice against BYU (winning 86-77 vs. No. 9 BYU at The Pit and winning 82-64 at No. 3 BYU in Provo)
- The Aztecs are making their first visit to The Pit since January of 2020, making them the only Mountain West team that hasn't visited yet during the Richard Pitino era

SERIES HISTORY

- UNM leads 49-43 (UNM leads 30-12 in ABQ, all at The Pit)
- The Lobos' won the first meeting, 76-67, over then No. 23 SDSU at Viejas Arena on Jan. 14 as Jaelen House scored 29 points
- The Aztecs haven't visited Albuquerque in three seasons
- SDSU won the last meeting in The Pit, 85-57 in 2020, but the Lobos have won three of the last four meetings in Albuquerque
- UNM is looking to sweep the season series for the first time since the 2016-17 season

THE FIRST MEETING

- New Mexico defeated No. 23 San Diego State 76-67 on Jan. 14 in Viejas Arena
- The win snapped the Aztecs' 16-game home win streak
- Jaelen House had a season-high 29 points to lead the Lobos
- Jamal Mashburn, Jr. had 22 points and Morris Udeze had 10 points and 15 rebounds

AGAINST RANKED FOES

- New Mexico is 1-0 this season against ranked opponents (won at #23 SDSU)
- UNM is 2-0 against AP ranked teams in the Pitino era (defeated #22 Wyoming at home last year)
- The Lobos have won six of the last seven games when hosting a ranked Mountain West team in The Pit, dating back to 2011-12, with the only loss coming to No. 4 San Diego State in 2019-20

LAST TIME OUT

- New Mexico suffered an 82-77 loss at Boise State on Wednesday night
- The Lobos shot 37.7% from the floor, only their second game this season under 40%
- Morris Udeze had 18 points and 14 rebounds for his 12th double-double of the season
- Jaelen House had 14 points and six assists

MOVING ON UP!

- The Lobos enter the game at No. 49 in KenPom, just off their season high of No. 42, their highest KenPom ranking since ending the 2014 season at No. 33
- UNM has moved up 245 spots from the final ranking of 2020-21, when Richard Pitino was hired
- New Mexico is the highest mover in KenPom during that time (since April 2021), as the three of the top four are from the MW
- UNM started this season ranked No. 138 in KenPom

GET THE BALL INSIDE

- New Mexico has made it focus to get the ball inside this season, with just 27.4 percent of their field goal attempts this season coming from 3-point range, the 13th fewest rate nationally (national average is 37.4 percent)
- The Lobos are averaging 36.3 points per game in the paint (up from 28.4 points per game in the paint last season)

DRAWING FOULS

- New Mexico is one of the nation's best at getting to the free throw line this season, ranking 23rd nationally with a 39.5 FTA/FGA percentage
- Overall, UNM ranks 10th nationally in free throw attempts per game (23.6) and seventh in the nation with 17.4 made free throws per game
- The Lobos rank 32nd nationally with 21.7% of their points this season coming from free throws
- Three Lobos are averaging over 5.0 fouls drawn per 40 minutes, with Morris Udeze at 5.9 (ranks 60th nationally), Jaelen House at 5.3 and Jamal Mashburn, Jr. at 5.1
- The Lobos are 16-2 this season when shooting more free throws than their opponent

THREE TOP SCORERS

- New Mexico has three of the top seven scorers in the Mountain West with Jamal Mashburn, Jr. leading the league at 19.6 ppg, Jaelen House sixth at 16.8 ppg and Morris Udeze seventh in the league at 15.9 ppg
- UNM is the only school in the nation with three players averaging at least 15.7 ppg
- It marks the first time three Lobos have scored over 400 points in a season since 2013-14 (Cameron Bairstow, Kendall Williams, Alex Kirk)
- Their combined 52.3 ppg is the highest for a Lobo trio since 1979-80 when Kenny Page (28.0 ppg), Everette Jefferson (16.5 ppg) and Jim Williams (10.7 ppg) combined for 55.2 ppg

THREE LOBOS "AT THE PEAK"

- Three different Lobos have been named Mountain West Player of the Week with Morris Udeze (Nov. 28), Jaelen House (Jan. 16) and Jamal Mashburn, Jr. (Jan. 23) all honored
- It marks the first time since 2012-13 that three different Lobos have received the honor as Tony Snell, Alex Kirk and Kendall Williams earned the recognition that season
- It is the first career Mountain West Player of the Week honor for all three, but Udeze did win Player of the Week honors in the American in 2020-21 at Wichita State

2022-23 Opponents in Bold

CONSISTENT MASH

- Jamal Mashburn, Jr. had his streak of double-figure scoring snapped at 48 consecutive games with seven points at Boise State on Feb. 22
- It was the fifth-longest double-figure streak in UNM history, and the longest by a Lobo in 32 years (Luc Longley's school record 61-game streak from 1989-1991)
- It was the second-longest streak in Mountain West history, trailing only a 58-game streak by Brandon Heath of San Diego State

MASHBURN'S 20-POINT GAMES

- Jamal Mashburn, Jr. leads the Mountain West with 13 20-point games this season, including nine in conference play
- He leads the Mountain West in scoring in conference games at 21.5 ppg, as he looks to become the sixth Lobo (fifth different player) to average at least 20.0 ppg in MW games
- His streak of six straight 20-point games earlier this season tied for the seventh longest in New Mexico history and the longest by a Lobo since Elijah Brown had a seven-game streak in 2015-16

MASHBURN HITS 500 AGAIN

- Jamal Mashburn, Jr. enters the game with 548 points this year
- When he reached the 500-point mark this season, he became the 13th player in program history to have consecutive 500-point seasons (582 points last season)
- He is two points away from becoming just the eighth Lobo to have consecutive 550-point seasons
- Jaalen House (436 points this season) could also accomplish the feat this season (525 points last season)

JOINING THE 1,000 POINT CLUB

- Jamal Mashburn, Jr. became the 36th player in program history to score 1,000 points as a Lobo during the win over Air Force on Jan. 27
- He enters tonight's game with 1,130 career points, 29th on UNM's all-time scoring list
- Jaalen House is less than 100 points away from becoming the 37th player in UNM history to score 1,000 points as a Lobo

HOUSE NAMED TO OSCAR ROBERTSON TROPHY WATCH LIST

- Jaalen House was one of 50 players named to the Oscar Robertson Trophy Watch List by the USBWA as top candidates for their national player of the year award
- House was the only Mountain West player selected to the list and the first Lobo honored since Cameron Bairstow in 2013-14
- House is fourth in the MW in scoring, sthird in assists and ranks third nationally in steals

YOU AREN'T ROBBING THE HOUSE, THE HOUSE IS ROBBING YOU!

- Jaalen House leads the Mountain West and ranks third nationally with 2.73 steals per game
- His 71 steals this season puts him just 13 steals shy of Hunter Greene's single-season school record of 84 in 1986-87
- His 71 steals already ranks fifth most for a single-season in New Mexico history
- He has 10 games this season with at least four steals (T-1st in the nation)
- He has three six-steal games this season (tied for most in a game this season in MW)
- His 139 steals over the past two seasons ranks 14th on UNM's career list

1,000 POINTS IS A FAMILY TRADITION

- When Jaelen House scored his 1,000th career point on Jan. 3, he became the fourth member of his family to reach the milestone
- He joined his father, Eddie, who scored 2,044 career points from 1997-00 and is still the all-time leading scorer at Arizona State; his grandfather, Henry Bibby, who scored 1,293 career points from 1970-72 while helping UCLA to three straight NCAA titles; and uncle, Mike Bibby, who scored 1,061 points during his two seasons (1997-98) as an All-American at Arizona

THREE REACH 1K

- Jamal Mashburn, Jr., Jaelen House and Morris Udeze have all reached the 1,000 career point mark this year
- Mashburn scored his 1,000th career point (Minnesota and New Mexico combined) in the victory over Iona on Dec. 18, House scored his 1,000th career point (Arizona State and New Mexico combined) in the loss at Fresno State on Jan. 3, and Udeze scored his 1,000th career point (Wichita State and New Mexico combined) in the double OT loss at Nevada on Jan. 23
- One more Lobo could reach the 1,000 career point mark this season (Josiah Allick-953)

DOUBLE-DOUBLE UDEZE

- Morris Udeze leads the Mountain West with 12 double-doubles this season, the most by a Lobo in a season since 2013-14 when Alex Kirk had 14

- Udeze enters the weekend with nine double-doubles in conference play, more than twice the amount of any other player in the MW, and one away from Drew Gordon's school record of 10 double-doubles in regular season Mountain West play

- From January 7-17, Udeze had four straight double-doubles, the longest streak by a Lobo since Joe Furstinger had four straight double-doubles in December of 2017

- Udeze is on pace to be the first Lobo to average a double-double in Mountain West games since Drew Gordon in 2011-12

30-30 CLUB

- Morris Udeze (two) and Jamal Mashburn, Jr. (two) each have multiple 30-point games this season

- It marks the first time two Lobos have had multiple 30-point games in a season since 1993-94 when Greg Brown had four and Marlow White had three

- If one other Lobo posts a 30-point game this season (Jaelen House had four last season), it would be the first time since 1997-98 that three different Lobos had a 30-point game in the same season (Lamont Long, Clayton Shields, Kenny Thomas)

LOBO FRONT COURT HAS ITS "MOJO"

- New Mexico's frontcourt of transfers Morris Udeze and Josiah Allick have made an immediate impact this season

- They rank one-two in the conference in rebounding as Udeze leads at 9.3 rpg and Allick is second at 7.5 rpg

- Both Udeze and Allick have a pair of 15-rebound games this season after the Lobos went over three seasons without one

- The last time two Mountain West teammates had multiple 15-rebound games in the same season was UNLV's Brandon McCoy and Shakur Juiston in 2017-18

- New Mexico is one of three schools nationally to have its conference's top two rebounders (Arizona-Pac 12; Long Beach State-Big West)

GOTTA GO TO MO

- Morris Udeze was dominant during November's Lobo Classic, earning tournament MVP honors and being named Mountain West Player of the Week

- Udeze averaged 22.3 points per game in the tournament on 66.7% (24-36) shooting from the floor and 90.5% (19-21) shooting from the free throw line, in addition to 7.3 rebounds and 2.3 assists per game

- In the win over Jacksonville State, he matched his previous career high with 22 points (9-11 FG)
- In the victory over Northern Colorado, he set career highs of 33 points and 14 boards, the first 33/14 game by a Lobo in 20 years and the one of eight 33/14 games in the nation this season

MOUNTAIN WEST LEADERS

- New Mexico leads the MW in scoring offense at 81.0 ppg (17th nationally)
- The Lobos have the conference leader in scoring (Mashburn), rebounding (Udeze), field goal percentage (Udeze), steals (House), defensive rebounds (Udeze) and double-doubles (Udeze)

ROAD WARRIORS

- New Mexico is 6-5 away from home this season, including a 5-5 record in true road games
- The Lobos are one of four teams in the nation with multiple top-25 NET (as of 2/23) road wins this season (Alabama, Kansas State, TCU)
- New Mexico has already snapped Saint Mary's 23-game home win streak in November and San Diego State's 16-game home win streak in January
- The five road wins are already the most by UNM in a season since 2017-18 and look to win six true road games for the first time since 2013-14 with the next road win (eight road wins)

THE PIT IS ROCKING

- New Mexico has already drawn over 14,500 for six games at The Pit, including four over 15,000 this season
- The Colorado State game on Dec. 28 (15,215) was the first time over 15,000 attended a game at The Pit since 2015-16
- The UNLV game on Jan. 7 (15,424) was the first sellout at The Pit since 2014-15 and the largest crowd since 2009-10 (season before renovations reduced the capacity)
- Saturday's crowd will take the Lobos to over 200,000 fans for the season at The Pit, the first time since 2015-16 that they have reached that mark

PITINO'S RANKED WINS

- With the victory at No. 23 San Diego State on Jan. 14, Richard Pitino continued a streak of defeating a ranked opponent
- Going back to his tenure at Minnesota, Pitino has coached his team to a win over an AP ranked opponent in nine straight seasons (since 2014-15)
- He is one of 13 coaches nationally to have accomplished that feat

- The Lobos went a perfect 13-0 in non-conference play
- It is the fourth time since 1931-32 (when UNM first joined the Border Conference) that the Lobos went undefeated in regular-season non-conference play (not including the 4-0 COVID-shortened non-conference schedule in 2020-21)
- The Lobos' 13 non-conference victories are their most in a season since going 13-2 in non-conference play in 2012-13

NOVEMBER/DECEMBER TO REMEMBER

- The Lobos went 14-0 over the first two months of the season, entering the New Year undefeated for the fifth time in the modern era of the program (1995-96, 1973-74, 1972-73, 1967-68)
- UNM had numerous milestones during the first two months of the season, including...
 - Snapping Saint Mary's school-record 23-game home winning streak with a 69-65 victory
 - Winning 84-63 at SMU, the Mustangs' largest margin of defeat at Moody Coliseum in non-conference play since a 97-58 loss to No. 5 Kansas in 1994-95
 - Winning the Lobo Classic with wins over Jacksonville State, North Dakota State and Northern Colorado, UNM's first tournament title in 10 seasons

WE'RE GOING STREAKING

- The Lobos opened the season with a 14-game win streak, not just their best start to a season since 1967-68, but tied for the third-longest overall win streak in program history
- It trailed only the 17-game streak to open 1967-68 and a 15-game streak in 2009-10, and matched the 14-game streak in 1977-78
- Dating back to the end of last season, UNM won 12 straight games at The Pit before the loss to UNLV, its longest home win streak since a 15-game home win streak from March of 2019 to January of 2020
- The Lobos' 14-game win streak was the longest win streak in Richard Pitino's career (eclipsing eight-game win streaks at Minnesota in February/March of 2017 and November/December of 2014)

TOPPIN SIGNS WITH UNM

- On Nov. 9, New Mexico signed forward Jacyd Toppin to a National Letter of Intent to join the Lobos in summer of 2023
- A 6-9 native of Dallas, Toppin helped Faith Family Academy of Oak Cliff to the 2022 Texas Class 4A state championship
- He is the No. 38 ranked power forward nationally and the No. 17 overall player in Texas by 247
- Toppin has moved into the Rivals top 125 during his senior season
