No. 4/4 San Diego State Postgame Notes vs. Wyoming Steve Fisher Court at Viejas Arena | San Diego, Calif. Saturday, Jan. 21, 2020

Big Note

- San Diego State becomes the 10th team since the start of the 2010-11 season to open a campaign 20-0 (the Aztecs also did it in 2010-11). Of those 10 teams, all made the NCAA Tournament and won a game (at least made the round of 32) with four advancing to at least the Elite Eight.
- San Diego State matches the school record for best start to a season and the program's longest winning streak (20-0) with its victory over Wyoming.

Big Picture

- San Diego State extends the nation's longest winning streak to 20 games.
- San Diego State is the only undefeated team in the nation.
- SDSU's 20-0 start equals the best start in program history (20-0 in 2010-11).
- San Diego State's 20-game winning streak is the longest in the Brian Dutcher era and equals the longest in school history (2010-11 & 2013-14).
- Brian Dutcher has now been on the sideline for all three of the longest winning streaks in program history (also 2010-11 and 2013-14).
- The Aztecs improve to 44-41 all-time against Wyoming, 26-17 in Mountain West play, and 28-11 in games played in San Diego.
- San Diego State improves to 9-0 in Mountain West play for just the third time. The previous two times (2013-14 & 2015-16) resulted in outright conference championships.
- The nine-game conference win streak is the third longest in school history.
- San Diego State has won 11 straight home games, the ninth-longest streak in school history.
- San Diego State is 20-1 in its last 21 home games dating back to last season.

Tonight

- Tonight's game is a sellout. It is the fifth sellout of the year, the fifth in a row and the 117th in Viejas history.
- San Diego State led 32-19 at halftime. It is the 18th time in 20 games this season SDSU has taken a lead in to the intermission.
- The Aztecs have won 25 straight games when leading at the half, dating back to last season.
- Wyoming's 19 points at intermission mark the fourth time this season SDSU has held an opponent under 20 points in a half.
- The Aztecs shot over 50 percent from the field for the eighth time this season. SDSU has won 13 straight games when shooting at least 50 percent from the field and 82 straight games at home when shooting at least 50 percent from the field.
- San Diego State outshot its opponent for the 18th time this season. SDSU has won 27 straight games when outshooting its opponent.
- The Aztecs had fewer turnovers than their opponent for the 16th time this season.
- SDSU trailed for only 18 seconds in the game and led for 38:44 (the other 58 seconds the game was tied).

- SDSU outscored Wyoming:
 - 18-9 in points off turnovers
 - 30-18 in the paint
 - 18-1 in fastbreak points

Series Notes

- SDSU improved to 44-41 all-time against Wyoming, including a 28-11 record in San Diego.
- The Aztecs have won four straight in the series and seven of the past eight meetings.
- SDSU has won the last 12 games at home vs. Wyoming, dating back to a 66-65 loss on Jan. 3, 2007.

Player Notes

Malachi Flynn (18 points, 5 rebounds, 5 assists, 4 steals)

Reached double figures in scoring for the 10th straight game, 19th time this season (his other game was nine points) and 57th time of his career (first 38 came while he was at Washington State)... Led the team in scoring for the 13th time this season and 28th time for his career... Has at least one 3-pointer in 19 of the 20 games this season and multiple 3-pointers in 17 of the 20 games... Led the team in assists for the 13th time this season and 45th time of his career... Was 4-for-4 from the free-throw line and has now made 36 of his last 37 free-throw attempts (.973) dating back to the Cal Poly game on Dec. 28 (he missed his first free throw in that game, but made the last three)... Became just the sixth Aztec (eight times overall) since the 1996-97 season to record at least 18 points, 5 rebounds, 5 assists and 4 steals in the same game, and is the only player to have those numbers and make all of his free-throw attempts.

Matt Mitchell (15 points, 5-7 FG, 3-4 3PFG, 3 rebounds, 1 steal)

Scored in double figures for the fourth straight game, 11th time this season and 48th time of his career (SDSU is 35-13 in those games)... Now has scored in double figures in eight of the nine Mountain West games... Scored his 15 points in just 21 minutes of action... Tied a season high with three 3-pointers... Now has 116 3-pointers for his career, which is the 14th most in SDSU history.

Yanni Wetzell (14 points, 6-8 FG, 4 rebounds, 1 blocked shot, 2 assists)

Reached double-figures in scoring for the sixth straight game, 14th time this season and 23rd time of his career... Was 6-for-8 from the field and has shot 50 percent or better in five consecutive games (36-for-54, 66.7 pct. over the stretch).

Jordan Schakel (11 points, 1 rebound, 1 steal)

Scored in double-figures for the 12th time this season and 22nd time of his career (SDSU is 20-2 in those games)... Has 23 points over the past two games after scoring just seven over the previous two contests... Had multiple 3-pointers for the 11th time this season and 32nd time of his career (SDSU is 25-7 in those games)... Now has 112 3-pointers for his career, tying Richie Williams (2006-09) for 16th on the program's career lists.

KJ Feagin (5 points, 2 rebounds, 5 assists, 1 steal)

Recorded his fifth game this season with at least five assists and first since San Diego Christian on Dec. 18... Made a 3-pointer for the eighth straight game, his longest streak this season... His +24 plus/minus rating was the highest in the game.

Entering Today

- Entering the day, San Diego State was the only unbeaten team in the nation.
- San Diego State was 2nd in NET.
- San Diego State was 2nd in strength of record.
- San Diego State was 9th in the Sagarin Ratings.
- San Diego State was 10th in BPI.
- San Diego State was 9th in KenPom.
- San Diego State was 13th in RPI.
