SDSU Opens In New Mexico

In what has become an annual trip for the Aztecs, the San Diego State women's golf team opens its 2006-07 campaign at the 28th Annual Branch Law Firm/Dick McGuire Invitational in Albuquerque, N.M. The tournament begins on Monday, Sept. 11, with two rounds of action, followed by the final 18 holes on Tuesday. The Invitational features shotgun starts on both days.

The event, which is hosted by New Mexico, will be held at the Lobos' par-73, 6,069-yard University Golf Course. SDSU will be among a field of 17 teams from around the country, including eight teams ranked in the preseason *Golfweek* top 30 poll and five schools in the Mountain West Conference.

No. 2 Arizona State will be the favorite, followed by No. 10 Texas A&M, No. 14 Florida, No. 18 UNLV, No. 25 South Carolina, No. 26 BYU, No. 27 New Mexico and No. 30 TCU. Also competing are Hawaii, New Mexico State, UNC-Wilmington, Oregon, USF, Texas, Texas Tech and UTEP.

The Aztecs have opened the season at the Dick McGuire Invitational in four of the last five years and have played in five straight tournaments. A year ago, the team tied for 15th after finishing 16th in 2004. SDSU was 11th in 2003 and 18th overall to open the 2002 campaign.

Felicia Brown, entering her fifth season as head coach, will bring one senior and four sophomores with her to New Mexico. The group will be led by the team's lone senior in Jamie Oliver (Los Alamitos, Calif.), while redshirt sophomore Jackie Kazarian (Dana Point, Calif.) and sophomores Alana Erlandson (Palm Desert, Calif.), Maki Kamimura (West Covina, Calif.) and Heather Wilson (Chula Vista, Calif.) are also making the trip.

Kamimura is the lone golfer to have also played in the Dick McGuire Invitational a year ago, while Kazarian is competing in her first tournament since the 2004-05 campaign, after redshirting a year ago.

Flashback: 2005 Branch Law Firm/Dick McGuire

The San Diego State women's golf team jumped one spot in the final standings, moving into a 15th place tie with UTEP, following a final round 305 at the 27th annual Branch Law Firm/Dick McGuire Invitational Tournament in Albuquerque, N.M. The Aztecs ended their second tournament of the 2005-06 season with a 54-hole total of 44-over 920.

The top finisher for SDSU was Heather MacRae (Dunblane, Scotland), who ended the three-day tournament in 34th place, finishing at 7-over 226 for the tournament. MacRae shot even par with a season-best final round 73. It was a boost in the standings for MacRae, who began the day in 41st place. MacRae also posted an eagle on the eighth hole.

It was one of two eagles on the day for the Aztecs, with the other coming from redshirt freshman Megan McLeod (Fallbrook, Calif.) on her second hole of the round. McLeod

was fourth among SDSU golfers, finishing in 74th overall.

Sophomore Anna Booth (Coffs Harbour, Australia), followed MacRae as the second Aztec finisher. Booth shot a 10-over 229, with three birdies in the final 18 holes for a 75.

After her great start in the opening round which saw her card a 71, freshman Maki Kamimura ended the tournament in 62nd place overall, completing action with an 81, including two birdies.

Rewind: Aztecs Win Three Tournaments in 05-06

The San Diego State women's golf team won three tournaments during its 2005-06 season, including two during the fall and one in the spring. The Aztecs opened both seasons with a victory at the LaQuinta Inn & Suites Shootout (fall) and Lady Braveheart Invitational (spring), while also picking up a win at their home event, the Lady Aztec Fall Classic in mid-October.

SDSU rounded out the season with a fifth-place finish at the Mountain West Conference Championships. Then freshman Maki Kamimura (13th) and Alana Erlandson (t17th) both ended up in the individual top 20.

Three Aztecs also garnered conference all-academic honors.

Coming Attractions

Following this week's tournament in Albuquerque, the SDSU 'B' team of Anna Booth, MacKenzie Swecker (Winnemucca, Nev.), Kim Carmody (Palatine, Ill.), Ashley Wood (Lake Tahoe, Calif.) and Marcela Campbell (Glendale, Calif.) will travel to Flagstaff Arizona for the LaQuinta Inn & Suites Shootout, Sept. 18-19. SDSU is the defending tournament champions, edging runner-up Sacramento State by one stroke, 614-615 at the par-73, 6,002-yard Continental Country Club in Flagstaff, Ariz.

Current Aztec sophomore Megan McLeod won the individual title by two strokes and was the only golfer under par.

After the NAU tournament, the team heads to Colorado, Sept. 25-26, before returning to play host to their only home event of the season, the Lady Aztec Fall Classic, Oct. 16-17 at Salt Creek Golf Course (formerly The Auld Course) in Chula Vista.

Head Coach Felicia Brown

Head coach Felicia Brown is in her fifth season at the helm of the SDSU golf program after serving as an assistant in 2001-02. A native San Diegan, Brown prepped locally at San Marcos High School before playing collegiately at Arizona.

She is assisted by Doug Barba for the fourth year in a row.
