WHAT'S ON TAP THIS WEEKEND IN AZTEC BASEBALL

- ◆ After Tuesday's win over Cal State Northridge, San Diego State resumes Mountain West Conference play as it hosts a three-game series against Brigham Young.
- ◆ The Aztecs and Cougars will meet for games on Thursday (May 12) and Friday (May 13) at Tony Gwynn Stadium with first pitch set for 6:00 p.m. each evening.
- ◆ The series will conclude on Saturday, May 14, with a contest scheduled for a 1:00 p.m. start.

SENIOR DAY

- ◆ Saturday's game will be San Diego State's final regular-season home contest and has been designated Senior Day.
- ◆ The Aztecs will honor four senior members of the 2011 squad in a brief ceremony prior to the game.
- ◆ That foursome includes outfielder-third baseman Pat Colwell along with pitchers Craig Rasmussen, Steven Moranda and Ryan Wynveen.

SERIES RECORD

- ◆ San Diego State's all-time record against Brigham Young stands at 72-57-1 in the series that began back in 1957.
- ◆ BYU took two of three from the Aztecs in Provo earlier this season (March 24-26). SDSU's win in that series came in extra innings in the final contest.
- ◆ The Aztecs are 36-21 against the Cougars in San Diego, 23-28 in Provo and 12-6-1 at neutral sites.

SCOUTING THE COUGARS

- ◆ Brigham Young's record stands at 25-22 (7-9 MWC) after splitting a pair of home games against Gonzaga on Monday and Tuesday. BYU has won five of its last six games including a victory over sixth-ranked Arizona State.
- ◆ Offensive leaders for the Cougars include first baseman Ryan Bernal (.325, 5 HR, 25 RBI), outfielder Jaycob Brugman (.316, 12 doubles, 33 RBI), and shortstop Austin Hall (.288, 11 doubles, 16 SB).
- ◆ Three players are in double figures in stolen bases including Austin Hall (16), Andrew Law (16) and Jaycob Brugman (12).
- ◆ Pitchers Matthew Neil and Kolton Mahoney lead the Cougars with three saves apiece.
- ◆ Brigham Young is hitting .267 as a team with a 3.92 ERA.

HEAD COACH TONY GWYNN

- ◆ Tony Gwynn is in his ninth season as San Diego State’s head coach after being named to the position in Sept. 2001. He became just the fourth head coach in SDSU history since baseball was elevated to major sport status in 1936.
- ◆ In 2002, he served as a volunteer coach for the Aztecs under Jim Dietz, who retired at the end of that season.
- ◆ In 2004, Gwynn led his squad to the Mountain West Conference regular-season championship and was named the MWC Coach of the Year.
- ◆ A former Aztec who played baseball at San Diego State from 1979 to 1981, Gwynn concluded a 20-year major league career with the San Diego Padres in 2001. With a career batting average of .338, he won eight National League batting titles, five Gold Gloves, and made 15 appearances in the annual All-Star Game.
- ◆ He was inducted into the National Baseball Hall of Fame on July 29, 2007.
- ◆ His overall record entering the weekend stands at 259-273 (.487). His mark in conference contests is 131-93 (.585).

TORRES PROVIDES PUNCH

- ◆ Jomel Torres hit his second home run of the year on Tuesday vs. CSU Northridge.
- ◆ He has hit safely in 10 of the last 12 games going 18-for-44 (.409) with three doubles, nine RBI and 14 runs scored.
- ◆ He has also drawn 14 walks and been hit by pitch once over that span for a .559 on-base percentage.
- ◆ He leads the Aztecs in multiple-hit games with 17 and is second with nine multiple-RBI efforts.
- ◆ He has reached base safely (hit, walk or hit by pitch) in each of the last 19 games.
- ◆ Torres has walked at least once (total of 13) in each of the last eight contests.
- ◆ He has scored at least one run in nine of SDSU’s last 10 contests.
- ◆ Torres is the only Aztec hitter among the regulars with more walks than strikeouts (38 BB, 32 K).
- ◆ His career walk total of 89 ranks 13th on the SDSU all-time list.

SMITH CONTINUES SOLID OFFENSIVE PLAY

- ◆ Freshman outfielder Cody Smith has the team’s current longest hitting streak at 11 games.
- ◆ In those 10 contests he is hitting .416 (20-for-48) with six doubles, a triple and 11 runs scored.
- ◆ He had a career-high four RBI in the contest at Utah last Saturday (May 7).
- ◆ He had his first three-hit effort of the year in Sunday’s (May 1) game at Western Carolina and followed that up with another three-hit contest vs. Long Beach State on Tuesday (May 3).
- ◆ He recorded three hits again on Tuesday (May 10) vs. Cal State Northridge.
- ◆ He hit his first homer as an Aztec in the game against Oral Roberts on April 3, a three-run shot over the right field fence.
- ◆ His three runs batted in during that contest were a season high.
- ◆ Smith had a season-long seven-game hitting streak end during the March 29 game vs. CSU Northridge.
- ◆ He is hitting .459 (17-for-37) with runners in scoring position.

BRYANT HITTING AWAY

- ◆ Freshman outfielder Dillon Bryant has hit safely in each of the last 10 games, going 10-for-30 (.333) with a pair of doubles, six RBI and five runs scored.
- ◆ He has also drawn nine walks and been hit by pitch once over that span for a .500 on-base percentage.
- ◆ He drove in the winning run against CSU Northridge on Tuesday (May 10) when he was hit by pitch with the bases loaded in the bottom of the ninth.
- ◆ He had a season-high three RBI in the series finale at Western Carolina on May 1.
- ◆ Bryant is one of two Aztec hitters with more than one pinch hit as he has gone 2-for-8 in that role.
- ◆ He has not committed an error this season (39 chances) playing primarily in left and right field.

WILSON SOLID AT THE PLATE

- ◆ Chris Wilson turned in his second four-RBI effort of the season in last Saturday's (May 7) win at Utah.
- ◆ He is one of the Aztecs to have driven in as many as four runs in a game in 2011.
- ◆ Wilson hit his team-leading 14th and 15th doubles of the season during the first two games of the series at Western Carolina (April 29-30).
- ◆ He had a streak of 15 games in which he reached base (via hit, walk or hit by pitch) come to an end in the final game at Western Carolina on Sunday (May 1).
- ◆ He tied a school record when he hit three home runs in the contest against Air Force on Thursday, April 21.
- ◆ He hit solo homers in the second and sixth innings plus a two-run blast in the eighth.
- ◆ He just missed a fourth homer with a fly ball to the warning track in the ninth.
- ◆ Wilson tied the SDSU record held jointly by Brad Gennaro (4/4/92 at Air Force) and Javier Ramos (3/21/99 at Air Force).
- ◆ He also had a single in the game to finish with four hits, four RBI and three runs scored.
- ◆ Wilson had a team season-best 15-game hitting streak that ran from March 11-26.
- ◆ During that streak he hit .363 with seven doubles, a triple, two home runs and 14 runs batted in.
- ◆ He has started 23 times in the outfield (left or right) and 17 times at catcher this year.

COLWELL GETTING ON BASE

- ◆ Fifth-year senior Pat Colwell has reached base safely (via hit, walk or hit by pitch) in each of the last 21 games.
- ◆ He had a season-best six-game hitting streak end on Saturday (May 7) at Utah.
- ◆ His 10 sacrifice bunts this season tie for seventh-most in a season for an Aztec and

give him a career total of 26, third-most on the SDSU all-time list.

- ◆ After playing in center and right field almost exclusively during his first three seasons at SDSU, he has moved from center field to the starting role at third base for 25 the past 26 contests.
- ◆ Prior to this season, he had appeared at third on only four occasions, starting there in four contests in 2009.
- ◆ Colwell has had a pair of four-hit games this season: vs. third-ranked Oklahoma on March 6 and vs. New Mexico on March 20.
- ◆ Only he and teammates Chris Wilson and Brandon Meredith have had as many as four hits in a game this season.

SWANSON GETTING SUPPORT

- ◆ In freshman left-hander Cole Swanson's four wins, the Aztecs have scored 41 runs including reaching double digits in three of those contests. SDSU scored just four runs in the game he lost.
- ◆ After missing one turn in the rotation due to injury, freshman Swanson has picked victories as the starting pitcher each of the past two weekends.
- ◆ Last Saturday (May 7) he was the winning hurler at Utah after allowing three runs (two earned) on seven hits with four strikeouts over 6.2 innings.
- ◆ In the win at Western Carolina on April 30, the freshman left-hander allowed five runs over 6.1 innings, but received enough run support to improve to 3-1 on the year.
- ◆ He had recorded his second win of the year in 11-8 victory over Utah on April 9 when he tossed 5.1 innings vs. the Utes.
- ◆ Swanson recorded his first career win in SDSU's victory over Brigham Young on March 26.
- ◆ In that game he went nine innings, allowing two runs (one earned) on six hits with a walk and a career-best eight strikeouts.

- ◆ Opponents are hitting just .225 against him. That mark ranks fifth in the Mountain West Conference this week while his 3.39 earned run average is eighth-best in the league.

ZIER GETTING ON

- ◆ Freshman second baseman Tim Zier (Escondido HS) has hit safely in each of the last five games going 8-for-22 (.364).
- ◆ He recorded two hits in the game vs. Long Beach State last Tuesday (May 1).
- ◆ He also had a pair of hits in each of the last two contests at Utah last weekend.

KENDZORA IN RELIEF

- ◆ Freshman TJ Kendzora has his best performance since the opening weekend of the season with a stellar relief effort against Cal State Northridge on Tuesday (May 10).
- ◆ He entered the game in the second inning with two men on and no outs and went on to toss the next 7.2 innings, allowing a run on three hits with two walks and seven strikeouts.
- ◆ It was his longest outing of the year, surpassing his six-inning start against Winthrop when he allowed a run on one hit with three walks and three strikeouts.
- ◆ Kendzora's seven K's against Northridge were a season high.

MEREDITH CONSISTENT

- ◆ Brandon Meredith is hitting .326 (14-for-43) over SDSU's last 12 games.
- ◆ Over those 12 games he has recorded five doubles, two home runs, 11 runs scored and 13 runs batted in.
- ◆ He had his first four-hit effort of the year on April 30 at Western Carolina that included two doubles and a home run.
- ◆ His 34 walks give him a career total of 96, a mark that ranks ninth on the SDSU all-time list.
- ◆ He was hit by pitch in each game during the series at Western Carolina (April 30-May 1) and now second in the SDSU career record book in that category with 35, one behind Pat Colwell.
- ◆ Meredith has four triples this season after recording none during his first two seasons at SDSU.
- ◆ He is hitting .375 (21-for-56) with runners in scoring position and leads the team with 10 multiple-RBI games.

BLACK PITCHING WELL

- ◆ Sophomore right-hander Corey Black had a fourth consecutive good start in the opener at Utah last Friday (May 6).
- ◆ He tossed a complete game, going eight innings and giving up three runs on five hits with six strikeouts.
- ◆ Unfortunately he took the loss as the SDSU offense was unable to generate any support in a 3-0 loss.
- ◆ Black had picked up his third win of the year in his previous start at Western Carolina (April 29) when he went seven innings and allowed two runs on three hits with eight strikeouts.
- ◆ In his four starts he has allowed three earned runs while striking out 14 over 15 innings for a 1.80 earned run average.
- ◆ Black has struck out 53 in 49.1 innings this season with a career-high 13 in eight innings vs. 15th-ranked Arkansas on March 11.
- ◆ He is expected to start the opening game of this weekend's series at Utah.

HAYNAL RECOVERING

- ◆ Freshman catcher Brad Haynal suffered a twisted knee while behind the plate in the opener at Air Force on April and has played only three times in the 11 games since.
- ◆ He returned to the lineup in the DH role in the middle game against Western Carolina (April 30) and was the starting catcher in the opener at Utah last weekend (May 6) as well as on Tuesday (May 10) vs. Cal State Northridge.
- ◆ He has started over half (27) of SDSU's games behind the plate this season.
- ◆ Haynal had reached base (via a hit, walk or HBP) in 14 games before the streak ended vs. TCU on April 16.
- ◆ He had a personal-best six-game hitting streak ended on March 15 in the game at Loyola Marymount. During that streak he went 10-for-24 (.417) with three doubles, a home run and eight RBI.

VASKO IMPRESSES

- ◆ Junior Ben Vasko has hit safely in each of the past eight games in which he has appeared and 10 of the last 11.
- ◆ During his streak he has gone 11-for-27 (.407) with six RBI and eight runs scored.
- ◆ He has scored at least once in seven of the last eight games in which he has appeared.
- ◆ In the series finale at Western Carolina on May 1 he went 2-for-2 with a walk, three RBI and a run scored.
- ◆ His three RBI came on a bases-loaded double.
- ◆ Vasko's best day at the plate came on March 29 vs. Cal State Northridge when he went 3-for-5 with a double, home run, two runs scored and four RBI.

BLUMAN ON THE MOUND

- ◆ Freshman left Mitch Bluman has gotten the job done out of the bullpen in recent weeks and made his first start on April 26 vs. UC Riverside.
- ◆ Against UCR he tossed seven innings allowing two runs on four hits with a pair of walks and two strikeouts, but was not involved in the decision against the Highlanders.
- ◆ In the May 1 game at Western Carolina, he entered the game with SDSU holding a two-run lead. After WCU put runners on second and third with no out, he retired the next three hitters to record his first save as an Aztec.
- ◆ He has given up just two runs overall in 12 relief stints with seven strikeouts in 9.2 innings for a 1.86 earned run average.
- ◆ His pitching has earned him the No. 3 spot in the SDSU rotation.
- ◆ Bluman doubles as a first baseman, making 10 appearances there including three starts.
- ◆ He is also 2-for-2 as a pinch hitter.

HAYNAL TIMES TWO

- ◆ Brothers Austin and Brad Haynal are both first-year Aztecs who arrived at San Diego State via different routes.
- ◆ Austin, a junior pitcher, came to SDSU from College of the Desert after also having played at Palomar JC.
- ◆ Brad, a freshman catcher, is a product of Rancho Bernardo High School.
- ◆ In the game against Connecticut on March 5, Austin came on in relief with Brad behind the plate.
- ◆ It was the first time that the Aztecs had a brother duo as a battery in a game since the 2001 season when Jon and Jacob Minter were the pitcher and catcher in the same contest (vs. Houston, Feb. 10, 2001).

DEFENSIVE IMPROVEMENT

- ◆ Over the last 13 games SDSU has a .985 fielding percentage.
- ◆ That compares to a .958 percentage in the first 35 contests.
- ◆ SDSU committed just three errors in its last seven games (.989 fielding percentage).

AZTECS IN THE MWC STATS

- ◆ San Diego State has two players ranked among the top 10 in batting average in Mountain West Conference games: Chris Wilson (eighth - .375) and Jomel Torres (10th - .361).
- ◆ Torres ranks fourth in on-base percentage (.500) with Wilson eighth (.432).
- ◆ Wilson's nine doubles is fifth-most in conference games and he is third with four home runs. He is also third in slugging percentage at .694.
- ◆ Time Zier is first in sacrifice flies (3) and ninth in runs scored (16).
- ◆ Torres leads the league in walks with 16 with Brandon Meredith second with 14.

GETTING PLUNKED

- ◆ Two of SDSU's players adept at getting hit by pitch during their college careers will be on the field this season.
- ◆ Senior Pat Colwell, who was hit in last Tuesday's (May 3) game vs. Long Beach State, has assumed the career lead with 36 HBPs.
- ◆ Junior Brandon Meredith is right behind him at 35.
- ◆ Meredith has been hit 10 times this season while Colwell has been plunked on five occasions.
- ◆ Meredith was hit 14 times during the 2010 season, a total that ranks second all-time for an SDSU batter.
- ◆ His 10 hit by pitches in 2011 ties for 11th on the SDSU single-season list.

AZTECS GET 100TH WIN AGAINST UTES

- ◆ San Diego State recorded its 100th win against the University of Utah with the 5-3 victory on April 8.
- ◆ The Aztecs' record vs. Utah now stands at 101-31. The 101 wins are the most for the Aztec baseball program against any team.
- ◆ Its next highest win total is vs. New Mexico against whom SDSU has an all-time record of 97-55.
- ◆ The Aztecs have played the most games vs. Fresno State, a total of 163 contests with a 79-84 record.
- ◆ SDSU has played over 100 contests against seven other schools including Brigham Young (71-55-1), Cal State Los Angeles (75-46), Hawaii (67-78), Long Beach State (77-47-1), San Diego (65-48-3), UC Santa Barbara (80-29-1) and UNLV (58-44).

YOUTH WILL BE SERVED

- ◆ Of the 32 players on San Diego State's roster, 16 are true freshmen.
- ◆ Three others are in their first year at SDSU after arriving from the JC ranks.
- ◆ Over half (20) of the athletes on the 2011 roster are from San Diego county.

AZTECS PICKED THIRD

- ◆ For the second straight year, San Diego State has been picked to finish third in the Mountain West Conference standings.
- ◆ In a vote of the six MWC head coaches and a select media panel, the Aztecs received 75 points to finish behind favorite TCU, which is favored to win the league title for the fifth consecutive season, and BYU.

AZTEC NOTES

- ◆ The Aztecs have a record of 5-3 over their last eight games.
- ◆ San Diego State has drawn an average of just under seven walks per game in its last six contests.
- ◆ The Aztecs have been in double digits in hits in five of the last seven games.
- ◆ Sophomore right-hander Ethan Miller made his first relief appearance of the season at Utah on Sunday (May 8), tossing 4.1 innings and allowing a run on five hits with a walk and strikeout.
- ◆ Evan Potter record his first two doubles of the year in back-to-back games at Utah on May 7-8.
- ◆ The Aztecs had 10 doubles during the three-game series at Western Carolina (April 29-May 1) including a season-high five in the middle contest.
- ◆ Senior lefty Craig Rasmussen picked off his seventh runner of the season against UC Riverside on April 26 to tie for the most in the MWC this season. His seven pickoffs is a new SDSU record.
- ◆ Twelve different Aztecs pitchers have made at least one start on the mound this season.
- ◆ SDSU has a record of 5-2 in one-run games this season and is 2-3 in extra-inning contests.
- ◆ SDSU's most productive innings on offense has been the seventh when it has scored 33 runs. Conversely, the Aztecs have put up only 18 runs in the second.
- ◆ Two of SDSU's nine pinch hits this season have been solo home runs (Denny Vigo and Brad Haynal).
- ◆ The team's 15 runs and 18 hits in the contest at Air Force on April 21 were both season highs for the team.

UP NEXT

- ◆ After this week's series against Brigham Young, the Aztecs will head to Las Vegas next week for its final series of the regular season.
- ◆ San Diego State will play three games at UNLV beginning with a contest on Thursday, May 19, at 7:00 p.m. at Earl Wilson Stadium.
- ◆ The Aztecs and Rebels will also meet on Friday (May 20) at 7:00 p.m. and Saturday (May 21) at 1:00 p.m.
