The contest was halted due to SDSU travel and will be resumed starting at 5:00 p.m. Friday in the top of the 10th inning with San Diego State at bat, a runner at second, two outs and the score tied 6-6.

WHAT'S ON TAP THIS WEEKEND IN AZTEC BASEBALL

- ◆ After its 4-2 loss at Long Beach State on Tuesday, San Diego State returns home to face Mountain West foe Nevada in a series that will include the completion of a suspended game from earlier this season.
- ◆ On Friday, April 29, the Aztecs and Wolf Pack will conclude the game that was halted in Reno due to SDSU's travel schedule with the contest tied at 6-6 heading into the bottom of the 10th inning. That game will resume at 5:00 p.m.
- ◆ That teams will then play the regularly scheduled contest which is tentatively slated to begin at 6:00 p.m. Friday night depending on the length of the suspended game.
- ◆ The Aztecs and Wolf Pack will also hook up for games on Saturday (April 29) and Sunday (May 1) at 2:00 p.m. and 1:00 p.m. (PT) respectively.

ON THE AIR

- ◆ The broadcast of Friday's games vs. Nevada is TBA at this time.
- ◆ Saturday's and Sunday's contests vs. the Wolf Pack will have live video streaming on the Mountain Digital Network and will also be carried on AM 1700 radio in San Diego. Links for those outlets may also be found at the SDSU web site (www.GoAztecs.com).
- ◆ In addition, live stats will be available for all of the games this weekend with the links available at GoAztecs.com.

SERIES RECORD

- ◆ San Diego State's record against Nevada stands at 13-17 since the teams first met during the 1986 season.
- ◆ Nevada won two games in Reno in early April with a third game suspended and expected to be completed this weekend.
- ◆ Last season the Wolf Pack swept a three-game series at Tony Gwynn Stadium in mid-April in the only meetings between the teams during the regular season.
- ◆ At the 2016 Mountain West Tournament in Reno, the Aztecs defeated Nevada, 9-7, in an elimination game.
- ◆ The Aztecs are 6-7 at home, 3-9 away and 4-1 on neutral fields in previous contests against Nevada.

THORNTON HEATING UP

- ◆ Senior left fielder Spencer Thornton is hitting .364 (20-for-55) over SDSU's last 15 games with three doubles, a triple, three home runs, five RBI and 12 runs scored.
- ◆ He has gone 2-for-4 in each of SDSU's last four contests.
- ◆ He hit his fifth home run, a solo shot in the eighth inning, at New Mexico on Saturday (April 23).
- ◆ He is now leads the team in home runs with five, one more than teammate Tyler Adkison.
- ◆ His home run in the bottom of the eighth inning vs. UNLV on Saturday, April 9, broke a 7-7 tie and was the

game-winner is the Aztecs' 9-7 victory over the Rebels.

- ◆ He has reached base safely (via hit, walk or hit by pitch) in each of the past 22 contests.
- ◆ Thornton has drawn six walks in the last seven games and is tied for the team lead with 18 this season.

ADKISON HITS AWAY

- ◆ Sophomore Tyler Adkison has hit in five straight games and seven of SDSU's last eight contests.
- ◆ He had doubled in three consecutive contests prior to Sunday's (April 24) finale at New Mexico.

- ◆ He had a personal season-best nine-game hitting streak come to an end in the game at USD on April 12.
- ◆ During that streak he went 12-for-35 (.343) with three doubles, a triple, home run, 11 RBI and four runs scored.
- ◆ In the win over No. 20 Long Beach State on April 5, he led off with a triple in the 12th inning after which he scored the game-winning run in SDSU's 6-5 win.
- ◆ He hit a pair of home runs in the contest at Air Force on March 20.

TREJO KEEPS HITTING

- ◆ Shortstop Alan Trejo is hitting .370 (17-for-46) over SDSU's last 11 contests with a double, triple, six RBI and six runs scored.
- ◆ He hit his second homer of the season in the win over New Mexico on Sunday (April 24).
- ◆ Trejo went 5-for-11 with a triple during the previous weekend's three-game series at No.10 Texas Tech.
- ◆ He had a team season-high 15-game hitting streak end on March 25 vs. New Mexico.
- ◆ During that streak he batted .419 (27-for-66) with two doubles, 11 RBI and 12 runs scored.
- ◆ He has drawn a walk in each of the last three games.
- ◆ He has recorded multiple-hit efforts in almost half of SDSU's games this season (18 of 38).

NEVAREZ IN A PINCH

- ◆ Freshman Dean Nevarez made his fifth pinch hitting appearance of the year at New Mexico last Saturday (April 23).
- ◆ He responded with a two-run double.
- ◆ He has gone 2-for-4 as a pinch hitter this season with a walk.
- ◆ Nevarez is the only Aztec pinch hitter with more than one hit.

WYLIE CONSISTENT

- ◆ Second baseman Justin Wylie hit safely in all three games at New Mexico last weekend (April 22-24) going 6-for-14 with two doubles, two RBI and four runs scored.
- ◆ He hit his third homer of the year at USD on Tuesday, April 12, a solo shot in the top of the seventh inning.
- ◆ He tied his season high with three hits in the game on April 9, vs. UNLV.
- ◆ He hit a leadoff home run in the contest at Cal State Fullerton on March 15 to give SDSU an early 1-0 lead. His first home of the year had come in the previous contest vs. Northwestern.
- ◆ Wylie leads the squad in stolen bases with six.

VERDON HEATS UP

- ◆ Freshman Jordan Verdon had a pair of hits and drove in three runs in the win at New Mexico on Sunday (April 24).
- ◆ His RBI single in the ninth drove in SDSU's final important run in what ended up as a 10-9 win.
- ◆ He connected for his second home run of the season at USD on April 19, a three-run shot that extended SDSU's two-run lead to five runs in the eighth inning.
- ◆ He went 4-for-10 in the three-game series vs. UNLV (April 8-10) with a double and four RBI.
- ◆ His three RBI vs. the Rebels on April 8 was a season high.
- ◆ He had an 11-game hitting streak come to an end on March 26 vs. New Mexico.
- ◆ It was the third-longest hitting streak by an Aztec this season.
- ◆ During that streak he hit .361 (13-for-36) with a double, triple, three RBI and five runs scored.

HENSLEY STREAK ENDS

- ◆ David Hensley ended a three-game hitless streak with an RBI single at Long Beach State on Tuesday (April 26).
- ◆ He hit his first career home run in the second inning of the April 12 contest at University of San Diego, giving SDSU a 1-0 lead in a game it went on to win, 7-3.
- ◆ He had a 12-game hitting streak, second longest on the squad this season, come to an end in the series finale vs. UNLV on April 10.

- ◆ During that streak he hit .365 (19-for-52) with a two doubles, four RBI and eight runs scored.
- ◆ Hensley leads the team in sacrifice bunts with nine, a number that ties for 14th on the SDSU single-season list.

CONFERENCE HITTING

- ◆ Seven of SDSU's regular starters are hitting above the .300 mark in Mountain West Conference games.
- ◆ That list includes Justin Wylie (.365), Chase Calabuig (.362), Alan Trejo (.350), Jordan Verdon (.327), Spencer Thornton (.322), Andrew Brown (.313) and Tyler Adkison (.303).
- ◆ As a team the Aztecs are hitting .304 in league games.

STREAKS.

- ◆ SDSU's current longest hitting streak is five games by Tyler Adkison.
- ◆ The team's longest streak this season is 15 games by Alan Trejo.
- ◆ Spencer Thornton has reached base safely (via hit, walk or hit by pitch) in each of the last 22 games, the longest such streak by an Aztec this season.
- ◆ Trejo leads the Aztecs with 18 multiple-hit contests while Adkison leads with six multiple-RBI games.

PLAYER OF THE WEEK

- ◆ Shortstop Alan Trejo earned the Mountain West Baseball Player of the Week award for games played through Sunday, March 13, 2016.
- ◆ It is the first MW weekly accolade for Trejo, a sophomore from Downey, Calif. (Warren HS).
- ◆ He led San Diego State to a 2-1 week in a home series against Northwestern.
- ◆ Over the three contests he posted a batting average of .600 (9-for-15) with six runs scored, five runs batted in and one stolen base.
- ◆ Trejo had at least two hits and two runs scored in all three games with a .625 on-base and a .600 slugging percentage.
- ◆ Defensively, Trejo recorded seven putouts and 12 assists with no errors.
- ◆ He was also named the Madness Mountain West Player of the week by *College Sports Madness*.

GOOD START

- ◆ Two Aztec newcomers recorded hits in their first collegiate at bat during the season-opening series vs. No. 14 Oregon.
- ◆ Jordan Verdon singled to right center field in his first plate appearance in the contest on Feb. 19.
- ◆ Dean Nevarez delivered a single to center in his first plate appearance as a pinch hitter vs. Oregon on Feb. 20.

NAVARRO'S FIRST HIT

- ◆ After going hitless in his first six collegiate plate appearances, freshman Niko Navarro came through with an important single in the win over Fresno State on Sunday (March 6).
- ◆ He was called upon to pitch hit in the bottom of the eighth inning with the bases loaded, one out and SDSU trailing, 4-2.
- ◆ Navarro proceeded to deliver a single to right field to drive home two runs and tie the game.
- ◆ SDSU added a third run one batter later and went on to win, 5-4.

NEW COACHES

- ◆ The Aztecs have added a pair of new coaches to their staff for the 2016 season: Pitching Coach Sam Peraza and Volunteer Assistant Joey Centanni.
- ◆ Peraza arrives at SDSU after two seasons at Florida International. He also had previous experience at Cal State Northridge, Cal State Los Angeles and Eastern Oklahoma State.
- ◆ He is a 2002 graduate of San Diego State, where he pitched during the 2002 season.
- ◆ Centanni played four seasons as a pitcher and first baseman at Pacific, graduating in 2009. After college, he spent one season in the Baltimore Orioles organization before an injury ended his playing career.
- ◆ He later served as an associate scout for the Orioles in the San Diego area and coach locally at Francis Parker High School.

VETERAN HONOREES

- ◆ Five players who earned individual honors a year ago return for the 2016 season.
- ◆ Second baseman Alan Trejo was named to the all-tournament team at the 2015 NCAA Regional at Lake Elsinore, Calif.
- ◆ Pitcher Jacob Erickson, outfielder Spencer Thornton and designated hitter Justin Wylie earned all-tourney recognition at the 2015 Mountain West Conference Tournament.
- ◆ Outfielder Chase Calabuig was named a Louisville Slugger Freshman All-American and a second-team All-Mountain West selection.

PRESEASON ALL-CONFERENCE

- ◆ Outfielder Chase Calabuig has been tabbed to the Preseason All-Mountain West team in a vote of the league's coaches.
- ◆ Calabuig batted .305 with eight doubles and 25 RBI las season en route to second-team all-conference honors at the end of the 2015 campaign.
- ◆ He was also named a Louisville Slugger Freshman All-American by *Collegiate Baseball* magazine.

COLLEGE SPORTS MADNESS ALL-MW

- ◆ *College Sports Madness* also named Calabuig to its All-Mountain West first team while four other Aztecs earned second-team honors.
- ◆ That quartet included outfielder Spencer Thornton and third baseman Andrew Brown along with pitchers Marcus Reyes and Cody Thompson.

DRAFTED AZTECS

- ◆ Three current members of the SDSU squad have been drafted by Major League clubs.
- ◆ That trio includes junior catcher CJ Saylor (33rd rd. in 2012, Los Angeles Dodgers) along with sophomore outfielder Denz'l Chapman (32nd rd. in 2014, Oakland A's) and freshman first baseman Jordan Verdon (24th rd. in 2015, New York Mets).

AZTEC NOTES

- ◆ Chase Calabuig was 5-for-9 in the final two games at New Mexico on Saturday and Sunday (April 23-24) with a double, three RBI and a run scored.
- ◆ Jordan Verdon is one of six Aztecs to have recorded a double, triple and home run this season. The others include Alan Trejo, Tyler Adkison, Andrew Brown, Dean Nevarez and Chase Calabuig.
- ◆ Andrew Brown went 3-for-9 with two runs scored in the final two contests at New Mexico last weekend (April 23-24).
- ◆ Senior outfielder Spencer Thornton had his first four-hit game of the season in the contest at Nevada on April 1. Only Thornton and Alan Trejo have recorded four-hit efforts for the Aztecs in 2016.
- ◆ Shortstop Alan Trejo is the only player to have started all 38 games this season at the same position.
- ◆ Only one other Aztec has started all 38 games, but not at the same position each time: Justin Wylie (2B-3B-DH).
- ◆ Niko Navarro (1-for-3), Dean Nevarez (2-for-4) and Jordan Verdon (1-for-2) are the only three Aztecs to have recorded a hit as a pinch hitter. Aztec pinch hitters are 4-for-22 on the year.

UP NEXT

- ◆ Following the Nevada series this weekend, San Diego State remains at home to host Cal State Fullerton on Tuesday, May 3, for a contest at 6:00 p.m. at Tony Gwynn Stadium.
