Aztecs Welcome Colorado State for Weekend Series

The San Diego State softball team returns home to play host to Colorado State this weekend at SDSU Softball Stadium. Because of incoming rain on Saturday, the Aztecs (17-13, 4-2 MW) and Rams (18-12, 1-4 MW) will now play a doubleheader on Thursday, beginning at 4 p.m. PT, with a single game closing out the series at 6 p.m. PT Friday.

SDSU has won eight of its last 10 games, including each of its Mountain West series this season (March 15-17 vs. Utah State and March 22/24 at Fresno State).

Out of San Diego State's 24 non-conference games this season, 17 have come against teams that made the 2023 NCAA tournament (the Aztecs are 7-10 in those games), including three against Women's College World Series programs, and nine have been against nationally ranked squads (SDSU is 2-7).

UCF transfer Lala Macario leads San Diego State in batting average (.329), runs (24), on-base percentage (.431) and stolen bases (13). Mac Barbara (.304) has continued to provide pop with six of the Aztecs' 10 home runs and 27 RBIs, while slugging .557 with a .424 on-base mark. Barbara is the Mountain West preseason player of the year. Macey Keester (.311, 23-for-74) and Jade Ignacio (.310, 9-for-29) are also over .300 for SDSU.

The San Diego State pitching staff has shined so far this season, combining for a 2.39 ERA and 111 strikeouts in 208 innings against just 34 walks. Dee Dee Hernandez, who was named the MW Pitcher of the Week on Monday, leads the staff with a 6-2 record, one save and 1.80 ERA in 42 2/3 innings, striking out 25 with eight walks, limiting the opposition to a .229 average. Cece Cellura has come on strong in her first season on The Mesa, posting a 4-2 record with a 2.43 ERA in 63 1/3 innings, striking out 27 against four walks. Defending MW Pitcher of the Year and the preseason pitcher of the year Allie Light is 6-7 with two saves and a 2.60 ERA in 78 innings, striking out 43 with 19 walks. Cassidy West has also come along nicely, going 1-2 with two saves and a 2.62 ERA in 24 innings.

STACEY NUVEMAN DENIZ
HEAD COACH | 3RD SEASON (16TH OVERALL) | UCLA, 2002

- Was named San Diego State's fifth head coach in program history on June 8, 2021, taking over for SDSU's all-time winningest head coach Kathy Van Wyk.
- Helped lead SDSU to seven straight NCAA tournaments from 2009-15 and a combined 398-264 (.601) record in her 14 seasons on The Mesa as an assistant coach, associate head coach and head coach in waiting.
- In her first season as SDSU's head coach in 2022, San Diego State went 39-16 (.712) for the second-best winning percentage in school history, winning the Mountain West regular-season title for the first time since 2014.
- Was named the Mountain West Coach of the Year in 2022 in her first season as head coach.
- Is 95-46 (.674) as head coach at San Diego State, leading the Aztecs to a Mountain West Tournament title in 2023.
- Was the head coach of the National Pro Fastpitch's Chicago Bandits for the 2018 season, leading the Bandits to the NPF Championship series in her first year.
- Also has served as an assistant coach for the Women's National Team and USA Softball Junior Women's (19-Under) Selection Camps.
- As a player, was a three-time U.S. Olympian, winning gold medals in 2000 and 2004, and a silver medal in 2008. Also helped the United States National Team to a World Cup championship (2006), two World Championships (2002 and 2006) and two Pan American gold medals (1999 and 2003).
- Was a standout player at UCLA, finishing her four-year career with four NCAA records - 90 home runs, .945 slugging percentage, 240 walks and 81 intentional walks. She was a four-time first-team NFCA All-American (1997, 1999, 2001-02) and a three-time Pac-10 Player of the Year (1999, 2001-02).
- In 1999, Nuveman Deniz led the Bruins to a national championship, batting .446 during the season with 31 home runs and 91 RBIs.

Notes on the Season so Far

- * SDSU finished the 2023 campaign with a 39-17 record, advancing to the program's first super regional after capturing the NCAA Los Angeles Regional, and being ranked No. 18 in the final ESPN/USA Softball poll and 19th in the final USA Today/NFCA Coaches Poll.
- * San Diego State, which was one win away from making the Women's College World Series, won the Mountain West tournament, the first held since 2006, with a perfect 3-0 record after finishing second in regular-season play.
- * The Aztecs are off to a 17-13 start through 30 games with 13 played at home (6-7), nine neutral (6-3) and eight on the road (5-3).
- * Out of SDSU's 24 non-conference games, 17 have been against teams that made the 2023 NCAA tournament. San Diego State is 7-10 in those games.
- * The Aztecs have played three of the eight teams who made the 2023 Women's College World Series (No. 1/1 Oklahoma, No. 3/3 Stanford and Utah).
- * SDSU has already played nine teams who are nationally ranked, going 2-7 in those games with wins over then No. 25/rv Kentucky, 2-1, on Feb. 10 and then No. 11/13 Missouri, 3-2, on Feb. 22.
- * According to NCAA RPI (as of March 26), the Aztecs have played the 12th-toughest strength of schedule in the country this year with their opponents playing the 28th-toughest strength of schedule.
- * SDSU's non-conference strength of schedule is ranked as the 11th toughest.
- * San Diego State's average adjusted RPI loss this season is 36.
- * The Aztecs have already played seven games against the top-10 RPI schools in No. 3 Stanford (L, 3-0), No. 4 Oklahoma (L, 7-0), No. 5 LSU (L, 9-1, and L, 3-1), No. 6 Missouri (W, 3-2), and No. 8 Texas A&M (L, 7-5, and L, 1-0).
- * Eleven of the SDSU's 30 games so far have come against top-50 RPI schools (SDSU is 2-9).
- * Out of San Diego State's 13 losses, four have been by one run, five have been by two runs, two by three runs, one was by seven runs and one by eight.
- * The Aztecs are hitting .263 as a team, but much of that can be attributed to the teams they have played. Three all-Mountain West performers from a year ago have yet to get on track in Bella Espinoza (.253 this season with nine runs and six stolen bases, .393 last season with 57 runs and 30 stolen bases), Makena Brocki (.195 this season with nine RBIs and three extra-base hits, .297 last season with 33 RBIs and 19 extra-base hits) and Cali Decker (.270 this season with 11 RBIs and a .357 on-base percentage, .368 last season with 40 RBIs and a .462 on-base percentage). Decker, however, is hitting .350 (7-for-20) with a home run, five RBIs and three runs in six Mountain West games so far.

Dee Dee Hernandez Named Mountain West Pitcher of the Week

San Diego State softball's Dee Dee Hernandez (La Crescenta, Calif.) has been named the Mountain West Pitcher of the Week, the league announced Monday. It is the first conference weekly award for the left-hander.

Hernandez helped the Aztecs to a 2-1 series win at Fresno State last weekend. Hernandez went 2-0 with a 0.00 ERA in 10 1/3 innings across three appearances (one start), giving up just five hits and two walks, while striking out four. In all, opponents hit just .152 off her with all five hits being singles.

Hernandez opened her weekend on Friday, pitching 1 1/3 scoreless innings of relief in a 4-1 SDSU loss, giving up two hits and a walk. In a 5-1, 13-inning San Diego State victory in the nightcap, Hernandez hurled five scoreless innings with two hits and a walk allowed, striking out two. She ended her weekend by combining on a shutout with Allie Light in a 4-0 win on Sunday, tossing Tossed four scoreless innings with just one hit and no walks allowed, while striking out two.

On the season, Hernandez is 6-2 with a save and team-low 1.80 ERA in 42 2/3 innings. She has appeared in 18 games with two starts, combining on two Aztec shutouts. Hernandez has struck out 25 with just eight walks, while holding the opposition to a .229 average. Hernandez is even better in Mountain West play, going 3-0 with a 0.00 ERA in 11 1/3 innings.

SDSU Picked to Win MW; Mac Barbara, Allie Light Named Preseason Players of the Year

The San Diego State softball team has been picked to win the Mountain West, while Mac Barbara (player) and Allie Light (pitcher) have been chosen as the league's preseason players of the year, the league announced Jan. 31.

Barbara and Light were joined on the 15-player preseason team by fellow Aztecs Cali Decker and Bella Espinoza. This was the first time in MW history that preseason players of the year and a preseason all-conference team were announced.

The preseason poll, players of the year and all-conference team were voted on by the league's nine head coaches.

SDSU picked up 64 points, including eight of the nine first-place votes. Defending regular-season champion Boise State is second with 57 points and the other first-place vote, while Colorado State (46), Fresno State (41), Nevada (37), UNLV (28), Utah State (19), New Mexico (17) and San Jose State (15) round out the voting.

Barbara made her second straight MW first team last season after being named the MW Player of the Year in 2022. Barbara batted .358 (57-for-159) a year ago with 13 home runs, 45 RBIs, 34 runs, nine doubles, a triple and 33 walks, while slugging .673 with a .469 on-base mark. Barbara, a two-time first-team All-NFCA West Region (2022-23) player, was even better in league play, hitting .459 (28-for-61) with eight home runs, 24 RBIs and 18 runs in 24 games, drawing 14 walks with a .902 slugging percentage and a .564 on-base percentage.

Light, meanwhile, was named the MW Pitcher of the Year in 2023, while also making her first all-conference team (first team) and first appearance on the all-NFCA West Region (second team). A four-time MW Pitcher of the Week, including three straight weeks from March 28-April 11, Light was 15-7 with a 1.90 ERA and a school-record seven saves in 132 2/3 innings. She started 17 games and played in 40 overall, playing a part in six Aztec shutouts, and striking out 106 with 20 walks, while limiting the opposition to a .218 average. Light was even better in MW play, going 7-1 with two saves and a 1.37 ERA across 61 1/3 innings, striking out 36 against 12 walks, while limiting the opposition to a .213 average.

Decker made the most of her first season on The Mesa in 2023, batting .368 (56-for-152) with six home runs, 40 RBIs, 29 runs, four doubles and 26 walks, posting a .513 slugging percentage and an .462 on-base mark en route to becoming a second-team NFCA all-West Region pick and a second-team all-MW selection. Decker hit .386 (22-for-57) in MW play with a home run, 14 RBIs, 15 runs and 12 walks, owning a .456 slugging percentage and a .493 on-base percentage. She was also named to the all-Mountain West Tournament team, batting a team-high .700 (7-for-10) with a home run, five RBIs and two runs. In nine postseason games overall (three in MW tournament, six in NCAA tournament), she hit .429 (12-for-28) with three homers, 13 RBIs and four runs, slugging .750 with a .467 on-base mark.

Espinoza made her second straight all-MW team a year ago (first team in 2022, second team in 2023), leading SDSU in batting average (.393), runs (57), hits (75), stolen bases (30) and at-bats (191). Espinoza's 70 singles were a SDSU single-season record, and she also ranked second in single-season history in stolen bases (30), third in runs (57), tied for third in hits (75) and eighth in batting average (.393). In MW play, Espinoza batted .352 (25-for-71) with 25 runs and 13 stolen bases and later made the all-MW Tournament Team after hitting .545 (6-for-11) with five runs and two stolen bases in just three games.

Aztecs Unexpectedly Fall in Opener

San Diego State has excelled in season-opening games since records were first kept in 1980. With a 3-0 loss to No. 3/3 Stanford on Feb. 8, the Aztecs fell to 33-12 (.733) in lid-lifters in recorded program history. Even with the loss, SDSU has won 10 of its last 12 season openers, 21 of its last 24 and 24 of its last 28.

San Diego State's only blemishes in the past 27 season-openers came on Feb. 8 (lost to No. 3/3 Stanford, 3-0), in 2018 (lost to No. 25/25 Georgia, 23-2), 2012 (lost to Texas Tech, 5-4) and in 2000 (lost to UIC, 5-3).

Over the last 28 openers, the Aztecs have outscored their opponent, 154-88, or 5.5-3.1 per game in lid-lifters.

SDSU ended up recording back-to-back shutouts over USD on 2021 opening day, the first time it had consecutive shutouts on an opening day since 2008.
