THIS WEEK

The Aztec swimming and diving team will travel to Stockton, Calif., this week to compete in the Pacific Invitational on Friday and Saturday (Oct. 19-20) at UOP's Chris Kjeldsen Pool complex. SDSU will compete against the host school and Brigham Young for the team title over the two-day meet. In addition, swimmers from UC Davis and UC Santa Cruz will be competing in Saturday's events. Action gets underway at 1:0 p.m. on Friday (Oct. 19) and at 10:00 a.m. Saturday (Oct. 20) morning.

HEAD COACH MIKE SHRADER

San Diego State head coach Mike Shrader is in his sixth season with the Aztecs and has compiled a dual meet record of 67-13 (.838) during his tenure. Shrader was named the Mountain West Coach of the Year each of the past three seasons (co-coach in 2009). Including eight seasons as the head coach at Nevada, his career record stands at 156-25-1 (.860).

AZTECS DEFEAT CONFERENCE FOE UNLV

In its first regular 16-event dual meet of the season, San Diego State recorded a 146-143 victory over UNLV on Sept. 29 at the Aztec Aquaplex. The final meet was not indicative of the Aztecs' dominance as San Diego State elected not to score pints in four of the final five swimming events.

Junior Mikaela Macklin was a triple winner for SDSU as she captured first place in the 200 butterfly (2:07.07), 200 breaststroke (2:21.82) and 200 individual medley (2:05.34). She was also a member of the 200 medley relay team that place second in 1:46.07, just .35 second behind the winning Aztec foursome of Chelsea Bailey, Kelsey Jenkinson, Gemma Johnson and Taylor Johnson to open the meet.

Freshman Natilee Ruiz captured a pair of first place finished impressive fashion. She first won the 200 freestyle in 1:51.26 and later took top spot in to 200 backstroke in 2:02.99. The Aztecs' other double winner was Melanie Garibaldi, who won both the 100 freestyle in 10:17.05 and the 500 freestyle in 4:59.81.

DIVERS SHINE VS. UNLV

In the diving competition, Anna Stein captured first place in the three-meter board with a score of 266.85 and also finished second in the one-meter springboard with a mark of 264.97. Of the four dives who competed for SDSU, three were freshman making their college debuts. That trio included Kelsey Bean (fourth in the one-meter at 2:01.90), Chandler Marshall (third in the three-meter at 232.72) and Ashley Stott (fourth in the three-meter at 222.38).

MACKLIN EARNS SWIMMER OF THE HONORS

San Diego State junior Mikaela Macklin has earned Mountain West Women's Swimming Athlete of the Week honor for meets contested from Sept. 21-Oct. 7, 2012. It is the first career honor for Aztec junior.

Macklin, a native of Placerville, Calif., won the overall title in the season-opening pentathlon against University of San Diego with a combined five-event time of 4:53.06. She followed up the pentathlon with a strong performance in an SDSU dual-meet win against UNLV with three individual wins and a second-place finish in the 200-yard medley relay yard individual medley.

RUIZ RECORDS PAIR OF SDSU TOP 10 TIMES

Freshman Natilee Ruiz turned in pair of times in her events at the dual meet vs. UNLV that have gone into the record book as being among the top 10 ever for an Aztec. Her mark of 1:51.26 against the Rebels ranks ninth on the SDSU list for that event while her mark of 2:02.99 in the 200 backstroke ranks 10th.

AOUAPLEX TIMES

In the meet against UNLV, SDSU swimmers had four times that ranks among the top 10 for the Aztec Aquaplex. Ruiz's marks of 2:02.9999 in the 200 back and 1:51.26 in the 200 free ranks as the fourth- and eighth-fastest ever at the facility. Jessica Crider's time of 1:51.37 in the 200 free ranks 10th while Meghan Zimmer's 52.20 in the 100 free ranks 10th as well. In addition, the 200 medley relay team of Chelsea Bailey, Katelyn Weddle, Gemma Johnson and Taylor Johnson went 1:45.72 vs. the Rebels, the eight-best time at the Aquaplex.

THE STREAK CONTINUES

With its victory over the University of San Diego last week, SDSU has now won its last 40 straight meets dating back to the 2009-10 season. Its last loss came against Wyoming on Jan. 29, 2010, in Laramie. San Diego State also has a streak of 51 straight wins against non-conference opponents. The last loss to a non-MWC team was a defeat at North Texas on Nov. 17, 2006. In current Head Coach Mike Shrader's four seasons at SDSU, the Aztecs have not lost a dual meet to a non-conference foe.

THERE'S NO PLACE LIKE HOME

San Diego State completed its second consecutive undefeated home season during its 2011-12 campaign with a 10-0. The Aztecs have now won their last 29 consecutive meets at home. SDSU's record at the Aztec Aquaplex stands at 40-3 since the facility opened for the 2007-08 season.

AZTECS FAVORED TO WIN MW TITLE

A voting panel comprised of the nine Mountain West head women's swimming & diving coaches has chosen San Diego State as the favorite to win the 2013 MW championship title, edging out defending champion Boise State by one point. The Aztecs collected four first-place votes and 60 total points. Complete poll results:
