@AztecWBB Prepares for Saturday Showdown vs. Boise State

San Diego State caps off its two-game homestand on Saturday when it plays host to defending Mountain West tournament champion Boise State at Steve Fisher Court at Viejas Arena. Opening tip is scheduled for 2 p.m. PT. The Aztecs-Broncos clash will be streamed live via the Mountain West Network on GoAztecs.com, with SDSU alumnus Chris Ello handling the play-by-play duties.

Saturday's matchup has also been designated Aztec Women's Basketball Alumni Appreciation Day, featuring on-court recognition of former SDSU players at halftime. In addition, the first 500 fans in attendance will receive a free rally towel.

The Aztecs dropped a hard-fought 60-57 decision to conference co-leader Colorado State in their last outing on Wednesday, while the Broncos came away with a 66-58 victory over Nevada at home. Against the Rams, SDSU rallied from a 15-point deficit in the second quarter to take a brief 41-40 lead early in the fourth period. For the second game in a row, however, an Aztec opponent caught fire in the final quarter, as the Rams connected on 9 of their last 13 field-goal attempts (69.2 percent) to escape with the win.

SDSU has captured all five meetings against the Broncos in San Diego and leads the all-time series 7-2. In Boise State's last visit to "America's Finest City" a year ago, SDSU registered a 57-40 conquest, limiting the Broncos to 34 points below their season scoring average at the time, as the visitors made just 4 of 26 shots from the floor in the second half.

On offense this season, Boise State is averaging 70.3 points per game, which ranks third in the Mountain West entering the weekend, while the Aztecs are currently seventh with 64.7 points allowed per contest. In an odd twist, SDSU is averaging nine fewer points per game at home (56.6) than it is on the road (65.7). The Broncos have experienced a similar fate, averaging 69.0 points per contest at home, compared to a 71.7 mean away from Boise.

Individually, the Aztecs are led by sophomore McKynzie Fort (Fontana, Calif.), who ranks fifth in the league for all games in scoring (15.1 ppg) and shares the fifth spot in steals (2.1/gm). In addition, the 5-9 guard is sixth among the MW leaders with five 20-point performances to her credit. Meanwhile, senior Ahjalee Harvey (Mountain View, Calif.) finds herself in the ninth position with an average of 13.0 points in conference games. The SDSU duo scored 37 of the team's 57 points vs. Colorado State on a combined 16-for-31 shooting (51.6 percent).

The Aztecs have been taking better care of the ball recently, maintaining the league's second-best turnover margin (+2.1). Through 15 games, SDSU has committed the third fewest miscues in the MW with 216 overall (14.4/gm), trailing only Colorado State (185 - 12.3/gm) and Wyoming (199 - 13.3/gm). At this juncture last year, the Aztecs ranked last in the conference with 315 turnovers (21.0/gm) and a minus-5.8 turnover margin.

Following its clash with the Broncos, San Diego State will hit the road for a pair of games next week, battling Fresno State on Wednesday, Jan. 20, followed by a rematch with Utah State on Saturday, Jan. 23.

Scouting the Broncos

Boise State (9-6, 2-2 MW) has earned a split in its first four conference games after defeating Nevada by a 66-58 tally at home on Wednesday. Four Bronco starters accounted for 80 percent of the team's final point total, led by junior Brooke Pahukoa, who scored 16 points, highlighted by four triples, while freshman Marta Hermida added 15 points of her own, followed by senior Miquelle Askew (11 pts) and sophomore Shalen Shaw (11 pts), who added a game-high 11 rebounds to complete the fourth double-double in her last five outings.

Pahukoa, a preseason all-MW selection, tops the conference in both three-point field goals made (2.6/gm) and three-point percentage (.437), which ranks fifth in the nation. The 5-9 guard also finds herself among the league leaders in scoring (4th -16.3 ppg), free-throw accuracy (4th - (.813)) and steals (1-10th - 1.8/gm), while Shaw occupies the third spot in rebounds (8.4/gm) and ranks 11th in scoring (12.5 ppg). In addition, Boise State has received a boost from junior Yaiza Rodriguez, who owns the third-best assist average (4.8/gm) in the MW heading into the weekend and is seventh in three-point percentage (.373).

As the team, the Broncos lead the conference in free-throw percentage (.770), which ranks 10th in the country, and also top the MW in three-point accuracy (.331), draining 82 of 269 attempts from beyond the arc. In addition, Boise State occupies the second position in overall field-goal percentage (.427) and scoring margin (plus-7.1 ppg), while their scoring average of 70.3 points per game is third entering Saturday's contest. For the season, the Broncos own a plus-3.7 rebounding advantage, but have committed the same numbers of turnovers per game (16.4) and they have forced.

Boise State sports five international players on its roster, including Rodrigue and Hermida (Spain), Lexie Der (Canada), Leonie Edringer (Germany) and Ella Fotu (New Zealand).

Head coach Gordy Presnell is in his 11th season with the Broncos, where he has compiled a record of 185-144, highlighted by a MW tournament title a year ago. Before BSU joined the MW in 2011, the native Idahoan piloted the Broncos to back-to-back Western Athletic Conference regular-season titles in 2007 and 2008, along with a WAC tournament crown and an NCAA first-round appearance in 2007. Prior to his return to the Gem State, Presnell coached at Division II Seattle Pacific for 18 years. His overall mark stands at 581-271.

Notes With a 'W'

An SDSU victory over Boise State on Saturday will mean:

- The Aztecs snap their three-game losing streak, moving to 7-9 on the year and 2-3 in conference play.
- SDSU keeps their home record against the Broncos unblemished at 6-0 and improve to 8-2 in the all-time series.
- The Aztecs raise their record to 4-5 on the year in games following a loss.
- SDSU moves to 2-1 in Saturday games this season.

Aztecs-Broncos: 2015 Home Edition

Behind a stellar defensive performance, San Diego State won its third straight with a convincing 57-40 decision over Boise State at Viejas Arena on Feb. 7, 2015. The Scarlet and Black limited the high-octane Broncos to 34 points below their average for the year, along with a season-low .264 shooting percentage, to help key its win.

With the victory, SDSU raises its record to 9-13 overall and moves into fifth place in conference play with a 6-5 mark, a half-game behind Boise State (14-7, 6-4 MW), which entered the game averaging 74.7 points per contest on the year and 83.1 points in its last six outings.

Junior Ahjaleé Harvey led the Aztec charge on offense, matching her career-best with 16 points on 7-of-11 shooting, while fellow classmate Erimma Amarikwa registered her eighth collegiate double-double with 10 points to go with a career-high tying 13 rebounds and three steals. In addition, the SDSU cause was advanced by sophomore Chloe Johnson, who grabbed a personal-best six rebounds and dished out three assists, tying for team-high honors with Harvey, senior Kristina Hunter and sophomore Ariell Bostick.

Collectively, SDSU maintained a 43-31 rebounding advantage, including a 31-23 spread on the defensive glass, while outscoring the Broncos 26-12 in the paint. The Aztecs also benefited from a cold-shooting Boise State squad that came in with a league-leading .380 three-point field-goal percentage, but connected on just 5 of 23 tries from beyond the arc for the game.

Still, the contest was a see-saw battle throughout the first half as

the two sides combined for four ties and seven lead changes. Trailing 26-22, the Aztecs received a huge three-ball from Harvey with 28 seconds remaining before intermission, sparking a 13-0 run that continued through the first four minutes of the second period.

After the Broncos cut the margin to 35-28 on jumper by Shalen Shaw at the 15:45 mark of the second half, SDSU fashioned a 10-4 spurt to seize control of the game. Senior Desi Culberson and freshman McKynzie Fort tallied two baskets apiece during the run that put the host school in front 45-32 with 8:04 left.

Boise State answered with five quick points, sandwiched around an SDSU jumper by junior Deidra Smith, as Tonishia Childress' triple trimmed the deficit to 47-37 with 6:16 remaining. However, consecutive layups by Amariqwa, coupled with a pair of errant Boise State three-point attempts, prevented the visitors from inching closer. In the interim, Bostick hit a short jumper, while Harvey fittingly closed out the scoring with another layup just over a minute later.

The Broncos, who converted just 4 of 26 shots (15.4 percent) from the floor in the second half, were held scoreless over the last three-and-a-half minutes of the game. Individually, Brooke Pahukoa led Boise State with nine points, while Yaiza Rodriguez finished with eight points and a game-high four assists in the loss.

Rewind: SDSU-CSU Recap

San Diego State put up a valiant fight in the second half against conference co-leader Colorado State on Wednesday but was unable to complete the upset, falling short by a 60-57 count in a Mountain West clash at Steve Fisher Court at Viejas Arena.

With the loss, the Aztecs suffered their third straight defeat, slipping to 6-9 on the year and 1-3 in league play, while the Rams won their 11th in row, improving to 14-1 overall and 4-0 in the MW.

Individually, SDSU was led by sophomore McKynzie Fort, who scored a game-high 20 points on 9-of-17 shooting to go with five assists, while senior Ahjaleé Harvey added 17 points, including 14 in the second half. In addition, the Aztecs received 10 points from sophomore Lexy Thorderson, while fellow classmate Cheyenne Greenhouse contributed six points and four rebounds.

After shooting just 26 percent in the first two periods (7-27), SDSU caught fire in the second half, connecting on 55 percent (17-31) of its attempts from the field to help erase a 31-18 deficit at intermission. However, CSU maintained a 36-24 advantage in the paint and out-rebounded the Aztecs by a 33-22 margin, including a sizable 25-13 spread on the offensive glass.

The Rams managed to withstand SDSU's rally with some clutch shooting, particularly in the fourth quarter when they drained 9 of 13 attempts from the floor (69 percent) to escape with the win. CSU committed 19 turnovers on the evening, but the Scarlet and Black was unable to completely capitalize, scoring just 16 points off those miscues.

The Aztecs took their only lead of the game, 41-40, at the 8:52 mark of the fourth quarter following a Thorderson jumper from the right baseline to punctuate a 23-9 blitz. However, CSU quickly reclaimed the upper hand on back-to-back layups by Jamie Patrick and Keyona Wharry.

SDSU would forge a pair of ties over the next three minutes and change, including a 50-50 deadlock following a Fort basket with 4:47 remaining. Wharry quickly stole the Aztecs' momentum after a timeout by nailing a tough jumper in the lane to spark an 8-3 spurt that put the Rams in front for good. Moments later, Patrick capped the run with a layup to provide CSU a seemingly safe 58-53 lead with 50.7 seconds to go.

However, the Aztecs would not surrender without a fight as Fort tallied four straight points on a jumper and two free throws, sandwiched around a pair of misfires at the charity stripe by Wharry. After a quick foul, the Rams' Ellen Nystrom sank two free throws at the other end with 13.6 seconds left to give the visitors a 60-57 edge. SDSU had one last chance to send the game into overtime, but could not get off a three-point shot with the clock winding down.

Alana Arias led the Rams with 14 points and 10 rebounds off the bench, while Patrick (12 pts) and Wharry (10 pts) reached double figures as well. As a team, CSU made 55 percent (27-49) of its shots for the game, compared to the Aztecs' 41-percent clip (24-58),

SDSU-CSU Postgame Notes

- The Aztecs recorded fewer turnovers than the opposition for the fourth game in a row and fifth time in their last six outings. SDSU is 5-4 on the year when committing fewer miscues than its adversaries.
- For just the second time this season, the Aztec bench was outscored an opponent after the Ram reserves maintained a 16-10 spread. For the season, the SDSU bench has amassed 332 points (22.1/g).
- For the 27th time in the last 34 meetings dating back to 2000, the winner of the Aztecs-Rams matchup has scored less than 70 points.
- Despite the loss, SDSU overcame its largest deficit of the year to take the lead in any game. The Aztecs trailed the

Rams 23-8 with 6:32 remaining in the second quarter before jumping in front momentarily 41-40 at the 8:52 mark of the fourth period.

- The Aztecs posted their best free-throw percentage of the year (.857) after sinking 6 of 7 attempts from the charity stripe.
- SDSU posted a season-low 9 three-point field-goal attempts.
- The Aztecs were unable to register a blocked shot for the fourth time this year.
- McKynzie Fort (20 pts) reached the 20-point barrier for the fifth time this season and third in the last six games. In addition, the sophomore guard tied a personal best with 17 field-goal attempts and finished with a season-high five assists. Not to be outdone, she also had two steals for her team-leading ninth game of the year with multiple takeaways.
- Ahjaleé Harvey (17 pts) matched her career high with seven field goals and set a season best with three steals.
- Lexy Thorderson (2) sank multiple treys for the seventh time this year. Last season, she drained two or more triples in just three games.
- Deidra Smith played in her 76th consecutive game for SDSU.

Take It to the Bank

With their victory over Wyoming on Dec. 30, the Aztecs have now won 49 in a row and improved to 79-1 since the 2012-13 campaign when leading with five minutes left in the game. The SDSU streak was in serious jeopardy at CSUN on Dec. 7 after the Matadors inched in front by a 66-65 margin with 20 seconds remaining. However, Lexy Thorderson's trey with 9.4 seconds to go saved the day for the Scarlet and Black.

The last time the Aztecs wound up losing a game after leading at the five-minute mark of the second half occurred in a heart-breaking 59-58 at Washington in December of 2012.

Comeback Kids

In three victories over Wisconsin, CSUN and Wyoming, San Diego State fought itself off the ropes, rallying from an 11-point deficit in each contest. Against the Badgers on Nov. 29, the Aztecs found themselves on the wrong side of a 32-21 score with three minutes elapsed in the third quarter before uncorking a 23-7 run to grab a 44-39 advantage. SDSU also trailed with under 10 seconds remaining, but Ariell Bostick saved the day with a late layup to send the game into overtime. The following week against the Matadors, the Aztecs overcame a 41-30 deficit at the 8:22 mark of the third period with a 12-0 run to climb back into contention. After six ties and four lead changes, CSUN went back in front 65-63 with 17 seconds to go. However, Lexy Thorderson tallied the go-ahead basket on a three-pointer with 9.4 seconds left, while Bostick added a late free throw to seal the win. In the MW opener against the Cowgirls on Dec. 30, SDSU trailed 15-4 with 5:21 elapsed in the first quarter before reeling off 15 unanswered points to take the lead for good.

Nothin' Like Home Cookin'

Despite its modest 4-5 home record to start the season, SDSU has claimed 47 of its last 64 games on Montezuma Mesa and has gone 79-33 (.705) at Steve Fisher Court since the start of the 2008-09 campaign. The Aztecs have finished with a winning record at home in eight of the last nine years.

Spreading the Wealth

A total of nine Aztecs have scored in double digits at least once this season, while seven have accomplished the feat on two or more occasions. That is especially notable since there are only 12 players on the active roster. In addition, SDSU has had seven games this season in which three players scored in double figures (UC Riverside, Wisconsin, CSUN, San Diego Christian, Wyoming, San José State and Colorado State).

Fort Tabled MW Player of the Week

McKynzie Fort was named Mountain West Women's Basketball Player of the Week for her stellar performances in three games from Nov. 23-29, as announced by the league office. With her award, the Aztec sophomore garnered weekly conference accolades for the first time in her career and first for SDSU this season.

Fort averaged 17.3 points, 3.7 rebounds, 2.0 assists and 3.3 steals, helping the Aztecs to a 2-1 record during that stretch. The 5-9 guard was the team's top scorer in all three games, connecting on 66.7 percent of her shots on 24 of 36 field-goal attempts, all inside the arc.

After recording 16 points on 8-of-13 shooting and four rebounds in a tough road loss to Washington on Nov. 23, Fort almost single-hand-

edly propelled the Scarlet and Black to a 64-54 triumph over North Dakota State in the opener of the SDSU Thanksgiving Classic last Friday, posting a game-high 20 points and a personal-best five steals. Against the Bison, the Etiwanda High alumna drained a collegiate-high 10 field goals on 12 tries (83.3 pct) and matched her season best with four rebounds.

Not to be outdone, Fort capped off her brilliant week with a 16-point, 4-steal effort in the Aztecs' thrilling 63-57 overtime victory over Wisconsin on Sunday, sinking 6 of 11 attempts from the floor to go with four clutch free throws. Against the Badgers, she converted two critical and-one opportunities, including one to punctuate a timely 23-7 run that erased an 11-point deficit in the second half.

In addition, Fort received MW Player of the Week honors from the website CollegeSportsMadness.com after her exceptional effort vs. Cal State Fullerton on Dec. 19. Against the Titans, Fort recorded the second-best scoring output of her career with a game-high 22 points, including 14 in the second half as the Scarlet and Black pulled away for the victory. The 5-9 guard matched her collegiate best with 10 field goals on 14 attempts (71.4 percent) and posted three rebounds, three steals and two assists to help SDSU pull away for the win.

For the season, Fort is averaging a team-high 15.1 points per game on 47.1 percent shooting and leads SDSU with 31 steals. She now has 11 double-digit scoring performances this year and 31 for her career.

Earlier this year, Fort set a career high with 25 points against UC Riverside in the Aztecs' home opener on Nov. 16, and established collegiate bests in three-pointers made (2), field-goal attempts (17), free throws (11) and free throw attempts (12).

@AztecWBB Picked Sixth in MW Preseason Poll

San Diego State has been predicted to finish sixth in the Mountain West preseason poll released on Oct. 28 by the league office. The voting panel consisted of the MW's 11 head coaches and select women's basketball media from around the conference.

The Aztecs, who placed seventh in the MW standings during the 2014-15 campaign, earned 135 points from the panel, trailing fifth-place UNLV (132) by just three points while topping seventh-place Wyoming (125) by 10 points.

Two-time defending regular-season champion Colorado State was picked to repeat once again after receiving 21 of 28 first-place votes and 237 points, just ahead of New Mexico, which garnered seven first-place votes and 221 points, while 2015 MW tournament champion Boise State followed closely in the third spot with six first-place votes and 215 points.

With the league's forecast, SDSU has not been selected to finish among the top three places in the MW preseason rankings in back-to-back years for the first time since the 2006-07 and 2007-08 campaigns. The Aztecs completed conference play where they were projected last season, landing in the seventh spot with an 8-10 record.

Back Again

San Diego State returns three starters from a year ago, featuring sophomore McKynzie Fort, along with seniors Ahjaleé Harvey and Deidra Smith. A 5-9 guard, Fort earned Mountain West all-freshman honors last spring after finishing third among conference rookies with 10.9 points per game in league play while averaging 3.2 rebounds and 1.7 assists. In addition, Harvey made a successful recovery from a knee injury that sidelined her for the final 22 games of the 2013-14 campaign with 25 starts in 29 appearances last season. The 5-6 point guard was SDSU's top ball-handler and main three-point threat in 2014-15, dishing out 2.3 assists per contest to go with 21 triples. Meanwhile, Smith has played in all 62 games for the Aztecs the past two years following her transfer from Boston College. The tallest member on the squad as a 6-2 forward, Smith is the team's top returning rebounder after averaging 3.5 caroms last season.

Third-year head coach Stacie Terry and staff welcome back four additional letterwinners, including juniors Ariell Bostick and Aleiah Brandon and sophomores Cheyenne Greenhouse and Lexy Thorderson. Fellow classmate Allison Brown, who made seven spot appearances last season, also finds herself in the mix once again.

Noting the Newcomers

Of the 12 student-athletes on the current roster, four players will be wearing a Scarlet and Black uniform for the first time during the 2015-16 campaign. Guard Kymberly Ellison (Columbus, Ga.) practiced with the squad last year, but did not compete after transferring from Georgia Tech, while fellow backcourt mate Geena Gomez (Huntington Beach, Calif.) utilized her redshirt season as well following her transfer from St. Joseph's (Pa.).

With the departure of forwards Erimma Amariqwa, Khristina Hunter and

Desi Culberson, who accounted for 43 percent of SDSU's rebounding total and 38 percent of the team's scoring offense from a year ago, a pair of newcomers look to gain significant experience on the frontline this season. Junior Kylie Herd (Phoenix, Ariz.) received second-team All-America recognition and was named the Arizona JC player of the year as a sophomore last year at Mesa Community College, following a solid freshman campaign when she helped the Thunderbirds to the NJCAA Division II national championship. Not to be outdone, freshman Arantxa Gómez (Valencia, Spain) brings strong credentials with her to The Mesa after sharpening her skills as a six-year member on the Spanish club circuit, including an MVP performance in U18 regional competition last April.

Listen Live

For the 15th consecutive year, Aztec women's basketball fans will have an opportunity to listen to live play-by-play of regular-season games over the internet at www.goaztecs.com.

SDSU alumnus Chris Ello begins his ninth season of calling the action and is a familiar voice in the San Diego area. In addition to his responsibilities with the Aztec women's basketball squad, Ello is a member of the football broadcast team as a sideline reporter for the school's flagship station, The Mighty 1090 AM.

Ello started his career in sports talk radio in San Diego on XTRA Sports 690 in the summer of 1994. He has accumulated a wealth of experience doing play-by-play for a variety of sports at every level, including stints with the SDSU football (1985), baseball (1998-99) and men's basketball (2006-07) squads.

From 1996-2006, Ello was the voice of the San Diego Gulls hockey team and has called the action for the San Diego Sockers (indoor soccer), San Diego Spirit (outdoor soccer), San Diego Wildcards (CBA) and San Diego Riptide (arena football). He also has experience broadcasting high school CIF football and basketball games since 2000.

For the third straight year, nearly all regular-season Aztec home contests in 2015-16 will feature a live video stream via the Mountain West Network to supplement the audio call from Viejas Arena.

NCAA Rule Changes at a Glance

Game Format

- Beginning with the 2015-16 campaign, NCAA women's basketball games will be played in four 10-minute quarters.
- Teams will now reach the bonus and shoot two free throws on the fifth team foul in each quarter. Previously, teams reached a one-and-one bonus on the seventh team foul of each half and reached the double bonus (two shots) on the 10th team foul.
- In the four-quarter format, team fouls reset to zero at the start of each quarter. However, if a team reaches the bonus in the fourth quarter, that team would remain in the bonus during any additional overtime periods.

Advancing the Ball

- Teams will be allowed to advance the ball to the frontcourt following a timeout immediately after a made basket in the last 59.9 seconds of the fourth quarter and any overtime periods.
- Teams will also be allowed to advance the ball to the frontcourt following a rebound or a change of possession. In these scenarios, the ball would be inbounded at the 28-foot mark on the side of the court where the scorer's table is located.

10-Second Backcourt Exceptions

- For the upcoming season, a team will not receive a new 10-second backcourt count when a throw-in results from the following situations:
 - The ball is deflected out of bounds by the defense.
 - There is a held ball and the possession arrow favors the offensive team.
 - A technical foul is called on the offensive team while the ball is in its backcourt.

Post Defense

- Defenders will be allowed to place a forearm or an open hand with a bend in the elbow on an offensive post player with the ball whose back is to the basket.

Bands and Amplified Music

- In an effort to improve the overall fan experience, bands or amplified music may be played during any dead-ball situation during a women's basketball game. Previously, rules allowed music to be played only during timeouts and intermission.

SDSU Holds Grand-Opening Ceremony for Jeff Jacobs JAM Center

San Diego State held a grand-opening ceremony for the 23,500-square foot Jeff Jacobs JAM Center on Sunday, Aug. 23. The event marked the official opening of the Aztecs' on-campus basketball performance center, which broke ground almost a year to the date on Aug. 27, 2014.

Speaking before the ceremonial ribbon cutting was SDSU president Elliot Hirshman, men's basketball head coach Steve Fisher and women's hoops senior guard Ahjalee Harvey.

Preliminary site work started in July 2014, just south of the Fowler Athletics Center and east of the football practice fields. The facility, which will support the continued growth and development of the SDSU men's and women's basketball teams, includes two full-length courts, eight baskets, locker rooms, film room, team lounges, athletic training room and coaches locker rooms.

Hundreds of supporters contributed to the effort to make the Jeff Jacobs JAM Center a reality. In addition to the naming gift from Jeff Jacobs, Hal and Debby Jacobs, Steve and Lisa Altman and Jim Morris, creating the name "JAM" Center, sizeable donations were made from the Manna Charitable Foundation and the Walter and Betty Zable Foundation. The total cost of the project was \$15 million.

The project was designed by JCY Architecture and was built by The Hunt Construction Group.

San Diego native Stacie Terry enters her third year at the helm of the Aztec women's basketball team after she was named the eighth head coach in program history on May 15, 2013.

Despite a 12-19 record and an 8-10 mark in the Mountain West, Terry's squad still showed dramatic improvement on defense last season, finishing second in the conference and 34th nationally in opponent three-point field goal percentage, compared to 2014 when SDSU ranked last in the league and near the bottom of Division I in that statistic.

In addition, the Aztecs were fourth in scoring defense during MW play a year ago, allowing nearly 10 points per game fewer than the previous campaign and topped the conference in rebounding defense for the second straight season.

Under Terry's watch, forward Erimma Amarikwa capped off her collegiate career with honorable mention all-MW accolades, while guard McKynzie Fort gave SDSU's its second consecutive all-conference freshman honoree.

Terry's charges also made tremendous strides in the classroom, with the squad posting the highest collective GPA in program history during the fall of 2014, while five Aztecs landed a spot on the MW all-academic team, the most since 2001-02.

During her first season on Montezuma Mesa, Terry was saddled with the unenviable task of replacing four senior starters who accounted for nearly 64 percent of the team's scoring offense from the previous year, as well as overcoming the loss of two key players to injuries prior to conference play, Amarikwa, who was a preseason all-MW selection, and starting point guard Ahjalee Harvey.

Despite those obstacles and a demanding schedule featuring nine games against teams that eventually advanced to postseason competition, Terry's squad flashed its resiliency during the 2013-14 campaign, finishing with a 13-17 overall record and a 9-9 ledger in the MW.

With Terry at the controls, the Aztecs led the league in rebounding margin and rebounding defense while ranking second in field-goal percentage.

Individually, Terry also oversaw the progress of senior center Cierra Warren, who became the fifth SDSU player in a six-year span to receive first-team all-MW recognition.

Prior to her arrival on The Mesa, Terry gained a wealth of experience as an assistant coach at the Division I level for 14 years, including five under head coach Nikki Caldwell, who transformed UCLA into a powerhouse before restoring LSU to national prominence.

During Terry's two seasons at LSU, the Lady Tigers compiled a 45-23 overall record and earned two NCAA tournament bids, including a Sweet 16 appearance during the 2012-13 campaign. During that season, the Lady Tigers also posted six victories against ranked opponents and finished with their second-highest scoring average (69.0) in the last seven years. Under Terry's guidance, forward LaShondra Barrett garnered first-team all-Southeastern Conference accolades and received honorable mention All-America distinction in 2012 before becoming a first-round draft choice of the WNBA's Washington Mystics.

Prior to her appointment at LSU, Terry served as an assistant under Caldwell at UCLA from 2008-11, helping the Bruins gain national acclaim with a pair of NCAA

tournament appearances. During Terry's tenure, UCLA posted 72 overall victories, as the 2010-11 squad finished with a 28-5 record, setting a school record for fewest losses in a single season to go with a No. 7 national ranking. In addition, the Bruins signed the fourth-ranked recruiting class that season, according to ESPN Hoop-Gurlz, while Terry helped mentor first-team all-Pac-10 performers in Doreena Campbell, Darxia Morris and Jasmine Dixon, a 2012 honorable mention AP All-America selection, as well as all-conference freshman honorees Atonye Nyingifa and Markel Walker.

Terry spent the 2007-08 campaign at Southern Mississippi, as the Golden Eagles posted a 21-14 record and earned a postseason berth in the Women's National Invitation Tournament (WNIT). While at Southern Miss, Terry spearheaded the development and coordination of the Lady Eagle recruiting campaign. Her responsibilities also included working with the perimeter players, scouting opponents and film breakdown, as well as coordinating all of the team's community service events.

Terry also coached for three seasons from 2004-07 as an assistant under Hall of Fame head coach Theresa Greutz at Illinois, where the Fighting Illini had three straight recruiting classes ranked among the top 25 in the nation, according to Blue Star Basketball, and made three consecutive trips to the WNIT. Her primary duties included defensive instruction and working with the perimeter players.

In addition, Terry coached at Dayton during the 2003-04 season following a three-year stint at Louisville from 2000-03. With the Cardinals, Terry's responsibilities encompassed recruiting, scouting, player development, summer camps and serving as a liaison for the program's community service outreach. Louisville captured the Conference USA regular-season title and earned a trip to the NCAA tournament in 2001 before making a WNIT appearance in 2002. She also assisted in signing the nation's 21st-ranked recruiting class in 2002-03, according to All-Star Girls Report. Terry recruited and coached all-Conference USA honoree Lori Nero, a draft choice of the WNBA's Houston Comets, as well as Sara Nord, who finished her collegiate career as the Cardinals' all-time assist leader and ranks among the top 15 scorers in school history.

Terry enjoyed a successful collegiate playing career at the University of Texas at Arlington, winning four varsity letters from 1994-98 under head coach Mike Dean. She earned first-team all-Southland Conference honors after leading the Mavericks in scoring with 17.4 points per game as a senior in 1997-98. Terry scored 1,169 points during her career at UTA and still ranks among the school's top 10 in three-point field goals made (third), assists (sixth), steals (seventh) and free-throw percentage (10th). She is just one of 17 players in Maverick history to surpass the 1,000-point plateau, while her .335 career three-point field-goal percentage is also a school and Southland Conference career record.

Terry played one season of professional basketball in Warsaw, Poland, averaging 12.0 points and 6.0 assists with the Polonia Phoenix, before returning to UT Arlington to begin her coaching career as a graduate assistant in 1999.

Terry prepped at El Capitan High and held the Vaqueros' career scoring record for three years following her graduation. She was inducted into the school's athletic hall of fame in 2008.
