## AUTONOMOUS 5 WINS

Through Week 3, the Mountain West has picked up wins against opponents from the ACC (Florida State), Big Ten (Purdue), Pac-12 (Arizona, Colorado, Oregon State and UCLA) and SEC (Missouri). The seven victories against autonomous five opponents are the most since 2010 (7). The league record for wins over A5 opponents is 10 (2008).

Through three weeks, the Mountain West has the most nonconference autonomous five victories amongst all FBS conferences. A conference-by-conference breakdown is below:

More autonomous five notes below:

- Air Force, which went on the road and beat an undefeated Colorado team, earned its first autonomous 5 victory since 2010.
- Boise State has defeated an autonomous five opponent in seven of nine seasons since joining the Mountain West.
- Nevada has defeated an autonomous five opponent in back-to-back years (Oregon State in 2018). The Wolf Pack's victory over Purdue is the first MW team to beat an opponent from the Big Ten since 2010.
- San Diego State owns the highest win percentage nationally against the Pac-12 since 2016, compiling a 5-1 (.833) record.
- Wyoming, which defeated Missouri on Aug. 31, earned its first A5 victory since Nov. 8, 2008 (Tennessee).

## NATIONAL POLLS

Boise State is firmly in the *Associated Press* Top 25 and Amway Coaches Poll after opening the season 3-0.

The Broncos are ranked No. 20 in both polls. This is the 18th-consecutive season Boise State has been nationally ranked, the eighth-longest streak in the nation. Boise State has been ranked in the top 20 in eight of nine seasons since joining the Mountain West.

Wyoming, also undefeated, is receiving one vote in the Amway Coaches Poll.

## CONFERENCE OPENERS

Conference action gets underway on Friday when No. 20/20 Boise State hosts Air Force. On Saturday, Utah State will hit the road to take on San Diego State.

Below is what you need to know about the Conference-openers:

- Boise State has won eight consecutive Mountain West openers, while Air Force has won 13 of its 20 MW lid-lifters.
- Air Force is seeking its first road victory over a nationally ranked opponent since Sept. 21, 2002 at No. 23 California.
- Air Force at Boise State is one of four undefeated vs. undefeated FBS matchups this weekend.
- Since the Mountain and West divisions were formed in 2013, San Diego State has a .800 (16-4) win percentage against opponents from the Mountain Division. This win percentage is tied as the best in the MW with Boise State.
- Utah State has won eight of its last 10 Mountain West contests, including a 7-1 mark last season.
- The Aggies are 5-1 in MW openers.
- San Diego State has won five of its last six Conference openers and overall the Aztecs have won nine MW lid-lifters.

## APPROACHING MOUNTAIN WEST SACK RECORD

Boise State junior **Curtis Weaver** has 26.5 career sacks, including a nation's-best 6.0 sacks this season. Weaver currently ranks third in Mountain West history with 26.5 sacks and is 2.0 away from tying for the top spot, which is currently held by BYU's Jan Jorgensen (2006-09) and TCU's Jerry Hughes (2006-09).

## HONORING GRADUATES

Many Mountain West student-athletes who already hold a degree will have a little something extra on their jerseys beginning with the 2019-20 academic year.

Mountain West student-athletes who have earned a degree, but have remaining eligibility will see the MW logo on their jersey replaced with one that incorporates both the MW mark and the word "graduate."



## #HIGHLIGHTS

(NOTES FROM AROUND THE MOUNTAIN WEST IN 280 CHARACTERS OR LESS)

- The @MountainWest has won eight of its last 12 games over the @pac12 (dating back to September 2018).
- Against all A5 competition, the @MountainWest has won 11 of its last 20 games.
- The @MountainWest's seven nonconference autonomous 5 victories are the most nationally.
- There are 35 undefeated teams nationally, four of which come from the @MountainWest: @AFFootball, @BroncoSportsFB, @GoAztecs and @wyo\_football.
- The @MountainWest has been nationally ranked in 14 of the last 18 College Football Playoff Rankings.
- The @MountainWest has won seven games against autonomous 5 opponents in 2019. The league single-season record for victories against A5 opponents is 10 (2008).
- In the past 15 years, the @MountainWest has been the top non-autonomous 5 conference nine times and second four times.
- In the 20 seasons since the league's inception, the @MountainWest's champion or a current MW member has been a BCS/CFP participant eight times.
- @wyo\_football is riding a seven-game win streak, tied for the fourth-longest active streak nationally.
- @GoAztecs' five victories over @pac12 opponents are the most for any non-autonomous 5 school against any autonomous 5 conference nationally.
- @BroncoSportsFB has been selected to win the Mountain Division for the sixth consecutive season, while @FresnoStateFB is favored to win the West Division for the second consecutive year.
- @BroncoSportsFB has won at least 10 games in three consecutive seasons, tied as the longest active streak amongst the nonautonomous 5 (Troy).
- @HawaiiFootball won back-to-back A5 games for the first time since 2006-07. On Dec. 24, 2006, the Rainbow Warriors knocked off Arizona State and then defeated Washington nearly a year later (Dec. 1, 2007).
- Since 2015, @BroncoSportsFB and @GoAztecs rank in the top 5 nationally in road wins, as the Broncos and Aztecs are tied for third with 18 road victories.
- @USUFootball kicker **Dominik Eberle** has made a @MountainWest record 135 consecutive PATs. Eberle has not missed a PAT in his collegiate career.
- @BroncoSportsFB's **Curtis Weaver** has 26.5 career sacks, the third-most all-time in @MountainWest history. The league record is 28.5 by Jan Jorgensen (BYU) and Jerry Hughes (TCU).
- @BroncoSportsFB's **Curtis Weaver** is the nation's active leader in career sacks with 26.5.
- @wyo\_football's **Logan Wilson** has 351 career tackles, the second-most in the nation among active defenders. Wilson is 45 tackles shy of entering the @MountainWest's top-5.

## POSTSEASON SUCCESS

The Mountain West has sent at least six teams to the postseason in six consecutive years.

The MW, which has earned 96 bowl bids, including Boise State's 2018 appearance vs. Boston College, since 1999 and holds a 52-43 (.547) all-time record, owns the second-best win percentage in bowl games in the last 15 seasons among the 10 FBS conferences (.563), trailing only the SEC (.617).

## FOOTBALL CHAMPIONSHIP HOST DETERMINATION PROCEDURE

**Host Determination:** The Mountain West Football Championship Game shall be played at the site of the divisional champion with the highest winning percentage in Conference games only.

**Host Tie Breaker:** In the event of a tie, the following procedure shall be used to determine the host location for the Championship Game:

1. Head-to-head result between the tied divisional champions.
2. If still tied:
  - If one team was ranked in the latest available CFP Selection Committee ranking and wins in the final weekend of the regular season, they will be declared the host. If in that same scenario, the team that was the highest-ranked team in the latest available CFP Selection Committee ranking loses in the final weekend of the regular season, a composite average of selected computer rankings will be used;
  - OR-
  - If both teams are ranked in the latest available CFP Selection Committee ranking, the highest-ranked team that wins in the final weekend of the regular season;
  - OR-
  - If neither of the ranked teams win in the final weekend of the regular season, a composite average of selected computer rankings after all games conclude the final weekend of the regular season will be used;
  - OR-
  - If neither team is ranked in the latest available CFP Selection Committee ranking going into the final weekend of the regular season, a composite average of selected computer rankings after all games conclude the final weekend of the regular season will be used.
3. If still tied, the best record against common Conference opponents.
4. If still tied, the team with the highest overall winning percentage (Conference and non-conference excluding exempt games).
5. If still tied, a coin toss will be conducted by the Commissioner.

## 2019 MOUNTAIN WEST FOOTBALL CHAMPIONSHIP GAME

The 2019 Mountain West Football Championship game will be played on Saturday, December 7 at 2 p.m. MT/1 p.m. PT/11 a.m. HT. The contest will be played at the home stadium of the regular-season Mountain West divisional champion with the highest win percentage in Conference games only. ESPN will broadcast the matchup for the fourth consecutive year.

Cradled among the most desirable locations in America, the Mountain West stretches to eight different states from the shores of the Pacific Coastline to the Rocky Mountains. The conference has long been known since its founding for its integrity and its commitment to the ideals of the student-athlete experience and the unique opportunities afforded to students at each institution.

From its inception in 1999, the Mountain West has been committed to excellence in intercollegiate athletics, while promoting the academic missions of its member institutions. Progressive in its approach, the Mountain West continues to cultivate opportunities for student-athletes to compete at the highest level, while fostering academic achievement and sportsmanship.

Now in its 21st year, the MW has been assertive in its involvement with the NCAA governance structure and has taken a leadership role in the overall administration of intercollegiate athletics.
