Aztec Softball Plays Host to San Diego; Travels to MWC-Leader UNLV This Week

The San Diego State softball team looks to break out of its recent slump when it plays host to city-rival San Diego on Wednesday before traveling to Las Vegas, Nev., this weekend for a pair of games against Mountain West Conference leader UNLV.

The Aztecs (25-18, 2-6 MWC) meet the Toreros (20-17, 4-4 PCSC) for a single game at 6 p.m. Wednesday. SDSU will then play the Rebels (30-17, 6-1 MWC) at 6 p.m. Saturday and again at 2 p.m. Sunday. All three games can be followed via gametracker on the Internet at www.goaztecs.com.

Earlier this season at USD, the Aztecs left a season-high 15 runners on base, but still came away with a 4-1 victory. Last season, SDSU won its third MWC regular season title in five seasons with a 15-3 league record. UNLV finished fourth at 8-12.

Aztec Quick Hits

- SDSU has won 19 of its last 28 regular season conference contests dating back to last year.

- The Aztecs are 4-6 on the year against top-25 teams, with three of their losses coming by one run.

- San Diego State has started a remarkable 38 different batting lineups in its 43 games and 30 different fielding lineups. Only junior Tamani Wells has earned a start in every game.

- San Diego State currently ranks first in the MWC in both team batting average (.305) and team ERA (2.06).

- Sophomore Melissa Owens (San Diego/Christian HS) is currently ranked first in the MWC in ERA (1.76) and sixth in batting average (.370). Her .574 slugging percentage would be a single-season school record if the season ended today.

Last Week With the Aztecs

The Aztecs had another disappointing weekend, as they went 1-3 at Colorado State and New Mexico. SDSU lost a wild 13-12, eight-inning game to the Rams on Friday and fell in the nightcap, 6-3, in a game that was halted in the bottom of the sixth because of poor lighting. San Diego State bounced back on Saturday as it tied a school record with 18 hits in an 11-2, six-inning rout of the Lobos. New Mexico, however, came back to beat the Aztecs on Sunday by a 6-4 score.

SDSU batted .409 over the four games, but committed 17 errors, including a season-high seven miscues in the first game against Colorado State. The Aztecs had three athletes - freshman Brittany Knudsen (San Diego/Escondido HS) (.643), freshman Lindsey Marquez (Tustin, Calif.) (.615) and sophomore Dani Sidoti (Tucson, Ariz.) (.600) - each hit at least .600. Junior Christina Ross (Santa Clarita, Calif.) went 1-1 with a 4.42 ERA over 19 innings in the circle. She struck out 20 and walked 11.

► **COLORADO STATE 13, SAN DIEGO STATE 12 (8 INNINGS) (GAME 1)**

April 13, 2007 • Ram Field • Fort Collins, Colo.

The game was played in near-freezing weather with temperatures in the mid-thirties ... The Aztecs had a season-high 16 hits, but also a season-high seven errors ... San Diego State also left nine runners on base ... SDSU scored six runs with two outs in the top of the seventh to take a 12-10 lead ... Colorado State rallied with two runs of its own in the bottom half of the inning and another on a solo homer in the eighth ... DP Kasey Mytinger had three hits, including a grand slam, and drove in a career-high six runs ... LF Brittany Knudsen was 3-for-3 with a double, her fourth homer of the season and two runs ... 2B Lindsey Marquez had two hits and scored three times ... CF/RHP Tamani Wells had two hits and scored twice and SS Amanda Beasley recorded two hits along with a run and a RBI ... Wells took the loss after allowing four runs (three earned) over the final three innings ... LHP Christina Ross pitched the first 4 2/3 innings and gave up nine runs (six earned) on 10 hits. She had six strikeouts and two walks.

► **COLORADO STATE 6, SAN DIEGO STATE 3 (6 INNINGS) (GAME 2)**

April 13, 2007 • Ram Field • Fort Collins, Colo.

The nightcap was called in the bottom of the seventh because of poor lighting on the field and impending darkness ... RF Dani Sidoti and 2B Lindsey Marquez each had two hits for the Aztecs ... C Megan McDonald her first home run in the sixth inning ... LF Brittany Knudsen had an RBI single and CF/RHP Tamani Wells had an RBI groundout ... Wells allowed four hits over 2 2/3 innings to take the loss. She struck out four and walked two ... 1B/RHP Monica Alnes fave up two runs in 1/3 inning of relief and LHP Christina Ross (3 H, 3 K, 3 BB) did not allow a run over the final 2 1/3 innings.

► **SAN DIEGO STATE 11, NEW MEXICO 2 (6 INNINGS)**

April 14, 2007 • Lobo Field • Albuquerque, N.M.

SDSU scored eight runs in the top of the fifth inning to break open a close game ... The Aztecs had 18 hits in the game, tying a school record set last season at New Mexico ... 11 of SDSU's 18 hits came in the big fifth inning, the inning was highlighted by five bunt singles, including four to start out the inning, and C Megan McDonald's second career grand slam. LF Brittany Knudsen and CF Tamani Wells each singled twice and scored two runs in the inning ... RF Dani Sidoti went 4-for-4 and scored two runs. The four hits were a career high ... C Megan McDonald had two hits and four RBI, including the grand slam, her second homer in as many games ... 2B Lindsey Marquez had a career-high three hits, drove in three runs and scored twice ... Knudsen (2 R, RBI) and Wells (R, RBI) each added three hits apiece ... 3B Christine Kulick added two singles ... LHP Christina Ross allowed seven hits and two runs (one earned) over six innings to pick up the win for SDSU. She struck out five and did not give up a walk, as only three Lobos advanced past second base.

► **NEW MEXICO 6, SAN DIEGO STATE 4**

April 15, 2007 • Lobo Field • Albuquerque, N.M.

SDSU gave up three runs in the bottom of the sixth to fall, 6-4, to New Mexico ... The scored was tied at 3-3 until the Lobos got four hits and three runs in the inning ... LF Brittany Knudsen went 2-for-3 with a triple and a run scored ... CF Tamani Wells was 2-for-3 with two runs and an RBI, while 1B Monica Alnes had two hits and an RBI ... RF Dani Sidoti added two hits. She grounded out in the sixth to end a streak of eight consecutive at-bats with a hit ... LHP Christina Ross scattered 10 hits and five earned runs over six innings to take the loss. She struck out six, but issued a season-high six walks.

Noting San Diego

San Diego comes into its game with San Diego State with a 20-17 record and 4-4 mark in PCSC play. Last weekend, the Toreros won three of four games against Santa Clara in San Diego.

Virginia Fritsch leads the squad in batting with a .352 average. Danielle Treiber (.311, 19 RBI, 6 SB) and Kathleen Bonja (.298) have also performed well for the Toreros. Jennifer Ellenbeck, who also leads the team with four home runs, is 8-3 in the circle with a 2.43 ERA. Christina Haake is 7-5 with a 2.56 ERA and has logged the most innings (87.2) of any USD pitcher.

San Diego State has dominated the all-time series between the two schools, winning 42 of the 43 meetings, including a 4-1 victory earlier this season at San Diego. The Aztecs' only loss to the Toreros came at home by a 2-0 score on March 9, 2005.

A Look at UNLV

UNLV is 30-17 with a doubleheader scheduled for Wednesday at Southern Utah. The Rebels are in sole possession of first place in the Mountain West Conference with a 6-1 record. Last weekend, UNLV went 2-1 in games against New Mexico and Colorado State.

Jaci Hull is one of the most prolific hitters in the MWC. In 47 games, Hull is leading the team in runs (40), hits (54), doubles (15), home runs (8), RBI (26), total bases (97), slugging percentage (.729), walks (37) and on-base percentage (.535). Kelli Fangonilo (.336, 19 RBI, 14 SB) and Caitlyn Paus (.303) are each batting over .300 for the Rebels. Three UNLV players - Christi Robinson (10-4, 2.00 ERA, 94 2/3 innings), Stephanie Bregante (12-7, 2.45 ERA, 91 1/3 innings) and Heather Slettvet (7-5, 2.45 ERA, 99 2/3 innings) - each have logged more than 90 innings in the circle.

The Aztecs hold a slight lead on the all-time series by a 35-32 advantage. SDSU won four of five meetings in 2006.

SDSU Softball Picked to Repeat as MWC Champions

The San Diego State softball team has been picked to win the Mountain West Conference by the league's coaches in a preseason poll released by the conference. Last season, the Aztecs won their third MWC regular season title in the last five years with a 15-3 record in league play and a 34-15 overall mark, their best winning percentage in school history.

SDSU, which returns six starters, including sophomore All-American Erin Floros and junior MWC Pitcher of the Year Christina Ross, collected 25 points to capture the top spot in the poll, including five of the possible six first-place votes. Brigham Young received the other first-place vote. The Aztecs were followed by UNLV (19 points), BYU (17 points), Utah (14), Colorado State (10) and New Mexico (5).

Head Coach Kathy Van Wyk

Under 11th-year head coach Kathy Van Wyk's leadership, the Aztecs have won three of the last six (2002, 2003, 2006) Mountain West Conference regular-season titles, advanced to the NCAA tournament three times in the past six seasons, including regional runner-up finishes in 2001 and 2006, and compiled a .600 or higher winning percentage in five of the last six campaigns. SDSU has improved its winning percentage in six of the last eight seasons and have been .500 or better in eight of Van Wyk's 10 years.

Under Van Wyk's guidance, the Aztecs had their best season in school history in 2006 with a 34-15 record, culminating with a runner-up finish to host UCLA in the NCAA Regional. En route to its third MWC regular season championship in the last six seasons, SDSU set numerous team records including winning percentage (.694), conference winning percentage (.833), home winning percentage (.769), road winning percentage (.692) and most MWC victories (15).

In addition, despite playing only 49 games (SDSU typically plays around 60 games), the Aztecs set program records in batting average (.293), runs (234), home runs (27), RBI (213), slugging percentage (.410), walks (161) and on-base percentage (.379).

Her accomplishments were rewarded when she was named the 2006 MWC Coach of the Year for the second time in her career (2002 was the other time).

It would be hard to outdue last year's offense as it set school records in batting average (.293), runs (234), home runs (27), RBI (213), slugging percentage (.410), walks (161) and on-base percentage (.379), but the 2007 SDSU offense is definitely making its case. Through 43 games, the Aztecs are batting .305 and slugging .414, both which would be school records. SDSU is also on pace (based on 60-game season) to set a school record in runs (260) ... Despite hitting at sea level while the other five teams hit at elevation (New Mexico - 5,000 feet, Colorado State - 4,800, Brigham Young - 4,553, Utah - 4,500 and UNLV - 2,030), the Aztecs are first in in batting average (.305), hits (352) and stolen bases (48), and second in triples (9) and fewest strikeouts (155) ... SDSU has reached double-figures in hits on 13 occasions in 43 games, after doing so 14 times in the same amount of games last season ... The Aztecs, however, have also had nine hits on six other occasions ... Five SDSU players - Brittany Knudsen (.389), Melissa Owens (.370), Tamani Wells (.338), Lindsey Marquez (.315) and Monica Alnes (.309) - are batting over .300 this season. Only two Aztecs ((Erin Floros, .388) and Alnes (.379)) were over .300 last year.
