### THIS WEEK

The No. 2-seeded San Diego State women's soccer team begins its quest for a Mountain West Conference Championship on Thursday at South Stadium in Provo, Utah.

The Aztecs, who had their best conference finish since 2000, await the winner of Wednesday's game between No. 3-seeded BYU and sixth-seeded TCU. Thursday's semifinal contest is scheduled to start at 4 p.m. MT and will be shown live on The Mtn.- The Mountain West Sports Network.

### SCOUTING THE HORNED FROGS

If the Horned Frogs are able to advance past BYU, the semifinal game would be a rematch of a tightly contested 1-0 overtime affair in the regular-season finale between TCU and SDSU.

The loss to the Aztecs dropped TCU's conference record to 3-4, 8-10 overall. The Horned Frogs will be making its second appearance at the Soccer Championship. In 2005, No. 7-seeded TCU fell to second-seeded UNLV, 3-0, in Las Vegas, Nev.

This season, TCU has been led by senior Angie Nickens and sophomore Lizzy Karoly, who both were second team all-MWC selections this year. Nickens scored two goals in conference play, including the game winner versus New Mexico.

Karoly netted three goals in conference action and five overall. The Escondido, Calif., native was also the team leader with four game-winning goals.

### SCOUTING THE COUGARS

BYU plays host to the MWC Championship for the third time this year. The Cougars have never been lower than a No. 3 seed and last captured the title in 2002. BYU last reached the championship game in 2003.

This year, BYU will have to win three games in four days to claim the automatic bid for the Women's College Cup thanks to the Cougars' 1-0 loss in overtime to UNLV in the two teams' regular-season finale.

This season, the Cougars, who finished with most wins of any team in the MWC (14) ranked second in the nation in goals-against average (.406), fourth in shutout percentage (.632), and eighth in save percentage (.882). The team is also 19th in won-loss-tied percentage (.789).

For their efforts this season, BYU was honored with four all-conference selections. Junior Katie Larkin, sophomore Andrea Willis and freshman Cassidy Christensen were all first-team honorees, while senior goalkeeper Erika Woodbury was named to the all-conference second team.

Larkin, who scored 12 goals overall, was tied for eighth in the MWC with two goals and third in shots with 21. Christensen was tied for second with four scores tallied, while Willis anchored a defense that allowed only eight goals this year.

Woodbury is the school's all-time leader in saves (245) and shutouts (38). She is one shutout shy of tying her own school single-season record of 12 and is fourth in the nation goals against average (.417).

## Mike Friesen



**Head Coach**  
**First Season/Fourth**  
**Overall at SDSU**  
**Sonoma State, 1996**

After spending the last three years as an assistant on the San Diego State coaching staff, including the last two as associate head coach, Mike Friesen begins his first season as the Aztecs' head coach.

Friesen, the fourth head coach in Aztec history, has played a significant role in bringing excitement back to San Diego State soccer. An offensive standout in his playing days at Point Loma Nazarene (1988-89) and Sonoma State (1993-94), Friesen has helped the Aztecs' become one of the most potent offenses in the West Coast.

In 2004, SDSU reached the Mountain West Conference championship game for the first time since 1999. The team's 3-1-2 conference record was also its best since that same 1999 season.

Friesen teamed with former Aztec head coach Dr. Mike Giuliano to bring an up-tempo-in-your-face style of defense, which was successful, as evident by the team's nine shutouts in 2004, second most in school history. The Aztecs' allowed just 18 goals in 21 games that season, the program's fewest since the 1990 squad gave up 12 goals in 13 games.

Prior to coming to San Diego State, Friesen spent five years working with the UC Santa Barbara women's program.

Upon arriving in Santa Barbara, Friesen helped turn the Gaucho program around, going from a 7-29-2 mark and scoring just 27 goals the two seasons prior to his arrival, to a 24-11-6 mark in 2002-03, tallying 105 scores.

Friesen has a great deal of experience coaching at a variety of levels. Before his time at UCSB, he guided the under-19 Santa Rosa United Aftershocks to the 1999 girls' California State Cup championship. In 1997, he directed Ursuline High School in Santa Rosa, Calif., to the CIF North Coast Section championship game.

### LAST TIME @ THE CHAMPIONSHIP

The Aztecs season ended last year in the first round of the MWC Championship when No. 4-seed New Mexico tied the fifth-seeded Aztecs, 1-1, but the Lobos were able to advance with the 4-3 win on penalty kicks.

Freshman Jessica Gordon, who scored a goal, had two shots on net and was named to the conference's all-tournament team.

### LAST TIME OUT

Freshman Lauren Marquez ended the home careers of six seniors in grand fashion on Friday, as she scored her first career goal in the 98th minute to give the Aztec women's soccer team the 1-0 victory over TCU at the SDSU Sports Deck.

With the victory, the Aztecs improved to 9-7-3 overall, 4-2-1 in the Mountain West Conference. The win snapped SDSU's 14-game winless streak in contests that have gone into overtime. The overtime victory was the first since Oct. 17, 2004, against New Mexico.

In the 98th minute, SDSU made one last charge as junior Alicia Piz and Nielsen were able to move the ball into the goal box and found Marquez who was able to coral the ball five yards in front of the net and get her shot past Walters to the left side of the net. For Nielsen, the assist was her first since 2005 and Piz's third of the campaign.

### FROSH SENSATION

Breaking in a new goalkeeper might worry some coaches, but the SDSU coaching staff has had little to fret about as freshman Aubree Southwick has shined, showing why she was one of the top goalkeeper recruits in the country.

Southwick has been a mainstay in the net, starting all 19 of the Aztecs' games in 2007. She has played in over 1,716 minutes of action and leads the Mountain West Conference with 101 saves. She owns a 0.84 goals against average and stopped .863 percent of the opposition's shots on goal, which places fourth and third in both categories in the MWC, respectively.

The Danville, Calif., native became the first Aztec

goalie since Sophia Perez in 2004 to post three consecutive shutouts and ran her personal scoreless streak to 429 minutes. Southwick currently has 10 shutouts, the third highest total in SDSU single season history and one shy of tying the school record of 11.

Southwick was the 2006 NSCAA California high school state player of the year and an NSCAA All-American. The 2004 U.S. Soccer Golden Glove Award recipient earned recognition on *Soccerbuzz.com* top-50 recruits list last season.

### NINE AND COUNTING

With the wins over BYU, Wyoming and TCU, the Aztecs improved to 9-7-3 overall and in the process surpass last season's win total (6). With a victory in the first round of the MWC tournament, SDSU can record double digit wins for the third time since 2000.

### ROAD WARRIORS

Last year, SDSU struggled on the road winning only three of 11 games. With the victory at Air Force, the Aztecs surpassed that number this season.

At 4-4-1, SDSU secured its best road record since 2005 when the team went 6-4-1 away from Montezuma Mesa.

### WE'LL BE BACK

When SDSU played its game against New Mexico last Thursday in Provo, Utah, it was getting a preview of South Stadium.

The Aztecs return to the campus of BYU on Thursday to compete in Mountain West Conference tournament. This year will mark the third time the Cougars have hosted the event.

### A GREAT NIGHT FOR TV

Not only did SDSU claim a victory against No. 19 BYU in the first televised event at the SDSU Sports Deck, the Aztecs also snapped their seven game winless streak (0-6-1) against ranked opponents.

The last time SDSU beat a ranked team was on August 27, 2006, at No. 21 Purdue. The Aztecs beat the nationally ranked Boilermakers, 4-0, to claim the Boilermaker Challenge Cup.

### RAGUDOS RECEIVES HONORS

This season, the Aztec soccer team has always been able to count on senior forward Jackie Ragudos to shoulder the offensive load.

The weekend of Oct.18-21 was no exception as the San Diego native's two goals help spark the team to victories over No. 19 BYU and Wyoming. For her efforts, Ragudos earned both the Mountain West Conference Offensive Player of the Week Honors and was also named to the *Soccer Buzz* Elite Team this week.

Ragudos recorded her team-leading sixth and seventh goals, including her fourth game-winner, in the two-game span. Ragudos scored the second goal in a 2-0 win over the Cougars in a nationally televised game and added the lone tally in San Diego State's 1-0 triumph over the Cowgirls.

After not recording a point last season, Ragudos leads the 2007 Aztecs in points (17), goals (seven), assists

### TRIBBEY MAKES HISTORY

When freshman forward Katie Tribbey scored her first collegiate goal in the season opener versus Toledo, she made SDSU history. Tribbey scored 24 seconds into the contest and became the fastest player to score the Aztecs' first goal of a new campaign.

The previous record was held by Shawn Vioria who scored at the 5:40 mark in SDSU's 1993 season-opening victory over CS Fullerton.

### SOUTHWICK CLAIMS MWC HONORS

Following a weekend where she recorded consecutive shutouts on the road versus Creighton and Nebraska, San Diego State freshman goalkeeper Aubree Southwick (Danville, Calif./San Ramon Valley High) was named Mountain West Conference Co-Defensive Player of the Week on Sept. 10.

Southwick led the Aztecs to their first win of the season, 2-0, by blanking the Bluejays in Omaha, Neb., and followed that up with a 10-stop performance in a double overtime tie, 0-0, against the Cornhuskers in Lincoln.

The Danville, Calif., native hadn't given up a goal in her last 286 minutes of action, spanning three games, and had made 19 saves while registering a 0.45 goals against average on the season.

Southwick shared the honors with BYU senior goalkeeper Erika Woodbury who also posted a pair of shutouts this weekend.

On Monday, Oct. 22, Southwick claimed her second Defensive Player of the Week honor and first outright recognition.

Southwick continued her solid play, making eight saves en route to picking up her seventh and eighth shutouts of the season over the weekend. Southwick recorded five stops against Brigham Young and added three saves in the Wyoming match. Against the Cowgirls, she added her first career assist on a free kick that landed deep in Wyoming territory.

On the season, Southwick is 8-6-2 with a 0.89 goals against average in 1,416-plus minutes. She has 83 saves and an 85.6 save percentage. Among the Aztec single-season leaders, Southwick is currently second in goals against average, third in shutouts and fifth in saves.

### AZTECS ON NATIONAL TELEVISION

The San Diego State women's soccer team made two appearances this season on The Mtn.-The Mountain West Sports Network, including the program's first televised event at the SDSU Sports Deck..

On Oct. 18, the Aztecs upended No. 19 BYU at the SDSU Sports Deck, 2-0. The win was the first in seven meetings against a ranked opponent.

This past weekend's 2-1 loss to Utah in Salt Lake City was also show live via the The Mtn.

## CLASS OF THE MWC

San Diego State freshman goalkeeper Aubree Southwick made Mountain West Conference women's soccer history on Tuesday when she became the first player since the league started play in 1999 to earn two postseason individual awards in the same year when the league's eight head coaches named her both the Defensive Player of the Year and Freshman Player of the Year.

The No. 2-seeded Aztecs, in this week's MWC tournament, also had four honorees, including Southwick, named to the 2007 all-conference team.

The Danville, Calif., native tallied a league leading five shutouts in seven MWC contests while leading the Aztecs to their best conference finish since 2000. In MWC play, Southwick led all netminders in goals against average (0.41) and save percentage (.921) while also finishing in a tie for third in saves (35). Overall, Southwick leads all conference goalies with 101 stops.

The two-time MWC Defensive Player of the Week honoree joins Alexis Solovij (2004) as the program's second conference defensive player of the year recipient. The first-team all-league selection also becomes SDSU's second freshman of the year award winner along with Kim Castellanos (2000).

Joining Southwick as a first team all-MWC selection was senior Jackie Ragudos. The San Diego, native led the Aztecs offensively with three goals, six points, 12 shots and nine shots on net. Ragudos was responsible for the game-winning goals against both Air Force and Wyoming. Overall, Ragudos, who transferred from Cal Poly Pomona prior to last season, has been the team's top offensive force, leading the Aztecs with seven goals, 17 points, 30 shots, four game-winning scores and 18 shots on net.

SDSU continued to receive honors as both sophomore Millie Allen and senior Jessica Girdner were named second-team all-conference selections. Allen, who started all seven MWC contests at defender, played all 660 minutes of conference action and helped anchor a defense in front of Southwick that allowed only three goals on 94 shots. The Thornton, Colo., native made her way back from an ACL injury in her left knee to start all 19 Aztec games and tallied two game-winning scores.

Girdner, who has started 38 games dating back to the beginning of last year, also participated in all 660 minutes of MWC action this year. The San Diego, native scored the game-winning goal in the Aztecs' 2-0 win over No. 19 BYU at the SDSU Sports Deck on Oct. 18. The win snapped the team's seven-game winless streak against ranked opponents.

## PERFECT HOME MWC RECORD

With a perfect 3-0-0 record at the SDSU Sports Deck during the conference season, the Aztecs accomplished their first undefeated record at home against the MWC since 2000 (4-0-0).

Overall, SDSU won five games on The Mesa, marking its best home record since 2004 (5-3-0).

## BEST MWC FINISH SINCE 2000

The Aztecs 4-2-1 record this year is their best mark since 2000 when the team went 4-2-0.

SDSU's No. 2 seed in the conference tournament is its best since 1999 when it was the top seed with a 5-1-0 record.

## SPREADING OUT THE SCORING

This season the Aztecs have had nine players score 18 goals. Only three of the nine scored more than one goal led by senior Jackie Ragudos' seven tallies.

Coming into this season, SDSU had lost 50 percent of its scoring from 2006. This year, seven of the nine players who scored did not record a tally last year. Their goals constituted 83 percent of team's offensive output.

## AZTECS IN THE NATIONAL RANKINGS

As a team, SDSU is tied for 15th in shutout percentage thanks to a tenacious defense and stellar goaltending of freshman Aubree Southwick.

Southwick and the team's other two netminders also have helped SDSU climb to No. 18 in the save percentage (.862) in the country.

Southwick's .863 save percentage places her 21st nationally among goalkeepers.

## WALKER OUT FOR SEASON

San Diego State sophomore midfielder Cat Walker will miss the 2007 women's soccer season after injuring her left knee.

Walker, who tied for second on the team with three goals scored in her initial campaign on The Mesa, suffered damage to her anterior cruciate ligament during the team's exhibition game versus Cal State Northridge. The Folsom, Calif., native was expected to be one of the team's top play makers after starting 17 of 19 contests as a freshman.

Walker will apply for a medical redshirt which will leave her with three years of eligibility remaining in her Aztec career.

## CSUN DEFEATS SDSU IN EXHIBITION

Senior Jessica Girdner scored the Aztecs' lone goal of the afternoon, but it wasn't enough as the San Diego State women's soccer team fell, 2-1, against Cal State Northridge in exhibition play Aug. 24, at the SDSU Sports Deck.

The Aztecs finished with the 1-0 lead after 80 minutes, but the Matadors rallied in the extra 35-minute third period behind two goals from sophomore Adriene Dickerson.

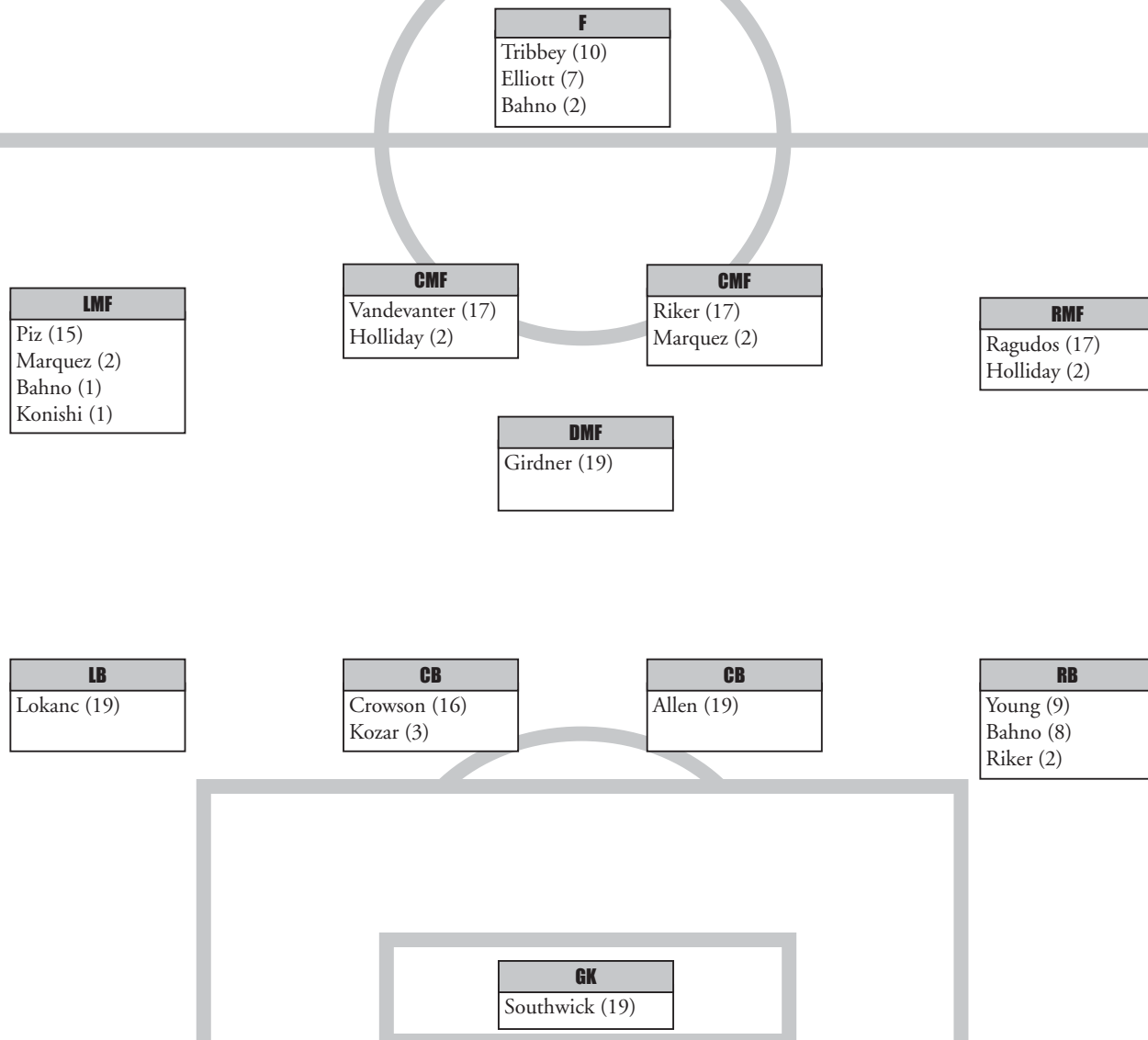
