What's On Tap

San Diego State enters its final week of play with one non-conference game versus cross-town rival USD and its final conference game at TCU. The Aztecs will play at USD on Wednesday at 7 p.m. and in Fort Worth, Texas on Saturday versus TCU at 10 a.m. PT.

Series History

- ▶ This will be the third year in a row the Aztecs and Toreros have faced each other. SDSU leads the overall series, 6-3-1, and won last year's match, 2-0, at SDSU Sports Deck
- ▶ San Diego State is a perfect 3-0 all-time versus TCU and has yet to allow the Horned Frogs to score a goal. Last year in Fort Worth, the Aztecs defeated the Frogs, 3-0.

A Look at the Opponents

- ► San Diego (9-8, 1-4 WCC) posts a 6-3 record at home but is currently in last place in the WCC. The Toreros have given up just as many goals as they have scored (25) and are being outshot, 194-182, by their opponents. Leigh Ann Robinson leads the Torero offense with seven goals and six assists. She currently leads the team in goals (seven), assists (six), points (20), shots (36) and shots on goal (23). In goal for USD as of late has been Karen Cook. Cook owns a 4-4 record with two shutouts and a 1.24 GAA.
- ▶ The Horned Frogs (5-8-4, 0-3-3 MWC) are still in search of their first conference win of 2006. TCU is being outdone by their opponents in all offensive categories (25-18 in goals, 264-231 in shots and 105-81 in corners). Lizzy Karoly leads the Horned Frogs in goals (six), points (14), shots (62) and shots on goal (35). Her six goals are tied for third best in the MWC while her 62 shots lead the MWC. Katy Buchanan has played the majority of minutes in goal for TCU and has a 4-7-3 record with a 1.48 GAA.

What to Watch For

- ▶ The ability of the Aztec defense to prevent scoring opportunities and plays from USD's Leigh Ann Robinson
- ▶ SDSU's offense. The Aztecs have not lost a game all season when they score at least one goal (6-0-

The Mello and Sutton Connection

They're back... A year after leading the team in scoring as freshmen and accounting for 44.6 percent of the team's points, sophomores Jen Mello and Erika Sutton could have an even better season in 2006.

Over the course of the last two seasons, the Aztecs are 12-2-1 (3-0-1 in 2006) when Sutton records at least one point, 11-2-1 (5-0-1 in 2006) when Mello does the same and 7-1 (2-0 in 2006) when each contributes at least one point.

The sophomore duo has 53.3 (8-of-15) of the squad's assists, 52.6 (30-of-57) percent of its points, and 52.4 (11-of-21) percent of the team's goals.

Earlier this season, Sutton became the fourth Aztec to be named to the Soccer Buzz Elite Team of the Week and also earned MWC Offensive Player of the Week honors. Mello became the third Aztec in 2006 to garner MWC Player of the Week honors, winning the award for her three-goal, one-assist performance versus No. 15 BYU and Wyoming.

Last season, Sutton earned Soccer Buzz Freshman All-Far West Region accolades and was named second-team all-MWC.

Aztec Notes

- ▶ 19 of 21 goals this year for SDSU have come from underclassmen.
- ▶ The Aztecs have started eight underclassmen in 15 of 17 games this season.
- ▶ 25 Aztecs have seen playing time this year.
- ▶ The Aztecs have used 13 different starting lineups in 17 games in 2006.

Not Mello-ing Out

In her sophomore year, Jen Mello is continuing to be an integral part of the Aztec offense. She currently leads the team in goals (8), points (19) and shots on goal (22). Mello has three multi-goal games in 2006 (Sept. 8 at UC Irvine, Oct. 8 vs UNLV and Oct. 15 at Wyoming). The Pleasanton, Calif., native is second in the Mountain West in goals (8), goals per game (0.47), points (19) and points per game (1.12). Mello's performance two weeks ago earned her the Mountain West Conference Co-Offensive Player of the Week for Oct. 9-15. During the week, Mello scored three goals and tallied one assist (two goals versus Wyoming; one goal, one assist at No. 15 BYU). Mello also was named to the Soccer Buzz National Elite Team of the Week for her performance versus BYU and Wyoming. It was the first such honor for the sophomore forward.

Sutton On Point

Despite playing defender for the last few matches, sophomore Erika Sutton has tallied 11 points through 17 contests this season, which has her tied for seventh in the Mountain West. Her five assists place her second in the MWC behind Utah's Amanda Feigt. The Arvada, Colo., native was named a Breitbard Star of the Month for August by the San Diego Hall of Champions for her two-goal, two-assist performance at the Purdue Boilermaker Cup, which also earned her the MWC Offensive Player of the Week award.

Strength of Schedule

The coaching staff certainly didn't make things easy for a young squad with a schedule that features 10 opponents that advanced to the 2005 NCAA soccer tournament. Here is a look at how far those teams advanced:

A Look Back

The Aztecs began the week with a 2-0 loss in Albuquerque at the hands of the Lobos. In its final home game of the 2006 season, SDSU held No. 15 Utah scoreless in the first half but the Utes scored two in the second half to win, 2-0. It is the first time since conference play began that the Aztecs have been shutout in consecutive games.

New Mexico 2, SDSU 0

ALBUQUERQUE, N.M. – The San Diego State women's soccer team lost its first conference match of the season, falling to New Mexico, 2-0, at the UNM Soccer Complex in Albuquerque. It is the first time in four games the Aztecs have been kept off the scoreboard.

New Mexico kept the ball on SDSU's side of the field, taking seven of the first nine shots (three on goal) early in the first half. Finally, in the 39th minute, the Lobos broke through when Bridgette Sanchez took a pass from Kristine Sweat and shot it in from five yards out to give New Mexico the 1-0 lead. SDSU would get three more shots in the first half, but none of them found their way into the net.

San Diego State would get the first two shots of the second half; one of them from sophomore Erika Sutton (Arvada, Colo.) just missed when it hit the crossbar and deflected out. New Mexico would score its second goal just over eight minutes into the second half when the Aztecs knocked the ball into their own net for an own goal.

Sutton led the Aztec squad with three shots (two on goal) followed by freshmen Heather Vandevanter (Alamo, Calif.) and Cat Walker (Folsom, Calif.), who each had two shots apiece. SDSU outcornered the Lobos, 5-3, but were outshot, 13-12.

Goalkeeper Cat Burson (Poway, Calif.) had seven saves while playing all 90 minutes for the Aztecs.

No. 15 Utah 2, SDSU 0

SAN DIEGO – After a scoreless first half, the Utah Utes scored twice in the second half to defeat SDSU, 2-0, at SDSU Sports Deck on Sunday. Jennifer Klunder (La Mirada, Calif.), the lone Aztec senior on the team, played her last game in front of the home crowd on Senior Day. Klunder, who led the team in points (8), shots (40) and shots on goal (22) as a sophomore, started the second half for SDSU.

Utah outshot the Aztecs, 5-1, in the first half but it was a fairly even game heading into halftime. The ball was kept in the middle of the field much of the first half as both defenses buckled down as the half progressed.

Just over eight minutes into the second half, the Utes Adele Letro happened to be at the right place at the right time when a ball bounced off an Aztec defender right to her. Letro then beat one defender and placed a high shot out of the reach of Aztec goalkeeper Cat Burson (Poway, Calif.) to give the Utes a 1-0 lead.

After Utah scored its first goal, SDSU went on the offensive, moving the ball into Ute territory. The Aztecs strung off three straight possessions that ended with shots on goal but none of the shots were able to get by Utah's Ashley Mason, who recorded five saves on the day.

In the 70th minute, Utah's Amanda Feigt ended up with the ball down the left sideline and ran it down toward the goal, beating one defender. Feigt placed her shot in the far right corner and made it 2-0 Utah with just over 20 minutes left to play.

Overall, the Aztecs outshot the Utes, 9-8, and held a 3-2 advantage in corner kicks. Sophomore Erika Sutton (Arvada, Colo.) took three of the Aztecs' nine shots while classmate Jen Mello (Pleasanton, Calif.) had two.
