San Diego State Softball Ready for Liberty at NCAA Los Angeles Regional

The back-to-back Mountain West champion San Diego State softball team heads to the campus of No. 2/2 UCLA to play Liberty for the NCAA Los Angeles Regional at Easton Stadium.

The Aztecs (35-15) earned the No. 3 seed in the double-elimination regional after winning the first Mountain West tournament contested since 2006 by a combined 20-4 score last weekend. SDSU plays the Flames (38-20) at 8 p.m. PT Friday on ESPN. The host Bruins (51-5), the No. 2 overall seed in the tournament, meet Grand Canyon (46-11) in the other game at 5 p.m. PT. The NCAA Los Angeles Regional is the toughest in the country according to average RPI (32.00).

SDSU is playing in its 13th NCAA tournament and second straight under second-year head coach Stacey Nuveman Deniz. San Diego State, which also made the tournament in 2001, 2003, 2006, 2008, 2009, 2010, 2011, 2012, 2013, 2014 and 2022, is 18-24 all-time in the NCAA championship, has advanced to six NCAA regional finals and won at least one game in the double-elimination regional in 11 of its previous 12 appearances.

The Aztecs are playing in Los Angeles for the fifth time out of their 13 appearances in a NCAA regional (also 2001, 2006, 2010, 2012 and 2015), owning a 10-10 record at Easton Stadium. SDSU played host Bruins earlier this month (May 5), falling by a 4-3 score.

The regional winners will advance to super regional competition for a best-of-three series from May 25-28 at eight campus sites.

Four players are hitting at least .350 for San Diego State, including Cali Decker (.381, 4 HR, 32 RBI, 27 R), Bella Espinoza (.379, 52 R, 28 SB), Mac Barbara (.376, 13 HR, 44 RBI, 31 R) and Jillian Celis (.357, 6 HR, 46 RBI, 37 R).

The Mountain West Pitcher of the Year Allie Light leads the Aztec pitching staff with a 12-6 record, school-record seven saves and a 1.86 ERA in 113 innings, while Sarah Lehman (10-4, 3 SV, 2.58 ERA, 84.0 IP) and Dee Dee Hernandez (8-3, 4 SV, 3.14 ERA, 71.1 IP) have also logged 70-plus innings in the circle.

STACEY NUVEMAN DENIZ
HEAD COACH | 2ND SEASON (15TH OVERALL) | UCLA, 2002

- Was named San Diego State's fifth head coach in program history on June 8, 2021, taking over for SDSU's all-time winningest head coach Kathy Van Wyk.
- Helped lead SDSU to seven straight NCAA tournaments from 2009-15 and a combined 398-264 (.601) record in her 14 seasons on The Mesa as an assistant coach, associate head coach and head coach in waiting.
- In her first season as SDSU's head coach in 2022, San Diego State went 39-16 (.712) for the second-best winning percentage in school history, winning the Mountain West regular-season title for the first time since 2014.
- Was named the Mountain West Coach of the Year in 2022 in her first season as head coach.
- Is 74-31 (.705) as head coach at San Diego State, leading the Aztecs to a Mountain West Tournament title in 2023.
- Was the head coach of the National Pro Fastpitch's Chicago Bandits for the 2018 season, leading the Bandits to the NPF Championship series in her first year.
- Also has served as an assistant coach for the Women's National Team and USA Softball Junior Women's (19-Under) Selection Camps.
- As a player, was a three-time U.S. Olympian, winning gold medals in 2000 and 2004, and a silver medal in 2008. Also helped the United States National Team to a World Cup championship (2006), two World Championships (2002 and 2006) and two Pan American gold medals (1999 and 2003).
- Was a standout player at UCLA, finishing her four-year career with four NCAA records - 90 home runs, .945 slugging percentage, 240 walks and 81 intentional walks. She was a four-time first-team NFCA All-American (1997, 1999, 2001-02) and a three-time Pac-10 Player of the Year (1999, 2001-02).
- In 1999, Nuveman Deniz led the Bruins to a national championship, batting .446 during the season with 31 home runs and 91 RBIs.

- * All 13 NCAA tournament appearances have come this century, including 2001, 2003, 2006, 2008, 2009, 2010, 2011, 2012, 2013, 2014, 2015, 2022 and now 2023.
- * San Diego State is 18-24 all-time at the NCAAs, with five of the losses coming at the hands of UCLA (twice in 2001, and once in 2006, 2010 and 2015).
- * SDSU has advanced to six NCAA regional finals (2001, 2006, 2011, 2012, 2015 and 2022) out of its 12 appearances, but has never made it to the NCAA Super Regionals.
- * San Diego State has made the regional final in four of its five trips to Easton Stadium (2001, 2006, 2012 and 2015), only not qualifying in 2010.
- * The Aztecs have won at least one game in the double-elimination regional in 11 of its 12 appearances.
- * SDSU is 18-14 in the tournament when playing as a neutral team (0-10 as the road squad).
- * San Diego State is 10-10 all-time in Los Angeles in the NCAA tournament, going 3-2 in the eight-team field in 2001, and in the current four-team field 2-2 in 2006, 1-2 in 2010, 2-2 in 2012 and 2-2 in 2015.
- * The Aztecs have made the regional final in four of their five appearances at UCLA.
- * SDSU is the No. 3 seed in the four-team regional for its seventh consecutive NCAA tournament appearance (also 2011-15, and 2022).
- San Diego State is 10-12 all-time as the No. 3 seed, advancing to four regional finals (2011 in Tempe, 2012 in Los Angeles, 2015 in Los Angeles and 2022 in Tempe).
- * The Aztecs are playing in the tournament's toughest regional for the fifth time over its last six appearances (also 2012, 2013, 2015 and 2022). The exception was the 2014 season in Tempe, which still featured ninth-ranked Arizona State and No. 20 Michigan. This year's Los Angeles Regional averages a 32.00 RPI, ahead of the Salt Lake City Regional (39.00). More on that below.

Aztecs Playing in the Toughest NCAA Regional (Again)

No stranger to playing tough competition, San Diego State will once again play in the toughest region out of the 16 regionals of the NCAA tournament.

This weekend's NCAA Los Angeles Regional features UCLA (No. 2 in the final regular season RPI), Liberty (No. 28), the Aztecs (No. 34) and Grand Canyon (No. 64), which comes out to an average RPI of 32.00. The next-toughest regional based on average RPI is the Salt Lake City Regional, which has Utah (No. 18), Baylor (No. 19), Ole Miss (No. 35) and Southern Illinois (No. 84), and an average RPI of 39.00.

This marks the fifth time in SDSU's last six appearances that it has played in the toughest region. In 2012, San Diego State played with a group at the NCAA Los Angeles Regional that averaged 30.75 (next best was 31.50). In 2013 at the NCAA Tempe Regional, the Aztecs' quartet averaged a 36.00 RPI (next toughest was 39.75). In 2015, SDSU played at the NCAA Los Angeles Regional, which had an average RPI of 31.00 (No. 2 was Eugene Regional at 36.00). Then last year San Diego State played at the NCAA Tempe Regional, which had a 36.25 (next toughest was 37.00). The only exception to the rule over the last five appearances was 2014 at the NCAA Tempe Regional, where San Diego State still had No. 4/4 Arizona State and No. 13/13 Michigan to contest with.

Allie Light Named Mountain West Pitcher of the Year

San Diego State softball junior Allie Light (Lexington, S.C.) has been named the Mountain West Pitcher of the Year, the league announced May 10. Light was one of a league-high seven all-MW selections for the Aztecs.

The postseason awards are voted on by the league's nine head coaches and take into account MW games only. Light was joined on the all-MW first team by sophomore Mac Barbara (Long Beach, Calif.) and junior Makena Brocki (Chino Hills, Calif.), while four SDSU players landed on the second team, including senior Sarah Lehman (Iowa City, Iowa), junior Jillian Celis (Corona, Calif.), and sophomores Cali Decker (Lake Mary, Fla.) and Bella Espinoza (Huntington Beach, Calif.).

Light became San Diego State's 11th MW Pitcher of the Year - the most in league history - and second straight Aztec to win the award (Maggie Balint in 2022). SDSU's other winners have been San Diego State hall of famer Sandra Durazo (2001), Bre DeSanta (2002), Celena Velasquez (2003 and 2004), Christina Ross (2006 and 2008), Samantha Beasley (2010), Rebecca Arbino (2013) and Danielle O'Toole (2014).

Light was 7-1 with two saves and a 1.37 ERA in league play across 61 1/3 innings, striking out 36 against 12 walks, while limiting the opposition to a .213 average. Light, who won four MW Pitcher-of-the-Week awards on the season, tops the MW in league games in ERA, and is tied for first in saves, third in appearances (16), tied for third in wins and fourth in opponent batting average, while pitching for the top pitching staff in the conference.

In all games, Light is 12-6 with an Aztec single-season record seven saves and a 1.86 ERA, striking out 93 with just 20 walks allowed in 113 innings, holding her opponents to a .212 average. Among the national leaders, the right-hander is tied for sixth in saves, 37th in strikeout-to-walk ratio (7.71) and 41st in walks allowed per seven innings (1.24).

Barbara made her second straight all-MW first team after being named the MW Player of the Year in 2022. A two-time MW Player of the Week this season, Barbara batted .459 (28-for-61) in league play with eight home runs, 24 RBIs, 18 runs, three doubles, 14 walks and five stolen bases, while posting a .902 slugging percentage and a .564 on-base mark. Barbara's eight home runs were tied for the most in MW-only games. She also was solo second in slugging percentage, on-base percentage, OPS percentage (1.466), total bases (55) and batting average, while ranking in a tie for fourth in RBIs. Overall, Barbara is batting .376 (53-for-141) with 13 home runs, 44 RBIs, 31 runs, eight doubles, 28 walks, seven stolen bases, a .709 slugging percentage and a .480 on-base percentage.

Brocki made her first all-MW team after hitting .371 (23-for-62) in league play with 19 RBIs, 13 runs, eight doubles, four triples, a .629 slugging percentage and a .423 on-base mark. Brocki's eight doubles were the second most in league games, while her four triples were tied for second. Overall, Brocki is hitting .271 (35-for-129) with 30 RBIs, 18 runs, 13 doubles, four triples and six stolen bases.

Lehman made the most of her one season on The Mesa, going 4-2 in league action with a save and a 3.05 ERA in 39 innings. Lehman, who was a second-team all-Big East selection last year at DePaul after spending 2019-21 with Iowa, struck out 49 in league play and limited her opponents to a MW-low .186 average. Overall, Lehman is 10-4 with three saves and a 2.58 ERA, posting 101 strikeouts in 84 innings, holding the opposition to a .185 average. Among the national leaders, the right-hander is 40th in hits allowed per seven innings (4.58) and 42nd in strikeouts per seven innings (8.42).

Celis made her second MW second team (2021), posting a .313 average (21-for-67) with three home runs, 21 RBIs, 20 runs, seven doubles, three triples and a .642 slugging percentage. Celis, who has started 177 consecutive games, is hitting .357 overall with six home

runs, a team-high 46 RBIs, 37 runs, 13 doubles, three triples, a .592 slugging percentage and a .429 on-base percentage.

Decker landed on the all-MW second team in her first season at SDSU after transferring from Florida, batting .386 (22-for-57) with a home run, 14 RBIs, 15 runs, 12 walks and a .493 on-base mark. In all games, Decker is hitting a team-best .381 (51-for-134) with four homers, 32 RBIs, 27 runs, 24 walks and a .476 on-base mark.

Espinoza made her second all-conference team after earning first-team honors as a freshman last year. In MW games, Espinoza hit .352 (25-for-71) with 25 runs, 10 walks and 13 stolen bases with her 25 runs ranking in a tie for first and her 13 stolen bases second. Overall, Espinoza is batting .379 (64-for-169) with 52 runs and 28 stolen bases.

Makena Brocki Named to College Sports Communicators Academic All-District Team

San Diego State softball junior second baseman Makena Brocki (Chino Hills, Calif.) has been named to the 2023 Academic All-District Team, the College Sports Communicators (CSC) announced today.

The Academic All-District teams are divided into eight geographic districts across the United States and Canada, and recognize the nation's top student-athletes for their combined performances athletically and in the classroom. Academic All-District honorees advance to the CSC Academic All-American Team ballot, where first-, second- and third-team All-America honorees will be selected next month.

To be nominated, a student-athlete must be a starter or important reserve with at least a 3.50 cumulative grade point average (on a 4.0 scale) at her current institution.

Brocki is a criminal justice major with a 3.70 GPA, and a two-time Mountain West Scholar-Athlete (2021-22) and two-time MW Spring All-Academic Team (2021-22) selection.

On the field, Brocki earned all-MW first-team accolades last week after hitting .371 (23-for-62) in league play with 19 RBIs, 13 runs, eight doubles, four triples, a .629 slugging percentage and a .423 on-base mark. Brocki's eight doubles were the second most in league games, while her four triples tied for second. Overall, Brocki is hitting .271 (35-for-129) with 30 RBIs, 18 runs, 13 doubles, four triples and six stolen bases.

Brocki is the first San Diego State player to earn Academic All-District honors since Samantha Camello in 2016 and just the sixth Aztec since 2004. Camello eventually was named a second-team CoSIDA (now CSC) Academic All-American that year.

Home Sweet Home

San Diego State has once again had a good season through 50 games, but has been even better at home. The Aztecs finished 24-4 at SDSU Softball Stadium for their highest home winning percentage (.857) in program history.

Additionally, SDSU closed the season with 13 consecutive home games at SDSU Softball Stadium, tied for the seventh-longest streak in the country with UCLA, Louisiana and Southeast Missouri State. Below is a look at the longest home winning streaks in the country.
