# San Diego State Postgame Notes vs. Bakersfield

Final Score: No. 16/16 San Diego State 51, Bakersfield 27

## **Top Notes**

- The 27 points allowed tonight is the fewest allowed in a Division I game this season. Tennessee Tech and UT-Martin both allowed 29 earlier this season.
- The 27 points allowed is also the fewest allowed in SDSU Division I history and the fewest since Dec. 3, 1949, when it defeated Whittier, 39-27.
- SDSU limited Bakersfield to 21.4-percent shooting, the fifth-lowest effort in Division I this season.
- Tonight was the 45th time SDSU has held an opponent to a field-goal percentage of 33.3 or below since 1996-97.
- The 12 first-half points given up by the Aztecs is tied for the fifth-fewest allowed in the nation, matching the 12 allowed by North Carolina State in its game vs. Jacksonville on Nov. 20.
- The 12 points allowed by SDSU in the first half were the second-fewest allowed by the Aztecs since 1996-97. The total ranks second behind the 11 Southern Utah points in the first 20 minutes on Dec. 18, 2013.
- San Diego State did not allow the opposing team to have a double-figure scorer for the second straight game.

#### **Team Notes**

- SDSU is 3-0 for the fifth time in the Steve Fisher era and for the first time since 2011-12.
- San Diego State has won 61 consecutive home games when holding its opponent to less than 60 points.
- The Aztecs won their 50th straight non-conference regular-season game vs. an unranked opponent.
- SDSU has won 17 consecutive home games, which matches the third-longest streak in school history.
- San Diego State has won 13 straight non-conference games, which is the second-longest streak in program history.
- The Aztecs have won eight straight non-conference home games.
- SDSU has won eight consecutive games vs. schools from the state of Utah.
- San Diego State won its 123<sup>rd</sup> straight game when leading with five minutes to play.
- The Aztecs are now 2-0 all-time vs. Bakersfield.
- SDSU grabbed at least 15 offensive rebounds for the third straight game.
- San Diego State has forced at least 17 turnovers in all three games this season.
- The Aztecs owned a 21-0 advantage in points off turnovers.

#### **Player Notes**

#### Dwayne Polee II – 13 points (6-6 FT), 5 rebounds, 2 assists, 1 blocked shot, 3 steals

Reached double-figures in scoring for the second times this season, the seventh time in his last eight games and for the 22<sup>nd</sup> time of his career... Recorded his third-straight multiple-steal performance of the year... Led all scorers with 13 points and led the team in scoring for the third time of his career (1<sup>st</sup> this season)... His three steals were a game-high.

## Winston Shepard – 6 points, 6 rebounds, 2 blocked shots

Set a season high in rebounds with six... His two blocked shots were also a season best and one off his career high... Led the team in rebounding for the fifth time of his career.

## Skylar Spencer – 1 point, 4 blocked shots, 3 rebounds, 2 steals

Posted his second multiple-blocked-shot effort of the season and the 40th of his career... Has blocked a shot in all three games this season... Led all players with four blocked shots.

## Kevin Zabo - 7 points, 2 rebounds, 2 assists, 1 steal

Established a career high in points and assists... His two boards matched a career high.

## Dakarai Allen – 5 points, 5 rebounds, 1 assist, 2 steals

Grabbed a career-high five rebounds... Picked up his first assist of the season... Recorded a season-high two steals.

#### Malik Pope – 4 points, 2 rebounds, 2 blocks, 2 steals

The true freshman saw his first action of his career and played 14 minutes.
