# Postgame Football Notes — San Diego State at No. 14/16 Brigham Young Dec. 12, 2020 | LaVell Edwards Stadium | Provo, Utah

Records: San Diego State (4-4, 4-2 Mountain West); Brigham Young (10-1)

## **Team Notes**

- SDSU has still won 14 of its last 21 games (14-7), 32 of its last 48 (32-16), 39 of its last 57 (39-18), 52 of its last 71 (52-19) and 53 of its last 75 since the 2015 season (53-22).
- San Diego State is outscoring the opposition, 59-20, in the first quarter this season.
- The Aztecs allowed seven points in the first quarter and have now allowed just 19 points over the last nine first quarters.

## **Series History**

- San Diego State dropped to 8-29-1 all-time against Brigham Young.
- The Aztecs are now 2-17 all-time against the Cougars in Provo.

#### **Trends**

- San Diego did not start with the ball for just the 19th time over the last 118 games.
- The Aztecs allowed their opponent to score on their opening possession for just the second time this season and for just the 20th time since 2015 (75 games).
- SDSU has scored in the first quarter in eight of the last nine games.
- San Diego State is outscoring the opposition, 59-20, in the first quarter this season.
- The Aztecs fell to 4-3 on the season when leading after the first quarter and 11-8 in the Brady Hoke era.
- SDSU had scored in 16 straight second quarters prior to tonight.

# **Player Notes**

- \* Kaegun Williams, Jr., RB (17 att., 91 yds., 1 TD | 1 rec., 4 yds.)
  - Rushed for 91 yards and a touchdown on 17 attempts, while adding a 4-yard catch.
  - Set career highs in both rushing attempts (17) and yards (91).
  - The rushing touchdown was the first of his career (was playing in his 27th career game).
  - Now has two overall touchdowns.
- \* Elijah Kothe, Jr., WR (2 rec., 28 yds., 1 TD)
  - Had a pair of catches for 28 yards with a touchdown.
  - The touchdown was the first of his career (was playing in his 28th career game).

# \* Jordon Brookshire, Jr., QB (21-for-31, 231 yds., 1 TD, 1 INT | 9 att., 13 yds.)

- Completed 21 of 31 passes for 231 yards with a touchdown.
- Ended up setting career highs in completions (21), pass attempts (31) and passing yards (231).
- The touchdown pass was his second this season (and second of career).

# \* Tayler Hawkins, Sr., CB (6 tackles (4 solo))

- Had six tackles, including four solo stops.
- Led the team in tackles for the second time of his career.

## **Other Notes**

- WAR Tariq Thompson started for the 47th consecutive game, the longest streak on the team (offense/defense).
- WAR Tariq Thompson and LS Turner Bernard each played in their 47th straight games, the longest streaks on the team.
- LS Turner Bernard played in his 51st career game, the most on the team.
- DE Connor Mitchell earned his first career start.
- LB Michael Shawcroft forced his second fumble of the season (and career).
- WAR Tariq Thompson recovered the sixth fumble of his career, tied for the third most in program history.
- Tonight's temperature was 25 degrees, the coldest game for SDSU since Dec. 3, 2016 at Wyoming in the MW Championship (18 degrees) and the fourth-coldest Aztec game in their Division I history (since 1969).
