AZTECS SET PAIR OF NON-COFERENCE MATCHES THIS WEEK

- San Diego State will play a pair of non-conference matches this week with one on the road and one at home.
- On Tuesday, Nov. 9, the Aztecs will make the short trip north to face Cal State Fullerton at 7:00 p.m. in Titan Gym.
- ◆ On Saturday, Nov. 13, SDSU be at home as it hosts Cal State Bakersfield for a match scheduled to get underway at 5:00 p.m. in Peterson Gym.

SERIES RECORDS

- ◆ San Diego State holds a 42-4 edge in its series vs. Cal State Fullerton that dates back to the 1976 season. SDSU won the first 32 meeting between the teams with the Titans picking up their first victory over the Aztecs in 1989. The teams have split their most recent six matches with the Aztecs defeating the Titans in five-sets in Peterson Gym last year. CSF has won the last three matches played in Fullerton (2004, 2006, 2008).
- ◆ SDSU is 3-0 against Cal State Bakersfield after defeating the Roadrunners both at home and on the road during the 2009 season. The first meeting between the teams came in Bakersfield during the 1992 campaign. The Aztecs captured that match in three sets.

SCOUTING THE OPPOSITION

- ◆ Cal State Fullerton enters the week with a record of 21-5 and is receiving votes in this week's AVCA national poll. The Titans are led by middle blocker Erin Saddler (4.33 kills, 2.02 digs per set) and outside hitter Torrie Brown (3.19 kills per set). Kayla Neto is averaging 3.03 kills per set with a .333 hitting percentage. The Titans are hitting .257 as a team while holding opponents to a 1.75 attack percentage.
- ◆ Cal State Bakersfield stands at 0-26 as the Roadrunners have had to deal with injuries throughout most of the season. CSUB is led by the hitting of Lindy DeGeare (3.07 kills, 2.06 digs per set) and Haleigh Haratyk (2.35 kills, 2.11 digs per set). Eight of the 14 players on the Roadrunner roster are from Bakersfield. Starting middle blocker Alysia Baker is a junior from Vista, Calif. (Tri-City Christian HS).

COACH DEITRE COLLINS-PARKER

- San Diego State Head Coach Deitre Collins-Parker is in her second season with the Aztecs after being named the fourth head coach in program history last year.
- ◆ She previously served as head coach at UNLV for eight seasons (1996-2003) and at Cornell for five years (2004-2008). Her record at SDSU is 27-28 (.491) and her career mark stands at 189-219 (.463).
- ◆ A three-time All-American as a player at the University of Hawai'i, she led the Rainbow Wahine to consecutive national titles (1983-84) and was named the national player of the year twice.
- Collins-Parker was a member of the U.S. Olympic Team and competed at the Goodwill and Pan Am Games prior to playing professionally in Europe for four years.
- ◆ She was one of six players named to the NCAA Division I Women's Volleyball 25th Anniversary Team in October 2005 and was inducted into the AVCA Hall of Fame in the fall of 2008.

HANNASCH ON THE BLOCK

- Middle blocker Andrea Hannasch tied her career high in kills last Thursday and then set a new career-best in kills on Saturday.
- At Utah on Thursday (Nov. 4), she recorded 16 kills to equal her personal best as an Aztec which she has achieved on five occasions
- ◆ In the match at Brigham Young on Saturday (Nov. 6), she set new career bests with 18 kills and 23 points.
- ◆ Over SDSU's two matches last week she averaged 3.78 kills, 1.33 blocks, 1.00 digs and 4.61 points per set while hitting .329.
- ◆ Hannasch continues to be among the top blockers in the Mountain West Conference as overall average of 1.26 blocks per set ranks third in the MWC this week.
- ♦ Her mark of 1.30 blocks per set in league matches ranks fourth.
- she is currently 31st in the nation in blocking. Those rankings include athletes from 319 Division I teams.
- ◆ In addition, she is averaging 2.65 kills, 1.25 digs and 3.48 points per set.

JACKELS DIGS CAREER BEST

- Sophomore libero Kristi Jackels ranks set her SSU career high with 32 digs in the match against Brigham Young last Saturday (Nov. 6).
- She becomes just the seventh Aztec to ever record 30 or more digs in a match, joining current teammate Johnna Fouch (who had 30 vs. UC Irvine in September) on that list.
- Her previous high in digs came at UC Santa Barbara in the final match of the 2009 season.
- She set her 2010 season best with 28 digs in the contest vs. UC Santa Barbara at home on Sept. 18.
- ◆ She ranks fourth in the conference in digs this week with an average of 3.62 per set.

- ◆ In SDSU's two matches last week she averaged 5.00 digs per set.
- Jackels had back-to-back 18-dig efforts earlier this season against Utah State and Arizona State.
- ◆ She has been in double figures in digs in 21 of SDSU's 26 matches.
- ◆ Her four aces against Northern Colorado on Aug. 28 are the most by an Aztec this year.
- ◆ She has recorded at least one assist in each of the last 10 matches and 18 of the last 19.

NASH ON THE ATTACK

- Freshman Summer Nash set her career high in kills for the fourth time in five matches with 16 against Utah last Thursday (Nov. 4).
- ◆ She had a pair of 12-kill efforts in contests at Air Force (Oct. 21) and UNLV (Oct. 23, which were her career-high at the time.
- Against UC Riverside on Oct. 26, she recorded 13 kills for a new personal SDSU best.
- ◆ Two days later (Oct. 28) she set another new career high with 15 kills in the win over Wyoming. She also hit .429 in that contest.
- Nash has a string of six straight double-figures kill matches end with last Saturday's contest at Brigham Young. In those matches she averaged 3.55 kills per set.
- ◆ Her .333 attack percentage in the contest at Brigham Young (Nov. 6) marks the 11th time this season that she has hit better than .300 in a match.

SHELTON SHINES

- ◆ Freshman Raegan Shelton tied her career best with 20 kills in the win over Brigham Young last weekend (Nov. 6).
- ◆ Her three blocks and six digs in that match were both one shy of her season bests.
- ◆ She has been in double figures in kills in five of the past six matches and she is averaging 3.52 kills per set over that span.
- After missing four matches due to injury, Shelton came off the bench in the second set against Wyoming on Oct. 28 to notch 14 kills, four blocks, two service aces and a .414 attack percentage in the win over the Cowgirls.
- ◆ The four blocks represented her career high as an Aztec.
- ◆ In the win over host Arizona State on Sept. 3, she recorded a career-high 20 kills while hitting .500 for the match.
- Shelton had her second-best kill total of the season with 16 in the win over Utah in the previous match (Oct. 9).
- ◆ She hit .417 in that match and also set a career best with eight digs.
- ◆ She is second on the team in kill average at 2.91 per set.

PEACOCK AT HER BEST

- Outside hitter Jessica Peacock recorded 13 kills in the victory at BYU last Saturday (Nov. 6) and also contributed four blocks.
- ◆ She set a career high hitting percentage (.562) in the contest vs. Seattle on Oct. 15.
- ◆ She had established career best in with 17 kills in the win over Utah on Oct. 9.
- ♦ Her 18.5 points in that match against Utah was her best total as an Aztec as well.
- ◆ She set her season high in blocks with six against UC Santa Barbara on Sept. 18.

FOUCH SETTING IT UP

- Freshman setter Johnna Fouch's 54 assists in the win at Brigham Young (Nov. 6) was her second-highest total of the season and just one short of her career high.
- ◆ Her 54 assists vs. BYU was the sixth time this season that she has had more than 50 in a match.
- ◆ She continues to lead the MWC in assists with an average of 10.62 per set.
- ◆ She recorded her 10th double-double of the fall with 47 assists and 13 digs at Utah last week (Nov. 4).
- ◆ Her assist average also ranks 54th in the nation (NCAA Division I) this week.
- ◆ In the match vs. UC Irvine in Honolulu on Sept. 11, she set career bests with five total blocks and 32 digs.

OROPEZA ON DEFENSE

- Freshman defensive specialist Kyla Oropeza has seen action in 25 of SDSU's 26 matches this season and started on three occasions.
- ◆ She recorded eight digs and a service ace at Utah last Thursday (Nov. 4) and followed that with six digs, an ace and an assist at Brigham Young two days later.
- ◆ Oropeza is averaging 1.33 digs per set and has appeared in 87 of the teams 98 sets this fall
- ◆ In the win over Utah (Oct. 9), she had her second-highest dig total of the season with nine and tied her season best with two assists
- ◆ She was the server in the fifth set vs. the Utes on Oct. 9 when SDSU came from behind (7-13) to score eight straight points and win the match.

MANASCO HEATS UP

- Senior outside hitter Kelsey Manasco set a new career high with a .550 hitting percentage in the win over UC Riverside on Oct. 26.
- Her 12 kills in that contest represented a season high as did her four block assists and 15.0 points.
- Against Wyoming (Oct. 28) she again recoded four block assists and added a season-high four assists which also tied her Aztec career best.

SALISBURY'S SIDELINED

- Senior middle blocker Lauren Salisbury suffered a wrist injury on Sept. 28 and is expected to miss the remainder of the 2010 season.
- She is a two-time all-conference selection and was named to the 2010 preseason all-MWC squad as well.
- With a total of 33 block assists this season, Salisbury will likely finish her Aztec career with as she has moved into the top 10 on the SDSU career list.
- Salisbury's total ranks tenth all-time and is eight behind Angelica Jackson's (1984-87) ninth-highest total of 341.

PEARSON PROVIDES SPARK

- ◆ Junior outside hitter Paije Pearson had a solid match in last Saturday's win at Brigham Young, finishing with six kills, nine digs, five blocks and a service ace.
- She set a career high with seven blocks assists and seven total blocks in the win over Wyoming on Oct. 28.
- She had tied her previous career best of five block assists two days earlier vs. UC Riverside.
- She has recorded six total blocks in a match twice this season. That came in back-to-back matches vs. Utah and Seattle.
- Her 10 digs vs. Wyoming (Oct. 28) was the third time she reached double figures in that category this season.

SEXTON LEADS THE OFFENSE

- ◆ Kyley Sexton hit double figure in kills for the 14th time this season with 13 in the win over UC Riverside on Oct. 26.
- ◆ She leads the Aztecs in kill average at 2.96 per set and is second in points (3.35 per set).
- ◆ Sexton recorded her fifth double-double of the season with 16 kills and 13 blocks in the win over TCU on Sept. 25.
- ◆ She set a career-high with 25 kills in the match vs. UCSB on Sept. 18. Her 27 points in that match was also a career best.
- ♦ In the match against UC Irvine on Sept. 11, she set a career high with 21 digs.

AZTECS IN THE MWC STATS

- ◆ Johnna Fouch leads the league's setters at 10.62 assists per set.
- Andrea Hannasch is third in blocking (1.26 per set).
- ◆ Kyley Sexton is ninth in the conference in kill average (2.96 per set).
- ◆ Kristi Jackels is fourth in digs at 3.83 per set.
- ◆ Lauren Salisbury is seventh in hitting percentage (.293).

GETTING DEFENSIVE

- In the win over UC Irvine on Sept. 18, the Aztecs recorded 108 digs as a team, their highest total in a match in over 10 years.
- ◆ In that contest, setter Johnna Fouch led SDSU with 32 digs, the most in a match by an Aztec since Aime Cordeiro had 33 against BYU on Nov. 2, 2007.
- ◆ The 32 digs were the 10th-most ever in a match by an SDSU player.

ALL TOURNAMENT AZTECS

- Aztec junior outside hitters Kyley Sexton and Paije Pearson were named to the alltournament team at the Aztec Invitational (Aug. 27-28) with Sexton picking up tournament MVP honors.
- ♦ Sexton average 3.90 kills, 2.40 digs and 0.50 blocks over SDSU's three matches.
- ◆ Pearson hit .300 with averages of 3.78 kills, 3.00 digs and 0.44 blocks.
- Outside hitter Raegan Shelton was named to the all-tournament team at the ASU Sheraton Classic in Tempe, Ariz., during the weekend of Sept. 3-4.
- Shelton averaged 3.40 kills and 3.79 points per set while hitting .389 over SDSU's three matches.
- Kyley Sexton was named to the alltournament team at the USD/SDSU Challenge (Sept. 17-18), her second alltourney honor of the 2010 season.
- ◆ Over SDSU's three matches she averaged 3.42 kills and 1.28 digs per set.

HANNASCH PLAYER OF THE WEEK

- Middle blocker Andrea Hannasch was named the Mountain West Conference Player of the Week for her effort in the matches against New Mexico and TCU (Sept. 23 and 25).
- ◆ In a three-set sweep of New Mexico at home, Hannasch led all players with 12 kills and a career-best .688 hitting percentage. In the 3-2 home win over TCU, Hannasch tied a career-high with 16 kills.
- ◆ For the week, Hannasch averaged 3.50 kills, 1.62 blocks and 4.50 points per set, while hitting .535 (28-5-43) over eight sets. She also had two assists, one service ace and six digs in the two matches.
- Hannasch shared the MWC Player of the Week award with Colorado State middle blocker Megan Plourde.

PEARSON PLAYER OF THE WEEK

- Paije Pearson was named the Mountain West Conference Player of the Week on Aug. 30 for her efforts during the season's opening weekend Aztec Invitational.
- She began tourney play with a 14-kill, six dig effort in the win over CSU Northridge. The 14 kills tied her SDSU career high at the time.
- ◆ In the Aztecs' sweep of Northern Colorado, she collected six kills, three digs and one block, then followed with career highs in kills (15) and digs (18) in the tournament's championship match vs. Cincinnati.

FRESHMEN NUMBERS

- San Diego State is one of three teams in the nation that lists nine true freshmen on its 2010 roster.
- Defending national champion Penn State and South Carolina are the only other two Division I schools with that many first-year players.
- ◆ Both Auburn and Maryland-Baltimore County have nine freshmen on their rosters, but that number includes redshirt freshmen who were at the schools last season.
- Among Mountain West Conference schools, Air Force and UNLV both have seven true freshmen on their squads.

AZTEC NOTES

- ◆ Freshman defensive specialist Justine Ricigliano tied her season high with seven digs in the win at Brigham Young on Nov. 6.
- As a team, the Aztecs have hit .300 or better in seven matches, their highest total since it reached that mark in nine matches during the 2005 campaign.
- ◆ The Aztecs are 3-3 in five-set matches this season.
- San Diego State has won six of its last nine matches.
- ◆ SDSU's team blocking total (13.0 blocks 1 solo, 24 assists) at Brigham Young on Nov. 6 tied its highest of the season. As a team SDSU has finished in double figures in blocking in nine matches this fall.
- The win over BYU was only the second one this season in which SDSU has trailed in kills and digs.
- Andrea Hannasch is the lone Aztec to have recorded at least one block in each of SDSU's matches this season.
