#AztecWBB Opens Homestand on Wednesday vs. Nevada

Fresh off an uplifting road victory, San Diego State returns to Montezuma Mesa to open a two-game homestand, starting Wednesday when it squares off against Nevada at Viejas Arena. Game time is set for 6 p.m. PT. A live video stream of the Aztecs-Wolf Pack clash will be available on GoAztecs.com, with SDSU alumnus Chris Ello handling the play-by-play handling the play-by-play responsibilities. In addition, Wednesday's matchup will feature a free Aztec Spirit Sleeve giveaway to the first 500 fans in attendance.

SDSU (7-13, 4-5 MW) will be looking to collect back-to-back wins for the first time this season after recording a 70-59 triumph at Utah State last Saturday. The Aztecs sank 20 of 26 free-throw attempts and outscored the Aggies 22-10 on points off turnovers to fuel their victory. Meanwhile, the Wolf Pack (6-13, 2-6 MW) have dropped six straight after falling at home to Wyoming by a 61-45 count on Jan. 31.

SDSU has cranked up the defense in its last four outings, allowing just 53 points per game while limiting the opposition to a .360 field-goal percentage, including a .255 clip on three-pointers. During that stretch, the Aztecs have also maintained a plus-6.2 advantage on offensive rebounds, outscoring foes 59-41 on second-chance points.

SDSU holds a slim 6-5 lead in the all-time series against Nevada, including a 3-1 mark in San Diego. However, the Wolf Pack captured both encounters last year, posting an 84-65 triumph in Reno during the regular season before holding on for a 53-48 victory in the quarterfinals of the Mountain West Championship. The two teams last met in Viejas Arena on Jan. 23, 2013, when the Scarlet and Black pulled away for a 69-57 win. In that contest, former Aztec Chelsea Hopkins registered the first of her four triple-doubles that season with 25 points, 10 rebounds and 10 assists.

The two sides have faced one common opponent in UC Santa Barbara during their respective non-conference schedules. Nevada prevailed over the Gauchos by a 71-58 margin in its season opener on Nov. 14, while SDSU emerged with a 64-58 victory on Dec. 7.

Collectively, the Aztecs find themselves in the top half of the MW in three-point field goal percentage defense (2nd - (.279)), which ranks 40th in the nation, rebounding defense (2nd - 35.4/gm) and rebounding margin (3rd - (+3.4)). Individually, junior Erimma Amarikwa occupies the seventh spot for all games in rebounding (6.9/gm) and is eighth in free-throw percentage (.716). She also enters the week averaging 12.9 points per contest in league play, which ranks 11th.

Following Wednesday's engagement, San Diego State will play host to Boise State on Saturday, Feb. 7, beginning at 2 p.m. PT, to highlight National Girls and Women in Sports Day.

Scouting the Wolf Pack

After opening their conference slate with back-to-back wins, Nevada (6-13, 2-6 MW) has dropped six in a row, including a 61-45 loss to Wyoming at home last Saturday. During that stretch, opponents have outscored the Wolf Pack by an average of 15.2 points per game.

However, Nevada has been plagued by injuries this year, with junior T Moe and freshman Mariah Williams lost for the season after each suffered a torn anterior cruciate ligament in December. In addition, senior Emily Burns returned to the lineup on Jan. 21 after missing eight games with a knee injury of her own.

In the interim, the Wolf Pack's fortunes have rested on the shoulders of senior Mimi Mungedi (12.3 ppg), who leads the Mountain West in both rebounding (8.3/gm) and field-goal percentage (.535) while occupying the second spot in blocked shots (2.4/gm). Nevada has also received a boost from Burns, who has averaged 15 points in her last two games, while sophomore Ashlee Jones is the team's top long-range threat, draining 29 of the Wolf Pack's 54 three-pointers for the season.

As a team, Nevada ranks second in the league in both total rebounds (42.8/gm), and rebounding margin (+5.5), as well as blocked shots (4.5/gm). However, the Wolf Pack have been bitten by the turnover bug this season, with opponents averaging 4.6 fewer miscues per game, which ranks 10th in the MW.

Collectively, Nevada is shooting 39 percent from the field, which ranks seventh in the conference, while its 28 percent clip from three-point territory is eighth.

Now in her seventh season on the Reno campus, Wolf Pack head coach Jane Albright remains the winningest coach at two of her three previous schools (Northern Illinois (1984-94) and Wisconsin (1994-2003). She also guided Wichita State for five seasons (2003-08) before her arrival at Nevada. In addition, Albright coached the Wolf Pack's first-ever WNBA draftee in Tahnee Robinson, who was a third-round selection of the Phoenix Mercury in 2011.

With a Victory...

An SDSU win over Nevada on Wednesday will mean:

■ The Aztecs win back-to-back games for the first time this season and even their record at 5-5 in the Mountain West.

■ San Diego State snaps a two-game losing streak against the Wolf Pack and improves to 7-5 in the all-time series between the two schools.

■ The Aztecs level their home record at 5-5 on the year and move to 72-27 on the Viejas Arena floor since the 2008-09 campaign.

■ SDSU raises its record to 4-2 in Wednesday games this season.

Last Meeting: Aztecs-Wolf Pack

Sixth-seeded San Diego State gave No. 3 seed Nevada all it could handle in its quarterfinal matchup at the Reese's Mountain West Championship, but ultimately came up short, dropping a 53-48 decision in a defensive struggle on March 11, 2014.

With the loss the Aztecs finish the year with a 13-17 overall record, while the Wolf Pack move to 18-12 on the season and advance to the semifinal round against Fresno State.

The two teams combined to shoot just 30 percent from the field (31-103) and committed 34 turnovers collectively in the ragged contest. However, SDSU came up empty on nine three-point field-goal attempts, while Nevada drained five of 20 shots from beyond the arc. The Aztecs were also victimized by a 12-0 run midway through the second half that catapulted the Wolf Pack into the lead for good.

Individually, SDSU was led by senior Danesha Long and junior Kristina Hunter, who finished with nine points apiece, while senior Kiera Warren totaled eight points, 11 rebounds and a career-high seven blocks, which tied a MW tournament record.

The Aztecs stayed close thanks to some clutch free-throw shooting, sinking a season-high 18-of-20 tries from the charity stripe (90 percent), including a 6-for-6 effort by Warren and a 5-for-5 performance by Long.

Conversely, Nevada was paced by Danika Sharp's game-high 12 points that featured a trio of baskets from beyond the arc, while Warren's counterpart, Mimi Mungedi, made her presence felt in the middle as well with seven rejections of her own to go with 10 points and two steals.

The two sides witnessed six ties and four lead changes in the first half, including a 19-19 deadlock, when the Wolf Pack reeled off seven straight points on a Sharp three-pointer, followed by two foul shots and a basket by Nyasha LeSure with 32 seconds remaining. Then with the clock winding down to four seconds, sophomore Deidra Smith drained a jumper from 17 feet away at the top of the key to give the contest its 26-21 score at intermission.

The Aztecs turned the tables in the first nine minutes of the second half as sophomore Deajanae Scurry scored six straight points in a 12-5 spurt that put the Aztecs back in front 33-30 with 11:05 remaining.

Hunter and freshman Chloe Johnson also got into the act with buckets during that span, while Warren added a pair of free throws.

However, SDSU was kept off the scoreboard over the next 4:46 as Nevada seized control of the contest with a 12-0 run of its own. The Wolf Pack sank five of six free throws during that stretch, while Sharp connected from three-point territory once again to help her team claim a 42-33 advantage by the 6:19 mark.

The Aztecs were forced to play catch-up for the remainder of the game, but could only muster eight free throws over the ensuing five minutes, until a jumper by junior Desi Culberson broke the drought, narrowing the gap to 49-43 with just 1:27 remaining.

SDSU twice cut the deficit to three in the final minute, including a 51-48 spread on a Johnson jumper with five seconds remaining. The Aztecs were able to foul on the inbounds pass; however, Sharp drained both free throws at the other end to seal the win for the Wolf Pack.

The Last Time Out: SDSU at Utah State

Balanced scoring, timely free-throw shooting and an opportunistic defense were all on display last Saturday as San Diego State pulled away for a 70-59 victory over Utah State in a Mountain West game at Dee Glen Smith Spectrum.

The Aztecs (7-13, 4-5 MW) had three players finish with double-digit scoring totals, led by junior Erimma AmariKwa, who tallied a game-high 17 points, highlighted by a career-best nine free throws. Freshman McKynzie Fort also got into the act with 15 points on 6-for-12 shooting, while senior Khristina Hunter chipped 11 points of her own to help snap SDSU's two-game losing streak.

Despite a 43-38 rebounding deficiency, the Aztecs scored 22 points off 20 Aggie turnovers and sank 20 of 26 free throws, including a 16-for-21 clip in the second half.

After the two teams witnessed six lead changes and four ties to start the game, SDSU went ahead to stay 25-22, following two Fort free throws and a Hunter layup with 2:26 left in the first half. USU (6-15, 3-6 MW) quickly cut the margin to one on a basket by Funda Nakkasoglu, but a clutch three-pointer by sophomore Aleiah Brandon on the Aztecs' next possession ignited an 8-4 spurt to give the visitors a 33-28 advantage at intermission.

Following the break, SDSU maintained the momentum with a 14-6 surge in a span of 6:35 to open a 13-point bulge at 47-34. Junior Ahjalee Harvey (Mountain View, Calif.) came up huge during the run, burying her first three-pointer in 11 games, while AmariKwa drained four foul shots. In the interim, the Aggies dug themselves a hole, misfiring on six of eight shots from the floor while committing three turnovers.

However, USU methodically crawled back into contention as two free throws by Julianne Anchling capped a 12-2 outburst that trimmed the Aztec lead to 49-46 with 7:31 remaining.

With the tide turning in the Aggies' favor, SDSU promptly righted the ship as Amarikwa scored six consecutive points to spark a decisive 16-6 blitz over the next five minutes that restored the Aztecs' double-digit advantage at 65-52 by the 2:08 mark. Fort connected on two key baskets during the run, while senior Desi Culbertson added a pair of free throws to put the Scarlet and Black in complete control.

USU trimmed the deficit to single digits at 67-59 on a triple by Franny Vaaulu, but only 1:22 remained on the clock. Fort then added a layup and a free throw down the stretch to provide the contest its final outcome.

Jasmine Porter led the Aggies with 13 points off the bench, while Anchling recorded 10 points in the loss. In addition, Vaaulu contributed nine points and a game-high nine rebounds, including eight on the defensive glass.

Noting the Utah State Game

■ San Diego State won its 40th straight and moved to 69-1 since the 2011-12 campaign when leading with five minutes to go in the game. The Aztecs also raised their record to 5-1 this year when leading at the half.

■ The Aztecs won for the first time in six games this season when getting outrebounded by an opponent (38-43).

■ SDSU moved to 4-1 on the year when committing fewer turnovers than the opposition. The Aztecs finished with just 11 miscues, while the Aggies posted 20.

■ The Aztecs emerged victorious for just the second time this season (2-10) when shooting below 40 percent for the game. SDSU connected on 37 percent (23-62) of its field-goal attempts vs. the Aggies.

■ Individually, Aleiah Brandon tied her career-high with seven points and set a personal best with two assists.

■ In addition, Ahjalee Harvey set a season-high with six rebounds.

■ Similarly, Khristina Hunter matched her season-best with two blocks.

That's Why They're Free

San Diego State has gradually improved its free-throw shooting recently, draining 70 percent (209-299) from the charity stripe over last 16 games after connecting on just 54 percent (41-76) of its foul shots in the first four contests of the year.

Individually, four Aztecs have eclipsed the 70 percent mark in free throws during this latest stretch, including Deidra Smith (.824), Erimma Amarikwa (.773), Chloe Johnson (.714) and Ahjalee Harvey (.700). Not to be outdone, Aleiah Brandon and Lexy Thorderson have combined to sink all six of their foul shots this year.

Against Utah State last Saturday, SDSU nailed 20 of 26 free throws, including a 16-for-21 clip in the second half, to help secure its victory.

Shoring Up the Defense

Despite their modest 7-13 record, the Aztecs have also showed marked improvement in their three-point field goal defense this year. For the season, SDSU is allowing opponents to shoot just 27.9 percent (107-382) from beyond the arc, which ranks second in the Mountain West and 40th in the nation.

Through 20 games last year, the Aztecs yielded 187 three-point baskets at a 38.2 percent clip, which ranked last in the conference and near the bottom among Division I schools.

Welcome to the Club

Senior Khristina Hunter and junior Erimma Amarikwa each surpassed 500-point barrier for their careers earlier this season. Amarikwa achieved the milestone with a 15-point performance against Idaho State at the San Juan Shootout on Nov. 27, while Hunter accomplished the feat with a basket and a free throw at USD on Dec. 9. In addition, both Aztec forwards have eclipsed the 400-rebound plateau this year.

Elsewhere, senior Desi Culbertson (452) is also on pace to reach 500 career rebounds before the season ends, junior while Ahjalee Harvey recently notched her 100th field goal and 100th rebound in an Aztec uniform.

Fort Named Top MW Preseason Freshman; Aztecs Picked Seventh

San Diego State's McKynzie Fort was tabbed as the Mountain West Preseason Freshman of the Year in a combined vote of the league's 11 head coaches and select media members. on Oct. 14.

Fort is the fifth consecutive Aztec player to garner top MW preseason freshman accolades, following in the respective paths of Chloe Johnson, Deajanae Scurry and Desi Culbertson, as well as Melissa Sweat, who received such distinction prior to the 2010-11 campaign.

Fort, who led the powerful Etiwanda High School program to the Southern Regional finals of the CIF playoffs as a senior last season, was a first-team all-state selection and Baseline League most valuable player honoree before earning all-area recognition by the *Los Angeles Times*.

As a team, SDSU was predicted to finish seventh in the preseason poll released by the conference office. SDSU earned 134 points from the panel, trailing UNLV (143 pts.) by just nine points for sixth place.

Defending regular-season champion Colorado State was picked to repeat after receiving 21 of 28 first-place votes and 276 points, comfortably ahead of Boise State, which received four first-place votes and 241 points, while Wyoming was slotted for the third position with three first-place votes and 235 points.

This year marks the first time since the beginning of the 2007-08 campaign that SDSU has not been selected to finish among the top three places in the MW preseason rankings.

Noting the Newcomers

In addition to McKynzie Fort, the Aztecs' highly touted freshman class includes two other former prep stars in Cheyenne Greenhouse (Riverside, Calif.) and Lexy Thorderson (Castle Rock, Colo.), both of whom could play significant roles in SDSU's fortunes this season. Greenhouse was a first-team all-CIF selection after leading Canyon Springs High to the Division I state championship as a senior in 2013-14. She also collected the Inland Empire League's most valuable player award and received first-team all-conference recognition for the fourth straight year.

Thorderson, meanwhile, garnered numerous postseason accolades at Rock Canyon High, where she finished her prep career as the school's all-time leading scorer. A nominee for the McDonald's All-America team, Thorderson led the state of Colorado in 3-point field goals made as a senior, earning second-team class 5A all-state distinction.

SDSU also solidified its depth for the 2015-16 season after junior Kym Ellison (Georgia Tech) and sophomore Geena Gomez (St. Joseph's) transferred to The Mesa in the summer of 2014. The two players will not be eligible to compete this season due to NCAA rules, but will serve as valuable assets to the team in practice.

2013-14 Rewind

After winning a program-record 27 games and capturing its second straight Mountain West regular-season championship, San Diego State faced a year of transition during the 2013-14 campaign. Not only did the Aztecs have to adjust to a brand new coaching staff, but they were also forced to overcome the loss of four senior starters who accounted for 64 percent of the team's scoring from the previous year. With five newcomers on board, growing pains were certainly inevitable. However, SDSU flashed its resiliency throughout the season, finishing with a 13-17 overall record and tying for sixth in the MW standings with a 9-9 mark. Below are some additional obstacles the Aztecs endured last year:

- SDSU had to replace two starters, Erimma Amarikwa and Ahjalee Harvey, who were lost for the year after suffering injuries during the non-conference schedule. As a result, the Aztecs employed 10 different starting lineups last season compared to just three in 2012-13.
- In addition, SDSU was faced with a difficult schedule featuring nine games against teams that advanced to postseason competition, including four squads that finished among the AP Top 25: South Carolina, Texas A&M, North Carolina State and USC.
- SDSU dropped four very close games during the non-conference slate by an average of three points in losses to Sacramento State, USC, San Diego and UCLA.

Despite these tribulations, the gritty Aztecs found success on the court during the 2013-14 campaign. Below are a few of the accomplishments of last year's squad:

- SDSU led the Mountain West as team in rebounding margin (+7.6) and rebounding defense (33.1/game).
- The Aztecs also ranked second in the conference in field-goal percentage (.419) and offensive rebounds (15.3/game).

- SDSU averaged over 40 rebounds per contest (40.6) for the third straight season, representing its longest stretch since a six-year span from 1984-89.

• The Aztecs handed two-time defending MW tournament champion Fresno State its only home loss in conference play with a 70-69 upset on a late basket by Danesha Long. Coupled with a win at Fresno in 2013, SDSU is the only MW team to defeat the Bulldogs twice on the road in the past two years.

• The Aztecs topped the 80-point barrier in back-to-back conference games for the first time since joining the Mountain West after scoring 88 points in consecutive home victories over San José State and Utah State.

• Elsewhere, Stacie Terry tied for the second-highest victory total (13) ever by a first-year SDSU head coach in program history.

2014-15 By the Numbers

With a new season already underway, below are a few trends to watch for the remainder of the 2014-15 campaign:

- SDSU has claimed 39 of its last 54 home games and has gone 71-27 (.724) on the Viejas Arena floor since the start of the 2008-09 campaign.
- The Aztecs have recorded 69 Mountain West victories in the last six-plus seasons after posting 31 wins in the league's first nine years.
- SDSU is 69-1 over the last three-plus seasons when leading with five minutes to go in the game, including its victory at Utah State on January 21. The Aztecs' lone blemish during that stretch was a heartbreaking 59-58 defeat at Washington in December 2012.
- The Aztecs have advanced to finals of the MW Championship in five of the last seven years after not winning a single game in the tournament's first eight years of existence.
- For the second straight season, SDSU will play 18 conference games. The Aztecs will complete a home-and-away slate with eight squads, while facing San José State (home) and Utah State (away) just once.

SDSU Holds Groundbreaking Ceremony for Jeff Jacobs JAM Center

San Diego State held a ceremonial groundbreaking for the Jeff Jacobs JAM Center, the men's and women's basketball performance center, on Aug. 27. The JAM Center is scheduled to be completed by August 2015 and in time for the start of the 2015-16 campaign.

SDSU President Dr. Elliot Hirshman, men's hoops head coach Steve Fisher and Jeff Jacobs spoke before a select group of invited guests, which included Steve and Lisa Altman, and Jim and Susan Morris, as well as members of both the Aztec men's and women's basketball programs. The master of ceremonies for the event was the voice of San Diego State men's basketball, Ted Leitner.

Preliminary site work started in July where the Jeff Jacobs JAM Center will be located, just south of the Fowler Athletics Center and east of the football practice fields. The facility, which will support the continued growth and development of the SDSU men's and women's basketball teams, includes two full-length courts, eight baskets, locker rooms, film rooms, team lounges, athletic training room and coaches locker rooms. Hundreds of supporters contributed to the effort to make the Jeff Jacobs JAM Center a reality. In addition to the naming gift from Jeff Jacobs, Hal and Debby Jacobs, Steve and Lisa Altman and Jim Morris, creating the name "JAM" Center, sizeable donations were made from the Manna Charitable Foundation and the Walter and Betty Zable Foundation. The total cost of the project is \$14.5 million, of which \$12.5 million in private funding has been raised. No state funds will be used to construct this building.

The project was designed by JCJ Architecture and is being built by The Hunt Construction Group.

San Diego native Stacie Terry was named the eighth head coach in the history of the San Diego State women's basketball program on May 15, 2013.

During her first season on Montezuma Mesa, Terry was saddled with the unenviable task of replacing four senior starters who accounted for nearly 64 percent of the team's scoring offense from the previous year, as well as overcoming the loss of two key players - forward Erimma Amariqwa, a preseason all-Mountain West selection, and starting point guard Ahjalee Harvey - to injuries prior to conference play.

Despite those obstacles and a demanding schedule featuring nine games with teams that eventually advanced to postseason competition, Terry's squad flashed its resiliency during the 2013-14 campaign, finishing with a 13-17 overall record and a 9-9 mark in the MW.

Under Terry's guidance, the Aztecs led the league in rebounding margin and rebounding defense, while ranking second in field-goal percentage.

Individually, Terry also oversaw the progress of senior center Cierra Warren, who became the fifth SDSU player in the last six years to receive first-team all-MW recognition.

Prior to her arrival on The Mesa, Terry gained a wealth of experience as an assistant coach at the Division I level for 14 years, including five under head coach Nikki Caldwell, who transformed UCLA into a powerhouse before restoring LSU to national prominence.

During Terry's two seasons at LSU, the Lady Tigers compiled a 45-23 overall record and earned two NCAA tournament bids, including a Sweet 16 appearance during the 2012-13 campaign. During that season, the Lady Tigers also posted six victories against ranked opponents and finished with their second-highest scoring average (69.0) in the last seven years. Under Terry's guidance, forward LaShondra Barrett garnered first-team all-Southeastern Conference accolades and received honorable mention All-America distinction in 2012 before becoming a first-round draft choice of the WNBA's Washington Mystics.

Prior to her appointment at LSU, Terry served as an assistant under Caldwell at UCLA from 2008-11, helping the Bruins gain national acclaim with a pair of NCAA tournament appearances. During Terry's tenure, UCLA posted 72 overall victories, as the 2010-11 squad finished with a 28-5 record, setting a school record for fewest losses in a single season to go with a No. 7 national ranking. In addition, the Bruins signed the fourth-ranked recruiting class that season, according to ESPN HoopGurlz, while Terry helped mentor first-team all-Pac-10 performers in Doreena Campbell, Darxia Morris and Jasmine Dixon, a 2012 honorable mention AP All-America selection, as well as all-conference freshman honorees Atonye Nyingifa and Markel Walker.

Terry spent the 2007-08 campaign at Southern Mississippi, as the Golden Eagles posted a 21-14 record and

earned a postseason berth in the Women's National Invitation Tournament (WNIT). While at Southern Miss, Terry spearheaded the development and coordination of the Lady Eagle recruiting campaign. Her responsibilities also included working with the perimeter players, scouting opponents and film breakdown, as well as coordinating all of the team's community service events.

Terry also coached for three seasons from 2004-07 as an assistant under Hall of Fame head coach Theresa Grentz at Illinois, where the Fighting Illini had three straight recruiting classes ranked among the top 25 in the nation, according to Blue Star Basketball, and made three consecutive trips to the WNIT. Her primary duties included defensive instruction and working with the perimeter players.

In addition, Terry coached at Dayton during the 2003-04 season following a three-year stint at Louisville from 2000-03. With the Cardinals, Terry's responsibilities encompassed recruiting, scouting, player development, summer camps and serving as a liaison for the program's community service outreach. Louisville captured the Conference USA regular-season title and earned a trip to the NCAA tournament in 2001 before making a WNIT appearance in 2002. She also assisted in signing the nation's 21st-ranked recruiting class in 2002-03, according to All-Star Girls Report. Terry recruited and coached all-Conference USA honoree Lori Nero, a draft choice of the WNBA's Houston Comets, as well as Sara Nord, who finished her collegiate career as the Cardinals' all-time assist leader and ranks among the top 15 scorers in school history.

Terry enjoyed a successful collegiate playing career at the University of Texas at Arlington, winning four varsity letters from 1994-98 under head coach Mike Dean. She earned first-team all-Southland Conference honors after leading the Mavericks in scoring with 17.4 points per game as a senior in 1997-98. Terry scored 1,169 points during her career at UTA and still ranks among the school's top 10 in three-point field goals made (third), assists (sixth), steals (seventh) and free-throw percentage (10th). She is just one of 17 players in Maverick history to surpass the 1,000-point plateau, while her .335 career three-point field-goal percentage is also a school and Southland Conference career record.

Terry played one season of professional basketball in Warsaw, Poland, averaging 12.0 points and 6.0 assists with the Polonia Phoenix, before returning to UT Arlington to begin her coaching career as a graduate assistant in 1999.

Terry prepped at El Capitan High and held the Vaqueros' career scoring record for three years following her graduation. She was inducted into the school's athletic hall of fame in 2008.
