WAVES FACE FIRST ROAD TEST, THEN RETURN TO MALIBU

August 29, 2012

MALIBU, Calif. — The No. 5 Waves (3-0-0) will hit the road for the first time this season to face No. 25 San Diego State (4-0-0) on Friday, Aug. 31. The Waves will return to Malibu for a 1 p.m. tilt on Sunday with Indiana (3-1-0). Sophomore forward **Amanda LeCave** was named to TopDrawerSoccer.com's Team of the Week and was L.A. Soccer News Women's College Player of the Week after her three goal performance over the Waves' two victories last weekend.

WATCH LIVE — New this season, Waves fans will be able to watch all home women's soccer matches streamed live via WaveCasts on pepperdinesports.com. The games will all be shown for free. Live internet statistics via Gametracker will be available for all home matches at www.pepperdinesports.com.

SAN DIEGO STATE — The Aztecs are off to their first 4-0 start in 16 seasons and entered this week's NSCAA poll at No. 25. JR MF Carli Johnson was named Mountain West Defensive Player of the Week after leading SDSU to their third and fourth consecutive shutouts over the weekend. No opponent has scored on the Aztecs in four games and they have put away six goals. The Aztecs have defeated the likes of SMU, Arizona State, St. Francis (Pa.) and Seattle University. The Waves are 4-2-0 all-time against the Aztecs, including a 2-1-0 record on the road. The last time the two team's faced off was in 2006 at home with the Waves winning 1-0. The last time they played at SDSU was in 2001, where Pepperdine won 3-1. The Waves have won four in a row against the Aztecs.

INDIANA — The Hoosiers bring a 3-1 record out West this weekend. They are slated to play at UC Santa Barbara on Friday before making it down the coast to Malibu. They have defeated Arkansas State, Missouri State and Ohio, while losing to USF. The team is led by Lisa Nouanesengsy, who has collected five goals so far on the season. Rebecca Candler is the only other Hoosier to have scored multiple goals this week. Shannon Flower has started all four games in goal for the Hoosiers. Sunday's game marks the first ever meeting between the Hoosiers and the Waves in women's soccer.

HOME FIELD ADVANTAGE — The Waves are always extra tough at Tari Frahm Rokus field, owning an all-time record of 126-38-21. Stemming back to the 2009 season, the Waves are currently riding a 24-game undefeated streak at home in the regular season. Last year the Waves finished 8-1-1 at home, with the one loss coming in the first round of the NCAA Tournament to Long Beach State.

INTERNATIONAL EXPERIENCE — Senior goalkeeper **Roxanne Barker** enters the 2012 season fresh off the Olympics as she was the starting goalkeeper for the South African National Team in London this summer. Senior forward **Anisa Guajardo** played with the Mexican National Team in the spring during Olympic qualifying tournaments.

2012 HONORS — Junior defender **Michelle Pao** was named a preseason All-WCC selection for the second straight season. She was also named to the watch list for the prestigious MAC Hermann Trophy Award, given to the top collegiate male and female soccer student-athletes in the country.

SCHEDULE — The Waves' difficult slate features seven teams that advanced to the 2011 NCAA Tournament. The Waves have a particularly tough road schedule, including nonconference road games at perennial favorites UCLA and Boston College. They will also play at Portland in conference play. The Waves will face top teams from the Pac-12, Big 10 and Southeastern Conferences. Pepperdine will play a total of nine home games.

WCC PRESEASON POLL — The Waves were picked to finish second in the conference in a preseason vote of the league's coaches. The predicted order went as follows: Santa Clara, Pepperdine, San Diego, BYU, Portland, Saint Mary's, Loyola Marymount, San Francisco and Gonzaga. Santa Clara garnered seven first place votes, with the Waves and Portland collecting one first place vote apiece.

2011 IN REVIEW — The Waves went 15-2-4 last season and were 7-1-0 in WCC play as they won their first WCC title since 2002 and second overall. The Waves finished the season ranked No. 10 nationally by the NSCAA and participated in the first round of the NCAA Tournament, before falling to Long Beach State 1-0 in overtime. The Waves racked up the honors, including WCC Coach of the Year and NSCAA/Mondo West Region Coach of the Year for **Tim Ward** and WCC Freshman of the Year for **Lynn Williams**. **Michelle Pao** was also named a NSCAA All-America second teamer. Returning All-WCC selections include first teamer Pao, second teamers Williams, **Roxanne Barker** and **Kelsea Smith** and honorable mention selections **Kristin DeGrandmont** and **Anisa Guajardo**.

ABOUT PEPPERDINE — Pepperdine boasts a one-of-a-kind athletic department with unprecedented success for a school of its size. The Waves have won NCAA Division I championships in five different men's sports – one of just 16 schools to have accomplished this feat – and nine overall. Of this elite group, Pepperdine has the smallest enrollment and is the only school not in a major conference. Located in scenic Malibu, Calif., the university overlooks the Pacific Ocean and its campus and athletic facilities are regularly voted among the nation's most beautiful universities.
