## SDSU Women's Hoops Returns Home for Mid-Week Clash with Fresno Pacific

► **When & Where:** Wednesday, Dec. 19, 2012, Viejas Arena (12,414), San Diego, Calif., 5 p.m. PT

► **Live Media:** A live audio webcast featuring Chris Ello, as well as live stats will be available on goaztecs.com.

► **SDSU Head Coach Beth Burns:** Burns (Ohio Wesleyan, 1979) is in the eighth year of her second stint as head coach at San Diego State. She led the Aztecs for eight seasons from 1989 to 1997, before returning in 2005. She has an overall head coaching record of 355-247 in 21 seasons, and she is 274-182 in her 16 campaigns at SDSU.

► **Fresno Pacific Head Coach Erin Scholz:** Scholz (Colorado, 1999) is in her third season at the helm of the Sunbirds and has amassed a record of 22-48. Prior to her appointment at FPU, Scholz served a three-year stint as an assistant at Utah State.

► **Series History:** The Aztecs and Sunbirds are meeting for the first time.

► **Up Next:** SDSU will have nine days off before playing host to the eighth annual San Diego Surf 'N Slam Classic at Viejas Arena. The Aztecs will square off against SMU on Friday, Dec. 28, starting at 5 p.m., while the other first-round matchup tips off at 7 p.m., featuring nationally ranked Oklahoma State and Harvard. On Sunday, Dec. 30, the consolation game gets underway at 12 noon, followed by the championship final at 2 p.m.

### NEWS & NOTABLES

■ After facing three consecutive opponents on the road, San Diego State opens a season-long five-game homestand on Wednesday when it tackles Fresno Pacific, starting at 5 p.m.

■ The Aztecs are coming off a 73-56 victory at Cal Poly on Sunday to move to 6-3 on the season.

■ SDSU won its ninth straight against the Mustangs after receiving 17 points apiece from Chelsea Hopkins and Courtney Clements, while Malia Nahinu (13 pts.) and Danesha Long (10 pts.) posted double-figures as well.

■ Hopkins was selected as the Mountain West Player of the Week for her efforts at Cal Poly where she narrowly missed a triple-double after adding 10 rebounds and nine assists to her scoring total.

■ Entering this week, Clements finds herself among the Mountain West leaders in several categories, including scoring (1st - 20.0 ppg), 3-pt. field goals per game (t-1st - 2.6), 3-pt. field-goal percentage (4th - .397), field-goal percentage (5th - .456) and steals (7th - 1.9).

■ In addition, Hopkins ranks among the league leaders in assists (2nd - 5.2), rebounding (5th - 7.0) and free-throw percentage (7th - .742).

■ As a team, SDSU occupies the top spot in the MW in scoring defense (54.2 ppg) and field-goal percentage defense (.344) and ranks second in both blocked shots (5.0) and turnover margin (+2.1).

■ San Diego State has been picked to repeat as Mountain West champions in 2012-13. The Aztecs received 22 of 24 first-place votes and earned 198 points to claim the top spot in the preseason poll.

**HEAD COACH BETH BURNS**



The winningest coach in SDSU women's basketball history, Beth Burns is in her 21st season as a collegiate head coach and her 16th overall at the helm of the Aztecs.

Since returning for her second stint on Montezuma Mesa in 2005,

Burns has taken the program to new heights, including a trip to the NCAA Sweet Sixteen, three NCAA tournament appearances (2009, 2010, 2012) and two conference regular-season (2009, 2012) and tournament titles (2010, 2012).

Last season, she directed the Aztecs to both the outright Mountain West regular-season (12-2) and tournament titles. The team made its third trip to the NAAs in the past four years and its 25 total victories not only tied for second in program history, but also are SDSU's most in 18 years. As a result, Burns captured her second MW Coach-of-the-Year honor.

Burns picked up her 350th career victory on Nov. 14 against UC Irvine. She enters Saturday's game with a 355-247 (.590) overall record, including a 274-182 (.601) mark in her 16 years (1989-97, 2005-present) on The Mesa.

**THE LAST TIME OUT**

Chelsea Hopkins and Courtney Clements scored 17 points each to lead visiting San Diego State to a 73-56 victory over Cal Poly last Sunday at Mott Gym in San Luis Obispo, Calif.

The Aztecs also received double-digit scoring totals from Malia Nahinu (13 pts.) and Danesha Long (10 pts.) to help defeat the Mustangs for the ninth straight time in the all-time series.

Hopkins narrowly missed a triple-double, finishing with 10 rebounds and nine assists to go along with a career-high tying eight field goals, while Clements grabbed six boards and dished out three helpers of her own.

As a team, SDSU logged its best field-goal percentage of the season (.552) after connecting on 32 of 58 shots, while Cal Poly was just 24 of 61 from the floor (.393), including a 1-for-8 clip over the final 4:39 of the first half, when the Aztecs erupted with a timely 13-2 blitz to turn a tight ballgame into a 40-27 advantage by halftime.

SDSU led throughout, save for a 2-2 tie, eventually building a 27-19 cushion following a jumper by junior Kiyana Stamps with 6:35 left before intermission. The Mustangs answered with a triple by Jonae Ervin, while Caroline Reeves capped off an old-fashioned three-point play shortly thereafter to narrow the gap to 27-25 at the 4:39 mark. However, the Aztecs gave themselves some breathing room heading into the locker room with the aforementioned run, featuring a pair of 3-pointers by Long and another by Clements.

SDSU extended the margin to 18 on five occasions during the first four minutes of the second half, including a 53-35 spread at the 16:15 mark after another basket by Clements, who finished the game with eight field goals on 16 attempts. Cal Poly quickly whittled the deficit to 12 with 14:47 to go, following a Nikol Allison jumper and consecutive buckets by Ariana Elegado. However, the host school could draw no closer, as Clements and Hopkins found the bottom of the net on back-to-back possessions to give the Aztecs a 57-42 advantage just over a minute later.

Despite outscoring SDSU 40-38 in the paint and maintaining a 16-8 edge on the offensive glass, the Mustangs were just 7-for-18 from the free-throw line and were out-rebounded on the defensive end, 27-19.

**HOPKINS TABBED MW PLAYER OF THE WEEK**

Chelsea Hopkins was named the Mountain West Player of the Week, the league office announced Monday. With her award, the Aztec senior earned the third MW weekly honor of her career and first this season.

Hopkins came within a whisker of a rare triple-double in SDSU's 73-56 road victory at Cal Poly on Sunday after finishing with a season-high 17 points to go along with 10 rebounds and nine assists. She also tied her career best with eight field goals on 14 attempts and came away with two steals in 39 minutes.

Hopkins set the tone early in the game by scoring six of the team's first 10 points, as the Scarlet and Black built an insurmountable 40-27 lead by halftime.

With her performance, Hopkins, who was also selected as conference player of the week by College Sports Madness on Monday, completed the seventh double-double and 25th double-digit scoring effort in her career. She enters this week ranked second in the MW with 5.6 assists per game and fifth with 7.0 rebounds per contest.

**TAKING CARE OF THE BALL**

The Aztecs are just one of four teams in the Mountain West to boast a positive turnover margin entering this week. SDSU is +2.1 in that statistic, good for second in the league behind Fresno State's +5.7 spread.

In just their sixth game this year against USC, the Aztecs posted a season-low eight turnovers in an 80-46 rout. During the 2011-12 campaign, SDSU didn't produce a single-digit turnover total until the 30th game when the Scarlet and Black finished with six miscues in their 73-55 semifinal victory over Wyoming at the MW tournament.

**GETTING DEFENSIVE**

In keeping with a familiar trend, the Aztecs have limited the opposition to an average of 54.2 points per game and a .344 field-goal percentage, both tops in the MW entering the week.

Last year, SDSU gave up 54.4 points a game to lead the conference, while its .362 field-goal percentage defense ranked second.

**WELCOME TO THE CLUB**

Earlier this season, Courtney Clements became the 17th player to surpass 1,000 points in an Aztec uniform. Through nine games this year, Clements has amassed 1,068 points during her career on The Mesa and has reached the 20-point plateau on 20 occasions, including five of her last seven outings. In 2011-12, she finished with 556 points, good for 11th place on the Aztecs' single-season charts.

**BLOCK PARTY**

Malia Nahinu ranks second in the MW this week with an average of 2.1 blocks per game. At Cal Poly last Sunday, the SDSU senior posted with two rejections in the Aztecs' 73-56 win. With her performance, Nahinu has 91 blocks in her career on The Mesa, moving into ninth place on the school's all-time list.

**WOMEN'S HOOPS SIGNS QUARTET TO NUS**

Head coach Beth Burns announced the addition last month of four talented recruits who will join the Aztecs for the 2013-14 season. Those signing National Letters of Intent include Ariell Bostick (Oakland, Calif.), Chloe Johnson (Phoenix, Ariz.), Alyssa Lawrence (New Rochelle, N.Y.) and Briteesha Solomon (San Diego, Calif.).

**DECEMBERS TO REMEMBER**

The Aztecs are a combined 29-9 during December since 2006. Four of those losses came to teams either ranked or receiving votes in the national poll in No. 2 UConn, No. 7 Texas A&M, No. 17 George Washington and USC (rv). The other five defeats were at Washington on Dec. 5, at Washington State and against USD in 2011, vs. Pepperdine in overtime in 2009 and against Quinnipiac in the opening contest of the 2007 Surf 'N Slam.

Of course, it should be noted that SDSU has played 28 of those 38 December contests at home.

**WITH A WIN...**

An Aztec victory over Fresno Pacific will mean:

- SDSU extends its winning streak to three games.
- SDSU improves to 4-0 at home this season.
- SDSU moves to 6-1 this year against teams from the state of California.
- SDSU's 7-3 record matches its best start to a season since the 2008-09 squad also went 7-3.
- SDSU raises its record to 30-9 in December games since 2006.

**FRESNO PACIFIC TIDBITS**

The Sunbirds, who are making the transition from the NAIA ranks to the NCAA Division II level, have struggled this year, allowing nearly 81 points per game in nine losses, including a 97-59 setback at Grand Canyon in a Pacific West Conference clash last Saturday.

For the season, sophomore guard Keairra White leads the Sunbirds with an average of 20.9 points per game and is the team's most consistent free-throw shooter, connecting on 51 of 66 attempts from the charity stripe (.773). Against Northwest Nazarene in the season-opener on Nov. 9, she tied a school record with 40 points and also tossed in 32 at Cal Baptist on Dec. 2. Elsewhere, freshman forward Charde Stevens (11.0 ppg) is FPU's top rebounder with 6.6 boards per outing, while senior guard Kayla Clement has drained a team-best 18 three-pointers.

As a team, the Sunbirds are shooting 32 percent from the field, 26 percent from 3-point range and 65 percent from the free-throw line.

San Diego State and Fresno Pacific have faced one

common opponent so far this year in Cal State Dominguez Hills. The Aztecs defeated the Toros 66-30 in their second home game of the season on Nov. 18, while the Sunbirds dropped an 81-53 decision to the same club at the Cal State L.A. Thanksgiving Classic the following week.

FPU head coach Erin Scholz was a two-time All-American during her playing days at the University of Colorado where she helped the Buffaloes to four NCAA tournament berths, including an Elite Eight appearance in 1995. Scholz, who owns the CU record with 132 games played during her career (1993-97), is currently second on the Buffaloes' all-time list with 1,067 rebounds and ranks sixth with 1,627 points.

The last time SDSU faced Fresno Pacific in any athletic event was April 3, 2011, when the Aztec women's water polo team came away with a 22-6 victory during the SDSU Mini-Invitational.
