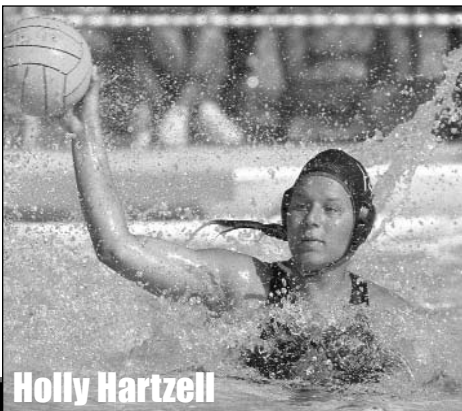

2003: Recorded her third straight All-American season by leading the Aztecs with 63 goals... Earned second team All-America plaques from the Collegiate Water Polo Coaches Association... Named Mountain Pacific Sports Federation all-conference second team for the third time after finishing second in the conference in goals scored... An All-MPSF tournament honoree, scoring five goals in leading SDSU to a fifth-place finish... Ranks second on the SDSU all-time scoring list with 221 goals scored, only 14 goals shy of the career record... First Aztec to record 60 or more goals in three seasons... Posted 20 assists last year and ranks third on the career list with 69 assists in her three seasons... Second on SDSU with 52 steals and has 154 steals in her career, which ranks fifth in SDSU annals... Recorded at least one goal in 28 of the 32 matches she played in and led the team in scoring 17 times... Scored a season-high five goals in a 17-8 victory over Hartwick on Feb. 8, and posted four goals on four different occasions... Named to American Water Polo Coaches Association's all-academic excellent team with a 3.26 GPA and earned MPSF all-academic honors.

2002: Followed up her terrific freshman season with a sophomore campaign that landed third-team All-American recognition... Registered the program's fifth-highest single-season scoring total in leading the Aztecs with 68 goals... Also paced the squad with 20 assists and finished second with 53 steals... Earned the season's first MPSF Player of the Week award on Feb. 14 after scoring 18 goals over the first six games of 2002... Led the team in scoring in each

of the season's first eight games and 19 overall... Scored at least one goal in 30-of-35 games played... Registered a season-high five goals in wins over Cal Baptist and Pacific... Gave the Aztecs a 7-6 victory over Hartwick in the season opener by scoring the game-winner with two seconds remaining... Also tallied the game-winner as the Aztecs defeated No. 6 San Jose State, 8-7... An honorable mention all-MPSF selection and was named to the academic all-MPSF team... Selected to the all-tournament first team for tallying eight goals and six assists in six games for the second-place Aztec "A" Team at the fall USWP Championship.
