## **TEAM NOTES**

- \* San Diego State secures its school-record sixth consecutive 20-win campaign.
- \* San Diego State recorded its seventh 20-win season under Steve Fisher. ... The Aztecs had a total of nine 20-win campaigns in the 78 seasons prior to his arrival on campus, which includes just two 20-win campaigns at the Division I level prior to Fisher's arrival. ... Overall, Fisher now owns 13, 20win campaigns in 20 full seasons as head coach.
- \* SDSU owns the longest active winning streak in the nation (20).
- \* San Diego State is one of three undefeated teams in the nation (No. 6 San Diego State: 20-0, No. 1 Ohio State: 19-0, No. 2 Kansas: 18-0).
- \* San Diego State is 5-0 to open Mountain West play for the first time in the 12-year history of the league.
- \* SDSU is 5-0 in conference play for the first time since 1966-67 when the Aztecs were members of the CCAA.
- \* San Diego State is the only 20-0 team in the country and the 20 victories are the most in Division I.
- \* No. 6 San Diego State improves to 20-0, its best start in 90 seasons of basketball.
- \* The 20-game winning streak is the longest in program history.
- \* The Aztecs have won...
  - ...29 straight vs. unranked teams at any location.
  - ...26 straight home games vs. unranked teams.
  - ...14 straight home games overall.
  - ...10 straight over MWC foes, with just three coming at home.
- \* Tonight was SDSU's 13th double-digit victory.
- \* SDSU recorded its seventh sellout of the season and the 15th in the history of Viejas Arena. SDSU has sold out seven of nine games this year.

- \* San Diego State has defeated Air Force six straight times and six consecutive times at Viejas Arena.
- \* Dating back to the 1990-91 season, SDSU is 23-2 against Air Force when it scores 60 or more points.

- \* D.J. Gay (20 points, 3 assists, 0 turnovers, 6-of-11 3-pt FG's) Tonight marks the first time Gay has scored 20 or more points in consecutive games in his career... Recorded his 12th double-figure scoring effort of the season... Led the team in scoring for the fourth time this season... After draining a career-high seven three-pointers at New Mexico, he followed it with another six tonight, which is highest two-game total of his career.... Now has six turnover-free games this season and 11 with one turnover or less.
- \* Billy White (12 points, 5 rebounds) Hit a three-point field for the third straight game, marking the first time he has done so in his career... Over his last three games he is 5-for-8 from the arc... Tied his career high with two three-point field goals... Scored in double figures for the eighth time this year and 53rd time in his career.
- \* Kawhi Leonard (10 points, 10 rebounds, 3 steals, 2 blocks) Reached double-figures in scoring for the 17th time this season... Recorded his 13th double-double this year and 30th of his career... Led the team in rebounding for the 14th time of the season... Now has 14 double-digit rebounding games this season and 33 for his career.
- \* Malcolm Thomas (8 points, 9 rebounds) Grabbed seven or more rebounds for the seventh straight game... Is still averaging a double-double (12.6 points and 11.2 rebounds) in MWC games this season.
- \* Chase Tapley (8 points, 3 assists, 3 steals) Knocked down multiple three-point field goals for the seventh time this year... Hit multiple three-pointers in consecutive games for the third time in 2010-11.
