- Under the direction of the fourth-year head coach Stacie Terry, SDSU returns nine letterwinners and three starters from a 2015-16 squad that posted a 12-19 overall mark, going 6-12 against Mountain West foes.
- The Scarlet and Black will look to benefit from a season that sees them return 69.3 percent of its scoring from a year prior.
- Returning starters McKynzie Fort (Fontana, Calif.), Ariell Bostick (Oakland, Calif.) and Cheyenne Greenhouse (Riverside, Calif.) accounted for 44.3 percent of the team's total points last year and 53.1 percent of its steals.
- The Aztecs will be led by Fort, a rising junior who received all-Mountain West honorable mention last season and earned a spot on the league's all-defensive team. She finished the season ranked sixth in the Mountain West with 14.4 points per game and was listed among the MW leaders in steals (t-3rd - 2.0/gm), free-throw percentage (6th - (.693)) and field-goal percentage (11th - (.462)).
- Coming off the bench for the Aztecs last season, Lexy Thorderson (Castle Rock, Colo.) was also a major contributor. The rising junior connected on multiple three-point field goals in 13 out of 31 games, shooting .323 from behind the arc to rank 13th in the league.
- San Diego State signed recent high school graduates Monique Terry (San Antonio, Texas), Baylee Vanderdoes (Auburn, Calif.), Naomi Ekwedike (Lagos, Nigeria) and Abby Lowe (Stockport, England) to National Letters of Intent for the 2016-17 campaign. The four incoming freshmen will join University of Washington transfer Khalia Lark (Irvine, Calif.), a junior who enrolled at SDSU prior to the Spring 2016 semester and is eligible Dec. 22.
- The Aztecs will have to contend with a challenging slate for the 2016-17 campaign. SDSU will face seven teams that advanced to the postseason, including conference foes Fresno State, New Mexico and Colorado State, all of which made appearances in the WNIT.
- In its lone exhibition of the year, San Diego State shot 50 percent (11-for-22) from beyond the arc to top Cal State San Marcos, 74-53, at Viejas Arena on Nov. 4.

Aztecs Picked Seventh in MW Preseason Poll

San Diego State has been picked to finish seventh in the 2016-17 Mountain West Women's Basketball Preseason Poll, the league office announced today. The voting panel consisted of the MW's 11 head coaches and select women's basketball media from around the conference.

The Aztecs collected 126 points in the poll, topping Wyoming, with whom they tied for eighth in the conference standings last season. by three points (123).

Three-time defending Mountain West champion Colorado State is expected to repeat as the league's top team, garnering 17 first-place points and 283 total points from the panel. Boise State picked up 11 first-place points and 271 total points for second place. Fresno State's 225 points ranked third in the poll. After finishing the season as the league's top-three teams, the trio represented the Mountain West in the 2016 Women's NIT.

Cal State San Marcos Exhibition Recap

Shooting 50 percent (11-for-22) from beyond the arc, San Diego State women's basketball topped Cal State San Marcos, 74-53, in its lone exhibition of the season Nov. 4 at Viejas Arena.

The Aztecs drained 11 three-pointers, with Kymberly Ellison and McKynzie Fort shooting three apiece. Last season, SDSU averaged 4.71 threes per game and Fort made three treys all season.

Despite Fort making the first basket of the game, Cal State San Marcos went on an 18-9 run and took an 18-15 lead into the second auarter.

By the start of the second quarter, however, the Aztecs were firing on all cylinders. SDSU went on a 12-0 run to start the frame and didn't allow a Cougar basket until just 5:23 remained in the period. At halftime, San Diego State led 34-24, due in large part to Fort's 20 points, 12 of which came in the second stanza.

The Aztecs kept up its pace in the third quarter. The period started with Bostick snatching the ball away from a Cougar and handing it off to Greenhouse, who sent it along to Ellison for the three. Ellison followed that up with a second three 92 seconds later for the 40-26 lead.

Freshman Naomi Ekwedike would go on to knock in a pair of layups, while Fort and Geena Gomez would fire off a pair of long balls. After 30 minutes of play, the Scarlet and Black held a 54-37 advantage.

San Diego State maintained its hot shooting in the final quarter, going 3-for-4 from behind the three-point line and recording an 8-for-12 field goal percentage for the final 74-53 score.

An All-Mountain West honorable mention a season ago, Fort led all players with 25 points. Greenhouse posted eight boards and 10 points, while Ellison recorded 11 points. Gomez also notched double-digit points with 10. Bostick led the club with four steals.

Bringin' it Back

San Diego State returns 69.3 percent of its scoring, three starters and nine letterwinners from its 2015-16 team.

The team will be led this season by All-Mountain West honorable mention and All-Mountain West Defensive Team honoree McKynzie Fort. The 5-9 guard from Fontana, Calif., was just one of two Aztecs to start all 31 games, finishing sixth in the conference with an average of 14.4 points per game. She also ranked among the conference's leaders in steals (t-3rd -- 2.0/gm), free-throw percentage (6th -- (.693)) and field-goal percentage (11th -- (.462)).

Ariell Bostick will don the Scarlet and Black for the final time as the team's top assist-getter from the previous season. The senior from Oakland, Calif., finished 10th in the Mountain West with a team-high 2.9 assists per outing. Classmate Aleigh Brandon was a top defensive threat for the Aztecs during the 2015-16 season, blocking 10 shots, the secondmost on the team, in 26 appearances and 18 starts.

The Aztecs' top three-point threat last season, Lexy Thorderson, a six-foot junior from Castle Rock, Colo., will be looked upon to fufill a similar role. Appearing in all 31 of SDSU's games, she drained 40 of 124 shots from behind the arc, ranking 13th in the conference.

A steady presence, Cheyenne Greenhouse also played in every game for San Diego State, making 22 starts, including 18 to end the season. She averaged 20.9 minutes per game, the fifth-most on the saugd.

In her first season in the Scarlet and Black after a transfer from Georgia Tech, senior Kymberly Ellison was another Aztec who appeared in every contest. In an average of 12.8 minutes per game, she posted a .722 free throw percentage, the second-best on

Fellow newcomer Geena Gomez was also quick to make an impact after her transfer from St. John's. The junior from Huntington Beach, Calif., appeared in 29 of SDSU's 31 games, maintaining the squad's highest assist-to-turnover ratio (1.42) and ranking second on the team with a .324 three-point field goal percentage (23-of-71).

Gomez's classmate Allison Brown has also made an impact on the team. A walk-on prior to her freshman season, Brown earned a scholarship for the 2016-17 season after playing in a career-high nine games last year.

Jumpin' Jehosaphat, Juniors!

The Aztecs' junior class has been anything but junior. During the 2015-16 season, Allison Brown, McKynzie Fort, Geena Gomez, Cheyenne Greenhouse and Lexy Thorderson averaged a combined 21.56 minutes per game, 7.17 points per game, 1.29 steals per game and 2.94 rebounds per game. The group accounted for 47.7 percent of SDSU's total offense a season ago, logging 41.2 percent of the team's total minutes played. Also excelling in the classroom, Greenhouse and Thorderson earned Academic All-Mountain West honors.

her junior season at Brennan High School, the 6-2 forward was the lone player in District 27-6A to average a double-double, posting 10.3 points and 10.4 rebounds per game while leading the district with a .540 field-goal percentage She was also named the District 27-6A's defensive player of the year and received all-region honors.

Vanderdoes played prep ball at Placer High School, where she averaged 21.1 points, 11.0 rebounds and 3.6 blocks per contest as a senior, earning a spot on the MaxPreps Division IV all-California state second team. The 6-1 forward was also named the Pioneer Valley League's most valuable player on two occasions and received second-team all-metro honors from the Sacramento Bee. She holds Placer High's single-game record for points scored (41) and blocked shots (11). Like Monique Terry, Vanderdoes received a scouts grade of 89 and was rated a three-star recruit by espnW. Her brother, Eddie, is a defensive lineman at UCLA.

A native of Lagos, Nigeria, Ekwedike is a 6-6 post player who prepped for three years at Potter's House Christian Academy in Jacksonville, Fla., where she was a member of two state championship teams and helped her sauad win a national championship in the National Christian School Athletic Association tournament in 2015. Ekwedike was also rated a three-star recruit by espnW and given a scouts grade of 88.

Rounding out the 2016 recruiting class is Lowe, who played two vears at the Barkina Abbey Academy near London, helpina the Crusaders capture the first-ever Women's Elite Academy Basketball League title last season. In addition, the 5-11 shooting guard earned a silver medal for the U16 squad representing England at the European Championships in 2014.

High School in Orange County, Lark helped the Monarchs win two CIF championships, one state title and one national championship alongisde fellow Aztec Allison Brown. As a sophomore, Lark's Mater Dei squad posted a 34-3 record and captured the Southern Section Division IAA crown, where she scored 14 points in the championship game.

A 6-foot guard, Lark appeared in 29 games over oneand-a-half seasons at Washington, where she averaged 2.5 points and 1.5 rebounds while shooting 38 percent from three-point range. As a freshman, she scored a career-high 10 points in a victory over Seattle University and grabbed a personal-best five rebounds that season in the Pac-12 title aame vs. California.

Stiff Slate

The Aztecs will have to contend with a challenging schedule for the 2016-17 campaign, as SDSU will face seven teams that advanced to the postseason.

San Diego State opens the season with a battle at UC Riverside, which played in the first round of the WNIT. Six days later, the Scarlet and Black visits crosstown rival San Diego, which advanced to the third round of the prestigious tournament. Over Thanksgiving Weekend, SDSU plays at the Seton Hall Tournament and could face the Pirates, returning in 2016-17 from a NCAA Tournament first-round showing. On Fri., Dec. 9, San Diego State welcomes Michigan to Viejas Arena, which is coming off of a WNIT semifinal appearance.

Additionally, SDSU faces conference foes Fresno State, New Mexico and Colorado State twice each, all of which made appearances in the WNIT.

Paris Johnson Named Director of Player Personnel

One of 20 1,000-point scorers in Aztec Women's Basketball history, Paris Johnson has joined San Diego State women's basketball as the team's director of player personnel, head coach Stacie Terry announced.

"We are so excited for Paris to join our coaching staff," Terry said. "Her professional experience combined with a tremendous knowledge of what it takes to be a student-athlete at San Diego State will be invaluable. She will be a great mentor to the team and her passion to continue the tradition of great basketball at SDSU will be instrumental in

our success. Also, her ties to the local community as a graduate of San Diego High will be welcomed."

In her role, Johnson will coordinate film exchange, edit game and practice film and develop team highlight videos. She will assist in the Aztecs' recruiting efforts and oversee the team's student managers. Additionally, Johnson will lend support to director of basketball operations Jon Silver in the planning and preparation of all women's basketball events.

Before joining the Aztecs' staff, Johnson served as the camp director at Skyhawks Sports Academy's San Diego camp from May-August 2015, supervising coaching staffs and coordinating daily lessons.

Johnson, an Aztec letterwinner from 2008-11, scored 1,598 points over her four-year career. San Diego State's career (267) and single season (94, 2009) blocks record holder, she garnered all-Mountain West honors each season she donned the Scarlet and Black. She also helped San Diego State to its first Mountain West tournament championship in 2010, a team that advanced to the NCAA Sweet 16.

After graduating with her bachelor's degree in social science, Johnson, a San Diego native, played overseas in Poland (Gorzow, 2011-12; Gdynia, 2015-16), Spain (Zamora, 2012-13), Australia (Brisbane and Sydney, 2014-15), the United Arab Emirates and Kuwait.

are trends to watch for in 2016-17:

- The Aztecs are true believers in the home court advantage. They enter the season with wins in 50 of its last 75 home games and have gone 82-37 on the Viejas Arena floor since the start of the 2008-09 campaign.
- With the game on the line, the Scarlet and Black gets the job done. The team has won 55 straight and has gone 85-1 since the beginning of the 2011-12 campaign when leading with five minutes left in the game. The Aztecs' lone blemish during that span occurred in a 59-58 heart-breaking loss at Washington on Dec. 5, 2012.
- The Aztecs are fond of closing out the calendar year on a high note. SDSU is 39-19 in December games dating back to the 2006-07 campaign, with seven of those losses coming against teams either ranked or receiving votes in the national polls.
- Over the last nine seasons, San Diego State has been solid in conference play. SDSU has recorded 87 Mountain West victories after posting 31 wins in the league's first nine years.
- The Aztecs have advanced to finals of the MW Championship in five of the last nine years, and advanced in the tournament every season since 2010-11, after not winning a single game in the tournament's first eight years of existence.

SDSU alumnus Chris Ello begins his ninth season of calling the action and is a familiar voice in the San Diego area. In addition to his responsibilities with the Aztec women's basketball squad, Ello is a member of the football broadcast team as a sideline reporter for the school's flagship station, The Mighty 1090 AM.

Ello started his career in sports talk radio in San Diego on XTRA Sports 690 in the summer of 1994. He has accumulated a wealth of experience doing play-by-play for a variety of sports at every level, including stints with the SDSU football (1985), baseball (1998-99) and men's basketball (2006-07) sauads.

From 1996-2006, Ello was the voice of the San Diego Gulls hockey team and has called the action for the San Diego Sockers (indoor soccer), San Diego Spirit (outdoor soccer), San Diego Wildcards (CBA) and San Diego Riptide (arena football). He also has experience broadcasting high school CIF football and basketball games since 2000.

For the fourth straight year, all regular-season Aztec home contests in 2016-17 will feature a live video stream via the Mountain West Network to supplement the audio call from Viejas Arena.

During the season, head coach Stacie Terry and the players are generally available to meet with the media following each workout, as requested. There will be no interviews on game days until postgame.

The Aztec basketball team officially began practice in early October. All workouts will take place at the Jeff Jacobs JAM Center with a few exceptions. Media wishing to attend practice should contact the Aztec media relations department at least one day in advance.

Media desiring to cover Aztec practices on campus can park in Parking Structure 7 and obtain a special parking permit from the SDSU athletic media relations office. Media parking via permit only will be provided for all home games in PS 4, adjacent to Viejas Arena.

STACIE TERRY

Head Coach Fourth Year at San Diego State; Fourth Year Overall UT Arlington, 1998

San Diego native Stacie Terry enters her fourth year at the helm of the Aztec women's basketball team after she was named the eighth head coach in program history on May 15, 2013.

Under Terry's direction, SDSU has continued its trend of garnering all-conference honors. In 2015-16, following a campaign that saw her team finish sixth in the league with 14.4 points per game and was tied for third with two steals per game, sophomore McKynzie Fort earned nods on the MW All-Defensive Team and as an All-MW honorable mention pick. San Diego State's 34th All-MW recipient, the Aztecs have picked up a conference nod each of the last 17 seasons.

During her first season on Montezuma Mesa. Terry was saddled with the unenviable task of replacing four senior starters who accounted for nearly 64 percent of the team's scoring offense from the previous year, as well as overcoming the loss of two key players to injuries prior to conference play.

Despite those obstacles and a demanding schedule featuring nine games against teams that eventually advanced to postseason competition, Terry's squad flashed its resiliency during the 2013-14 campaign. The Aztecs led the league in rebounding margin and rebounding defense while ranking second in field-goal percentage.

Individually, Terry also oversaw the progress of senior center Cierra Warren, who became the fifth SDSU player in a six-year span to receive first-team all-MW recognition.

Prior to her arrival on The Mesa, Terry gained a wealth of experience as an assistant coach at the Division I level for 14 years, including five under head coach Nikki (Caldwell) Fargas, who transformed UCLA into a powerhouse before restoring LSU to national prominence.

During Terry's two seasons at LSU, the Lady Tigers compiled a 45-23 overall record and earned two NCAA tournament bids, including a Sweet 16 appearance during the 2012-13 campaign. During that season, the Lady Tigers also posted six victories against ranked opponents and finished with their second-highest scoring average (69.0) in the last seven years. Under Terry's guidance, forward LaShondra Barrett garnered first-team all-Southeastern Conference accolades and received honorable mention All-America distinction in 2012 before becoming a first-round draft choice of the WNBA's Washington Mystics.

Prior to her appointment at LSU, Terry served as an assistant under Fargas at UCLA from 2008-11, helping the Bruins gain national acclaim with a pair of NCAA tournament appearances. During Terry's tenure, UCLA posted 72 overall victories, as the 2010-11 squad finished with a 28-5 record, setting a school record for fewest losses in a single season to go with a No. 7 national ranking. In addition, the Bruins signed the fourth-ranked recruiting class that season, according to ESPN HoopGurlz, while Terry helped mentor first-team all-Pac-10 performers in Doreena Campbell, Darxia Morris and Jasmine Dixon, a 2012 honorable mention AP All-America selection, and all-conference freshman honorees Atonye Nyingifa and Markel Walker.

Terry spent the 2007-08 campaign at Southern Mississippi, as the Golden Eagles posted a 21-14 record and earned a postseason berth in the Women's National Invitation Tournament (WNIT). While at Southern Miss, Terry spearheaded the development and coordination of the Lady Eagle recruiting campaign. Her responsibilities also included working with the perimeter players, scouting opponents and film breakdown, as well as coordinating all of the team's community service events.

Terry also coached for three seasons from 2004-07 as an assistant under Hall of Fame head coach Theresa Grentz at Illinois. where the Fighting Illini had three straight recruiting classes

ranked among the top 25 in the nation, according to Blue Star Basketball, and made three consecutive trips to the WNIT. Her primary duties included defensive instruction and working with the perimeter players.

In addition, Terry coached at Dayton during the 2003-04 season following a three-year stint at Louisville from 2000-03. With the Cardinals, Terry's responsibilities encompassed recruiting, scouting, player development, summer camps and serving as a liaison for the program's community service outreach. Louisville captured the Conference USA regular-season title and earned a trip to the NCAA tournament in 2001 before making a WNIT appearance in 2002. She also assisted in signing the nation's 21st-ranked recruiting class in 2002-03, according to All-Star Girls Report. Terry recruited and coached all-Conference USA honoree Lori Nero, a draft choice of the WNBA's Houston Comets, as well as Sara Nord, who finished her collegiate career as the Cardinals' all-time assist leader and ranks among the top-15 scorers in school history.

Terry enjoyed a successful collegiate playing career at the University of Texas at Arlington, winning four varsity letters from 1994-98 under head coach Mike Dean. She earned first-team all-Southland Conference honors after leading the Mayericks in scoring with 17.4 points per game as a senior in 1997-98. Terry scored 1,169 points during her career at UTA and still ranks among the school's top 10 in 3-point field goals made (third), assists (sixth), steals (seventh) and free-throw percentage (10th). She is just one of 17 players in Maverick history to surpass the 1,000-point plateau, while her .335 career 3-point field-goal percentage is also a school and Southland Conference career record.

Terry played one season of professional basketball in Warsaw, Poland, averaging 12.0 points and 6.0 assists with the Polonia Phoenix, before returning to UT Arlington to begin her coaching career as a graduate assistant in 1999.

Terry prepped at El Capitan High and held the Vaqueros' career scoring record for three years following her graduation. She was inducted into the school's athletic hall of fame in 2008.
