- ▶ **The Records:** The San Diego State women's basketball team will look to get back to its winning ways on two fronts, when it plays host to cross-town rival University of San Diego, Wed., Dec. 10, at Cox Arena. The Aztecs are coming off a 71-52 loss at Cal State Northridge on Saturday, which snapped a three-game win streak. A victory over the Toreros would also avenge last year's 72-53 defeat at USD.
- ▶ San Diego has dropped its last four games of 2003-04, after defeating Nevada 96-74 on Nov. 22, for its only win of the season. The Toreros have only beaten the Aztecs once in 18 chances in games played at SDSU.
- ▶ **In The RPI:** In the second RPI released by the WBCA on Dec. 8, SDSU is ranked 300th, while San Diego is 281st of the 324 NCAA Division I teams. The Aztecs are 258th in the Jeff Sagarin/*College Basketball News* rankings.
- ▶ **SDSU Head Coach Jim Tomey:** Tomey (Michigan '81) is in his second season at San Diego State after taking over the Aztec helm on April 9, 2002. His career and Aztec head coaching record is 12-20.
- ▶ **USD Head Coach Kathy Marpe:** Marpe is in her 24th season as head coach at USD. Her record at USD is 379-362, while she is 366-425 in 31 seasons as a head coach.
- ▶ **Series History:** SDSU leads 24-2 (Last: USD def. SDSU, 72-53, at USD, 12/11/03).

SDSU Women's Basketball Looks For Redemption Against Rival San Diego Wednesday
The SDSU women's basketball team begins a three-game homestand Wednesday as it plays host to cross-town rival University of San Diego at 7 p.m. at Cox Arena. The Aztecs are coming off a 71-52 loss at Cal State Northridge on Saturday after stringing together a three-game win streak for the first time since 2001-02.

San Diego State will look to avenge last year's 72-53 loss to USD, which is 1-5 overall, dropping its last four contests. Both sides boast victories over winless Nevada in 2003-04, with the Aztecs winning 67-52 and the Toreros cruising, 96-74.

Aztecs' Winning Ways End At CS Northridge

The San Diego State women's basketball team's three-game winning streak came to an end Saturday as the Aztecs fell at Cal State Northridge, 71-52, in non-conference action at The Matadome. With the loss, SDSU fell to 3-2 overall, while the Matadors tallied their first win of

the season, improving to 1-2 in 2003-04.

Aztec sophomore **Ashlee Dunlap (Los Angeles, Calif.)** recorded her second straight double-double and her third of the season, finishing with a team-best 19 points and a season-high 15 rebounds. Freshman **Michelle Elliott (Pasco, Wash.)** tallied her fifth straight game in double-figures, adding 11 points.

Other CS Northridge Notes

Two other streaks came to an end in the Aztecs' loss to the Matadors. For the first time this season, SDSU allowed more than 52 points in a game and did not limit its opponent to 20 points or below in either half ... SDSU was outrebounded for the first time, 32-30.

Double Her Pleasure

With three double-doubles this season, including two in her last two outings, Aztec Ashlee Dunlap continues to rise up the conference ladder.

With her 13 career double-doubles, Dunlap is tied for fifth in MWC history and is tops among active players along with UNLV junior Sherry McCracklin.

Linda Frohlich (UNLV) owns the conference record of 43, while Carrie Bacon (WYO) is second with 23. With three more double-doubles, Dunlap can vault into third place all-time, moving past Utah's Lauren Beckman and BYU's Jennifer Leitner, who each finished their careers with 15 double-doubles.

Seeing Double

SDSU freshman Michelle Elliott and sophomore Ashlee Dunlap continue to be the team's most consistent threats on offense. Elliott has opened her career with double-figure scoring efforts in each of the team's five games, the only Aztec player to do so this season. Dunlap, meanwhile, has scored 10 or more points four times and in 15 of her last 17 outings.

Freshmen Fantastic

With only three letterwinners returning from last year's squad, new faces have no doubt been a key part of the Aztecs' success in 2003-04. Three of SDSU's top four scorers so far this season are all true freshmen, with Michelle Elliott leading the way with a team-best 15.0 points per game. Elliott has scored in double-figures in all five contests, while **Jessica Huettl (Eau Claire, Wis.)** has done so three times, averaging 9.2 points per game. **Courtney Fritz (Newberg, Ore.)** rounds out the group with 8.8 ppg., including a 21-point effort at Cal State Fullerton.

Elliott, Fritz and Huettl have also combined for 22 of the team's 23 three-pointers in 2003-04.

Drawing The Line

After making just 61.5 percent of their free throws a year ago, the Aztecs have already made steps toward improving that mark, hitting a conference-best 77.5 percent in the first five games.

The four-game mark includes an 84.6 percent (22-for-26) effort at Cal State Northridge last week, the team's highest free-throw percentage since the Aztecs shot 85.7 percent at Missouri-Kansas City on Dec. 20, 2001. SDSU has made 80 percent or more of its free throws in a game twice this season (also vs. Nevada) after doing so only once in 2002-03, versus New Mexico (81.8 percent) in the season finale.

The improvement at the line can especially be seen with the team's top two returnees in forwards Ashlee Dunlap and **Nicolette McCartney (Chicago, Ill.)**, who were both under 60 percent free-throw shooters a year ago.

- ▶SDSU is 25-2 all-time against the Toreros and 18-1 at SDSU. USD has never put together back-to-back victories in the series, which dates back to 1978.
- ▶SDSU improves to 1-1 this season against West Coast Conference schools with a Jan. 6, meeting with Santa Clara still left to play.
- ▶SDSU is 2-2 against teams which it also faced a year ago, after going 1-3 versus the same schools in 2002-03.

USD Tid-Bits

San Diego enters Wednesday's game 1-5 overall, dropping its last four games ... USD only win of the season came Nov. 22 against Nevada (96-74) ... the Toreros have been led this season by senior Marta Menez, who averages 16.5 points per game ... Melissa Padgett is the team's top rebounder with 8.3 per game, while Polly Dong already has 34 assists on the season ... the two sides will play at Cox Arena for the first time since a 55-34 SDSU win on Nov. 26, 1996 ... USD hit seven three-pointers and shot 47.5 percent from the field to win last year's game, outscoring the Aztecs 42-28 in the second half.

In The MWC

Through games of Dec. 8, SDSU ranks in the top three among conference schools in scoring defense (2nd - 53.0 ppg.), free-throw percentage (1st - 77.5), field-goal defense (.382), three-point defense (2nd - .279) and rebounding defense (2nd - 31.6). Interestingly, the Aztecs were ranked fifth or below in the Mountain West a year ago in all five of those categories and dead last in two of them.

20-20

In the last two seasons, the 20-point mark has been a barrier reached by only one Aztec - 2003 graduate Jamey Cox. Cox scored 20 points or more five times in 2002-03 and once in 2001-02.

Already this year, three different Aztecs have been able to reach the 20-point mark. Freshman Courtney Fritz became the latest addition to the club, putting up 21 points in the 73-50 victory at Cal State Fullerton Monday. Sophomore Ashlee

Forward Ashley Cheesman (Orem, Utah), point guard Kate Eveland (Southlake, Texas), center Whitney Hollison (Rancho Santa Margarita, Calif.) and wing Marin McCue (Calgary, Alberta) will join the Aztecs in the fall of 2004.

Pick Six

The San Diego State women's basketball team has been picked to finish sixth in the Mountain West Conference in a preseason poll released Oct. 7, at the league's basketball media day in Denver, Colo. The voting panel consisted of the conference's eight head coaches and select media.

The Aztecs jumped one spot from each of the three previous polls, receiving 57 total points. SDSU, which finished seventh in the MWC a year ago, was accurately picked to place sixth in the inaugural poll in 1999-2000.
