San Diego State Softball Set for Home Series with Boise State

San Diego State returns home for a weekend series with Boise State at SDSU Softball Stadium. The Aztecs (27-11, 11-1 MW) and the Broncos (27-8, 6-3 MW) are set to play games at 6 p.m. PT Thursday, 6 p.m. PT Friday and noon PT Saturday.

All three games will be broadcast on Mountain West Network (links will be available on GoAztecs.com).

SDSU, which moved up a spot to 24th in the latest D1Softball rankings, is coming off a series victory at UNLV, which along with San Diego State were the preseason picks to win the league. SDSU has won all four of its MW series and has won 13 of its last 14 games.

The Aztecs started 10-0 in MW play, their second-best league start in program history.

Mac Barbara is leads SDSU in most offensive categories, including batting average (.414, T-54th in NCAA), hits (48, tied, T-34th in NCAA), doubles (9), home runs (13, T-21st in NCAA), RBIs (46, T-8th in NCAA), total bases (98, T-13th in NCAA), slugging percentage (.845, 27th in NCAA), walks (23, T-62nd in NCAA) and on-base percentage (.507, 54th in NCAA).

Bella Espinoza is hitting .400 and tops San Diego State in hits (48, tied, T-34th in NCAA) and stolen bases (10), while Jillian Celis (.346, 20 RBI, 25 R, 7 2B, 4 3B) and Makena Brocki (.300, 1 HR, 13 RBI, 12 R, 2 2B, 3 3B) are also hitting at least .300.

Maggie Balint (13-4, 1.43 ERA, 4 SV, .173 opp. avg.) has won seven of a possible nine MW Pitcher-of-the-Week awards, and is tied for fifth the country in saves (4), eighth in strikeouts (195), 14th in strikeout-to-walk ratio (7.80), 15th in strikeouts per seven innings (10.72), 28th in ERA (1.43), 34th in hits allowed per seven innings (4.34) and tied for 40th in victories (13)

Dee Dee Hernandez (7-3, 1.87 ERA, 3 SV, 52 K, 8 BB) has pitched 63 2/3 innings, while Dani Martinez (4-2, 3.75 ERA, 26 K, 5 BB, 37.1 IP) and Allie Light (3-2, 4.08 ERA, 37 K, 11 BB, 34.1 IP) have also logged innings in the circle.

- Helped lead SDSU to seven straight NCAA tournaments from 2009-15 and a combined 398-264 (.601) record in her 13 seasons on The Mesa as an assistant coach, associate head coach and head coach in waiting.
- Over her first nine seasons as an assistant and associate coach, the Aztecs improved their batting average from .275 in 2008 (the year before she arrived) to a school-record .356 mark in 2017, and also in runs per game (3.98 to 6.61), home runs per game (0.23 to 1.09 (0.92 in 2017)), slugging percentage (.348 to .516) and on-base percentage (.347 to .418).
- Was the head coach of the National Pro Fastpitch's Chicago Bandits for the 2018 season, leading the Bandits to the NPF Championship series in her first year.
- Also has served as an assistant coach for the Women's National Team and USA Softball Junior Women's (19-Under) Selection Camps.
- As a player, was a three-time U.S. Olympian, winning gold medals in 2000 and 2004, and a silver medal in 2008. Also helped the United States National Team to a World Cup championship (2006), two World Championships (2002 and 2006) and two Pan American gold medals (1999 and 2003).
- Was a standout player at UCLA, finishing her four-year career with four NCAA records - 90 home runs, .945 slugging percentage, 240 walks and 81 intentional walks. She was a fourtime first-team NFCA All-American (1997, 1999, 2001-02) and a three-time Pac-10 Player of the Year (1999, 2001-02).
- In 1999, Nuveman Deniz led the Bruins to a national championship, batting .446 during the season with 31 home runs and

Scouting Boise State

Boise State enters the weekend with a 27-8 record, including a 6-3 mark in Mountain West play. So far in Mountain West play, the Broncos swept a home series against Fresno State (March 18-19) and swept a road series at Nevada (March 25-27), before being swept at home against UNLV (April 1-3). BS hasn't played since an 8-5 setback to UNLV on April 3.

Boise State is hitting .312 as a team, led by Kelsey Hall, who paces the squad in average (.420), runs (25), home runs (9), total bases (68, tied), slugging percentage (.840), on-base percentage (.505) and stolen bases (5). Alycia Flores (.374, 3 HR, 21 RBI, 23 R), Kelsey Lalor (.360, 7 HR, 29 RBI, 24 R, 11 2B) and Abby Bumcrot (.326) are also hitting above .325 for the Broncos.

The BS pitching staff, meanwhile, has combined for a 2.89 ERA with 239 strikeouts in 230 1/3 innings. Hannah Bailey (9-2, 2.40 ERA, 87 K, 87.2 IP), Sara Johnson (7-1, 2.48 ERA, 47 K, 53.2 IP) and Taylor Caudill (11-5, 3.23 ERA, 101 K, 82.1 IP) have done the bulk of the pitching for Boise State.

Maggie Balint, AJ Murphy Each Receive MW Weekly Accolades

San Diego State softball's Maggie Balint (West Grove, Pa.) and AJ Murphy (Goodyear, Ariz.) have each been named Mountain West Players of the Week, the league announced Tuesday. Balint was chosen as the MW Pitcher of the Week for the seventh time in nine opportunities this season, while Murphy became the third Aztec to be selected as the MW Freshman of the Week.

San Diego State has now won 14 of the 27 MW weekly awards, including seven pitchers of the week, six freshmen and one player.

The duo led SDSU (27-11, 11-1 MW) to a series win at UNLV last weekend. San Diego State, which was picked to win the league along with the Rebels (28-9, 6-3 MW), won on Friday (2-0) and Sunday (7-6 in 11 innings), dropping an 8-7 game in between on Saturday

Balint, who has now been named the MW Pitcher of the Week nine times for her career, pitched in both Aztec wins, going 1-0 with a 2.33 ERA in 15 innings. Balint struck out 16 with six walks, while limiting a team that led the league in batting average (.330), on-base percentage (.432) and slugging percentage (.560), to a .196 average and just 11 hits. The right-hander tossed a three-hit shutout in a 2-0 SDSU win on Friday night, striking out 10 with three walks. The Rebels were 0-for-12 against Balint with runners on base and 0-for-10 with runners in scoring position. On Sunday, Balint pitched the first eight innings of a 7-6, 11-inning victory, giving up five runs (both on home runs) on eight hits and three walks, striking out six.

On the season, Balint is 13-4 with four saves and a 1.43 ERA, striking out 195 against 25 walks, while limiting her opponents to a .173 average. Among the SDSU single-season leaders, Balint ranks first in winning percentage (.765) and strikeouts per seven innings (10.72), second in opponent average (.173, since 1991), fourth in strikeout-to-walk ratio (9.42), seventh in hits allowed per seven innings (.434), tied for seventh in saves (4) and eighth in WHIP (0.82). Among the national leaders, Balint is tied for fifth in saves (4), eighth in strikeouts (195), 14th in strikeout-to-walk ratio (7.80), 15th in strikeouts per seven innings (10.72), 28th in ERA (1.43), 34th in hits allowed per seven innings (4.34) and tied for 40th in victories (13).

Aztecs 24th in D1Softball Rankings; Receiving Votes in Two Major Polls

San Diego State moved up one spot and is 24th in the latest D1Softball rankings, which were released Monday on D1softball.com. The Aztecs (27-11, 11-1 MW) are coming off a series victory at UNLV, which was picked to win the Mountain West along with SDSU.

San Diego State is just ahead of No. 25 Stanford, while No. 21 Michigan, No. 22 Auburn and No. 23 Notre Dame are also near the Aztecs. SDSU is 1-2 against teams in the current D1Softball rankings with a 7-5 win over current No. 15 Washington, and a pair of one-run losses to No. 7 Northwestern (7-6 in eight innings) and No. 25 Stanford (1-0). Oklahoma remains atop the rankings with a 36-0 record, while Alabama, Virginia Tech, Florida Sate and UCLA round out the top 5.

San Diego State and No. 18 UCF are the only two Group of 5 teams in the rankings.

For the seventh time over the last eight weeks, San Diego State is receiving votes in the ESPN.com/USA Softball Collegiate Top 25 Poll. The Aztecs received five votes in the latest poll, which is voted on by coaching representatives of 10 Division I conferences as well as members of the media who consistently cover Division I softball across the country.

The five votes are tied with USC Upstate for the 31st-most votes in the poll. Notre Dame is ranked 25th in the poll with 32 points. Mississppi State leads the receiving votes group with 28 points, followed by South Florida (20), Arizona (12), Nebraska (11), Missouri (8), SDSU (5), USC Upstate (5), Illinois (4), Louisiana (4) and Utah (1).

SDSU previously had three votes in the Feb. 22 poll (T-34th most in the country), 12 on March 1 (32nd), four on March 8 (31st), four on March 15 (29th), none on March 22, six on March 29 (T-32nd) and six on April 5 (T-34th).

Oklahoma has 24 of the 25 first-place votes and 624 points overall.

San Diego State is also receiving votes in the USA Today/NFCA poll for the first time this year. The Aztecs have two votes, which is tied with Louisiana for the 32nd most in the poll. Arizona is the No. 25 team in the USA Today/NCAA poll with 78 points. Oregon State is just out with 38, followed by Missouri (29), USC Upstate (17), Mississippi State (4), Nebraska (4), USF (4), Louisiana (2) and SDSU (2). Oklahoma has all 32 first-place votes and 800 points overall.

Start Me Up

San Diego State has had an incredible start to the Mountain West season. The Aztecs started 10-0 in league action and are currently 11-1 on MW play. So far in league games SDSU is outscoring its opposition, 59-26, in 12 games (4.9-2.2).

The 10-0 start was San Diego State's best conference start since the 2006 season, when the Aztecs started out 13-0. Below are SDSU's longest undefeated starts in league history (since 2000):

San Diego State had won 12 consecutive games before falling at UNLV last Saturday, 8-7. The 12-game winning streak was its longest streak since winning a school-record 13 straight games from March 12-April 6, 2013. That stretch was one of four times the Aztecs have won 13 consecutive games.

Mac Barbara Slugging Her Way into SDSU History

Mac Barbara is off to one of the best individual starts in program history.

Through 38 games, Barbara is batting .414 with 13 home runs, 46 RBIs, nine doubles, a .845 slugging percentage and a .507 on-base mark. Among the NCAA leaders, Barbara ranks in a tie for eighth in RBIs (48), tied for 13th in total bases (98), tied for 21st in home runs (13), 27th in slugging percentage (.845), tied for 34th in hits (48), 54th in on-base percentage (.407), tied for 54th in batting average (.414) and tied for 62nd in walks (23).

Barbara's 13 home runs in 38 games are already tied for the seventh most in San Diego State single-season history. Barbara also ranks second in slugging percentage (.845) and OPS percentage (1.352), fourth in on-base percentage (.507), fifth in batting average (.414), ninth in extra-base hits (23) and ninth in RBIs (46).

With two home runs against Stony Brook on March 6, Barbara became the fastest player in program history to reach 10 home runs in a season, doing so in SDSU's 21st game of the season. Barbara is currently seven home runs behind the school record of 20 set by Hayley Miles in 2012.

Maggie Balint Pitching Her Way into the SDSU Record Books

Maggie Balint is having her best season as an Aztec and one of the best seasons of her career. Balint, who was 28-4 with a 1.51 ERA at Oregon from 2017-18 en route to being named a all-region, all-Pac-12 and all-Pac-12 freshman pick as a freshman in 2017, is currently 13-4 with a 1.43 ERA in 117 1/3 innings. The right-hander has struck out 195 against just 25 walks, limiting the opposition to a .173 average. Balint, who has been named the MW Pitcher of the Week seven times in nine tries this season, is ranked among the NCAA and SDSU single-season bests.

In the NCAA, Balint is tied for fifth in saves (4), eighth in strikeouts (195), 14th in strikeout-to-walk ratio (7.80), 15th in strikeouts per seven innings (10.72), 28th in ERA (1.43), 34th in hits allowed per seven innings (4.34) and tied for 40th in victories (13).

Among the Aztec single-season leaders, Balint currently ranks first in winning percentage (.765) and strikeouts per seven innings (10.72), second in opponent average (.173, since 1991), fourth in strikeout-to-walk ratio (9.42), seventh in hits allowed per seven innings (.434), tied for seventh in saves (4) and eighth in WHIP (0.82).

Aztecs Excel in Lid-Lifters

San Diego State has excelled in season-opening games since records were first kept in 1980.

Following a 3-1 victory over Middle Tennessee on Feb. 10, the Aztecs improved to 32-11 (.744) in lid-lifters in recorded program history

SDSU has won nine of its last 10 season openers. 20 of its last 22 and 23 of its last 26.

San Diego State's only blemishes in the past 26 season-openers came in 2018 (lost to No. 25/25 Georgia, 23-2), 2012 (lost to Texas Tech, 5-4) and in 2000 (lost to UIC, 5-3).

Over the last 26 openers, the Aztecs have outscored their opponent, 149-81, or 5.7-3.1 per game in lid-lifters.

SDSU ended up recording back-to-back shutouts over the Toreros on 2021 opening day, the first time it had consecutive shutouts on a opening day since 2008.

Aztecs Picked to Win the Mountain West with UNLV

The San Diego State softball team has been picked to win the Mountain West along with UNLV in a preseason poll voted on by the league's nine head coaches, the conference announced Feb. 3. The Aztecs have won a MW-record seven regular-season titles.

Both the Aztecs and Rebels received 57 points, but UNLV (5) had more first-place votes than SDSU (3). Fresno State had the other first-place vote and is tied with Boise State for third with 43 points, while Nevada was predicted fifth with 42 points. Rounding out the poll was Colorado State (35) in sixth, New Mexico (17) in seventh, and San José State and Utah State tied for eighth with 15 points.

Last year, San Diego State finished with a 28-16 record, its best winning percentage (.636) since the 2015 squad went 38-20 (.655) before falling in the NCAA Los Angeles Regional final to UCLA. It was also the ninth-best record in program history.

Stacey Nuveman Deniz Named Program's Fifth Head Coach

San Diego State's Stacey Nuveman Deniz was named the softball head coach, director of athletics John David Wicker announced on June 8. A three-time U.S. Olympian, Nuveman Deniz is just the fifth head coach in program history after spending the last 13 seasons with the Aztecs as an assistant, associate head coach and head coach in waiting under SDSU's all-time winningest coach Kathy Van Wyk.

"I am humbled and honored to have this opportunity to lead San Diego State Softball into the future," Nuveman Deniz said. "Kathy Van Wyk spent 25 years building this program, and now it is my turn to take the reins and continue that growth. I would like to thank (SDSU director of athletics) John David Wicker for this opportunity and for the unwavering support he has shown me. The University, the city of San Diego and our incredible community have captured my heart and I truly am an Aztec for Life. I can't wait to get started."

Nuveman Deniz, who was hired at San Diego State following her stint with the U.S. team at the 2008 Beijing Olympics, helped SDSU to seven straight NCAA tournaments from 2009-15 and a combined 398-264 (.601) record in her 13 seasons on The Mesa. Over her first nine seasons as an assistant and associate coach, the Aztecs improved their batting average from .275 in 2008 (the year before she arrived) to a school-record .356 mark in 2017, and also in runs per game (3.98 to 6.61), home runs per game (0.23 to 1.09 (0.92 in 2017)), slugging percentage (.348 to .516) and on-base percentage (.347 to .418).

In 2018, Nuveman Deniz was the head coach of the National Pro Fastpitch's Chicago Bandits, leading the team to the NFP Championship season series in her first year. In the spring of 2010, Nuveman Deniz served as an assistant coach for the Women's National Team Selection Camp, at the Canadian Open Fast Pitch Women's International Championship and at the World Cup of Softball VI. She was also named to the USA Softball Coaching Pool in 2014 and was an assistant coach at the USA Softball Junior Women's (19-Under) National Team (JWNT) Selection Camp in January 2015.

In addition to her two Olympic gold medals (2000 and 2004) and silver medal in 2008, Nuveman Deniz helped the United States National Team to a World Cup championship (2006), two World Championships (2002 and 2006) and two Pan American gold medals (1999 and 2003). Her 2004 Olympic gold medal team, meanwhile, was inducted into the U.S. Olympic hall of fame in July 2012.

Nuveman Deniz was a standout at UCLA, finishing her four-year career with four NCAA records - 90 home runs, .945 slugging percentage, 240 walks and 81 intentional walks. She was a four-time first-team NFCA All-American (1997, 1999, 2001-02) and a three-time

Pac-10 Player of the Year (1999, 2001-02). Nuveman Deniz is also ranked first in school history in games played (264), total bases (653) and on-base percentage (.600).

Among the current all-time NCAA leaders, Nuveman Deniz ranks first in home runs per game (0.34), total bases (653) and intentional walks (81), second in slugging percentage (.945), third in home runs (90) and walks (240), fifth in RBIs (299), seventh in batting average

In 1999, Nuveman Deniz led the Bruins to a national championship, batting .446 during the season with 31 home runs and 91 RBIs. For her efforts in the national title run, Nuveman was named to the all-Women's College World Series team. Nuveman Deniz was inducted into UCLA's hall of fame in October 2012.

Nuveman Deniz graduated from UCLA in 2002 with a degree in sociology and public policy and later earned her master's in kinesiology from Texas Women's University in 2012.

Canadian Olympian Victoria Hayward Named Assistant Coach

Victoria Hayward was named an assistant coach for the San Diego State softball team, head coach Stacey Nuveman Deniz announced Aug. 26, 2021. Hayward recently represented Canada at the 2020 Tokyo Olympics and has been a member of the Canadian Senior National Team since 2009.

Hayward has nine years of experience in the college ranks, most recently serving as the director of operations at UCF in 2019 and as an assistant coach at Maryland in 2018.

Prior to Maryland, Hayward helped guide UMass to back-to-back winning seasons in 2016 and 2017. UMass was one of the top hitting teams in the Atlantic 10 in 2017, finished second in regular-season standings and advanced to the A10 title game. At UMass, Hayward helped nine batters/position players earn all-conference honors and three Minutewomen hitters garnered NFCA All-Region selections during her tenure.

Hayward spent the 2015 season as a graduate assistant at LSU under head coach Beth Torina. The Tigers opened the year with 25 consecutive victories and spent three weeks as the top-ranked team in the country, before ending the season with a 52-14 record and a third-place finish at the Women's College World Series (WCWS). LSU's coaching staff was named the Division I South Region Staff of the Year by the National Fastpitch Coaches Association (NFCA).

As a player, Hayward made the Canadian squad in 2009 at 16 years old, becoming the youngest player ever to join the senior team. Hayward has been a mainstay in the outfield and has won numerous medals in international competition. She was the 19th overall selection in the 2014 National Pro Fastpitch Draft by the Pennsylvania Rebellion.

In college, Hayward starred at national power Washington, helping the Huskies to four NCAA tournaments. Hayward was a 2014 All-American, a four-time all-Pac-12 selection and a three-time Academic All-Pac-12 honoree (2011-14). UW won four NCAA Regional Championships during her career and advanced to the Women's College World Series in 2013. She finished her Washington career ranked seventh in runs (176), 10th in triples (7) and 12th in average (.351), while stealing a league-best 28 bases as a senior without committing an error.

SDSU Adds Former UCLA Star Rachel Garcia to Staff

Rachel Garcia, one of the most decorated players in NCAA softball history, has joined San Diego State as a volunteer assistant coach, head coach Stacey Nuveman Deniz announced Jan. 7.

Garcia, who most recently helped the United States to a silver medal at the 2020 Tokyo Olympics in the summer, garnered numerous accolades during her time at UCLA, including twice being named the Collegiate Woman Athlete of the Year (Honda Cup) for all sports (2019 and 2021) and three times the Honda Sports Award for softball (2018, 2019 and 2021). Garcia also won the Senior CLASS Award in 2021.

Garcia, who redshirted in 2020 while playing for Team USA on its Stand Beside Her Tour, also has been chosen twice as the USA Softball Collegiate Player of the Year (2018-19), and once each as the NFCA National Pitcher of the Year (2019) and the NFCA National Player of the Year (2018). Garcia was also the 2017 NFCA National Freshman of the Year.

In the circle, Garcia was 99-17 with a 1.43 ERA with 11 saves for her career with the Bruins, striking out 996 against 172 walks in 749 innings. Garcia tossed 28 shutouts and 66 complete games, while limiting the opposition to a .172 batting average. Her 2019 NFCA pitcher-of-the-year season featured a 29-1 record with a 1.14 ERA and seven shutouts in 202 innings, striking out 286 as UCLA captured the NCAA title.

At the plate, Garcia hit .337 for her career with 43 home runs, 175 RBIs, 103 runs and 32 doubles, while owning a .594 slugging percentage and a .430 on-base mark. When she was named the NFCA Player of the Year in 2018, Garcia hit .339 with 11 home runs and 54 RBIs in 61 games.

Garcia is also a four-time NFCA All-American (first team in 2018, 2019 and 2021, second team in 2017), four-time NFCA All-Region selection (2017, 2018, 2019 and 2021), three-time Pac-12 Player of the Year (2018, 2019 and 2021), 2019 Pac-12 Pitcher of the Year, 2017 Pac-12 Freshman of the Year and four-time all-Pac-12 selection (2017, 2018, 2019 and 2021).

Throughout her career. Garcia was a multi-time national player of the week (three times by USA Softball and twice by NFCA) and a two-time NFCA national player of the week. Additionally, Garcia was an 11-time Pac-12 Pitcher of the Week and a four-time Pac-12 Player of the Week.

Garcia has been with the USA National Team since 2018, helping the squad wind the gold medal at the 2018 WBSC Women's World Championship, and the 2019 USA Softball International Cup, Pan American Games and Japan Cup, before settling for a silver medal at Tokyo last summer.

Aztecs to Have Majority of Games on Streaming Devices

San Diego State Releases 2022 Schedule

San Diego State softball head coach Stacey Nuveman Deniz has announced a 52-game schedule for the 2022 season, highlighted by three home tournaments, including the 31st annual Campbell/Cartier Classic.

The Aztecs, who have won a league-best seven Mountain West titles, are scheduled to play 12 games against teams that made last year's NCAA tournament and five conference champions.

SDSU begins its season at home for the first time since 2007 when it plays host to the SDSU Season Kickoff from Feb. 10-13. San Diego State opens with Middle Tennessee on Thursday, followed by games against 2021 NCAA tournament teams UIC (Horizon League champion) and Stanford on Friday, UIC once again on Saturday and Cal Poly on Sunday.

The Aztecs continue their 11-game homestand to open the season on Feb. 16 vs. San Diego.

SDSU then plays host to the 31st annual Campbell/Cartier Classic from Feb. 17-20. San Diego State will meet CSUN on Thursday, Army West Point on Friday, Army West Point and Southern Utah on Saturday, and California Baptist on Sunday.

The Aztecs then head to the always competitive Mary Nutter Collegiate Classic from Feb 24-26, which will take place at Big League Dreams Park in the Palm Springs area in Cathedral City, California. SDSU is slated to play three teams that made the NCAA tournament a year ago, including Northwestern and Washington on Saturday, and Missouri on Sunday. San Diego State opens the weekend with Friday night games against Cal State Fullerton and UC Davis.

The Aztecs return to America's Finest City to host the San Diego Classic from March 3-6 along with USD and UC San Diego. SDSU will take on three conference champions and NCAA tournament qualifiers in Brigham Young (Thursday), Boston Univ. (Friday) and Long Beach State (Saturday), along with California (Friday), Yale (Saturday) and Stony Brook (Sunday).

San Diego State wraps up its regular-season tournament play from March 10-13 at the Torero Classic, hosted by San Diego. The Aztecs are scheduled for games against the Toreros on Thursday, Valparaiso and Weber State on Friday, Weber State again on Saturday and CSUN for a second time this season on Sunday.

SDSU kicks off Mountain West play at home against Colorado State on March 19-20 before traveling to Fresno State for a series from

San Diego State follows with a home series against Nevada from April 1-3 and then a road trip to UNLV from April 8-10.

Next up for the Aztecs is a weekend home series with Boise State from April 14-16 and its final non-conference game of the season on April 20 at UC San Diego.

SDSU finishes the MW regular season with a road series at San José State from April 29-May 1, a home series with Utah State from May 6-8 and a road series at New Mexico from May 12-14.

The NCAA Regional kicks off postseason play from May 19-22 at 16 campus sites.


