San Diego State vs. Ohio State Postgame Notes

Big Notes

- San Diego State improves to 4-0 on the season for the fifth time in the last 13 campaigns.
- San Diego State's win snaps a two-game slide in neutral site games and improves the Aztecs record in neutral site contests to 14-5 since the start of the 2019-20 season.
- In Maui Invitational play, San Diego State improves to 6-4 in its 10 games in the event.
- SDSU has won 150 of its 235 road/neutral site games (150-85) since the start of the 2009-10 season, which is the eighth best record in the nation in that time frame.
- San Diego State improves to 3-2 against Big Ten competition in neutral site games and has won its last two in the category (also: Nov. 29, 2019, 83-73 vs. Iowa in the championship game of the 2019 Continental Tires Las Vegas Invitational).
- San Diego State blocked (4) shots and moves to 35-3 since the start of the 2019-20 season in contests in which it has at least four blocks.
- San Diego State wins its 22nd straight game when scoring between 80-89 points.
- San Diego State moves to 77-4 since the start of the 2010-11 season in games in which it scores at least 80 points.
- San Diego State moves to 3-0 this season when leading with five minutes to play, is 113-8 in the Brian Dutcher era and has won 366 of its last 379 in the category.
- San Diego State improves to 22-3 in its last 25 games on Monday and has won eight straight on the day.
- San Diego State led at the half and moves to 107-13 in the Brian Dutcher era and 38-2 in the last 40 when leading after 20 minutes.
- San Diego State moves to 3-1 in its four quarterfinal games in the Maui Jim Maui Invitational.
- San Diego State outshot Ohio State from the floor and improves to 22-1 in its last 23 games and 104-7 in the Brian Dutcher era.

Series Notes

- San Diego State improves to 3-1 in the all-time series against Ohio State and has won the last three meetings, including the last two in the quarterfinal round of the Maui Invitational (also: 83-61 on Nov. 24, 2003).

Team Notes

- Nathan Mensah won the opening tip and sent it to Darrion Trammell.
- San Diego State missed its first eight shots and didn't score until an Adam Seiko jumper from the baseline with 15:31 to play in the first half. The Aztecs then hit seven of its next 11 to forge a 21-13 lead with 7:23 to play in the half and never trailed again.
- San Diego State is 63-15 in November since the beginning of the beginning of the 2010-11 campaign.
- In its three previous appearances in the Maui Invitational, San Diego State has finished second (2104), third (2003) & sixth (2018).
- Against the Big Ten, San Diego State climbs above the .500 mark with a 9-8. Since a 77-61 loss versus Michigan State on Dec. 29, 1984, SDSU record against Big Ten competition is now 6-5.
- SDSU outscored Ohio State:
 - 9-8 off turnovers
 - 28-26 in the paint
 - 14-10 on fast break attempts
 - 41-27 off the bench

Player Notes

Matt Bradley – 18 points, 6-of-11 FG, 4-of-6 3FG, 2-of-2 FT, 1 rebound, 1 assist

Scored in double figures for the first time this season and the 98th time in his career... Since the start of the 2021-22 season SDSU is 21-6 when he scores at least 10 points, 15-5 when he has at least 15 points and 12-3 when he totals 18 pr more points... When he hits four or more 3-pointers as an Aztec, SDSU is 6-1.

Lamont Butler – 15 points, 6-of-12 FG, 1-of-3 3FG, 2-of-2 FT, 3 assists, zero turnovers, 1 steal, 2 rebounds

Had his third double-digit scoring effort, a season-high 15 points, in four games this year and the 14th time in his Aztec career... Has totaled nine assists and zero turnovers in the last two games, the first time in his college career he has had back-to-back games without a turnover... For the season, four games, he has 19 assists and five turnovers (3.8:1 assist-to-turnover ratio)

Micah Parrish – 15 points, 6-of-8 FG, 3-of-5 3FG, 5 rebounds, 1 assist

Scored in double figures for the first time as an Aztec and 34th time of his college career... In games in which he has three or more made 3-pointers, his is 1-0 at San Diego State and 4-4 in his college career... He shoots 75.0 percent from the floor for the ninth time in his career and the third time against a team from the Big Ten... Pulled down at least five rebounds in a game for the 39th time in 63 career games and has done it in all four games as an Aztec.

Adam Seiko – 14 points, 5-of-5 FG, 2-of-3 3FG, 2-of-2 FT, 5 rebounds,

Scored in double figures for the first time this season and the 10th time in his career (9-1)... He has 27 career games with multiple 3-pointers and in those games SDSU is 23-4 and have won 16 of the last 17... His five rebounds are tied for the second most in a game for his career (career-high 7 at UNLV on Jan. 1, 2022) and SDSU is 6-0 when he grabs at least that many.

Nathan Mensah – 4 blocks, 5 rebounds

Had his second multi-block game this season and 26th in his last 40... In eight career games in which he has at least four blocks the Aztecs are 7-1,
