AZTEC HEADLINES

- San Diego State opens a two-game road trip on Wednesday, when it heads to the Central Valley to face Mountain West leader Fresno State. Tipoff is set for 7 p.m. PT, and a live audio feed featuring Chris Ello on play-by-play will be available on www.goaztecs.com.
- The Aztecs are coming off their most complete game of the year with a resounding 72-39 triumph over Air Force at home last Saturday.
- SDSU was led by junior Khristina Hunter, who logged her third collegiate double-double with a career-high tying 20 points on 9-of-18 shooting to go with a personal-best 17 rebounds. In addition, freshman Ariell Bostick posted a career-high 17 points off the bench, while Cierra Warren reached double figures with 11 points, all in the first half.
- In addition to points, the Aztecs limited the Falcons

to several opponent team lows for the year, including field goals (14), field-goal percentage (.269), assists (10), free throws (4) and steals (4).

■ Warren is second in the Mountain West with a .557 field-goal percentage (68-122) and ranks 13th with 13.1 points per game. The SDSU center owns two of the top single-game performances in the MW this season (14 FGs at Sac State and 9-10 FGs at UCSB) and has eclipsed the 20 point-barrier on three occasions this year.

■ As a team, SDSU tops the MW with a .426 field-goal percentage and ranks first in rebounding defense as well, allowing just 34.5 boards per game.

■ Elsewhere, the Aztecs rank among the league leaders for all games in rebounding margin (3rd - (+3.7)), scoring defense (5th - 66.9 ppg), blocked shots (5th - 3.1/gm) and steals (5th - 8.4/gm).

#AztecWBB Heads North to Face Fresno State on Wednesday

Fresh off a convincing victory over Air Force, San Diego State embarks on a two-game road trip this week, beginning with a key matchup at first-place Fresno State on Wednesday, Jan. 15.

Despite maintaining a 24-12 lead in the all-time series, the Aztecs dropped two of three during the 2012-13 campaign to the Bulldogs, who were making their Mountain West debut. The two sides emerged triumphant on each other's court in the regular season, with Fresno State capturing an 80-72 win at Viejas Arena, before SDSU turned the tables with a 74-49 conquest in Fresno. However, the Bulldogs put a damper on one of the most successful campaigns in Aztec program history with a 76-70 victory in the finals of the Mountain West Championship, which cost the Scarlet and Black a berth in the NCAA tournament.

Despite the allure of billing Wednesday's game as a title rematch, SDSU will likely have just three players from last year's squad available to play. Khristina Hunter and Desi Culberson combined for 12 points off the bench in the 2013 MW finale as sophomores, while then-junior Danesha Long also suited up as a reserve for that contest, but did not see action.

Scouting the Bulldogs

Fresno State (10-5, 4-0 MW) gained sole possession of first place in the conference race with a 60-50 triumph at home against Colorado State on Jan. 11, extending its winning streak to four games. Senior Taylor Thompson narrowly missed a double-double for the Bulldogs in that contest, posting game-highs of 19 points, nine rebounds and four assists, while sophomore Jacinta Vandenburg finished with 12 points and five boards.

Individually, Thompson leads Fresno State in both scoring (13.3 ppg) and assists (4.1/gm), while Vandenburg tops the squad in rebounds (6.7/gm).

For the season, Fresno State is shooting 39.8 percent from the field, including a league-best 34.5 percent clip from three-point territory, and 74.1 percent from the free-throw line, which ranks third in the MW.

The Bulldogs boast four players with 20 or more three-pointers made so far this year, including senior Bree Farley, who leads the conference with 43.8 percent shooting from beyond the arc (21-48), joining sophomore Moriah Faulk (25), Thompson (23) and junior Robin Draper (20).

Head coach Raegen Pebley is in her second season at Fresno State after spending nine years at the helm of the Utah State program. Her overall career record stands at 144-169. Pebley also played two seasons in the WNBA for the Cleveland Rockers and the Utah Starzz, following a stellar collegiate career at Colorado.

Stacie Terry has never faced Fresno State during her coaching career nor as a player at Texas-Arlington. However, the two coaches crossed paths in 2005, when Terry was an assistant at Illinois and Pebley was in charge at Utah State. In the opening round of the Coors Classic in Boulder, Colo., Terry and the Fighting Illini upended Pebley's Aggies, 62-43.

With a Victory...

An SDSU win over Fresno State on Wednesday will mean:

- The Aztecs collect their second straight victory at Save Mart Center.
- SDSU improves to 25-12 all-time against the Bulldogs, including a 9-7 mark in Fresno.
- The Aztecs win back-to-back games for the second time this year and hand Fresno State its first conference loss of the season.
- SDSU improves to 28-12 in January games since 2009.

Dissecting the Slow Start

The fact that San Diego State sits at 4-9 heading into the third week of January can be at least partially attributed to the following factors:

► **Three-Point Field Goals** - The Aztecs' opponents have drained a staggering 107 three-point field goals on the season for an average of 8.2 per game. Conversely, SDSU has connected on just 38 treys for the year and has combined for just 16 in its last six games. As a result, the opposition is outscoring the Scarlet and Black by over 15 points per game on triples alone. In addition, the Aztecs have allowed their opponents to shoot 37 percent from beyond the arc, which ranks near the bottom of 343 Division I teams entering the week.

► **Turnovers** - The Aztecs are committing nearly four turnovers more per game (19.8-16.2) than their foes this season, which ranks last in the MW. Last season, SDSU was just one of three teams in the league to finish with a positive turnover margin (+2.9), along with Fresno State and Colorado State. Opponents have capitalized on the Aztecs' miscues by maintaining a combined 281-199 advantage in points off turnovers.

However, SDSU has made progress in recent games, committing a combined 28 fewer miscues (35-63) in victories over Miami (OH), UC Riverside and Air Force.

► **Schedule** - The Aztecs have played one of the toughest schedules in the country so far this year, featuring a pair of games against AP Top 25 foes in No. 19 South Carolina and No. 23 Texas A&M. In addition, NC State has cracked the AP Top 25 for the past two weeks. Entering Wednesday's contest, the combined record of SDSU's first 13 opponents stands at 108-81 (.571).

► **Experience** - San Diego State's starting lineup against Air Force featured five players who have combined for just 47 starts in an Aztec uniform prior to Jan. 11. With that lack of experience, growing pains are certainly inevitable.

Despite the adversity, five of the Aztecs' nine losses have come by a mere 15 points. The youthful SDSU squad has displayed much resiliency during the early part of the season, overcoming a 14-point deficit on Dec. 28 against UC Riverside and nearly rallying from a pair of 19-point deficits at Sacramento State and USC. In fact, the Aztecs owned late leads at Sac State and against San Diego, only to cede go-ahead three-pointers by the opposition.

Cleaning Up the Glass

Over the first seven games, San Diego State got out-rebounded by an average margin of 15.6-9.9 on the offensive glass. As a result, the Aztecs' foes maintained a 110-55 advantage in second-chance points during that stretch. However, SDSU has gradually reversed that trend, out-rebounding their last six opponents on the offensive boards by a 111-63 margin and maintaining an 89-39 spread in second-chance points.

Spreading the Wealth

A total of nine Aztecs have scored in double digits at least twice this season, while five have accomplished the feat on three or more occasions. That is especially notable since SDSU has carried no more than 11 active players on its roster this year. In addition, the Aztecs have played five games this season in which four players scored in double figures, including three straight games against Miami (OH), UC Riverside and NC State. The last time SDSU had four players reach double figures in three consecutive outings occurred in 2009 vs. Pepperdine, Long Beach State and Loyola Marymount.

Nothin' Like Home Cookin'

Despite its 3-5 home record to start the season, SDSU has posted a 63-20 ledger on the Viejas Arena court since the beginning of the 2008-09 campaign and has captured 30 of its last 37 on The Mesa.

The Last Time Out - SDSU vs. Air Force

The San Diego State women's basketball team chose last Saturday's home game with Air Force to get well and did so in convincing fashion, defeating the Falcons by a 72-39 count in a Mountain West clash at Viejas Arena.

Junior Khristina Hunter recorded her third collegiate double-double, tying her career-high with 20 points to go with a personal-best 17 rebounds as the Aztecs (4-9, 1-2 MW) snapped a three-game losing streak.

Hunter shot 9-for-18 from the field and capped off her all-round effort with a career-high four assists, while freshman Ariell Bostick contributed a collegiate-best 17 points, including a pair of three-pointers, to go with a game-high four steals. In addition, senior Cierra Warren reached double figures for the ninth time this season after scoring 11 points, all in the first half.

With no player standing taller than 5-11, Air Force (1-13, 0-4 MW) was overpowered in the middle by SDSU, which maintained a 48-33 rebounding advantage and a hefty 40-10 margin on points in the paint. The Aztecs also committed a season-low 10 turnovers and led wire-to-wire for the first time this year. In addition, the Scarlet and Black benefited from a cold-shooting Falcon squad that posted a mere 27 percent field-goal percentage on 14-of-52 attempts from the floor.

Sophomore Deajanae Scurry drained her first collegiate triple to punctuate a 16-4 run during the first 4:29 of the game, and SDSU never looked back. Air Force managed to trim the deficit to eight on two occasions, including a 19-11 spread following a pair of Lindsay Lewis free throws with just under 12 minutes to go in the period. The Falcons could draw no closer, however, as the Aztecs uncorked a 15-3 run over the ensuing three-and-a-half minutes to build a comfortable 34-14 cushion by the 9:22 mark.

Following a three-pointer by Air Force's Mary Cavanaugh with 3:48 remaining, SDSU scored the final eight points of the half, including back-to-back layups by Hunter and junior Desi Culberson, to give the contest its 46-24 score at intermission.

The Aztecs connected on 50 percent of its shots from the floor in the frame (20-40) and owned a sizeable 13-3 advantage on the offensive glass to help key its big lead.

Following the break, SDSU maintained its defensive intensity, limiting the Falcons to just 15 points, an opponent-low for a half this season, on 6-of-26 shooting (23 percent). The Aztecs eventually increased their lead to 30 as Hunter scored her final points of the afternoon on a jumper with 4:50 left to give the hosts an insurmountable 67-37 advantage.

Air Force was led by Camille Thompson, who scored 12 points, while Cavanaugh and Cherae Medina (four assists) finished with eight apiece in the loss.

Good Will Hunter

Junior Khristina Hunter has seen her role increase significantly this season with starting assignments in the last 11 games. The Fairfield, Calif., native has been averaging 12.8 points, 8.5 rebounds and 1.8 steals in her last six outings, highlighted by her third career double-double vs. Air Force on Jan. 11, when she scored a career-high tying 20 points to go with a collegiate-best 17 rebounds. The feat was even more remarkable when one considers that she had 15 points and 13 boards by halftime.

In addition, Hunter posted a personal-high nine field goals and four assists against the Falcons and came up with a pair of steals.

Warren Tabbed MW Player of the Week

Senior Cierra Warren (Rancho Cucamonga, Calif.) was named the Mountain West Women's Basketball Player of the Week on Dec. 2 for her dominating performance in the Aztecs' 71-67 victory at UC Santa Barbara.

With her award, the SDSU center garnered her first career weekly conference accolade and the first for an Aztec player this season.

Against UCSB on Nov. 30, Warren scored a team-high 21 points on 9-of-10 (.900) shooting from the floor and a 2-for-2 effort at the free-throw line. She also added one assist, one block and a steal to help SDSU notch its first win of the season.

In the second half, Warren tallied 11 straight points, including the first three-point basket of her career, during a 22-9 run that overturned a 42-33 deficit and catapulted SDSU into the lead for good at 55-51. She also secured the game-clinching rebound after the Gauchos missed a potential game-tying three-pointer with nine seconds remaining in the contest.

Scorching the Nets

San Diego State has finished with a .600 or better field-goal percentage in two games already this season (.623 - at Sacramento State and .652 - at UCSB) after recording just two overall between 2000 and 2013. The two percentages mark the top team performances in the Mountain West so far this year.

#AztecWBB Inks Pair to NLI's

San Diego State head coach Stacie Terry inked her first pair of recruits on Nov. 15, with the signing of Cheyenne Greenhouse (Riverside, Calif.) and Lexy Thorderson (Castle Rock, Colo.) to National Letters of Intent. The two high school seniors are set to join the Aztecs for the 2014-15 season.

Greenhouse signs with SDSU out of Canyon Springs High School, where she captured CIF Division 1A co-player of the year honors as a junior last season after leading the Cougars to the Southern Section championship and a berth in the semifinals of the CIF regional tournament.

A 5-11 guard, Greenhouse averaged 18.4 points, 5.5 rebounds, 2.4 assists and 2.1 steals during the 2012-13 campaign, earning first-team all-state CIF Division 1A recognition while landing a spot on MaxPreps all-state first team.

"Cheyenne is going to be very important to us because she has can play multiple positions," Terry said. She will add tremendous athleticism to our program with her great leaping ability. Cheyenne is also a very intelligent player and her basketball IQ is off the charts."

Greenhouse makes her signing official as a three-star recruit, according to ESPN HoopGurlz. A three-time all-Inland Valley League selection for head coach

Gail Hale at Canyon Springs, Greenhouse also brings three years of club experience with her to The Mesa, having played for Cal Swish in 2011, followed by a two-year stint with the West Coast Premier program. She intends to study biology or pre-medicine at San Diego State.

Thorderson, meanwhile, garnered first-team all-Continental Leagues accolades as a junior last year at Rock Canyon High School after averaging a team-best 16.1 points to go along with 5.7 rebounds, 2.6 assists and 1.3 steals. Under the tutelage of head coach Robbie Ballard, the 6-0 guard/forward received Colorado 5A honorable mention all-state distinction on two occasions in 2011 and 2013.

In a game against eventual state champion Regis Jesuit last February, Thorderson scored 32 points to earn player of the game honors by MaxPreps. Earlier in the season, she also gained recognition as the Denver Post's female student-athlete of the week.

"Lexy's addition will enable us to extend our offense because she is deadly from three-point range," Terry said. "Her ability to knock down that jumper will also help open up the game for our post players."

Thorderson, who also competed at the USA Basketball U16 national team trials in 2011, has a basketball pedigree in her family. Her father Eric Thorderson played collegiately at Wayne State (Mich.) from 1980-85, while two of her sisters, Ali and Abby, earned varsity letters at Weber State. She is undecided on a major at San Diego State, but is considering a career in physical therapy and physical education.

Noting the Newcomers

Of the 12 student-athletes on the current roster, five players will be wearing an Aztec uniform for the first time this season. Cierra Warren practiced with the squad last year but did not compete after transferring from Louisville, while Deidra Smith utilized her redshirt campaign as well, following her transfer from Boston College. In addition, sophomore Deajanae Scurry missed the latter half of the 2012-13 campaign to con-

centrate on academics.

With San Diego State losing nearly 67 percent of its scoring offense from a year ago, three true freshmen look to gain significant experience this season. Guard Ariell Bostick (Oakland, Calif.) led Bishop O'Dowd High School to a pair of CIF titles, while forward Alyssa Lawrence (New Rochelle, N.Y.) was an all-league and all-section honoree during her prep career. Not to be outdone, Chloe Johnson (Phoenix, Ariz.), who was named the Mountain West preseason freshman of the year, brings strong credentials with her to The Mesa after earning all-state honors for prep powerhouse St. Mary's High, which finished with a No. 1 national ranking in 2011-12.

Meet the New Staff

The talent at Viejas Arena is not just limited to the playing court as head coach Stacie Terry has assembled a prolific staff in her first season on The Mesa. Assistant coaches Jesse Clark, Aisha Veasley and Ciara Carl bring a vast array of experience with them to "America's Finest City", while Mike Bynum returns for his fourth season as the Aztecs' director of player development.

A native of Tacoma, Wash., Clark spent seven years as an assistant at Saint Mary's College, where he helped the Gaels to four straight WNIT berths, including a quarterfinal appearance in 2012-13. He also had stints at Stanford, San Francisco, CSU Bakersfield and Pacific Union.

Veasley, who enjoyed a successful playing career at UCLA, returns to her Southern California roots after two productive stops as an assistant at Tulsa and Colorado. While at CU, Veasley played a pivotal role as the team's recruiting coordinator, helping to land three top-40 classes.

Carl also has ties to the area, having graduated from Point Loma Nazarene and coaching with San Diego club teams. Most recently, she served an assistant at Metro State in Denver, Colo., following a two-year run at Division II power Cal Poly Pomona.

Aztecs Garner MW Preseason Honors

San Diego State received three preseason Mountain West individual honors on Oct. 15, as forward Erimma Amariqwa was named to the all-conference team, center Cierra Warren was selected newcomer of the year, while guard Chloe Johnson was tabbed the MW preseason freshman of the year.

As a team, the Aztecs were picked to finish third in the MW preseason poll, which was conducted in a combined panel of the league's 11 head coaches and select conference media members. SDSU collected 196 points and picked up two first-place votes, trailing second-place Wyoming, which received 212 points and four first-place votes, while preseason favorite Fresno State garnered 238 points and 17 first-place votes.

Basketball Performance Center On the Docket

San Diego State Director of Athletics Jim Sterk announced on Nov. 12 that a proposed 23,500-square-foot basketball performance center is under design, with a plan to break ground on the project in late spring 2014.

The \$14.5 million facility, which will be located just south of the Fowler Athletics Center and east of the football practice fields, will include two full-length courts, eight baskets, locker rooms, film rooms, team lounges, athletic training room and coaches locker rooms to help support the Aztec men's and women's championship basketball programs.

Although a majority of the funds have been pledged, fundraising continues for the project which is tentatively scheduled to be completed in 2015.

"This is an exciting day to be able to announce this project is moving forward," Sterk said. "It is a project that will greatly benefit our already successful men's and women's basketball programs. It is also an important day because we

are going public with our drive to raise funds for the project and hope that the community that has enjoyed San Diego State basketball will get behind this project."

"The basketball performance center is more than just a building, it is our classroom," SDSU women's basketball head coach Stacie Terry said. "The facility will provide an opportunity for our student-athletes to enhance their individual games, which will in turn benefit our program. It also keeps San Diego State competing at the highest level not only in basketball, but in recruiting as well."

Two For The Show

Former SDSU All-Americans Courtney Clements and Chelsea Hopkins both earned roster spots with the WNBA this past season after completing their illustrious careers for the Scarlet and Black following the 2012-13 campaign. Clements joined the Atlanta Dream as a free-agent rookie last May, while Hopkins was signed by the San Antonio Silver Stars in September.

Clements appeared in 30 games for Atlanta in 2013, becoming the first former Aztec to compete for a WNBA title after the Dream advanced to finals against the eventual champion Minnesota Lynx. The Long Beach native totaled 59 points (2.2/gm) on the year to go with 26 rebounds, eight assists and five steals. Against the Seattle Storm on July 14, Clements recorded a season-best 12 points before logging season highs of five rebounds and 29 minutes played vs. San Antonio on Sept. 15.

Hopkins, meanwhile, averaged 14.3 minutes in three games during a late-season tour of duty with the Silver Stars, finishing with six points, six rebounds and five assists.

What's New in the Mountain West

With the addition of newcomers San José State and Utah State, the Mountain West will have a different look for the third year in a row. Following the departures of Brigham Young and Utah in 2011, the league added Boise State, while Fresno State and Nevada joined the circuit last year after the defection of TCU. The latest realignment means the Aztecs will now have 18 league games this season instead of 16, with the Scarlet and Black facing Wyoming (home) and Nevada (road) just once, while completing a home-and-home slate with the rest of the conference.

The Mountain West Championship, scheduled for March 10-15, 2014, has also been revamped to include three games with the six lowest-seeded teams during the first round. In addition, the four surviving squads from the quarterfinals will have two days to prepare for the semifinal round.

SDSU alumus Chris Ello will handle the play-by-play duties both at home and on the road for the seventh straight season.

In addition, all Aztec home contests during the 2013-14 regular season will feature a live video stream via the Mountain West Network to supplement the audio call from Viejas Arena.

After Wednesday game, San Diego State will head to the Silver State for a clash with UNLV on Saturday, Jan. 18, beginning at 7 p.m. PT.

Stacie Terry was named the eighth head coach in the history of the San Diego State women's basketball program on May 15, 2013. A native of San Diego, Terry gained a wealth of experience as an assistant coach at the Division I level over the past 14 years, including the last five under head coach Nikki Caldwell, who transformed UCLA into a powerhouse before restoring LSU to national prominence.

During Terry's two seasons at LSU, the Lady Tigers compiled a 45-23 overall record and earned two NCAA tournament bids, including a Sweet 16 appearance during the 2012-13 campaign. This past season, the Lady Tigers also posted six victories against ranked opponents and finished with their second-highest scoring average (69.0) in the last seven years. Under Terry's guidance, forward LaShondra Barrett garnered first-team all-Southeastern Conference accolades and received honorable mention All-America distinction in 2012 before becoming a first-round draft choice of the WNBA's Washington Mystics.

"I am honored and humbled to be the next head coach at San Diego State University," Terry said. "I want to thank Jim (Serk) and his staff for this amazing opportunity. This is such a special place for me. Not only is this my dream job, but it is home. SDSU is a first class university that has all the resources in place to be successful. I am so eager to get started and confident that we can continue the winning tradition that Aztec supporters have become accustomed to both on and off the court."

Prior to her arrival at LSU, Terry served as an assistant under Caldwell at UCLA from 2008-11, helping the Bruins gain national acclaim with a pair of NCAA tournament appearances. During Terry's tenure, UCLA posted 72 overall victories, as the 2010-11 squad finished with a 28-5 record, setting a school record for fewest losses in a single season to go with a No. 7 national ranking. In addition, the Bruins signed the fourth-ranked recruiting class that season, according to ESPN HoopGurlz, while Terry helped mentor first-team all-Pac-10 performers in Doreena Campbell, Darxia Morris and Jasmine Dixon, a 2012 honorable mention AP All-America selection, as well as all-conference freshman honorees Atonye Nyin-gifa and Markel Walker.

Terry spent the 2007-08 campaign at Southern Mississippi, as the Golden Eagles posted a 21-14 record and earned a postseason berth in the Women's National Invitation Tournament (WNIT). While at Southern Miss, Terry spearheaded the development and coordination of the Lady Eagle recruiting campaign. Her responsibilities also included working with the perimeter players, scouting opponents and film breakdown, as well as coordinating all of the team's community service events.

Terry also coached for three seasons from 2004-07 as an assistant under Hall of Fame head coach Theresa Grentz at Illinois, where the Fighting Illini had three straight recruiting classes ranked among the top 25 in

the nation, according to Blue Star Basketball, and made three consecutive trips to the WNIT. Her primary duties included defensive instruction and working with the perimeter players.

In addition, Terry coached at Dayton during the 2003-04 season following a three-year stint at Louisville from 2000-03. With the Cardinals, Terry's responsibilities encompassed recruiting, scouting, player development, summer camps and serving as a liaison for the program's community service outreach. Louisville captured the Conference USA regular-season title and earned a trip to the NCAA tournament in 2001 before making a WNIT appearance in 2002. She also assisted in signing the nation's 21st-ranked recruiting class in 2002-03, according to All-Star Girls Report. Terry recruited and coached all-Conference USA honoree Lori Nero, a draft choice of the WNBA's Houston Comets, as well as Sara Nord, who finished her collegiate career as the Cardinals' all-time assist leader and ranks among the top 15 scorers in school history.

Terry enjoyed a successful collegiate playing career at Texas-Arlington, winning four varsity letters from 1994-98 under head coach Mike Dean. She earned first-team all-Southland Conference honors after leading the Mavericks in scoring with 17.4 points per game as a senior in 1997-98. Terry scored 1,169 points during her career at UTA and still ranks among the school's top 10 in three-point field goals made (third), assists (sixth), steals (seventh) and free-throw percentage (10th). She is just one of 17 players in Maverick history to surpass the 1,000-point plateau, while her .335 career three-point field-goal percentage is also a school and Southland Conference career record.

Terry played one season of professional basketball in Warsaw, Poland, averaging 12.0 points and 6.0 assists with the Polonia Phoenix, before returning to Texas-Arlington to begin her coaching career as a graduate assistant in 1999.

Terry, who graduated from El Capitan High, stills holds the Vaqueros' career scoring record and was inducted into the school's athletic hall of fame in 2008.
