AZTECS VISIT NEVADA IN LONE MATCH THIS WEEK

- ◆ San Diego State will be back on the road this week for one Mountain West Conference match.
- ◆ On Thursday, Nov. 14, the Aztecs will take on league foe Nevada at 7:00 p.m. (PT) in the Wolf Pack's Virginia Street Gym.
- ◆ That match will have live video streaming in the Mountain Digital Network.

SERIES RECORDS

- ◆ San Diego State all-time record vs. Nevada is 3-1 with the teams having met on only four previous occasions. The Aztecs prevailed earlier this year with a three-set win over the Wolf Pack on Aztec Court in late September.
- ◆ Last season the Aztecs finished the regular season with a three-set win over the Wolf Pack after Nevada had defeated the Aztecs in five sets in Reno earlier in the season to record its lone Mountain West win of the year.
- ◆ The Aztecs' other victory in the series came in three sets during the 2011 Aztec Invitational in San Diego.

HEAD COACH DEITRE COLLINS-PARKER

- ◆ San Diego State head coach Deitre Collins-Parker is in her fifth season with the Aztecs after being named the fourth head coach in program history prior to the 2009 campaign. Her four-year record at SDSU is 84-61 (.579).
- ◆ She was named the 2012 Mountain West Coach of the Year after leading the Aztecs to a 23-8 overall record and their first conference title since 1995.
- ◆ She previously served as head coach at UNLV for eight seasons (1996-2003) and at Cornell for five years (2004-2008). Her 17-plus year career record stands at 246-252 (.494).
- ◆ A three-time All-American at the University of Hawai'i, she led the Rainbow Wahine to consecutive national titles (1983-84) and was named the national player of the year twice.
- ◆ She was a member of the U.S. Olympic Team and competed at the Goodwill Games and Pan Am Games prior to playing professionally in Europe for four years.
- ◆ She is one of six players named to the NCAA Division I Women's Volleyball 25th Anniversary Team in October 2005 and was inducted into the AVCA Hall of Fame in the fall of 2008.

SCOUTING THE OPPOSITION

- ◆ Nevada enters the week with a record of 2-24 overall and 0-14 in the Mountain West. The Wolf Pack has lost its last 17 straight matches and has gone seven in a row without winning a set. Nevada is led by Tessa Lea'ea (2.80 kills per set, 1.11 blocks per set) and Sam Willoughby (2.43 kps, 0.61 bps). Willoughby is from Jamul, Calif., and attended Steele Canyon High School.

SHELTON HEATS UP

- ◆ Senior outside hitter Raegan Shelton has been in double figures in kills in five of the past six matches and is averaging 3.74 kills per set over that span.
- ◆ She led all players with 16 kills in Monday's (Nov. 11) three-set win over UNLV.
- ◆ Shelton made her return from a prolonged spell on the sidelines due to injury when she appeared in the final set against Wyoming on Oct. 17, registering a kill and three digs.
- ◆ She made her full return as a starter in the ensuing contest vs. Colorado State (Oct. 19). In that match she led the Aztecs with 11 kills and also had a block and three digs.
- ◆ A preseason all-conference selection, Shelton had been out since suffering a broken finger during the NAU Fiesta Bowl Tournament (Sept. 6-7).

HARRIS ON THE ATTACK

- ◆ Middle blocker Emily Harris tops the team in hitting percentage with a mark of .358.
- ◆ She recorded a season-high .667 attack percentage in the win over Air Force on Oct. 31 while leading all players with 11 kills in that match.
- ◆ Her .339 career hitting percentage ranks fourth on the SDSU career list and 10th in the Mountain West record book heading into this week's match.
- ◆ She is leads the team in blocking with a mark of 1.11 blocks per set.
- ◆ She is 16 block assists shy of entering the SDSU career top 10 in that category despite being in only her third season as an Aztec.
- ◆ Harris' eight block assists in the win over Fresno State (Oct. 3) was her season high.

FOUCH SETTING IT UP

- ◆ Senior setter Johnna Fouch recorded a double-double in the win over UNLV on Nov. 11 (28 assist-15 digs), to give her 10 on the season.
- ◆ Fouch tied her career best with three block assists in the win over Air Force on Oct. 31.
- ◆ During the NAU Fiesta Bowl Classic the weekend of Sept. 6-7, her 54 assists vs. Idaho established a tournament record for assists in a three-set match.
- ◆ The senior from Riverside, Calif., recorded a career high eight kills on 12 attempts with no errors for a .667 hitting percentage in the match vs. Texas-San Antonio (Aug. 31).
- ◆ She also had three service aces and a pair of block assists vs. the Roadrunners to establish a career best with 12.0 points in the contest.

SANDBERG COMING ON

- ◆ Kaja Sandberg has registered six kills in each of SDSU's past three matches.
- ◆ She had a .600 hitting percentage in the contest at Fresno State (Nov. 9) with six kills and no errors on 10 attacks.
- ◆ She had eight total blocks (2 solo, 6 assists) in the win over Air Force on Oct. 31, the third time this season she has tied her personal best in that category.
- ◆ She recorded a career-high eight block assists for the second time in three matches when she did so vs. Colorado State on Oct. 19.
- ◆ Sandberg is second on the team in blocking this season with a mark of 1.08 bps.
- ◆ She had a number of career-bests during on Oct. 12 at Air Force.
- ◆ Those highs included kills (9), attempts (20), service aces (2), block assists (8) and total blocks (8) and points (15.0).

NASH LEADS THE OFFENSE

- ◆ Senior Summer Nash matched her career high with 21 kills in the match at San Jose State on Nov. 7.
- ◆ She also had 21 kills this season in contests vs. Texas-San Antonio (Aug. 31) and Northeastern (Sept. 14).
- ◆ After appearing in the two road matches last week (at San Jose State and At Fresno State), she missed Monday's (Nov. 11) contest due to injury.
- ◆ She set a career-high with a .706 hitting percentage in the win at Boise State (Oct. 26) with 12 kills and no errors on 17 attempts.
- ◆ She leads the team in kills at 3.52 per set and in points at 3.98 per set.

- ◆ She has recorded three double doubles this season (kills-digs).
- ◆ Her 16 digs vs. Texas-San Antonio on Aug. 31 was her career high as an Aztec.

RING DEBUTS AT LIBERO

- ◆ Senior defensive specialist Christie Ring, in her second start at the libero position, turned in a career-high 21 kills in the match at San Jose State on Nov. 7.
- ◆ She also set a career best with six assists in the win over UNLV this past Monday (Nov. 11)
- ◆ She had made her first start at the libero position on Nov. 2 vs. New Mexico and responded with 12 digs.
- ◆ Over San Diego State's last four contests Ring is averaging 4.07 assists per set.

LITTLE SEES MORE TIME

- ◆ Freshman Baylee Little set her SDSU personal high with a .500 hitting percentage in the win over New Mexico on Nov. 2 as she notched seven kills on 12 attempts with one error.
- ◆ She also tied her personal best with three digs in that contest.
- ◆ She set personal highs in every other category during the Aztecs' road trip to New Mexico and Air Force (Oct. 10-12).
- ◆ At New Mexico she set career bests in kills (16) attempts (26), assists (2) and points (16.5).
- ◆ She also tied her highs in service aces (1), digs (3) and solo blocks (1).
- ◆ At Air Force she had career highs in block assists (5) and total blocks (5).

RICIGLIANO DIGS IT

- ◆ Justin Ricigliano has averaged 2.39 digs per set during the Aztecs' past four matches.
- ◆ Her 14 digs at Utah State on Oct. 24 was her sixth double figure effort in that category this season.
- ◆ Making her first start at the libero position, she recorded a career-high 24 digs in the four-set win at Air Force on Oct. 12.
- ◆ Her previous personal best of 13 digs was set earlier this season in a five-set match at Louisiana State on Aug. 31.
- ◆ Ricigliano also turned in a career-high four assists in the win at Air Force.

WABER SOLID UP FRONT

- ◆ Michelle Waber had seen limited action in the previous matches prior to recording 12 kills in the three-set victory over UNLV on Monday (Nov. 11).
- ◆ She had 10 kills over the three sets at Utah State (Oct. 24), reaching double figures in that category for the third time in four matches.
- ◆ In the absence of Summer Nash due to injury (Oct. 10-12), Waber led the Aztecs with 16 kills in each match that week (at New Mexico and at Air Force).
- ◆ She also had a season-high eight digs at UNM and added eight more at Air Force for a weekly average of 1.67 per set, almost double her season mark.

FOUCH MOVING UP THE CHARTS

- ◆ Setter Johnna Fouch's three-plus year mark of 4,379 assists places her third on the SDSU career list.
- ◆ The top spot is held Andrea Clark (1994-97) with 4,916.
- ◆ Fouch ranks seventh on the Mountain West career assist list and needs 90 assists to move into the No. 6 spot.
- ◆ Her 43 career double-doubles is the most among active players in the Mountain West and is fourth on the all-time conference list.

AMONG THE LEAGUE LEADERS

- ◆ Six Aztecs ranks among the top 10 in the Mountain West overall stats this week in various categories.
- ◆ Summer Nash ranks fourth in both points (3.98 per set) and kills (3.52 per set).
- ◆ Emily Harris is fifth in hitting percentage at .358 and ninth in blocking at 1.11 per set.
- ◆ Setter Johnna Fouch stands seventh in assist average at 9.30 per set.
- ◆ Libero Courtney Vaccarello ranks sixth in digs with an average of 3.66 per set.
- ◆ Michelle Waber is eighth in kill average at 3.07 per set.
- ◆ Raegan Shelton ranks seventh in kills (3.28 per set) and ninth in points at 3.48 per set.

ALL-TOURNEY AZTECS

- ◆ Summer Nash, Emily Harris and Michelle Waber earned all-tournament honors at the Holiday Inn Mission Valley Aztec Invitational (Sept. 13-14).
- ◆ Nash, who was also named the tourney MVP, averaged 3.83 kills and 1.67 digs per set over SDSU's three matches. Her kill average and mark of 4.33 points per set led all players.
- ◆ Harris, meanwhile, led all tourney players with an average of 1.42 blocks per set and also recorded 2.83 digs per set while hitting at a .429 clip.
- ◆ Waber had marks 3.42 kills and .50 blocks per set along with a .316 hitting percentage.

VACCARELLO ALL-TOURNEY AT NAU

- ◆ Libero Courtney Vaccarello was named to the all-tournament team at last weekend's Fiesta Bowl Tournament at Northern Arizona.
- ◆ The senior from San Jose, Calif., averaged 4.36 digs per set and also contributed eight assists and a service ace over the Aztecs' three matches.

ALL-TOURNEY AT LSU

- ◆ Three Aztecs were named to the all-tournament team at Tiger Classic at LSU during the weekend of Aug. 30-31. That trio included setter Johnna Fouch along with outside hitters Summer Nash and Raegan Shelton.
- ◆ Fouch averaged 11.21 assists and 2.64 digs per set over her team's three matches and also hit .409 with 11 kills.
- ◆ Nash ended the weekend with marks of 3.83 kills and 2.00 digs per set and led the Aztecs with five service aces while Shelton averaged 3.23 kills per set.

PRESEASON PROGNOSTICATIONS

- ◆ The Mountain West coaches' poll has predicted the Aztecs to finish first in the 11-team league. ◆ In the 14 years of the MW's existence, SDSU has finished first (2012), second (2002, 2011), fourth (2000, 2001, 2003), fifth (2005), sixth (1999, 2004, 2006, 2009, 2010), seventh (2008) and eighth (2007) in the final league standings.

- ◆ San Diego State leads the Mountain West in assists at 13.44 overall and in league matches only at 13.56 per set.
- ◆ As a team, SDSU ranks 17th in the nation in assists (13.44 per set) and 21st in kills (14.26 per set).
- ◆ The Aztecs' longest win streak this season has been three matches (twice) while the longest losing streak has also been three contests (on two occasions).
- ◆ SDSU is 22-3 on its home court over the past two seasons.
- ◆ Redshirt freshman Ellen Novotny recorded her first kills as an Aztec with a pair in the win over Air Force on Oct. 31.
- ◆ Halle Aiken had career highs of 10 kills, 12.0 points and a .500 hitting percentage in the match at Air Force on Oct. 12.
- ◆ Setter Chloe Mathis notched her first double-double of the season with 22 assists and 10 digs against Colorado State last Saturday (Oct. 19).
- ◆ Three players have started all 25 matches for the Aztecs this fall: Johnna Fouch, Emily Harris and Chaiymin Steel.
