HEAD COACH - MARK FEW











NOTES

Gonzaga University head coach Mark Few has established himself as one of the most successful coaches in NCAA Division I basketball annals in his 24 seasons at the helm, and in the process has made Bulldog basketball a household name across the country. He served as an assistant coach at GU for 10 seasons prior to take the reins of the program. Few has put together one of the most dominating runs in NCAA history, especially in the West Coast Conference. The Zags have won or shared 22 regular season league titles in his 24 seasons (all but the 1999-2000 and 2011-12 season) and taken home the conference tournament championship 19 times. The Bulldogs won or shared 11 straight West Coast Conference regular-season titles from 2000-11 and from 2012-23, which are the third-best streaks all-time in the NCAA Division I ranks behind UCLA's 13 Pac-10 Conference titles from 1967-79 and Kansas's 14 Big 12 Conference titles from 2005-18. Few led Gonzaga to the national championship game in the program's first-ever Final Four in 2017, and again in the second Final Four in 2021. Under Few, GU has appeared in five Elite Eight appearances (2015, 2017, 2019, 2021 and 2023) and 12 Sweet 16 appearances (2000, '01, '06, '09, '15, '16, '17, '18, '19, '21, '22, '23). He has coached 21 All-Americans, nine Academic All-Americans, 98 all-conference selections, 17 WCC Players of the Year, 10 league newcomers of the year and nine league defenders of the year. Few has also cultivated NBA talent, including current NBA players in Domantas Sabonis, Kelly Olynyk, Zach Collins, Rui Hachimura, Brandon Clarke, Jalen Suggs, Corey Kispert, Chet Holmgren, Andrew Nembhard, Julian Strawther and Filip Petrusev. He also helped recruit and develop Dan Dickau, Richie Frahm, Adam Morrison, Jeremy Pargo, Elias Harris, Austin Daye, Rob Sacre, Ronny Turiaf, Kevin Pangos, Killian Tillie and Joel Ayayi, all NBA players. Morrison was the highest-drafted player in GU history when he was taken No. 3 overall by the Charlotte Bobcats in 2006, but Holmgren was taken second overall by the Oklahoma City Thunder in the 2022 draft.

Entering the 2023-24 Season, Few:

- Is the winningest active coach by percentage at .836 (688-135)
- Ranks second in winning percentage after 21 seasons at .828 (599-124), second after 22 seasons at .834 (630-125) and second after 23 seasons at .836 (657-129).
- Is in the Top 15 among active Division I coaches for most 20-win seasons with 24, never having won less than 20 games in a season ... Is first for most consecutive 20-win seasons for active coaches with 24

In December 2021, Few was named as an assistant coach for the USA men's national team. The coaching staff for the 2022-24 USA Basketball Men's National Team was announced when USA Basketball Men's National Team managing director Grant Hill officially named eight-time NBA championship Golden State Warriors head coach Steve Kerr to lead the USA Men's National Team. Additionally, Few, Miami Heat head mentor Erik Spoelstra and Los Angeles Clippers head coach Tyron Lue will complete the 2022-24 USA National Team coaching staff as assistant coaches. As an assistant coach, Few will help lead the USA National Team in 2022-24, which will include all USA Men's National Team training camps, the 2023 FIBA World Cup that was held in the Philippines, Japan, and Indonesia, and the 2024 Summer Olympic Games that are scheduled for July 26-Aug. 11 in Paris, France. Few was an assistant coach to the Team USA Select Team at the USA Basketball Men's National Team Training Camp in Las Vegas in 2021. Few served as an assistant coach with the 2019 Select Team and was one of nine assistants at the national team's 2018 minicamp in Las Vegas. He was the head coach for the United States team that took third place at the 2015 Pan American Games, and he was an assistant coach when the U.S. won a gold medal at the 2012 FIBA Americas U18 Tournament.

For all that Few has accomplished on the court, his achievements off of it are equally impressive. In 2002, Mark and his wife Marcy initiated the Spokane branch of Coaches vs Cancer. The Few's annual event would become the largest Coaches vs Cancer fundraiser across the country. Quietly and without fanfare, Few has created a culture of giving at Gonzaga. In 2007, Gonzaga began hosting the Ronald McDonald House Charities Classic. For six seasons, these annual games helped raise over \$750,000 for Spokane's Ronald McDonald House. Building on their success with Coaches vs Cancer, the Fews and others in the Spokane region launched the Community Cancer Fund in 2014 to keep more money in the local market while devoting more resources to cancer patients, their families and the local organizations that serve them. In the last six years, the Community Cancer Fund has raised over 17 million dollars bringing the total raised over 18 years between the organizations to well over 25 million dollars. Among the highlights, the charity established a 3-million-dollar endowment to fund Camp Good Times, a week-long summer camp for kids with cancer.

And this year, the Community Cancer Fund worked to increase lodging options for cancer patients and their families traveling to the region for treatment, which included the completion and opening of a 5-million-dollar Hospitality Center at Kootenai Health and a campus expansion of Spokane's Ronald McDonald House.

ABOUT THE AZTECS

- San Diego State enters the matchup on a three-game win streak, most recently beating Stanford in San Diego on Dec. 21, 74-60.
- Lamont Butler led SDSU with 18 points, while Jaedon LeDee and Micah Parrish added 16 and 10 in the win over Stanford.
- LeDee averages a team-high 21.6 points and 9.4 rebounds per game. He leads the Mountain West Conference in both of those stat categories. He is shooting 57.2 percent from the field.
- Reese Waters chips in 13.7 points per outing, and Parrish is at 10.8 points per game.
- Butler dishes out a team-best 3.67 assists per game.

SERIES INFO

- This will be the fifth all-time meeting between GU and San Diego State, with both programs winning twice in the series.
- It's the first of a home and home series with the Zags making the trip to Viejas Arena next year.
- The Aztecs held off GU in the last meeting, 72-70, at Viejas Arena on Dec. 22, 2017.
- Gonzaga won the first meeting, 72-69, in the 1959 City of Roses Tournament in Portland. The Aztecs won the second matchup, 79-76, on Nov. 16, 2010, during the third annual ESPN Tip-Off Marathon. In the second game of the 2016-17 season, the Bulldogs cruised to a 69-48 win in Spokane during ESPN's Tip-Off Marathon.

UP NEXT

- Gonzaga opens West Coast Conference play against Pepperdine in the Community Cancer Fund Classic in the Spokane Arena Jan. 4 at 6 p.m.
- The Zags open conference play against the Waves for the second straight season.
- Last season, No.10 Gonzaga eased to a 111-88 win over Pepperdine in Spokane. Anton Watson scored 11, while Ben Gregg chipped in 10.
- The Bulldogs have won 27 straight West Coast Conference openers, dating back to a 72-61 loss at Santa Clara in 1996. Gonzaga has won all 24 WCC openers under Mark Few.
- It will be the 96th all-time meeting between Gonzaga and Pepperdine. The Zags have a 65-31 advantage in the series.
- GU has won 45 straight versus the Waves, with the last Pepperdine victory in the series coming on Jan. 18, 2002, 88-79, in Malibu.

- Gonzaga won the first-ever meeting, 93-70, in the Knights of Columbus Tournament in Portland, on Dec. 11, 1964.

HUFF NAMED WCC FRESHMAN OF THE WEEK

- Braden Huff was named the Credit Union 1 West Coast Conference Freshman of the Week.
- During Gonzaga's 100-76 win over Jackson State, Huff just missed a double-double with 17 points and

nine rebounds in 23 minutes of action off the bench. He also added an assist, a steal and two blocks. Huff connected on seven of nine field goal attempts.

 This is the second time this season that Huff has won CU1 Conference Freshman of the Week (Dec. 4), and it is the Bulldogs' fourth overall Conference weekly accolade this season.

BACK TO THE BAHAMAS

ANOTHER BIG NIGHT VERSUS EOU

- After setting the margin of victory record against Eastern Oregon last season in a 120-42 win, Gonzaga defeated the Mountaineers 123-57 this season.
- The Zags a new program record with 52 made field goals in the victory.
- Graham Ike (25), Braden Huff (23), and Anton Watson (20) all scored 20 points, while all playing less than 20 minutes. Ike also grabbed 11 rebounds in 18 minutes.
- The trio combined to make 31 of 38 attempts from the field and set the tone for a Gonzaga team that shot 63 percent from the field overall.
- GU outscored Eastern Oregon 84-18 in the paint, while outrebounding the Mountaineers 62-29.
- All 12 Gonzaga players scored and played at least eight minutes.

HUFF IS TOUGH

- Braden Huff had quite the collegiate debut in the Zags' regular season-opening win over Yale.
- The redshirt freshman finished with a game-high 19 points in 20 minutes off the bench. He was 7-of-10 from the field with nine boards.
- Per Will Maupin of The Inlander, Huff became the 16th Gonzaga freshman to score 10+ in a season opener in the Mark Few era.

SEASON-OPENING SUCCESS

- The Zags have now won 20 straight regular season-openers dating back to a 73-66 loss to Saint Joseph's in the 2003 Coaches vs. Cancer Classic in New York City.
- GU has won 34 consecutive regular season home-openers since a 73-65 loss to Boise State on Dec. 7, 1988.
- Gonzaga has won all 19 regular season home-openers in the McCarthey Athletic Center and all 25 regular season home-openers under Mark Few.

NEMBHARD NAMED TO NAISMITH WATCH LIST

- Gonzaga had three players named to preseason watch lists for the Naismith Starting Five awards.
- Ryan Nembhard was named to the Bob Cousy Point Guard Award Watch List
- Anton Watson was named to the Julius Erving Small Forward Award Watch List.
- Graham Ike was named to the Karl Malone Power Forward Award Watch List.
- Gonzaga (3) is one of 12 schools with three or more players on a watch list. Creighton, Duke, Kansas, Kentucky, Marquette, and UConn all have four players.

ZAGS OPEN SEASON RANKED NO. 11 IN AP POLL

- Gonzaga was ranked No. 11 in the preseason Associated Press poll.
- This marks the 23rd straight season GU has been ranked in the AP poll. It's the 14th consecutive year the Zags have appeared in the preseason poll, starting in the top-20 for the 11th straight season.
- GU is one of five programs that have appeared in each of the last 11 preseason polls, and have an average ranking of 8.64.
- The Bulldogs average ranking in the last five preseason poll is 4.60, which is second-best in the nation.
- Gonzaga and Purdue square off in the opening game of the Maui Invitational on Nov. 20. Tennessee is a potential second game opponent in Maui, and the Vols were No. 9 in the preseason AP poll. Defending national champion UConn was sixth in the preseason poll with two first-place votes. The Huskies and Zags meet in Seattle on Dec. 15. The Zags visit No. 16 Kentucky on Feb. 10, and welcome No. 17 San Diego State Dec. 29. Southern California and GU faceoff in Las Vegas Dec. 2. The Trojans are No. 21 in the preseason poll. West Coast Conference foe Saint Mary's is No. 23. The Gaels and Bulldogs are scheduled to meet on Feb. 3 in Spokane and March 2 in Moraga, Calif.

THE SLATE

- The Zags will face a guaranteed five teams ranked in the preseason AP Top 25 poll during non-conference play, which ties the most among Top 25 ranked teams.
- During their non-conference schedule, the Zags face a potential of six teams that advanced to the NCAA Tournament last season, and another that played in the postseason. The Bulldogs face both teams that played in the 2023 national championship game.
- Seven non-conference opponents won 20 or more games in 2022-23 and finished inside the Top 125 in last year's NET rankings.
- Gonzaga plays teams from nine different conferences, including the Big Ten, Big East, Pac-12, SEC and potentially the ACC and Big 12.

ZAGS ENJOY PACKED KRAZINESS

- A standing room only crowd of over 6,000 were entertained by Gonzaga at the annual Numerica Kraziness in the Kennel on Oct. 7.

- In the Navy and White scrimmage, the White squad made 51.4 percent from the field and won 52-38. Braden Huff's 19 points in the scrimmage were the most since 2009. points in his McCarthey Athletic Center debut, while Nolan Hickman chipped in 10 points. Watson, Jun Seok Yeo, and Ben Gregg all grabbed a scrimmage-high six rebounds. Ryan Nembhard led all players with four assists. Colby Brooks made two steals.

- In a highly contested Three Point Contest, Hickman held off Huff for the title. Hickman won the three-point crown as a freshman in 2021.
- Krajnović won the Skills Challenge, defeating fellow freshman Dusty Stromer in the finals.

BULLDOGS PICKED SECOND IN WCC

- The Zags were slated second in the league's preseason poll behind Saint Mary's. GU received 60 points in the poll, with four first place votes, while the Gaels grabbed five first place votes and 61 points. San Francisco was tabbed third with 45 points.
- The conference's preseason poll and team were selected by the league's 10 coaches. Coaches are not allowed to vote for their own program.
- Except for this season and 2017-18, the Zags have been first place in every WCC preseason poll since 2001. GU won the 2017-18 regular season title outright.

TRIO TABBED PRESEASON ALL-WCC

- Graham Ike, Ryan Nembhard, and Anton Watson were named to the West Coast Conference Preseason Team.
- Watson was tabbed Honorable Mention All-WCC last season. The Spokane native was second in the WCC shooting 60.8 percent from the field, while also topping the league in conference play at 64.8 percent. He started all 37 games in 2022-23, averaging a career-best 11.1 points per game, and 12.9 points per WCC contest.
- Nembhard started 64 games the past two seasons for Creighton, averaging 12.1 points, 4.0 rebounds and 4.8 assists this past season
- During the 2021-22 season, lke averaged 19.5 points and 9.6 rebounds per game as Wyoming went 25-9 and made the NCAA Tournament.

ZAGS IN THE NBA

- The NBA season opened with 11 former GU standouts on NBA rosters.
- Kelly Olynyk had the longest tenure in the league and returns to the Utah Jazz roster.
- Julian Strawther is the newest Bulldog in the league on the Denver Nuggets after being drafted 29th in June.

NCAA TOURNAMENT NOTES

- Gonzaga is making its 24th consecutive NCAA Tournament appearance and 25th overall.
- The 24 straight berths to the field are the third-longest current streak in the nation (Kansas and Michigan State), and the sixth-longest in NCAA Div. 1 history.

The Zags are 44-24 all-time in their 24 NCAA Tournament appearances with 13 trips to the Sweet 16, six trips to the Elite Eight, two Final Fours and two appearances in the national championship game.

- GU is 41-22 in the NCAA Tournament under Few with a berth in all 24 seasons of his head coaching career.
- The Bulldogs have the most wins in the NCAA Tournament since 2017, going 20-5, Kansas is next at 16-4.
 GU's 25 wins in the tournament since 2015 is also the most, with Villanova and North Carolina second at 21. Duke and Kansas both have 20.
- Gonzaga is one of only two teams to win its opening-round NCAA Tournament game each of the last 14 tournaments,

Kansas is the other at 16.

- The Zags are 35-18 all-time as a single-digit seed, with a 16-2 record in first round games as a single-digit seed.
- The Zags receive a three-seed for the third time in program history, with the last coming in 2006 when they advanced to the Sweet 16.
- Gonzaga played in Denver in the NCAA Tournament for the third time in program history. In 2011 in the Pepsi Center, the Zags upset 6-seeded St. John's in the first round, 86-71, before falling to 3-seeded BYU in the second round. In 2016, Gonzaga upset 6-seeded Seton Hall 68-52 and 3-seeded Utah 82-59 in the first and second rounds.
- In 2022-23, third-seeded Gonzaga defeated 14th-seeded Grand Canyon (82-70) and sixth-seeded TCU (84-81) in Denver. The Zags then advanced to the Sweet 16 in Las Vegas, where it beat second-seeded UCLA (79-76), before falling to eventual national champion and fourth-seeded UConn (82-54).

ELITE FEAT

- GU clinched its sixth appearance in the 2023 Elite Eight.
- The Zags have appeared in the Elite Eight five times in the last seven tournaments. (2015, 2017, 2019, 2021, 2023)

SWEET 16 ALL OVER AGAIN

- Gonzaga is the only program in the country to appear in each of the last eight Sweet 16s, including last year.
- Per ESPN stats, the Zags are the fourth program ever to reach eight straight Sweet 16s. They join UCLA, Duke, and North Carolina.
- Since the field expanded in 1985, UNC and Duke had streaks of 9 straight Sweet 16s, which rank as the longest.
- The Bulldogs appear in the Sweet 16 for the 13th time in program history, which ranks 21st in NCAA history.
- All 13 appearances have been since 1995-96, which ranks seventh in the nation.

THIRTY-WIN CLUB

- Gonzaga reached the 30-win plateau for the eighth time in program history last season.
- GU has reached 30 wins in a season eight times, all coming in the last 11 years; 32-3 in 2012-13, 35-3 in 2014-15, 37-2 in 2016-17, 32-5 in 2017-18, 33-4 in 2018-19, 31-2 in 2019-20, 31-1 in 2021-22, 31-6 last year.
- Gonzaga is the only program in NCAA Div. 1 history to reach post five consecutive 30-win seasons, accomplishing the feat from 2016-17 to 2021-22.
- GU has finished with 29 wins three previous times.


