NEWS AND NOTES

- Just over 20 hours (20 hours, 21 minutes) after disposing of No. 14/13 California, San Diego State looks to claim the Continental Tire Las Vegas Invitational inside the Orleans Arena when the Aztecs face undefeated No. rv/22 West Virginia.
- On the strength of a 14-0 run, which was part of a larger 28-5 run, San Diego State rallied from a 15-point second-half deficit to defeat the Golden Bears in the semifinal game Thursday evening.
- The 15-point second-half deficit is the second largest overcome by the Aztecs under head coach Steve Fisher, eclipsed only by the 16-point comeback against New Mexico to clinch the 2014 Mountain West regular-season title.
- The Aztecs survived a stretch in which it made one of just 19 field-goal attempts. How did they do it? They held California 27.2 points below its season average entering the game.
- For the game, California shot just 37.5 percent from the floor, the same percentage it shot when the Aztecs defeated the Golden Bears during the 2010-11 campaign.
- The Aztecs outshot California (39.0-37.5) and is 128-6 the last 134 times it has had an advantage in the category.
- San Diego State has now won 149 consecutive games when leading with five minutes to play.
- Senior forward **Winston Sheppard** tied for team-high honors with 15 points, five rebounds, and a game- and season-high four assists with no turnovers in 27 minutes. A Houston native, Sheppard had a team-high plus/minus rating of +20.
- Senior forward **Skylar Spencer** scored a career-high 15 points, including three dunks, on 5-of-5 field-goal shooting.
- Freshman forward **Zylan Cheatham** posted the first double-double of his career with a career-high tying 13 points and a career-high 10 rebounds.
- Freshman point guard **Jeremy Hemsley** played 30 turnover-free minutes and added 14 points and six rebounds. It was the fourth consecutive double-digit scoring game and the fifth in six games for the true freshman.
- San Diego State posted its 43rd consecutive non-conference victory against teams from the state of California (includes six Pac-12 games during that stretch).
- The win extended San Diego State's school record of defeating an AP Top 25 opponent in each of the last eight seasons.
- San Diego State, which is 7-6 against AP Top 25 teams since the beginning of the 2013-14 season, is one of just 11 programs in the nation to play at least 10 games and post a winning record in such games.
- The Aztecs are playing in a city where they have had considerable success over the last several seasons. Since 2008-09, San Diego State is 22-8 in games played in Las Vegas, including a 7-2 mark the last two-plus years.
- We know it is early, but SDSU's defensive efficiency is ranked sixth by Kenpom following last night's game. San Diego State has held all six of its opponents this season to 40 percent or less from the field and the season percentage of 35.0 is 20th nationally.
- **Skylar Spencer**, the 2015 Mountain West Defensive Player of the Year, set the school's all-time blocked shot record last year as a junior and has 237 to date. He is seven blocks shy of the conference record held by Wyoming's Justin Williams (244).
- Although San Diego State and West Virginia have never met, the Aztecs have had some recent encounters with the Big 12 Conference. The Aztecs have won their last two encounters with Big 12 foes. On March 22, 2013, SDSU defeated Oklahoma, 70-55, in the second round of the NCAA tournament and on Jan. 5, 2014, the Aztecs won at Allen Fieldhouse, defeating Kansas, 61-57 (KU's last home loss).







Team Notes

- The Aztecs overcame a 15-point second-half deficit to win the game. The rally was the second-largest in school history (since 1996-97).
- SDSU's 15-point successful rally was the fourth-largest in a victory, regardless of half, in school history (since 1996-97).
- San Diego State improves to 4-2 and has won two consecutive games.
- SDSU defeats previous undefeated No. 14/13 California. The Golden Bears had won their first four games by a total of 84 points.
- The Aztecs have won 43 consecutive non-conference games against teams from the state of California. Included in that streak are six games against Pac-12 Conference schools (California (3), USC (2) and UCLA). Of those six victories against the Pac-12, only two came at home.
- San Diego State has defeated a nationally ranked opponent in a school-record eight consecutive seasons.
- The Aztecs are 7-6 in their last 13 games against AP Top 25 teams (Since the beginning of the 2013-14 campaign).
- Since the beginning of the 2013-14 season, San Diego State is one of just 11 schools nationally to play at least 10 games against AP Top 25 teams and own a winning record in those games (listed alphabetically: Connecticut, Duke, Iowa State, Kansas, Kentucky, Michigan State, North Carolina, Notre Dame, San Diego State, Villanova and Wisconsin).
- Entering today, only 14 teams in the country had a win over an AP Top 25 team (at the time of the game) this season.
- San Diego State is now 22-8 in its last 30 games played in Las Vegas (that includes road games at UNLV).
- The Aztecs are a remarkable 70-32 in road/neutral games since March 6, 2010. That is the seventh-best record nationally during that span.
- San Diego State is 15-7 in its last 22 games against Pac-12 teams.
- San Diego State owns three consecutive victories over the Golden Bears and has not suffered a defeat to the Golden Bears since Nov. 24, 2007.
- SDSU is 26-12 in its last 38 neutral site games.
- San Diego State is 30-7 in its last 37 contests played during the month of November.
- This was just the 18th game played on a Thursday since the beginning of the 2010-11 campaign. SDSU has won four straight games played on Thursdays.
- SDSU went on a 20-3 run to help the Aztecs take a 50-48 lead (2nd/9:32), its first lead since leading 11-10 with 15:33 left in the first half.
- Had a season-low eight turnovers, three less than its previous low.
- Held California to 58 points after averaging 85.2 coming into the game.

Player Notes

Winston Shepard – 15 points, 5 rebounds, 4 assists, 0 turnovers

Scored nine straight points to fuel a 14-0 run to get SDSU to within a point of California... Finished 15 points to share the team lead in points... Reached double figures in scoring for the second straight game, marking the first time he has accomplished the feat this season... Posted his third double-figure scoring performance of the season and the 56th of his career... Led the team in scoring for the third time this season and 22nd time of his career... Had a season-high

four assists, marking the second time he has done it this season (29th career)... Committed zero turnovers and the Aztecs are 3-0 this season when he has one turnover or less (30-9 in career)... The six field goals tied his season high.

Skylar Spencer – 15 points, 3 rebounds, 2 blocked shots

Posted his first double-figure scoring effort of the season with his career-high 15 points... He has nine double-digit scoring performances in his career... After going 0-for-2 from the field in his last two games combined, he answered by going 5-for-5 tonight... Made a season-high five free throws, which was one shy of his career high... Blocked two shots for this third multi-block effort the season (66th career).

Zylan Cheatham – 13 points, 10 rebounds, 2 assists, 1 blocked shot, 1 steal

Logged his first career double-double and the first for San Diego State this season... The 13 points matched a career high... His 10 boards were two more than his previous career best... Tied a career high with two assists, a total he has had in three of the last four games... His one blocked shot matched his career high as did his one steal... Played a career-high 28 minutes.

Jeremy Hemsley – 14 points, 6 rebounds

Scored in double figures for the fourth straight game, which is the longest streak of the season for SDSU... He now has five double-digit scoring efforts in six games... Had a season-high six rebounds, which matched his effort vs. Illinois State in the opener.
