WHAT'S ON TAP THIS WEEKEND IN AZTEC BASEBALL

- ◆ San Diego State began its week by defeating the University of San Diego, 7-3, on Tuesday (April 12) at the Toreros' Fowler Park.
- ◆ The Aztecs will continue play this weekend when they travel to Lubbock, Texas, for a three-game series against Texas Tech.
- ◆ That set gets underway on Friday, April 15, with a contest scheduled to start at 6:30 p.m. (CT) at Dan Law Field.
- ◆ The Aztecs and Red Raiders will also hook up for games on Saturday (April 16) and Sunday (April 17) at 2:00 p.m. and 11:30 a.m. (CT) respectively.

ON THE AIR

- ◆ Live Stats will be available for all three games at No. 10 Texas Tech this weekend with the links available at GoAztecs.com.
- ◆ Video and audio coverage of the three games will be available from Texas Tech for a fee. The links to those may be found on the Texas Tech web site (TexasTech.com).

SERIES RECORD

- ◆ San Diego State has won only two of its previous 12 meetings against Texas Tech. The teams first met during the 1988 season in San Diego with SDSU winning, 11-4.
- ◆ The Aztecs' other win came in 2015 when they shut out the Red Raiders, 9-0, at Tony Gwynn Stadium before the visitors captured the final two games of the series.
- ◆ SDSU's only previous trip to Lubbock came during the 2000 season when it dropped three games in a weekend series.
- ◆ San Diego State has a record of 2-7 vs. Texas Tech in San Diego and 0-3 in Lubbock, Texas.

SCOUTING THE RED RAIDERS

- ◆ Texas Tech comes into the week with a record of 24-9 and is scheduled to host a doubleheader against Sam Houston State on Wednesday (April 13) prior to SDSU's visit.
- ◆ The Red Riders are ranked from 10th to 22nd in the nation in this week's five collegiate polls.
- ◆ Top offensive leaders include center fielder Tanner Gardner (.405, 9 2B, 17 RBI), first baseman Eric Gutierrez (.345, 5 HR, 32 RBI) and designated hitter Cory Raley (.338, 5 HR, 31 RBI).
- ◆ Texas Tech is hitting .303 as a team with a 4.01 earned run average.

TREJO KEEPS HITTING

- ◆ Shortstop Alan Trejo went 7-for-13 during last weekend's three-game series vs. UNLV with two RBI and three runs scored.
- ◆ He had a team season-high 15-game hitting streak end on March 25 vs. New Mexico.
- ◆ During that streak he batted .419 (27-for-66) with two doubles, 11 RBI and 12 runs scored.
- ◆ He has recorded multiple-hit efforts in almost half of SDSU's games this season (14 of 30).

ADKISON HITS AWAY

- ◆ Sophomore Tyler Adkison had a nine-game hitting streak come to an end in the game at USD on Tuesday (April 12).
- ◆ During that streak he went going 12-for-35 (.343) over that span with three doubles, a triple, home run, 11 RBI and four runs scored.
- ◆ He leads the team in home runs with four including one last Saturday in the victory over UNLV.
- ◆ In the win over No. 20 Long Beach State on April 5, he led off with a triple in the 12th inning after which he scored the game-winning run in SDSU's 6-5 win.
- ◆ He hit a pair of home runs in the contest at Air Force on March 20.

- ◆ In the series vs. Northwestern the previous weekend, he went 5-for-8 (.625) three RBI and six runs scored (two in each game).
- ◆ He also hit his first home run of the year and recorded a double in that game.

HENSLEY STREAK ENDS

- ◆ David Hensley hit his first career home run in the second inning of Tuesday's (April 12) contest at University of San Diego, giving SDSU a 1-0 lead in a game it went on to win, 7-3.
- ◆ He had a 12-game hitting streak come to an end in the series finale vs. UNLV last Sunday (April 10).
- ◆ During that streak he hit .365 (19-for-52) with a two doubles, four RBI and eight runs scored.
- ◆ He has scored six runs in the Aztecs' past five contests.
- ◆ Hensley leads the team in sacrifice bunts with seven.

CALABUIG RETURNS

- ◆ Outfielder Chase Calabuig returned to the starting lineup for the contest at Nevada on April 1.
- ◆ After starting SDSU's first 17 games in center field, he came back and played in left field during the two games in Reno. He has been in center field in the past four contests.
- ◆ In the April 5 win against No. 20 Long Beach State, he came off the bench as the DH and had three RBI including a two-run triple.
- ◆ Prior to Tuesday's contest at USD, he had hit safely in each of the previous four games going 4-for-13 with two triples, four RBI and three runs scored.

BROWN CONSISTENT

- ◆ Andrew Brown had the game-winning RBI in the win over No. 20 Long Beach State last Tuesday, April 5, with a single in the bottom of the 12th inning that brought home Tyler Adkison in the 6-5 win.
- ◆ Brown had a seven-game hitting streak end at USD on Tuesday (April 12) during which he batted .323 (10-for-31) two doubles, a triple, three RBI and four runs scored.
- ◆ In that contest at USD he drove in a run with a sacrifice fly and also drew a base on balls.
- ◆ Prior to that he had hit safely in four of the previous five contests.
- ◆ Since March 22, he has raised his batting average from .158 to .242 over that span of 13 games.

WYLIE KEEPS HITTING

- ◆ Second baseman Justin Wylie hit his third homer of the year at USD on Tuesday, a solo shot in the top of the seventh inning.
- ◆ He has hit safely in 7 of SDSU's last 8 games.
- ◆ In those games he has batted .333 with two doubles, a home run, four RBI and eight runs scored.
- ◆ He tied his season high with three hits in the game on Saturday (April 9) vs. UNLV.
- ◆ He hit a leadoff home run in the contest at Cal State Fullerton on March 15 to give SDSU an early 1-0 lead. His first home of the year had come in the previous contest vs. Northwestern.

VERDON HEATS UP

- ◆ Freshman Jordan Verdon connected for his second home run of the season at USD on Tuesday, a three-run shot that extended SDSU's two-run lead to five runs in the eighth inning.
- ◆ He went 4-for-10 in last weekend's three-game series vs. UNLV with a double and four RBI.
- ◆ His three RBI vs. the Rebels on April 8 was a season high.
- ◆ He had an 11-game hitting streak come to an end on March 26 vs. New Mexico.
- ◆ It was the third-longest hitting streak by an Aztec this season.
- ◆ During that streak he hit .361 (13-for-36) with a double, triple, three RBI and five runs scored.
- ◆ He leads the team in being hit by pitch this season with seven.

HELDMAN SAVES

- ◆ Senior Brian Heldman recorded his second save of the year in the win at No. 6 Oregon State on March 28.
- ◆ He retired the side in order in the bottom of the ninth after Alan Trejo's home run in the top of the inning had given SDSU the lead.
- ◆ At USD on Tuesday, he closed out the final 1.1 innings in the Aztecs' 7-3 win. He did surrender a run on two-out solo homer in the ninth.
- ◆ Over his last four relief appearances (6.0 innings) he has allowed one run on five hits with no walks and five strikeouts.
- ◆ Heldman's first save of the 2016 season came in the win at UC Irvine on Feb. 23.
- ◆ He tossed the final two innings allowing one hit and hitting a batter to preserve the Aztecs' two-run lead.
- ◆ The two saves are the second and third of Heldman's two-year Aztec career.
- ◆ Last season he served primary as a late-inning set-up reliever.

STREAKS

- ◆ Jordan Verdon has the team's longest current hitting streak at four games.
- ◆ The team's longest streak this season is 15 games by Alan Trejo.
- ◆ Spencer Thornton has reached base safely (via hit, walk or hit by pitch) in each of the last 14 games while Tyler Adkison has done so in the last 10 contests.
- ◆ Trejo leads the Aztecs with 14 multiple-hit contests while Adkison leads with six multiple-RBI games.

PLAYER OF THE WEEK

- ◆ Shortstop Alan Trejo earned the Mountain West Baseball Player of the Week award for games played through Sunday, March 13, 2016.
- ◆ It is the first MW weekly accolade for Trejo, a sophomore from Downey, Calif. (Warren HS).
- ◆ He led San Diego State to a 2-1 week in a home series against Northwestern.
- ◆ Over the three contests he posted a batting average of .600 (9-for-15) with six runs scored, five runs batted in and one stolen base.
- ◆ Trejo had at least two hits and two runs scored in all three games with a .625 on-base and a .600 slugging percentage.
- ◆ Defensively, Trejo recorded seven putouts and 12 assists with no errors.
- ◆ He was also named the Madness Mountain West Player of the week by *College Sports Madness*.

GOOD START

- ◆ Two Aztec newcomers recorded hits in their first collegiate at bat during the season-opening series vs. No. 14 Oregon.
- ◆ Jordan Verdon singled to right center field in his first plate appearance in the contest on Feb. 19.
- ◆ Dean Nevarez delivered a single to center in his first plate appearance as a pinch hitter vs. Oregon on Feb. 20.

NAVARRO'S FIRST HIT

- ◆ After going hitless in his first six collegiate plate appearances, freshman Niko Navarro came through with an important single in the win over Fresno State on Sunday (March 6).
- ◆ He was called upon to pitch hit in the bottom of the eighth inning with the bases loaded, one out and SDSU trailing, 4-2.
- ◆ Navarro proceeded to deliver a single to right field to drive home two runs and tie the game.
- ◆ SDSU added a third run one batter later and went on to win, 5-4.

NEW COACHES

- ◆ The Aztecs have added a pair of new coaches to their staff for the 2016 season: Pitching Coach Sam Peraza and Volunteer Assistant Joey Centanni.
- ◆ Peraza arrives at SDSU after two seasons at Florida International. He also had previous experience at Cal State Northridge, Cal State Los Angeles and Eastern Oklahoma State.
- ◆ He is a 2002 graduate of San Diego State, where he pitched during the 2002 season.
- ◆ Centanni played four seasons as a pitcher and first baseman at Pacific, graduating in 2009. After college, he spent one season in the Baltimore Orioles organization before an injury ended his playing career.
- ◆ He later served as an associate scout for the Orioles in the San Diego area and coach locally at Francis Parker High School.

VETERAN HONOREES

- ◆ Five players who earned individual honors a year ago return for the 2016 season.
- ◆ Second baseman Alan Trejo was named to the all-tournament team at the 2015 NCAA Regional at Lake Elsinore, Calif.
- ◆ Pitcher Jacob Erickson, outfielder Spencer Thornton and designated hitter Justin Wylie earned all-tourney recognition at the 2015 Mountain West Conference Tournament.
- ◆ Outfielder Chase Calabuig was named a Louisville Slugger Freshman All-American and a second-team all-Mountain West selection.

PRESEASON ALL-CONFERENCE

- ◆ Outfielder Chase Calabuig has been tabbed to the Preseason All-Mountain West team in a vote of the league's coaches.
- ◆ Calabuig batted .305 with eight doubles and 25 RBI as season en route to second-team all-conference honors at the end of the 2015 campaign.
- ◆ He was also named a Louisville Slugger Freshman All-American by *Collegiate Baseball* magazine.

COLLEGE SPORTS MADNESS ALL-MW

- ◆ *College Sports Madness* also named Calabuig to its All-Mountain West first team while four other Aztecs earned second-team honors.
- ◆ That quartet included outfielder Spencer Thornton and third baseman Andrew Brown along with pitchers Marcus Reyes and Cody Thompson.

DRAFTED AZTECS

- ◆ Three current members of the SDSU squad have been drafted by Major League clubs.
- ◆ That trio includes junior catcher CJ Saylor (33rd rd. in 2012, Los Angeles Dodgers) along with sophomore outfielder Denz'l Chapman (32nd rd. in 2014, Oakland A's) and freshman first baseman Jordan Verdon (24th rd. in 2015, New York Mets).

AZTEC NOTES

- ◆ Jordan Verdon is one of five Aztecs to have recorded a double, triple and home run this season. The others include Tyler Adkison, Andrew Brown, Dean Nevarez and Chase Calabuig.
- ◆ Senior outfielder Spencer Thornton had his first four-hit game of the season in the contest at Nevada on April 1. Only Thornton and Alan Trejo have recorded four-hit efforts for the Aztecs in 2016.
- ◆ Shortstop Alan Trejo is the only player to have started all 30 games this season at the same position.
- ◆ Only one other Aztec has started all 30 games, but not at the same position each time: Justin Wylie (2B-3B-DH).
- ◆ Niko Navarro (1-for-3), Dean Nevarez (1-for-2) and Jordan Verdon (1-for-2) are the only three Aztecs to have recorded a hit as a pinch hitter. Aztec pinch hitters are 3-for-17 on the year.

UP NEXT

- ◆ Following the Texas Tech series this weekend, San Diego State will host UC Irvine on Tuesday, April 19, at 6:00 p.m. at Tony Gwynn Stadium.
- ◆ The Aztecs will then face a three-game series at league-leading New Mexico the following weekend.
- ◆ That set gets underway on Friday, April 22, at 6:00 p.m. (MT) at the Lobos' Santa Ana Star Field in Albuquerque.
- ◆ The teams will also meet for games on Saturday (April 23) and Sunday (April 24) at 2:00 p.m. and 1:00 p.m. (MT) respectively.



SAN DIEGO STATE AZTECS
