INSIDE SCOOP

• **The Matchup:** Washington leads the all-time series against SDSU 3-2. The last meeting between the teams was in the 2016 NIT, a game the Aztecs won in San Diego. The home team has held serve in each of the past four matchups, but the teams have never met at a neutral site. Following a win over Xavier on Friday, Washington aims to win an in-season tournament for the second consecutive year after winning the Wooden Legacy last November with wins over Fresno State and Saint Mary's. UW will play three of its next four games in Las Vegas. The Huskies are 23-65 all-time against Final Four teams from the previous year.

• **Last Time Out:** Keion Brooks Jr. scored 16 of his 20 points in the second half and added eight rebounds and three blocked shots. Sahvir Wheeler added five assists, four rebounds, two blocks and two steals. Franck Kepnang scored six of his eight points in the second half and finished with a career-high 12 rebounds. Xavier grabbed 50 rebounds which marked the first time in two years a team grabbed 50 rebounds in a game.

• **Top Dawg:** Keion Brooks Jr. averaged 24.3 points per game over the first week of the season, which ranks first on the Pac-12 leaderboard. He is currently in the top-ten nationally in total scoring.

• **The Returners:** UW is one of three Pac-12 teams to return multiple All-Conference honorees, behind only USC. Preseason First-Team All-Conference choice Keion Brooks Jr. headlines the core of returners as the top returning scorer in the Pac-12. He averaged 17.7 points and 6.7 rebounds to earn Second Team All-Pac-12 honors a season ago. Braxton Meah is back for another season in purple and gold after shooting over 70 percent in 2022-23 to lead the league and set a new single-season Husky record. He was selected to the All-Defensive team after averaging 1.6 blocks per game. Koren Johnson enters his sophomore season following a stellar freshman campaign in which he racked up 34 steals off the bench, which were tied for second on the team. Franck Kepnang is expected to return to the frontcourt after missing the majority of the 2022-23 season due to injury.

• **The Newcomers:** The Huskies added seven transfers, highlighted by Kentucky grad transfer Sahvir Wheeler and Rutgers product Paul Mulcahy. Wheeler twice led the SEC in assists, both times ranking in the top five in the NCAA with over six helpers per game. Mulcahy helped the Scarlet Knights to back-to-back NCAA Tournament appearances and was a two-time Big Ten Honorable Mention. Wilhelm Breidenbach (Nebraska), Nate Calmese (Lamar), Anthony Holland (Fresno State), Nehemie Kabeya (Carson-Newman) and Moses Wood (Portland) also arrived in Seattle via the transfer portal. Four-star guard Wesley Yates III headlines the freshman class. Yates ranked 37th in the ESPN top 100.

• **The Coach:** Head Coach Mike Hopkins is in his seventh year at Washington. He became the sixth coach in program history to win 100 games with the Huskies' win over Oregon State (2/18/23). Hopkins is a two-time Pac-12 Coach of the Year, winning the honor in each of his first two seasons with the Huskies as he led UW to back-to-back 20 win seasons with postseason appearances each year, including the NCAA Second Round in 2019. He won his 100th game as a head coach against Cal (1/14/23), which includes 4 wins as Interim Head Coach at Syracuse.

• **2022-23 Recap:** The Huskies held opponents to 29.7% from three which ranked top-15 nationally and inside the top-3 for a single season in program history. They also made over 74% of free throws which is tied for second all-time in program history. The Huskies ranked ninth in the NCAA in blocks per game (5.2). The team won at least 10 games at Hec Ed for the fifth time in the Mike Hopkins era. Washington went 4-0 in overtime games in a single season for the first time in program history. Keion Brooks Jr. was named to the Pac-12 All-Conference Second Team, Braxton Meah earned All-Defense honors.

• **NBA Connections:** Not only are there six former Huskies currently active in the NBA, but there are two former players on the Huskies' coaching staff with NBA experience. Eighth-year coach Will Conroy spent part of four seasons in the NBA, while second-year coach Quincy Pondexter wrapped up a nine-year career in 2019. Markelle Fultz (Orlando Magic), Jaden McDaniels (Minnesota Timberwolves), Dejounte Murray (Atlanta Hawks), Justin Holiday (Denver Nuggets), Isaiah Stewart (Detroit Pistons), and Matisse Thybulle (Portland Trail Blazers) are also former Huskies.

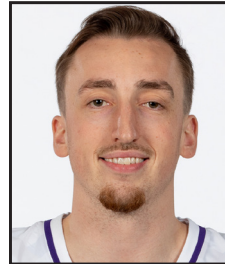

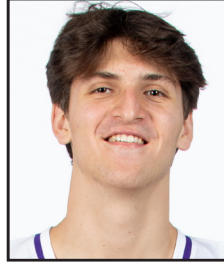

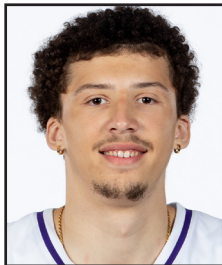

WASHINGTON HEAD COACH MIKE HOPKINS - 7TH SEASON

Mike Hopkins took over the helm of the University of Washington men's basketball program prior to the 2017-18 season. He led the Huskies to back-to-back 20 win seasons in his first two years, earning Pac-12 Coach of the Year honors both years.

Entering his seventh season in 2023-24, Hopkins has led the Huskies to an NCAA Tournament, an NIT berth, a Pac-12 regular season title, coached four McDonald's All-Americans, and has mentored five players that have been selected in the first round of the NBA Draft.

On February 18, 2023 he became the sixth coach in program history to win 100 games with the Huskies following a win over Oregon State.

In his third season, the Huskies welcomed a heralded recruiting class bringing two McDonald's All-Americans to Montlake in Isaiah Stewart and Jaden McDaniels and added Kentucky transfer Quade Green to the mix. Stewart earned Pac-12 All-First Team and All-Freshman honors.

Washington continued to improve during year two of the Hopkins' era this most recent season finishing with an overall record of 27-9 after advancing to the second round of the NCAA Tournament. The Huskies posted a 15-3 mark in league action earning them the Pac-12 Regular Season Championship, which they claimed in February with games still to be played. Washington also saw Matisse Thybulle and Jaylen Nowell get picked in the first two rounds of the 2019 NBA Draft going eighth and 43rd, respectively.

Alongside his Pac-12 Coach of the Year honor, Hop mentored the 2019 Pac-12 Player of the Year in Jaylen Nowell, just the third Husky to earn the honor and the 2019 Pac-12 Defensive Player of the Year in Matisse Thybulle. Thybulle would also go on to win the Naismith National Defensive Player of the Year award after setting the Pac-12 Career and Single Season steals record.

In his first year, Hop was also named the Pac-12 Coach of the Year becoming just the sixth coach in league history to earn the honor in their first year at their institution and first since 2006-07.

Hopkins led a team that went from 9-22 to 21-13 with almost entirely the same roster and helped guide Matisse Thybulle to Pac-12 Defensive Player of the Year honors, the first Dawg to earn the award. Noah Dickerson was named to the All-Pac-12 First Team while freshman Jaylen Nowell picked up All-Pac-12 Honorable Mention and All-Pac-12 Freshman Team accolades. Thybulle was also named to the All-Pac-12 Defensive Team.

Hopkins spent 22 seasons alongside Hall of Fame coach Jim Boeheim at Syracuse University. During his time in New York, Syracuse advanced to postseason play in all but one year, including the 2003 National Championship, four Final Fours, five Elite Eights and ten Sweet 16s. Hopkins played a key role in the recruitment and success of Carmelo Anthony, Rakeem Christmas, Johnny Flynn, Jason Hart, Gerry McNamara, Andy Rautins.

The Syracuse alum not only made an impact with the Orange, but he also played a major role in the success of Team USA Basketball. Hopkins has been a court coach for nine various Team USA staffs which have gone on to win six championships.

As a student-athlete himself, Hopkins became the Orange's starting shooting guard his junior year en route to the team winning the 1992 Big East Championship. Outside of playing 111 career games in the Carrier Dome, he was also named team captain as a senior en route to averaging 9.2 points and 3.7 rebounds. Hopkins went on to play in the Continental Basketball Association before ending his professional career after stints in the Netherlands and Turkey. Prior to his collegiate experience, the San Mateo, California native, was a member of the 1987 California State Championship team with Mater Dei High School where he played alongside LeRon Ellis.

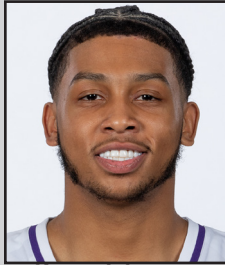

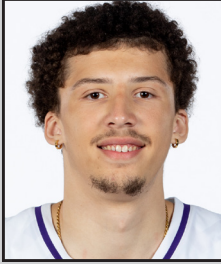
