SDSU POSTGAME NOTES

SAN DIEGO STATE (23-11)

Team Notes:

* San Diego State finished with 23 victories, its second straight season with 22 wins. The last time that happened was when the 1994-95 team won 24 and the 1993-94 squad had 26 victories.

Saturday, March 27, 2010

- * SDSU, which came into the NCAA Tournament ranked 241st nationally in three-point field goal percentage and eighth of nine teams in the Mountain West Conference, hit 22-of-50 (44.0 percent) from beyond the arc in its three tournament games.
- * The Aztecs finished with 34 games played, the program's most since also playing 34 in the 1988-89 campaign.
- * The Aztecs have tallied at least four blocks in 13 of its last 16 contests after entering the week ranked second in the MWC and 20th in the nation.
- * SDSU finished 9-of-11 (.818) from the free-throw stripe, its best free-throw percentage in an NCAA Tournament game in program history.
- * With Jessika Bradley's first career three-pointer, San Diego State matched its NCAA Tournament record with nine makes (at Texas, March 21, 2010).
- * With the loss, SDSU dropped to 6-8 all-time in NCAA Tournament games (2-1 in 2010).

Individual Notes:

* Jené Morris (13 points, 5 steals)

Jené Morris has reached double-figures in scoring in all five career NCAA contests ... She finished with 13 tonight, giving her a career average of 24.2 in her five NCAA Tournament contests ... Finished her career with 1,499 points, the third-most in school history, despite wearing the Scarlet and Black for just three seasons ... Her 566 field goals made are the fourth-most on the Aztec career list, while her 293 career steals are tied for fourth ... Moved into eighth-place on the school single-season scoring list, passing Kieishsha Garnes, who had 574 in 1992 ... Played in her 34th game of the year, tying for the sixth-most in a season in school history ... Her three three-point field goals gave her 52 for the season, the eighth-most in a season in school history ... Had five steals to finish her season with 101, one more than she had last year and the fifth-most in a season in program history.

* Quenese Davis (14 points)

Extended her school record with her 122nd consecutive start ... Played in her 125th career game, moving her into a tie for third on the school's all-time list ... Finshed with a school-record 670 assists, 222 more than second-place Falisha Wright's (1992-95) 448 ... Played in her 34th game of the year, tying for the sixth-most in a season in school history ... Her 171 assists this season are the sixth-most in a single-season in school history.

* Paris Johnson (12 points, 8 rebounds, 5 blocks)

Played in her 34th game of the year, tying for the sixth-most in a season in school history ... Had five blocks, the most ever by an Aztec in an NCAA Tournament game ... Had her ninth game with three or more blocks this season (SDSU finished 7-2 in those games)

* <u>Jessika Bradley (9 points)</u>

Played in her 34th game of the year, tying for the sixth-most in a season in school history.
