AZTECS HIT THE ROAD FOR CONTESTS AT BOISE STATE & UTAH STATE

- San Diego State will be on the road this week for a pair of Mountain West matches.
 SDSU's week gets underway on Thursday, Nov. 12, when it faces Boise State in a match slated to get underway at 6:00 p.m. (MT) in Bronco Gym.
- Two days later (Saturday, Nov. 14), the Aztecs will face Utah State at 7:00 p.m. (MT) at the Dee Glenn Smith Spectrum.
- Live stats will be available for both matches this weekend with links located at GoAztecs.com.
- \blacklozenge In addition, live video streaming of the two contests will be available at the SDSU web site.

SERIES RECORDS

- ◆ The Aztecs and Boise State have met just nine times previously with SDSU winning on six of those nine occasions. Earlier this season the Broncos defeated the Aztecs in five sets on Aztec court. The Aztecs are 3-1 vs. the Broncos on Aztec Court, 2-2 in Boise and 1-0 on neutral courts.
- ◆ San Diego State holds a 10-4 lead in its series with Utah State. SDSU has won each of the past three meetings vs. the Aggies including a three-set victory on Aztec Court in mid-October. The Aztecs are 7-0 vs. Utah State in San Diego, 1-1 in Logan and 2-3 on neutral courts.

HEAD COACH DEITRE COLLINS-PARKER

- ◆ San Diego State Head Coach Deitre Collins-Parker is in her seventh season with the Aztecs after being named the fourth head coach in program history prior to the 2009 campaign. Her record at SDSU is 110-96 (.534).
- She previously served as head coach at UNLV for eight seasons (1996-2003) and at Cornell for five years (2004-2008). Her 19-year career record stands at 272-287 (.487).
- ◆ A three-time All-American as a player at the University of Hawai'i, she led the Rainbow Wahine to consecutive national titles (1983-84) and was named the national player of the year twice.
- She was a member of the U.S. Olympic Team and competed at the Goodwill Games and Pan Am Games prior to playing professionally in Europe for four years.
- She is one of six players named to the NCAA Division I Women's Volleyball 25th Anniversary Team in October 2005 and was inducted into the AVCA Hall of Fame in the fall of 2008.

SCOUTING THE OPPOSITION

- ◆ Boise State comes into the week with a record of 18-7 (10-3 Mountain West) and has won each of its last four matches. The Broncos are led by outside hitters Sierra Nobley (4.65 kps, 2.43 dps) and Sabryn Roberts (2.69 kps, 0.73 dps). Nobley's kill average leads the conference. The Broncos lead the Mountain West in kills and assists and are second in hitting percentage.
- Utah State's record stands at 5-22 (1-12 MW) and the Aggies will host Nevada Thursday evening prior to facing SDSU. USU begins the week having lost its last seven matches and 12 of its last 13. Top players for Utah State include outside hitters Kaylee Kamalu (3.13 kps, 1.44 bps) and Rachel Gale (3.03 kps, 1.95 dps).

CAGE OFF THE MARK

- Alexis Cage recorded her first doubledouble of the season with 10 kills and 10 digs against UNLV on Nov. 7.
- In the previous contest vs. Fresno State she led the Aztecs with 11 kills and recorded a career-high .611 hitting percentage in the match.
- For the week she averaged 3.50 kills, 2.67 digs and 0.83 blocks per set with a .395 hitting percentage.
- She registered a career-high 16 digs vs. Air Force on Oct. 22.
- Cage's mark of 2.28 digs per set in league matches ranks second on the team behind libero Devyn Pritchard.
- She turned in a career-high five blocks in the match vs. Boise State on Oct. 17.

LITTLE ON THE ATTACK

- Baylee Little led the Aztec with 11 kills in the three-set win over UNLV on Nov. 7.
- She hit .500 in that contest, the 10th time this season she has been above the .300 mark in attack percentage in a match.
- She averaged 1.00 block per set in the Aztecs two matches last week.
- ◆ Little set a career high with 17 kills in the win over New Mexico on Oct. 24.
- Her 18.5 points in that match was also a career best.
- She tied her season high with five total blocks in the match vs. Air Force last week (Oct. 22).
- She ranks second on the team in kills overall (2.27 per set) and third in league matches (2.22 per set).

SABA FOR THE DEFENSE

- Alexa Saba made her first start at the libero position since late September in the win over UNLV on Nov. 7.
- In that match she registered 19 digs, an assist and a service ace.
- In the win over CSU Bakersfield on Aug. 29 she recorded a careerhigh 29 digs.
- Saba set a career best with eight assists in the win over Eastern Washington on Sept. 11.

BOLDEN ON THE OFFENSIVE

- Defensive specialist Dani Bolden averaged 2.50 kills and 2.50 digs per set in SDSU's wins over Fresno State and UNLV last week.
- She tied her season high with 11 digs vs. Fresno State (Nov. 5) and also had a pair of service aces.

- She led the Aztecs with 10 kills in the contest at Colorado State on Oct. 29.
- Bolden, who missed the Oct. 22 match vs. Air Force with a sprained ankle, returned for the New Mexico contest on Oct. 24 and recorded her second career double-double with 12 kills and 10 digs.
- She had recorded her first career double-double in the match against Boise State on Oct. 17 when she finished with 19 kills and 11 digs.
- The 19 kills vs. Boise State represented a career high and tied for the most by an Aztec this season.
- She also recorded a season-best four service aces in that match and her 24.0 points was a career high as well.

PSOMA LEADS HITTERS

- Freshman Alexandra Psoma had a career-high 13 digs along with 14 kills vs. New Mexico on Oct. 24 to record her second double-double of the season.
- She had a career best three blocks in the match at Colorado State on Oct. 29.
- ♦ Her 19 points in the match vs. Air Force on Oct 22 were a career best.
- Her two service aces against Air Force were a personal best.
- She recorded the second-most kills in match by an Aztec this season when she had 18 vs. Denver on Saturday, Aug. 29.
- She also registered a dozen digs in that contest for her first career doubledouble as an Aztec.
- Psoma currently leads the team with an overall average of 2.41 kills per set and a mark of 2.53 kills per set in conference matches.

- Redshirt freshman Deja Harris has averaged 1.89 blocks over SDSU's past three matches.
- She has recorded at least one block in 25 of the Aztecs' 26 matches this season.
- She ranks eighth in the Mountain West in league matches with a .322 hitting percentage.
- She is the only freshman to rank among the league's top 10 in that category.
- She had a career-high 19 kills in the victory at Fresno State on Oct. 10, the most kills in a match by an Aztec this season.
- Her 21.0 points in that match were also her career high.
- Her .700 hitting percentage in the match at New Mexico on Sept. 24 was a career best as she had 15 kills with only one error on 20 attacks.
- She had a career-high 10-block performance at UC Santa Barbara on Sept. 19 that included two solo efforts and eight assists.

PRITCHARD AT LIBERO

- Sophomore libero Devyn Pritchard had a streak of 13 matches in which she recorded at least one assist end in the contest vs. UNLV on Nov. 7 when she appeared in only one set.
- She registered a season-high two service aces in the matches against Utah State and Boise State (Oct. 15 and 17).
- She set a career high with 31 digs in the win at Fresno State on Oct. 10.
- She also had a career-best six assists in that match.
- Her 4.04 digs per set average in league matches ranks eighth in the conference this week.

FUZIE CONSISTENT

- Emma Fuzie tied her SDSU career high with six blocks in the win over Fresno State on Nov. 5.
- She also had six blocks in the wins over New Mexico on Oct. 24 and at Fresno State on Oct. 10.
- She equaled her personal best with 11 kills in contest vs. Air Force on Oct. 22.
- ◆ In that match vs. the Falcons she had a career-high 14.0 points as well.
- She has recorded five or more block in a match on eight occasions this season.

UTCHEN DOUBLE-DOUBLE

- Freshman setter Lauren Utchen had her third double-figure digs match of the season with 10 in the won over UNLV on Nov. 7.

- Sandberg turned in a season-high seven blocks in that match vs. Boise State as well.

- Junior setter Hailey Jones averaged 2.33 digs per set in SDSU two wins last week.
- She recorded her fourth double-double of the season with 26 assists and 10 digs in the contest at UNLV on Oct. 8.

ALL-TOURNAMENT AZTEC I

- Sophomore libero Alexa Saba was named to the all-tournament team at San Francisco Invitational during the opening weekend of the season (Aug. 28-29).
- Over SDSU's three matches, Saba averaged 4.50 digs per set and also had five assists and three service aces.

ALL-TOURNAMENT AZTEC II

- Junior outside hitter Baylee Little was named to the all-tournament team at last weekend's Outrigger Resorts Volleyball Challenge in Honolulu.
- Over SDSU's three matches she averaged 2.00 kills, 0.78 digs and 0.33 blocks per set.
- She also recorded four service aces in the Aztecs' win over Eastern Washington and hit .588 with 11 kills in that match.

DOUBLE-DOUBLES

- Four Aztecs have recorded at least one double-double during the 2015 campaign.
- Two Aztecs recorded double-doubles during the season-opening San Francisco Invitational (Aug. 28-29).
- Setter Hailey Jones did so twice with 47 assists-15 digs vs. Denver and 57 assists-11 digs vs. CSU Bakersfield.
- She also added double-doubles at Air Force on Sept. 26 (25 assists, 10 digs) and at UNLV on Oct. 8 (26 assists, 10 digs).
- Alexandra Psoma had 18 kills and 12 digs in the match vs. Denver.
- Danielle Bolden has double-doubles in two of her last three matches: vs. Boise State on Oct. 17 (19 kills, 11 digs) and vs. New Mexico on Oct. 24 (12 kills, 10 digs).
- In addition, setter Lauren Utchen has registered pair of double-doubles: at Fresno State on Oct. 10 (20 assists, 14 digs) and vs. Boise State (27 assists, 11 digs).

AZTEC VETERANS

- SDSU returns three starters and the libero from a team that compiled a mark of 14-15 overall and 9-9 in Mountain West play (tie-6th).
- Those starters include outside hitters Alexis Cage and Ciara Brown plus middle blocker Kaja Sandberg and libero Alexa Saba.
- Cage and Brown finished one-two in kills for the Aztecs at 3.00 and 2.75 per set respectively.
- Sandberg hit .284 and averaged 1.91 kills and 0.99 blocks per set while Saba had 2.86 digs per set from the back line.

Other returnees who saw significant playing time include outside hitter Baylee Little (1.96 kps) and middle blocker Cassie O'Hara (1.35 kps, 0.81 bps) along with defensive specialists Danielle Bolden (1.80 dps) and Devyn Pritchard (2.97 dps).

THE REDSHIRT

- Also back is redshirt freshman middle blocker Deja Harris.
- Harris played briefly in two matches early in the 2014 campaign before missing the remainder of the season due to injury.
- In the three sets in which she appeared she totaled one kill, one service ace and a block.

FIVE FRESHMEN

- Among the eight new players on the roster this season are five true freshmen.
- Outside hitter Alexandra is a member of the Greek national team who was named Rookie of the Year in the Greek national league's top division.
- Outside hitter Alexis Harris was a second-team all-state selection in Nevada and is the younger sister of middle blocker Deja Harris.
- Outsider hitter Bailey Osborn was an all-state selection by *MaxPreps* and was her league's Player of the Year last season.
- Setter Lauren Utchen was an all-league honoree and league player of the year as senior in 2014.
- Outside hitter Alyssa Mathis was an allarea honoree the past two seasons at her high school in Florida.

TRANSFERS ADDED

- The Aztecs have also added one fouryear transfer and a pair of junior college athletes to their 2015 roster.
- Emma Fuzie comes to SDSU after two seasons as a middle blocker at Pepperdine.
- Setter Hailey Jones was a two-time allstate selection at Irvine Valley JC where she led her team to the state championship last season.
- Middle blocker Jordan Conole arrives at SDSU from Pierce JC where she was a second-team all-Western States Conference honoree as a freshman.

UP NEXT

- San Diego State will be on the road for one match next week before returning home for its season finale on Nov. 24.
- That contest is a match against San Jose State on Saturday, Nov. 21, at 1:00 p.m. (PT) in Spartan Gym.
- The Aztecs will return home for a contest on Tuesday, Nov. 24, vs. Nevada at 6:00 p.m. on Aztec Court to wrap up the 2015 season.
