Aztec Softball Heads to No. 4/5 LSU's Purple & Gold Challenge

San Diego State continues its challenging non-conference schedule this weekend when it travels to Baton Rouge, Louisiana, for the Purple & Gold Challenge, hosted by No. 4/5 LSU.

The Aztecs (8-6), who are receiving votes in both national polls, play games against McNeese (1:30 p.m. CT) and LSU (6:30 p.m. CT) on Friday, Louisiana Tech (2:30 p.m. PT CT) and LSU (5 p.m. CT) on Saturday, and Illinois at 10 a.m. CT Sunday. The five participating teams have combined to go 43-18 (.705) on the season.

Out of San Diego State's 14 games so far this season, 11 have come against teams that made the 2023 NCAA tournament (the Aztecs are 5-6 in those games) and seven have been against nationally ranked squads (SDSU is 2-5). San Diego State's upcoming opponents this weekend McNeese and LSU (two games) both made the NCAA tournament last season with the latter hosting an NCAA regional.

Lala Maccario leads the Aztec offense in many categories, including average (.343), runs (13), walks (8), stolen bases (10) and on-base percentage (.467). Mac Barbara, the Mountain West Preseason Player of the Year, is hitting .303 with three home runs and 16 RBIs, slugging .606 with a .425 on-base mark.

Allie Light, the defending MW Pitcher of the Year and the preseason pitcher of the year, leads a pitching staff that has combined to record a 2.11 ERA with 51 strikeouts in 96 innings. Light is 4-2 with a 2.11 ERA in 38 1/3 innings, striking out 23 with nine walks. The right-hander was named the MW Pitcher of the Week on Monday for the fifth time of her career for her play last week at the Mary Nutter Collegiate Classic (2-1 with a 1.97 ERA in 10 2/3 innings).

Both of SDSU's games against host LSU will be broadcast on SEC Network and ESPN+.

STACEY NUVEMAN DENIZ
HEAD COACH | 3RD SEASON (16TH OVERALL) | UCLA, 2002

- Was named San Diego State's fifth head coach in program history on June 8, 2021, taking over for SDSU's all-time winningest head coach Kathy Van Wyk.
- Helped lead SDSU to seven straight NCAA tournaments from 2009-15 and a combined 398-264 (.601) record in her 14 seasons on The Mesa as an assistant coach, associate head coach and head coach in waiting.
- In her first season as SDSU's head coach in 2022, San Diego State went 39-16 (.712) for the second-best winning percentage in school history, winning the Mountain West regular-season title for the first time since 2014.
- Was named the Mountain West Coach of the Year in 2022 in her first season as head coach.
- Is 86-39 (.688) as head coach at San Diego State, leading the Aztecs to a Mountain West Tournament title in 2023.
- Was the head coach of the National Pro Fastpitch's Chicago Bandits for the 2018 season, leading the Bandits to the NPF Championship series in her first year.
- Also has served as an assistant coach for the Women's National Team and USA Softball Junior Women's (19-Under) Selection Camps.
- As a player, was a three-time U.S. Olympian, winning gold medals in 2000 and 2004, and a silver medal in 2008. Also helped the United States National Team to a World Cup championship (2006), two World Championships (2002 and 2006) and two Pan American gold medals (1999 and 2003).
- Was a standout player at UCLA, finishing her four-year career with four NCAA records - 90 home runs, .945 slugging percentage, 240 walks and 81 intentional walks. She was a four-time first-team NFCA All-American (1997, 1999, 2001-02) and a three-time Pac-10 Player of the Year (1999, 2001-02).
- In 1999, Nuveman Deniz led the Bruins to a national championship, batting .446 during the season with 31 home runs and 91 RBIs.

The Aztecs continue their tough competition to start the season this weekend when the head to the Purple & Gold Challenge, hosted by LSU in Baton Rouge, Louisiana.

The Purple & Gold Challenge is the third and final tournament hosted by the Tigers this season after hosting and winning both the LSU Invitational (Feb. 9-11) and the Tiger Classic (Feb. 22-25).

This weekend's tournament includes No. 4/5 LSU, rv/rv SDSU, --/rv McNeese, Illinois and Louisiana Tech with the five teams combining for a 43-18 (.705).

On the docket for San Diego State are games against McNeese (1:30 p.m. CT) and LSU (6:30 p.m. CT) on Friday, Louisiana Tech (2:30 p.m. PT CT) and LSU (5 p.m. CT) on Saturday, and Illinois at 10 a.m. CT Sunday.

Notes on the Season so Far

* SDSU finished the 2023 campaign with a 39-17 record, advancing to the program's first super regional after capturing the NCAA Los Angeles Regional, and being ranked No. 18 in the final ESPN/USA Softball poll and 19th in the final USA Today/NFCA Coaches Poll.

* San Diego State, which was one win away from making the Women's College World Series, won the Mountain West tournament, the first held since 2006, with a perfect 3-0 record after finishing second in regular-season play.

* The Aztecs are off to an 8-6 start through 14 games with nine played at home (4-5), three neutral (3-1) and one on the road (1-0).

* Out of SDSU's 14 games, 11 have been against teams that made the 2023 NCAA tournament. San Diego State is 5-6 in those games.

* The Aztecs have already played seven teams who are nationally ranked, going 2-5 in those games with wins over then No. 25/rv Kentucky, 2-1, on Feb. 10 and then No. 11/13 Missouri, 3-2, on Feb. 22.

* The largest margin of defeat for SDSU this season is seven runs in a 7-0 loss to three-time defending NCAA champion and No. 1/1 Oklahoma on Feb. 24.

* Out of San Diego State's six losses, one has been by one run, three have been by two runs, one was by three runs and one was by seven runs.

* The Aztecs are only hitting .242 as a team, but much of that can be attributed to the teams they have played. Three all-Mountain West performers from a year ago have yet to get on track in Bella Espinoza (.270 this season with four runs and three stolen bases, .393 last season with 57 runs and 30 stolen bases), Makena Brocki (.150 this season with three RBIs and one extra-base hit, .297 last season with 33 RBIs and 19 extra-base hits) and Cali Decker (.111 this season with 0 RBIs and a .273 on-base percentage, .368 last season with 40 RBIs and a .462 on-base percentage). Although Espinoza did go 5-for-12 (.417) with three runs last weekend at the Mary Nutter Collegiate Classic.

* UCF transfer Lala Macario leads the Aztecs in average (.343), on-base percentage (.467), runs (13), walks (8) and stolen bases (10) despite missing a game.

* Mac Barbara (.303) has continued to provide pop with three of SDSU's four home runs and 16 of its 44 RBIs, despite missing two games

last weekend, while slugging .606 with a .425 on-base mark. Barbara is the Mountain West preseason player of the year.

* San Diego State's pitching staff has continued to produce, combining for a 2.11 ERA and 51 strikeouts in 96 innings against just 18 walks.

* Defending MW Pitcher of the Year and the preseason pitcher of the year Allie Light leads the way with a 4-2 record to go along with a 1.28 ERA in 38 1/3 innings, striking out 23 with nine walks and limiting the opposition to a .264 average.

* Light was named the MW Pitcher of the Week on Monday after going 2-1 with a 1.97 ERA in 10 2/3 innings at the Mary Nutter Collegiate Classic, pitching in three games (all against 2023 NCAA tournament teams) with two starts. Light struck out six with three walks allowed.

Allie Light Named MW Pitcher of the Week

San Diego State senior pitcher Allie Light (Lexington, S.C.) has been named the Mountain West Pitcher of the Week, the league announced Monday. It is the first MW weekly award of the season for the right-hander and fifth of her career.

Light, the defending MW Pitcher of the Year and preseason MW Pitcher of the Year, helped the Aztecs (8-6) to a 3-1 record last weekend at the Mary Nutter Collegiate Classic, including wins over No. 11/13 Missouri and Nebraska. Light was 2-1 with a 1.97 ERA in 10 2/3 innings, pitching in three games (all against 2023 NCAA tournament teams) with two starts. Light struck out six with three walks allowed.

Light picked up the win against No. 11/13 Missouri on Thursday night after allowing one unearned run on four hits and a walk over five innings, striking out one. Light recorded her second victory the following day vs. Nebraska after tossing four scoreless innings of relief, allowing four hits and no walks, while striking out five. Light's only loss was on Saturday against three-time defending NCAA champion and No. 1/1 Oklahoma, where she allowed five runs (three earned) on six hits and two walks over 1 2/3 innings, starting the game and coming back to pitch in the sixth.

On the season, Light is 4-2 with a 1.28 ERA across 38 1/3 innings and 10 appearances (five starts). She has struck out 23 with nine walks allowed.

Aztec Softball Receiving Votes in Both National Polls

The San Diego State softball team is still receiving votes in both national polls, which were released on Tuesday.

In the USA Today/NFCA Coaches Poll, the Aztecs have 24 points, up from nine points the week before, which are the 29th most in the poll. 25th-ranked Oregon has 51 points, while also receiving votes are Boston Univ. (30), Northwestern (27), Utah (26), San Diego State (24), Auburn (12), Texas State (3), Louisiana (2), Penn State (1) and Wichita State (1). Back-to-back-to-back national champion Oklahoma is first in the poll once again with all 32 first-place votes and 800 votes total.

The USA Today/NFCA Coaches Poll is voted on by 32 NCAA Division I head coaches with one representing each of the DI conferences.

San Diego State received 15 votes in the latest ESPN.com/USA Softball poll, up from 10 in last week's poll. No. 25 is Auburn with 48 points. Those receiving votes are Oregon (26), San Diego State (15), Boston Univ. (14), Louisiana (11), Utah (9), Northwestern (9), Texas Tech (4), Wichita State (4), Indiana (2), McNeese (1) and Louisville (1).

SDSU Picked to Win MW; Mac Barbara, Allie Light Named Preseason Players of the Year

The San Diego State softball team has been picked to win the Mountain West, while Mac Barbara (player) and Allie Light (pitcher) have been chosen as the league's preseason players of the year, the league announced Jan. 31.

Barbara and Light were joined on the 15-player preseason team by fellow Aztecs Cali Decker and Bella Espinoza. This was the first time in MW history that preseason players of the year and a preseason all-conference team were announced.

The preseason poll, players of the year and all-conference team were voted on by the league's nine head coaches.

SDSU picked up 64 points, including eight of the nine first-place votes. Defending regular-season champion Boise State is second with 57 points and the other first-place vote, while Colorado State (46), Fresno State (41), Nevada (37), UNLV (28), Utah State (19), New Mexico (17) and San Jose State (15) round out the voting.

Barbara made her second straight MW first team last season after being named the MW Player of the Year in 2022. Barbara batted .358 (57-for-159) a year ago with 13 home runs, 45 RBIs, 34 runs, nine doubles, a triple and 33 walks, while slugging .673 with a .469 on-base mark. Barbara, a two-time first-team All-NFCA West Region (2022-23) player, was even better in league play, hitting .459 (28-for-61) with eight home runs, 24 RBIs and 18 runs in 24 games, drawing 14 walks with a .902 slugging percentage and a .564 on-base percentage.

Light, meanwhile, was named the MW Pitcher of the Year in 2023, while also making her first all-conference team (first team) and first appearance on the all-NFCA West Region (second team). A four-time MW Pitcher of the Week, including three straight weeks from March 28-April 11, Light was 15-7 with a 1.90 ERA and a school-record seven saves in 132 2/3 innings. She started 17 games and played in 40 overall, playing a part in six Aztec shutouts, and striking out 106 with 20 walks, while limiting the opposition to a .218 average. Light was even better in MW play, going 7-1 with two saves and a 1.37 ERA across 61 1/3 innings, striking out 36 against 12 walks, while limiting the opposition to a .213 average.

Decker made the most of her first season on The Mesa in 2023, batting .368 (56-for-152) with six home runs, 40 RBIs, 29 runs, four doubles and 26 walks, posting a .513 slugging percentage and an .462 on-base mark en route to becoming a second-team NFCA all-West Region pick and a second-team all-MW selection. Decker hit .386 (22-for-57) in MW play with a home run, 14 RBIs, 15 runs and 12 walks, owning a .456 slugging percentage and a .493 on-base percentage. She was also named to the all-Mountain West Tournament team, batting a team-high .700 (7-for-10) with a home run, five RBIs and two runs. In nine postseason games overall (three in MW tournament, six in NCAA tournament), she hit .429 (12-for-28) with three homers, 13 RBIs and four runs, slugging .750 with a .467 on-base mark.

Espinoza made her second straight all-MW team a year ago (first team in 2022, second team in 2023), leading SDSU in batting average (.393), runs (57), hits (75), stolen bases (30) and at-bats (191). Espinoza's 70 singles were a SDSU single-season record, and she also ranked second in single-season history in stolen bases (30), third in runs (57), tied for third in hits (75) and eighth in batting average (.393). In MW play, Espinoza batted .352 (25-for-71) with 25 runs and 13 stolen bases and later made the all-MW Tournament Team after hitting .545 (6-for-11) with five runs and two stolen bases in just three games.
