► **The Records:** With just two games left in the regular season, the San Diego State women's basketball team's seed for next week's MWC tournament is still in doubt, as the Aztecs travel to Brigham Young (14-12, 4-8 MWC) Thursday and Utah (21-5, 11-1 MWC) Saturday. SDSU rounded out its home schedule with a split, as both games went down to the wire. The Aztecs defeated Air Force, 52-50, but then fell to New Mexico, 47-44, to head into this week at 8-17 overall and 3-9 in conference play.

SDSU will need a win in its first contest against the Cougars to have a chance to move into the No. 6 spot at the MWC tournament.

► **SDSU Head Coach Jim Tomey:** Tomey (Michigan '81) is in his second season at San Diego State after taking over the Aztec helm on April 9, 2002. His career and Aztec head coaching record is 17-35.

► **BYU Head Coach Jeff Judkins:** Judkins is in his third season with the Cougars and boasts a career record of 57-29.

► **BYU Series History:** BYU leads the series, 17-9 (Last: BYU def. SDSU, 82-50, in San Diego, 2/7/04).

► **Utah Head Coach Elaine Elliott:** Elliott is in her 21st season at Utah and owns a school and career record of 434-176.

► **Utah Series History:** Utah leads the series, 18-10 (Last: Utah def. SDSU, 56-29, in San Diego, 2/5/04).

SDSU Women's Hoops Closes Out Regular Season At Brigham Young, Utah

The San Diego State women's basketball team plays four of its final six regular season games on the road for the second consecutive year. The Aztecs travel to Brigham Young and Utah with their seeding for next week's Mountain West Conference tournament still in doubt.

SDSU is coming off a 1-1 split in its last two home games, as both went down to the final seconds. The Aztecs ended up on the winning side in a 52-50 decision over Air Force Thursday, only to see their place reversed two days later in a 47-44 loss to second place New Mexico.

Aztecs Nearly Get Upset Of New Mexico

In a much different game than the two schools' meeting earlier this season, the San Diego State women's basketball team's one-point lead slipped away in the final seconds, falling to second-place New Mexico, 47-44, Saturday night in front of the Aztecs' largest home crowd of the season (871) at Peterson Gym. SDSU, which suffered a 76-42 loss to the Lobos last month in Albuquerque, dropped to 8-17 overall and 3-9 in Mountain West Conference play. New Mexico improved to 18-7 overall and 10-2 in the league, winning its sixth straight.

Aztec freshman **Courtney Fritz (Newberg, Ore.)** led the team in scoring for the second straight game, finishing with 14 points, including four three-pointers. Fritz was helped by classmate **Michelle Elliott (Pasco, Wash.)**, who added three triples and tallied 13 points in all. Junior **Candace Mattson (Alpine, Utah)** had a team-best eight rebounds and added seven points, while **Nicolette McCartney (Chicago, Ill.)**, playing in her final home game as an Aztec, had two blocks and three steals.

Other New Mexico Notes

SDSU trailed by as many as 10 points at 20-10 with 5:58 remaining in the first half ... the loss snapped a nine-game Aztec win streak in Peterson, dating back to the 1996-97 campaign ... the three-point margin ties as the smallest in the 28-game all-time series between the two schools (also in SDSU's last win over New Mexico, 56-53, in San Diego, Feb. 15, 2001) ... the Aztecs held the Lobos to 14 points below their conference season scoring average.

On The Top Of Turnovers

The Aztecs tied their season low for turnovers in a game with 10 against New Mexico Saturday. SDSU has committed less turnovers than its opponent in each of its last three games and 17 times overall this year, exceeding its 2002-03 total from a year ago by four.

The 10 turnovers against the Lobos matches SDSU's total versus league-leading Utah on Feb. 5, which are the fewest by an Aztec squad since the 1996-97 campaign. That team had 10 turnovers or less in a game three times with the most recent being the WAC tournament game on March 7, 1997, versus Hawai'i when SDSU had exactly 10.

On The Line

Just one game removed from its best-ever free throw performance in an MWC outing, San Diego State failed to go to the charity stripe until just 13 seconds remained in the game against New Mexico Saturday night. The Aztecs then were unable to convert on their only free throw attempts, which would have all but clinched the upset.

SDSU's two free throw attempts were a season low, while the team failed to record a free throw in a game for just the fourth time in its history.

With two conference games left, SDSU opponents have gone to the free-throw line 80 more times than the Aztecs, making 250 trips to SDSU's 170.

San Diego State has gone to the charity stripe more times than their opponent in just three MWC games, owning a 18-9 margin versus Utah, an 18-13 mark at Wyoming and a 20-16 advantage versus Air Force.

Aztec opponents own a slightly smaller advantage in overall games at 484-433. A year ago, the Aztecs took 84 fewer free throws than their opponents and 43 less in MWC contests. The MWC mark includes a school-record zero trips to the charity stripe at home versus Utah.

Three-Ball

San Diego State has gotten back on track from beyond the arc, making 22 threes in its last four games, after making only five in its previous four outings. Courtney Fritz has led the way, accounting for over half of the team's total with 12 on 29 opportunities. **Michelle Strawberry (Corona, Calif.)**, who started the season just 3-for-26, has made five of her last eight, while Michelle Elliott has four three's all in the last two games. Candace Mattson made just her sec-

ond three-pointer of the season on Saturday against New Mexico with her first coming in the team's second game versus Nevada.

Overall, six Aztecs have made at least one three-pointer in 2003-04, combining for 110 on 361 attempts. SDSU needs 15 more three pointers (124 - 2001-02) and 29 more attempts (389 in 1998-99) to set team single-season record in both categories.

Fritz For Three

Aztec freshman Courtney Fritz continued to add to her season three-point total with a 4-for-12 performance against New Mexico. Fritz was held without a trey during the team's last home-stand, but has made 12-of-29 since.

With her four three-pointers against the Lobos, the freshman moved from seventh to fifth on the Aztec single-season list with 54. She needs nine more to move up a spot past Falisha Wright's 1994 season total of 62.

Fritz's 12 three-point attempts, a season-high, Saturday also moved her up in that category, jumping from ninth all the way to sixth. Fritz needs two more tries to secure the fourth place slot, going past Wright and Jamey Cox, who had 148 in 1993 and 2002, respectively.

For the season, Fritz has made at least one three in 20 of 25 games, including a span of 13 straight from Dec. 10 to Jan. 31.

More About The Three

Not only has she moved up in the season books, Courtney Fritz has already etched her name in the Aztec career list for three-pointers. Fritz is eighth overall and trails Jodi Nowlin-Tres (1994-97) for the No. 7 spot by just four.

Fritz's classmate Michelle Elliott has 30 this season and figures to be among the top 10, if not this year, but certainly early in 2004-05.

Forecasting the MWC Tourney

If the season ended today, SDSU would earn the No. 7 seed in next week's MWC tournament in Denver and would face New Mexico for the fourth time in five tries in the first round.

Two games, however, remain for the Aztecs to make a move upward. The team needs a victory over BYU, which sits just one game ahead in the league standings, to set up the potential for the No. 6 seed.

SDSU can't go any higher than the No. 6 seed or

were unable to match that effort on the offensive end, falling to the visiting Utes, 56-29.

- The Utes, ninth nationally in scoring defense, held the Aztecs to 19 percent shooting from the floor.

- Michelle Elliott and sophomore **Veronica Shaw (Phoenix, Ariz.)** led the Aztecs in scoring with eight points each and sophomore **Ashlee Dunlap (Los Angeles, Calif.)** grabbed nine rebounds.

- Utah was led offensively by Kim Smith, who tallied 16 points and 13 rebounds.

A Force In The First Half

Fourteen times this season, an Aztec player has reached double-figures in points in the first half.

Sophomore Ashlee Dunlap has led the charge, tallying 10 or more points in the first half six times, including against UNLV last week. Freshmen Michelle Elliott and Courtney Fritz are close behind with double-figures in four games, including a 13-point outburst in the first half by Fritz versus Air Force on Thursday.

In The MWC

Through games of March 1, Ashlee Dunlap is the league's third-leading rebounder with her 8.1 rpg., while she is third in defensive (3.04/g) and offensive boards (5.20/g) and blocked shots (1.16/g). Courtney Fritz is second in three-pointers (2.16/g) and Nicolette McCartney is tied for third with Dunlap in blocks (1.16/g).

In MWC contests, Veronica Shaw is third in steals (2.09/g), Fritz is second in three-pointers (2.17/g) and McCartney is second in blocks (1.17/g).

Seeing Double

After a three-game dry-spell, Michelle Elliott has reached double-figures in scoring in four of her last six outings, bringing her season total in that category up to a team best 18. For the season, Elliott is SDSU's leading scorer with 12.4 ppg., a stat that ranks her eighth overall and first among freshmen in the Mountain West Conference.

20 Or More

With Michelle Elliott's career high 21 points against BYU on Feb. 7, three different Aztecs have been able to reach the 20-point mark six times this season. Elliott, sophomore Ashlee Dunlap and freshman Courtney Fritz have each scored 20 or more points in a game twice.

The six times an Aztec has scored 20 or more points in 2003-04, is just one short of the team's total in the same category in 2000-01. That year, five different players combined to score 20 or more points in a game seven times.

Double-Double

Ashlee Dunlap has 11 double-doubles in 2003-04, one more than she had last season and tied for the conference lead with UNLV's Sherry McCracklin. Dunlap is still in her third place spot in Mountain West Conference career history with the 21 double-doubles. Linda Frohlich (UNLV) owns the MWC record of 43, while Carrie Bacon (WYO) is second with 23 and McCracklin, a junior, is three behind Dunlap with 19.

A year ago, Dunlap had 10 double-doubles in 27 games, including one in each of the team's final two contests.

A.D. On The Boards

Ashlee Dunlap has tallied double-figures in rebounding in an MWC best 12 times overall in 2003-04. For her career, the sophomore has 23 double-figure rebounding performances in her 52 career games and has tallied nine boards in five others.

Other Aztec Notes

SDSU has just 10 active players on its roster with freshmen **Jessica Huettl (Eau Claire, Wis.)** and **Jordie Smith (Ft. Collins, Colo.)** both out due to injury ... all available players have seen action for the Aztecs in nine of the last 14 contests ... the Aztecs have outrebounded their opponent in 10 games this year after doing so only five times (once in league play) in 27 outings in 2002-03 ... SDSU has held four opponents to 20 points or less in the first half ... an Aztec opponent has scored 20 points or less six times in either the first or second half.
