OPENING TIPS

• Utah State leads the nation in 3-point field goal percentage (.427) and is fourth in effective field goal percentage (.578).

• Junior guard **Steven Ashworth** is third in the nation in 3-point field goal percentage (.486), and leads the Mountain West and ranks ninth in the nation in 3s made per game (3.45), while grad forward **Taylor Funk** is second in the MW and 26th in the nation in 3-point FG percentage (.424), and is second in the conference and 46th in the nation in 3-pointers made per game (2.79).

• Utah State is one of eight teams in the nation with five players averaging in double figures in **Ashworth** (15.7 ppg), **Funk** (14.2 ppg), junior guard **Max Shulga** (12.0 ppg), grad forward **Dan Akin** (11.8 ppg) and senior guard **Sean Bairstow** (10.5 ppg).

• Utah State's bench leads the Mountain West and is 19th in the nation in points per game (28.95). Utah State is 13-2 this season and 22-8 all-time under head coach **Ryan Odom** when the Aggie reserves outscore their opponents. USU's bench has outscored its opponents 579-348 (29.0 to 17.4) this season as its reserves have accounted for 35.9 percent of Utah State's points.

• Utah State has recorded all but three of its victories under **Odom** (30-8) when winning the battle of the boards. USU has won the rebounding battle in all but four games this season. In total, Utah State has outrebounded opponents 713-625 this season.

• An Aggie has logged a double-double in nine games this season as **Akin** has posted five double-doubles (10p/11r vs. Bradley; 21p/15r at San Diego; 12p/10r vs. Weber State; 11p/13r vs. Fresno State; 16p/15r vs Wyoming), **Shulga** has had three (10p/10r vs. Oral Roberts; 10p/10a vs. Utah Tech; 12p/10r vs Seattle U) and **Funk** has posted three (18p/14r vs. UVU; 22p/12r vs. Santa Clara; 15/10 at Nevada). **Akin** ranks first in the nation in double-doubles off the bench with five.

• Utah State has scored at least 80 points in half of its games, including a season-high 106 against Westminster. Utah State is 33-9 under **Odom** when scoring at least 70 points and is a perfect 22-0 under **Odom** when scoring at least 80 points.

• Utah State has recorded 15 or more assists in 40 of its last 54 games. When the Aggies record 20 or more assists under **Odom**, USU is 21-1. USU has dished out over 20 assists eight times this season.

• Utah State is second in the MW and 12th in the nation with 17.55 assists per game. **Shulga** is fourth in the MW in assists per game (4.50), while **Ashworth** is fifth (4.40).

• Utah State is 34th in the NCAA net rankings (as of Jan. 23) and is ranked 46th by KenPom. Overall, USU is 0-2 in Quad 1 games, 5-0 in Quad 2, 7-0 in Quad 3 and 3-2 in Quad 4.

TEAM NOTABLES

HOT OUT OF THE GATE

• Utah State opened the season 9-0 for the best start in school history, along with the 1938-39 and 1917-18 teams.

• Utah State went 11-2 in non-conference play for its best non-conference record since the 2019-20 squad went 11-2.

• Utah State's 16-4 mark through the first 20 games is the best since the Aggies were 18-2 through their first 20 contests in the 2010-11 season.

SPLASHTOWN, USA - PART I

• Utah State leads the nation in 3-point field goal percentage (.427) and is 12th in 3-pointers made per game (10.20).

• Junior guard **Steven Ashworth** is third in the nation in 3-point field goal percentage (.486), and leads the Mountain West and ranks ninth in the nation in 3s made per game (3.45).

• Grad forward **Taylor Funk** is second in the MW and 26th in the nation in 3-point FG percentage (.424), and is second in the conference and 46th in the nation in 3-pointers made per game (2.79).

• Utah State has made at least eight 3-pointers in 15 of its 20 games this season and double-digit 3-pointers in 11 of its 20 games.

• Utah State is 21-2 when making 10 or more 3-pointers under head coach **Ryan Odom**.

SPLASHTOWN, USA - PART II

• Utah State is shooting 42.7 percent (204-of-478) from behind the arc, which currently ranks second on the single-season record list. Overall, USU has finished a season shooting over 40 percent from 3-point range just eight times in program history:

• Utah State junior guard **Steven Ashworth** is currently shooting 48.6 percent (69-of-142) from behind the arc, which ranks fourth on the single-season record list. Only one Aggie has ever finished a season shooting 50.0 percent from behind the 3-point line (**Brian Green**, 2009-10):

• Utah State is the only team in the nation to have five players shooting above 40.0 percent from behind the arc with at least 20 attempts this season:

SPLASHTOWN, USA - PART III

• Utah State set a school record with 21 made 3-pointers in its win against Westminster, breaking the previous mark of 20 treys set during the 2005-06 season at New Mexico State.

• Utah State's 19 made 3-pointers against Oral Roberts are the third-most in school history.

• Utah State shot a season-high 64.7 percent (11-of-17) from behind the arc against Washington State, which is the best mark in the MW the season and tied for 18th in the nation with a minimum of 10 makes from long distance.

• Utah State shot 61.3 percent from behind the 3-point line against Oral Roberts, which was the best shooting percentage for a USU team from behind the arc since shooting 61.9 percent (13-of-31) against UNLV during the 2016-17 season. The 61.3 shooting percentage is the second-best in the MW this year and the 38th-best in college basketball with a minimum of 10 made 3-pointers.

• Utah State is the only team in the nation to shoot over 50 percent from behind the arc while making at least

19 3s in two games this season: 61.3 percent (19-of-31) vs. Oral Roberts; 56.8 percent (21-of-37) vs. Westminster.

• The 21 made 3-pointers are the most by an MW team this year and tied for the fifth-most in college basketball, while the 19 made 3-pointers are tied for the second-most by an MW team and tied for 15th in the nation.

• Utah State was 14-of-29 (.483) from 3-point range against San Diego and those 14 made treys are tied for the fifth-most in a single-game in school history.

SPLASHTOWN, USA - PART IV

• Junior guard **Steven Ashworth** made a career-high eight 3-pointers against Oral Roberts, which tied for the third-most in a single game in school history.

• **Ashworth** shot 88.9 percent (8-of-9) from behind the arc against ORU, which was the eighth-best shooting percentage from behind the arc in a single game in program history.

• Junior guard **Max Shulga** was 5-for-5 from 3-point range as he scored a career-high 20 points at San Diego. Overall, **Shulga** is just the seventh player in school history to have a perfect shooting percentage from behind the arc with a minimum of five attempts.

• Sophomore forward **Zee Hamoda** shot 85.7 percent (6-of-7) from behind the arc against Westminster, which is tied for the 10th-best shooting percentage from behind the 3-point line in a single game in school history.

HOT SHOOTING

• Utah State is second in the MW and 17th in the nation in field goal percentage, shooting 48.8 percent (555-of-1,137) from the field this season.

• Utah State is 25-1 under head coach **Ryan Odom** when shooting 50 percent or better from the field.

• Utah State has shot over 60 percent from the field twice (60.9 percent vs Westminster; 60.4 vs Washington State).

• Overall, Utah State has shot over 50 percent from the floor 12 times this season.

• Utah State shot 50.0 percent (31-of-62) from the field in its game against San Francisco, capping a five-game streak the Aggies had shot at least 50 percent from the field. The last time USU shot 50.0 percent or better from the field in five-straight games was during the 2004-05 season, when the team had both a seven- and eight-game stretch.

AGGIES SCORE 80 AGAIN AND AGAIN

• Utah State has scored at least 80 points in 10 of its 20 games, including a season-high 106 points against Westminster.

• Utah State is 33-9 under head coach **Ryan Odom** when scoring at least 70 points. The Aggies have won just one game under **Odom** when scoring less than 70 points (Fresno State, 67-54 - Dec. 31, 2022).

• USU is a perfect 22-0 under **Odom** when scoring at least 80 points.

• Utah State had a six-game stretch scoring 80-plus points for the first time since the 2019-20 team scored 80-plus points in each of its first six games of the season.

BENCH MOB

• Utah State's bench leads the Mountain West and is 19th in the nation in points per game (28.95).

• An Aggie reserve has led the team in scoring in eight of the 20 games this season. Junior guard **Steven Ashworth** has led the Aggies off the bench five times, grad forward **Dan Akin** has led the Aggies twice and sophomore forward **Zee Hamoda** has led USU twice.

• Utah State is 13-2 this season and 22-8 all-time under head coach **Ryan Odom** when the Aggie reserves outscore their opponents.

• Utah State's bench has outscored its opponents 579-348 (29.0 to 17.4) this season as its reserves have accounted for 35.9 percent of USU's points.

• Utah State has had at least two bench players score in double figures in eight of its games this season as the Aggies are 8-0 when multiple bench players score in double figures during the campaign.

• Utah State's bench is shooting 52.6 percent (193-of-367) from the field, 49.3 percent (66-of-134) from behind the arc and 72.2 percent (127-of-176) at the free throw line this season.

DID YOU KNOW?

• Utah State has lost only two games under head coach **Ryan Odom** when holding its opponent to fewer than 60

points (10-2).

• Utah State won its first game under **Odom** when scoring less than 70 points with a 67-54 victory over Fresno State (Dec. 31).

WINNING THE CLOSE ONES

Utah State is 4-2 this season in games decided by five points or less after going 2-8 in such games a year ago.

OFFENSIVE NOTABLES

• Utah State has held a double-digit lead in 16 of its 20 games this year, while only five opponents (LMU, SMU, Boise State, Nevada & San José State) have led USU by double figures.

• Utah State has outshot its opponent in 16 of 20 games this season, including in 12 games from 3-point range. USU has also had more assists than its opponent in 15 of its games this year and has recorded more blocked shots in 13 games.

MISCELLANEOUS NOTABLES

• Utah State has outscored its opponents in the paint in 12 of its 20 games this year and has an overall advantage of 648-584 in points in the paint on the season.

• USU also has a 261-248 advantage in points off turnovers, a 202-171 advantage in second-chance points and 215-125 advantage in fast break points on the season.

AGGIES IN THE NET

• Utah State is 34th in the NCAA net rankings (as of Jan. 23) and is ranked 46th by KenPom.

• Utah State has had at least four players score in double figures in all but six games this season as USU is 12-2 when at least four Aggies score 10 points or more.

• Utah State has had six players score in double figures twice this season (Westminster & Washington State).

• Utah State is one of eight teams in the nation with five players averaging double figures in junior guard **Steven Ashworth** (15.7 ppg), grad forward **Taylor Funk** (14.2 ppg), junior guard **Max Shulga** (12.0 ppg), grad forward **Dan Akin** (11.8 ppg) and senior guard **Sean Bairstow** (10.5 ppg).

DOUBLE-DOUBLE, TOIL AND TROUBLE

• An Aggie has logged a double-double in nine games this season as graduate forward **Dan Akin** has posted five double-doubles (10p/11r vs. Bradley; 21p/15r at San Diego; 12p/10r vs. Weber State; 11p/13r vs. Fresno State; 16p/15r vs. Wyoming), and junior guard **Max Shulga** has had three (10p/10r vs. Oral Roberts; 10p/10a vs. Utah Tech; 12p/10r vs. Seattle U) and graduate forward **Taylor Funk** has posted three (18p/14r vs. UVU; 22p/12r vs. Santa Clara; 15/10 at Nevada).

• **Akin** leads the nation in double-doubles off the bench with five.

REBOUNDING TO VICTORY

• Utah State has recorded all but three of its victories under head coach **Ryan Odom** (30-8) when winning the battle of the boards.

• USU has won the rebounding battle in all but five games this season.

• In total, Utah State has outrebounded opponents 713-625 this season.

• Utah State has also notched all but two of its victories

under **Odom** (32-7) when recording more defensive rebounds than its opponents.

• Utah State has logged more defensive rebounds than all but four of its opponents this season.

• The Aggies rank third in the MW and 38th in the nation with 27.40 defensive rebounds per game.

SHOOTING TO VICTORY

• Utah State has notched all but one of its victories under head coach **Ryan Odom** (33-1) when recording a better field goal percentage than its opponent.

• The Aggies are 16-0 this season when shooting better from the field than their opponent.

• Utah State has recorded each of its victories under **Odom** (34-10) when three or more players score in double figures.

• Utah State is 16-3 this season when at least three Aggies score in double figures.

ASSISTING VICTORIES

• Utah State has recorded 15 or more assists in 40 of its last 54 games.

• When the Aggies record 20 or more assists under head coach **Ryan Odom**, USU is 21-1. USU has dished out over 20 assists eight times this season.

• Utah State is second in the MW and 12th in the nation with 17.55 assists per game.

• Junior guard **Max Shulga** is fourth in the MW in assists per game (4.50), while junior guard **Steven Ashworth** is fifth (4.40).

• Multiple Aggies have dished out at least five assists in the same game eight times this season, including a season-best three Aggies in the wins against Westminster (**Shulga 9, Sean Bairstow 6, Ashworth 6**) and against UNLV (**Ashworth 9, Taylor Funk 5, Shulga 5**).

• Utah State is 30-7 under head coach **Ryan Odom** when it has more assists than its opponent.

• Utah State has dished out more than 15 assists in all but five of its games this season.

WIN THE HALF, WIN THE GAME

• Utah State is 27-9 under head coach **Ryan Odom** when leading at the half.

• The Aggies have led at the break in 28 of their last 37 games, including 14 of their 20 games this year.

WHAT IT TAKES

• In its 16 wins this season, Utah State is averaging 83.6 points, 36.3 rebounds, 18.8 assists, 5.1 steals and 3.8 blocks per game, while shooting 51.2 percent (465-of-908) from the field, 45.5 percent (171-of-376) from behind the arc and 74.4 percent (236-of-317) at the free throw line.

• Conversely, Utah State averages 68.6 points, 33.0 rebounds, 12.8 assists, 3.3 steals and 3.5 blocks per game in its four losses, while shooting 39.3 percent (90-of-229) from the floor, 32.4 percent (33-of-102) from behind the 3-point line and 73.8 percent (62-of-84) at the free throw line.

• In USU's wins, the Aggies have held their opponents to 69.0 points, 30.5 rebounds, 12.3 assists, 5.8 steals and 2.3 blocks per game, shooting 40.8 percent (390-of-957) from the floor, 34.8 percent (119-of-339) from behind the 3-point line and 74.1 percent (206-of-278) at the charity stripe.

• In its losses, USU opponents average 79.8 points, 34.3 rebounds, 17.3 assists, 5.0 steals and 2.5 blocks per game, while shooting 50.6 percent (119-of-235) from the floor, 48.5 percent (33-of-68) from behind the 3-point line and 75.0 percent (48-of-64) at the free throw line.

NATIONAL LEADERS - TOP 50

• Utah State leads the nation in 3-point field goal percentage (.427) and is fourth in effective field goal percentage (.578).

• USU also ranks in the top 50 nationally in 3-pointers made per game (10.20, 11th), assists per game (17.55, 12th), field goal percentage (.488, 17th), bench points per game (28.95, 19th), assist-to-turnover ratio (1.42, 21st), points per game (80.60, 22nd) and defensive rebounds per game (27.40, 38th).

• Junior guard **Steven Ashworth** is third in the nation in 3-point field goal percentage (.486), while he is ninth in 3s made per game (3.45) and 11th in assist-to-turnover ratio (3.10).

• Graduate forward **Taylor Funk** is 26th in the nation in 3-point field goal percentage (.424) and 46th in 3-pointers made per game (2.79).

MOUNTAIN WEST - TOP FIVE

• USU leads the MW in 3-point field goal percentage (.427), effective FG percentage (.578), 3-pointers made per game (10.20) and bench points per game (28.95).

• The Aggies also rank in the top five in the league in assists per game (17.55, 2nd), field goal percentage (.488, 2nd), assist-to-turnover ratio (1.42, 2nd), points per game (80.60, 2nd), defensive rebounds per game (27.40, 3rd), scoring margin (+9.45, 3rd), free throw percentage (.743, 3rd), blocks per game (3.70, 4th), rebounding margin (+4.40, 5th) and rebounds per game (35.65, 5th).

• Junior guard **Steven Ashworth** leads the MW in 3-point field goal percentage (.486), 3s made per game (3.45) and assist-to-turnover ratio (3.10).

• **Ashworth** also ranks in the top five in the MW in free throw percentage (.843, 4th), assists per game (4.40, 5th) and points per game (15.70, t-5th).

• Graduate forward **Dan Akin** is second in the league in both double-doubles (5), third in defensive rebounds per game (5.85) and fifth in rebounds per game (7.40).

• Graduate forward **Taylor Funk** ranks second in the Mountain West in both 3-point FG percentage (.424) and 3s made per game (2.79), while he is tied for fifth in double-doubles (3).

• Junior guard **Max Shulga** ranks fourth in the conference in assists per game (4.50) and is tied for fifth in double-doubles (3).

CROSSING THE CENTURY MARK

Utah State scored a season-high 106 points in its victory over Westminster. It marked the first time this year that USU has scored 100 points and the first time it has hit the century mark under head coach **Ryan Odom**. It was also the most points scored by an Aggie team since the 2020-21 team posted a 107-62 home win against San José State.

DON'T CALL IT A COMEBACK

• Utah State overcame its then-largest deficit of the season (13) in its 79-67 neutral-site victory against LMU (Dec. 10). Prior to its game against the Lions, USU had not trailed an opponent by double digits during the season.

• Utah State trailed San José State for nearly 32 minutes in USU's 75-74 home victory. The Aggies led for just over four minutes of the game as a free throw from junior guard **Max Shulga** with just over five seconds to go sealed the Aggies' one-point victory.

NO-LOSS NOVEMBER

Utah State went undefeated (5-0) in the month of November for the first time since the 2008-09 campaign (4-0).

WE'RE GOING TO OVERTIME

• Utah State improved to 64-48 all-time in overtime games, including a 30-30 road record, after beating San Diego. Overall, USU is 9-2 in its last 11 overtime games, including a 3-1 record under head coach **Ryan Odom**.

• Utah State was 5-of-6 (.833) from the field, including 2-for-2 from 3-point range and 1-for-2 at the free throw line in overtime of its win at San Diego, scoring 13 points in the extra five minutes.

PLAYER NOTABLES

SPLASHWORTH DOMINATION

• After scoring nine points in the season opener against Utah Valley, junior guard **Steven Ashworth** scored in double figures in 14-straight games, including 28 points against Bradley (11/11/22), a career-high 30 points against Oral Roberts (11/22/22) and 27 points against Utah Tech (12/1/22). All three of **Ashworth's** 25-plus scoring outings were off the bench.

• **Ashworth** has shot 75.0 percent or better from the floor in two games this season and has shot better than 50.0 percent from behind the arc 12 times.

• In his last 16 games, **Ashworth** is averaging 15.6 points, 4.1 assists and 3.1 rebounds, while shooting 48.1 percent (75-of-156), including 49.6 percent (57-of-115) from 3-point range.

• **Ashworth** has attempted 73.6 percent (142-of-193) of his shots from behind the arc, as 74.2 percent (69-of-93) of his makes come from downtown.

• **Ashworth** has also dishered out at least three assists in all but three games this season.

ASHWORTH SETS SCHOOL RECORD

• Junior guard **Steven Ashworth** was the first player in school history to make at least seven 3-pointers in consecutive games as he was 8-of-9 from behind the arc against Oral Roberts (11/22/22) and 7-of-12 from behind the arc against Utah Tech (12/1/22).

• Overall, **Ashworth** is one of just two players in school history to make seven or more 3-pointers in multiple games in

a career, along with **Jaycee Carroll**, who made a career-high 10 treys at New Mexico State in 2006 and eight treys against UC Santa Barbara in 2005.

• **Ashworth** is one of just 17 players in the country and the only player in the MW with multiple games of seven or more 3-pointers.

ASHWORTH ALL-TOURNAMENT

Junior guard **Steven Ashworth** was named to the Hawaiian Airlines Diamond Head Classic all-tournament team after averaging 14.7 points, 3.67 assists, 3.3 rebounds and 1.67 steals per game to lead the Aggies to a third-place finish.

FUNK NOT IN A FUNK

• Graduate transfer forward **Taylor Funk** is one of the Utah State leaders in every category as he ranks second in points (14.2 ppg) and rebounds (5.7 rpg), tied for second in blocks (0.8 bpg), ranks fourth in steals (0.7 spg) and fifth in assists (2.0 apg).

• **Funk** has scored in double figures in all but four games this season, including five 20-plus point outings.

• In his last six games, **Funk** is averaging 15.8 points and 4.5 rebounds per game, while shooting 55.0 percent (33-of-60) from the floor and 57.1 percent (20-of-35) from behind the arc.

AKIN ADJUSTING WELL

• After scoring six points, to go along with five rebounds and five turnovers off the bench in his Aggie debut, graduate transfer forward **Dan Akin** has played extremely well as he has scored in double figures 13 times and has recorded a team-best five double-doubles.

• In his last 19 games, including his first start as an Aggie versus Westminster, **Akin** is averaging 12.1 points and 7.5 rebounds per game, while shooting 60.9 percent (78-of-128) overall and 69.8 percent (74-of-106) at the free throw line.

• **Akin** was named the America First Credit Union USU Student-Athlete of the week on Jan. 2. **Akin** led Utah State led Utah State to a 67-54 win against Fresno State in the Aggies' Mountain West opener. The 6-foot-9, 225-pound grad senior forward logged his fourth double-double of the season with 11 points and a game-high 13 rebounds, including a game-high-tying three offensive boards. He also recorded one steal and one block, while tying his season high with seven makes at the free throw line.

SHULGA POSTS THREE DOUBLE-DOUBLES

• Junior guard **Max Shulga** had consecutive double-doubles, the first of his career, after logging 10 points and 10 rebounds against Oral Roberts (Nov. 22), and 10 points and 10 assists against Utah Tech (Dec. 1).

• **Shulga** logged his third-career double-double against Seattle U at the Hawaiian Airlines Diamond Head Classic with 12 points and 10 rebounds (Dec. 22).

• Overall, **Shulga** has scored in double figures in 13 of his last 17 games, which is a career high.

• During his last 17 games, **Shulga** is averaging 12.4 points, 4.8 assists and 4.6 rebounds per game, while shooting 47.0 percent (62-of-132), including 37.3 percent (26-of-67) from 3-point range and 82.7 percent (62-of-75) from the free throw line.

BAIRSTOW NAMED PLAYER OF THE WEEK

• Senior guard **Sean Bairstow** is a two-time America First Credit Union USU Student-Athlete of the Week honoree (Dec. 12; Dec. 26). He was the first MBB player to earn player of the week accolades this season.

• Against LMU on Dec. 10, he had 14 points, a then-career-high-tying seven rebounds, a career-best six assists, one block, one steal and zero turnovers in 34 minutes. **Bairstow** shot 63.6 percent (7-of-11) from the field in the game.

• During the week of Dec. 19-25, **Bairstow** averaged 14.0 points, 4.3 rebounds, 2.3 assists and 0.5 blocks per game, while shooting 51.2 percent (21-of-41) from the field and a team-best 57.1 percent (8-of-14) from behind the arc. **Bairstow** shot at least 50 percent from the field in all for games last week, while shooting 66.7 percent from behind the arc against both SMU (4-of-6) and Washington State (2-of-3).

• **Bairstow** has scored in double figures in 11 of his last 14 games, averaging 11.7 points, 4.3 rebounds and 2.8 assists per game, while shooting 52.0 percent (66-of-127) from the field, including 45.2 percent (14-of-31) from 3-point range.

DIAMOND HEAD DORIUS

• Senior center **Trevin Dorius** had some of his best games of the season at the Hawaiian Airlines Diamond Head Classic, averaging 6.7 points, 5.3 rebounds, 1.3 blocks, 1.0 assists and 0.7 steals at the tournament.

• During the tournament, **Dorius** tied his career high in points (12), free throws made (4) and assists (2) against Washington State, while he had a career-high-tying two blocks against both Seattle U and SMU.

• Against Washington State, **Dorius** also had season highs in

• During his last three games, **Dorius** is averaging 9.7 points, 3.0 rebounds, 1.7 blocks and 1.0 steals per game, while shooting 55.0 percent (11-of-20) from the field and 77.8 percent (7-of-9) at the free throw line.

HAMODA'S CAREER NIGHT

Sophomore forward **Zee Hamoda** scored a career-high 28 points in the win against Westminster as he played a career-high 28 minutes. He also had a career-high four steals and tied his career high with three assists. **Hamoda** was 10-of-12 from the field and 6-of-7 from 3-point range, all of which are career highs. His 85.7 percent shooting from 3-point range is tied for the eighth-best shooting percentage from behind the arc in school history.

GUARDS PLAYING WELL

• Utah State's guards in senior **Rylan Jones**, junior **Steven Ashworth** and junior **Max Shulga** have combined for 221 assists to 96 turnovers so far this year.

• **Jones** has had two games this year (vs. Utah Valley and Santa Clara) where he had eight assists and zero turnovers.

• **Ashworth** had a career-high nine assists and just one turnover at San Diego, to go along with a five-assist, zero-turnover performance against Utah Valley, and a four-assist, one-turnover outing against Santa Clara, Loyola Marymount and Boise State. He is tied for sixth in the nation in games with at least three assists and zero turnovers with five games.

TEAM NOTES

* Utah State improved to 69-22 all-time against San José State, including a 40-4 home record. USU has now won nine straight and 30 of the last 31 overall in the series. USU has also now won 30 straight games at home against SJSU and improved to 18-1 against the Spartans in Mountain West play.

* Utah State improved to 10-1 at home on the season and 19-8 at home under head coach Ryan Odom. Overall, USU is now 34-20 under Odom, which includes a 13-12 Mountain West record.

* Utah State is now 4-2 on the season and 6-9 under Odom in games decided by five or less points.

* Utah State improve to 33-9 under Odom, including a 15-3 record this year, when scoring at least 70 points.

* Utah State trailed 37-30 at the half and improved to 3-2 on the season and 5-9 under Odom when trailing at the half.

* Utah State shot 53.8 percent (28-of-52), marking the 12th time this year, and second straight game, it has shot over 50 percent. USU is now 16-0 on the season and 33-1 under Odom when shooting better than its opponent as San José State made 43.5 percent (27-of-62) of its shots.

* Utah State was 10-of-23 (.435) from 3-point range, marking the 11th time this season and second straight game, that it made double-digit treys.

* Utah State finished the game with 19 assists and improved to 15-0 on the season and 30-7 under Odom when it has more assists than its opponent as San José State finished the game with 14 assists.

* Utah State improved to 3-2 on the season and 4-10 under Odom when getting outrebounded as San José State had a 33-27 advantage on the glass. SJSU also had 17 offensive rebounds, which is tied for the most by an Aggie opponent this year (San Diego). Overall, it is just the third time this season that USU has allowed double-digit offensive rebounds by an opponent (Seattle).

* Utah State had just three double-digit scores for the second straight game and sixth time this year.

UTAH STATE RALLIES BACK FROM DOUBLE DIGITS TO BEAT SJSU 75-74

LOGAN, Utah – And, the streak lives on. But, just barely.

In danger of seeing its 29-game home winning streak against San José State snapped by the Spartans, Utah State rallied from as many as 11 points down, including by six with less than five minutes to go, to eke out a 75-74 victory on Saturday at the Dee Glen Smith Spectrum.

Junior guard Max Shulga made the second of two free throw attempts with five seconds left to give the Aggies (16-4, 5-2 Mountain West) their final margin of victory over the gritty Spartans (12-8, 3-4 MW).

SJSU had a chance to win it at the buzzer, but Alvaro Cardenas' 3-point attempt was off the mark, preserving the Aggies' win and extending their home winning streak over the Spartans to 30.

Cardenas finished with 17 points for San José State, which has not won in Logan since Feb. 25, 1982. The Spartans' Tibet Gorener led all scorers in the game with 20 points off the bench, while Omari Moore had 16 points and eight assists for the visitors.

Junior guard Steven Ashworth led the Aggies with 19 points and six assists, Shulga had 15 and grad senior forward Dan Akin had 13 points and a team-best seven rebounds off the bench.

A jumper by Moore gave SJSU a 70-64 advantage with 4:42 to go in the game, but USU clawed back and regained the lead when Ashworth drilled a 3-pointer to make it 74-72 with 1:44 remaining.

The Spartans' Sage Tolbert tied it at 74-apiece with 1:25 left when he scored on a layup, setting up the down-to-the-wire finish.

Utah State found itself in unfamiliar territory on the afternoon. For just the fifth time this season, including only the second in conference play, the Aggies found themselves trailing at the half.

Grad senior forward Taylor Funk gave the Aggies a 10-9 lead with 12:53 remaining in the opening half when he sank a trio of free throws after being fouled while attempting a shot from beyond the arc.

Akin made it 12-9 less than 30 seconds later on a dunk, but the Spartans countered with a 20-7 run to open a 29-19 lead with 5:26 left until the break. SJSU was up 37-26 with 2:02 to go before USU closed the half on a 4-0 run.

Utah State shot a sizzling 53.8 percent from the field on the day (28-of-52), including 43.5 percent from beyond the arc (10-of-23), but just 69.2 percent from the free throw line (9-of-13).

The Aggies had 19 assists on their 28 made baskets, but were outrebounded 33-27.

Defensively, Utah State held SJSU to 43.5 percent shooting from the field (27-of-62), including 45.5 percent from 3-point range (10-of-22). The Spartans shot 90.9 percent from the charity stripe (10-of-11).

RYAN ODOM

Head Coach • 160-101 (Nine Seasons) • Second Season at Utah State • Hampden-Sydney

Ryan Odom was named the head men's basketball coach at Utah State on April 5, 2021. In all, Odom is 150-97 (.607) in eight years as a head coach and has 26 years of collegiate coaching experience.

In his first season in Logan, Odom led the Aggies to an 18-16 overall record, including 8-10 in MW play, and their fourth-straight NCAA postseason berth as USU hosted Oregon as an at-large seed in the opening round of the NIT. Odom's 18 victories during the 2021-22 season marked the fourth-most by a first-year head coach in Utah State history. Under his tutelage, senior forwards Justin Bean and Brandon Horvath were each named all-Mountain West, earning second-team and third-team honors, respectively. Utah State's offense ranked second in the league in scoring (73.4 ppg) and field goal percentage (.476), while leading the MW and ranking fifth nationally in assists per game (18.0). The Aggies were also tops in the MW with an assist-to-turnover ratio of 1.44.

Odom came to Utah State after spending five years as the head coach at the University of Maryland, Baltimore County (UMBC), leading the Retrievers to a 97-60 (.573) record, including a 50-29 mark in the America East Conference. In the 2018 NCAA Tournament, UMBC became the first-ever 16-seed to win a first round game as it posted a 74-54 win against top overall seed Virginia.

In his five years at UMBC, Odom coached three of the top four win-producing teams in school history and set a program record by winning 20 or more games in three consecutive seasons, including a school-record 25 victories during the 2017-18 campaign.

In 2020-21, Odom led UMBC to a 14-6 record, including a 10-4 league mark. Following the year, he was named the National Association of Basketball Coaches (NABC) District 1 Co-Coach of the Year. Odom also earned America East Conference Coach of the Year honors after leading the Retrievers to a share of the regular-season title and the No. 1 seed in the America East Playoffs.

The 2018-19 Retrievers advanced to the championship game of the America East Tournament after posting a 21-13 record, including an 11-5 conference mark, for its third-straight 20-win season.

In his second year at UMBC, Odom and the Retrievers posted a 25-11 record, including a 12-4 league mark, to finish second in the America East and set a school record for wins. UMBC also won an America East Conference title at prohibitive favorite Vermont and followed that up by engineering the first victory by a No. 16 seed over a No. 1 seed in NCAA Men's Basketball Tournament history. UMBC overwhelmed the tournament's top overall seed, Virginia, 74-54, in Charlotte, N.C., earning an ESPY nomination for the "Best Moment" of the year. Following the season, Odom earned the 2018 Hugh Durham Award as the nation's top mid-major coach.

After taking over a program that finished 7-25 in 2015-16, Odom led UMBC to its first winning season since 2007-08 with a 21-13 record, as the Retrievers advanced to the semifinals of

the 2017 CollegeInsider.com Tournament (CIT). UMBC finished the 2016-17 campaign as the nation's third-most improved team, with a +13.0 mark, behind only Minnesota and UCLA. Odom's team posted three wins in the CIT and became the first America East team to win three games in a postseason tournament.

At the end of the season, Odom earned the 2017 Joe B. Hall Award, which is presented annually to the top first-year coach in Division I.

Before serving as the head coach at UMBC, Odom was the head men's basketball coach at Lenoir-Rhyne (N.C.) University for one year (2016). The Bears (21-10) advanced to the NCAA Division II Regional Finals for the first time in school history and won 20 games in a season for the first time in eight years. Lenoir-Rhyne improved by 10.5 games from the previous campaign, led the nation in 3-point field goals made per game (12.4), and finished ninth in the country in scoring at 90.1 points per game.

Odom was also an assistant coach at Charlotte for five seasons (2011-15), including serving as the interim head coach for the final 19 games of the 2014-15 campaign. In 2013, he helped the 49ers earn a bid to the postseason NIT.

Prior to his tenure in Charlotte, Odom spent seven years (2004-10) on the coaching staff at Virginia Tech and was part of a Hokies' team that earned a berth to the NCAA Tournament in 2007 and beat Illinois in the first round.

Odom was also an assistant coach at American for three years (2001-03), at UNC Asheville for one season (2000) and at Furman for two years (1998-99). He also served as an administrative assistant at South Florida for one season (1997).

Odom graduated from Hampden-Sydney in 1996 with a bachelor's degree in economics and was a four-year starting point guard on the men's basketball team. He served as team captain his senior season and led Hampden-Sydney to an 80-30 record during his playing career, including two berths in the NCAA Division III Tournament. In addition, Odom finished his career as the school's all-time leader in 3-pointers made and placed fourth in assists.

Ryan is the son of Dave Odom, who retired in 2008 as the head coach at South Carolina. The elder Odom earned SEC Coach of the Year honors while at South Carolina in 2004 and ACC Coach of the Year honors in 1991, 1994 and 1995, while at Wake Forest.

Odom and his wife, Lucia, have two sons - Connor and Owen.
