San Diego State Postgame Notes vs. Cal State San Marcos

Final Score: (rv/rv) San Diego State 86, Cal State San Marcos 48

Notes

- * San Diego State won its 22nd consecutive exhibition game.
- * Tonight's game was sold out (12,414). It marks the fourth-straight time and fourth time in school history an exhibition game has sold out.
- * SDSU started seniors Winston Shepard and Skylar Spencer, junior Dakarai Allen, sophomore Trey Kell and freshman Jeremy Hemsley.
- * All 11 Aztecs who saw action scored and had at least one made field goal.
- * Six Aztecs scored at least seven points.
- * SDSU shot 16 for 33 in both the first and second halves for a game total of 48.5 percent.
- * San Diego State held Cal State San Marcos to single digits made field goals in both halves (9 in the first, 6 in the second).
- * The Aztecs held advantages in rebounding (45-37) and in all the specialty stats, including points in the paint (46-14), points off turnovers (21-8), second-chance points (14-9), fastbreak points (20-2) and bench points (40-5).

Player Notes

Winston Shepard – 22 points, 6 rebounds, 5 assists, 2 steals, 26 minutes

Led all players in scoring (22 points) and assists (5), while grabbing six rebounds... His scoring total would have been a career high (previous: 21), along with his field goal count (10)... Finished the game by making 10 of 15 from the field... His rebound total was tied for the second-highest on the team (Zylan Cheatham).

Skylar Spencer – 9 points, 10 rebounds, 2 blocked shots, 18 minutes

Had a team-high 10 rebounds, which was also tied for game-high honors (CSUSM's Ben Dickinson)... Finished with a game-high-tying two blocked shots (Trey Kell).

Angelo Chol – 11 points, 3 rebounds, 1 blocked shot, 1 steal, 17 minutes

Scored 11 points, which would have been a career high... Made 4 of 5 field-goal attempts... The four makes would have tied a career high as well.

Ben Perez – 13 points, 1 rebound, 1 assist, 1 blocked shot, 2 steals, 19 minutes

Reached double figures in scoring in his first appearance in an Aztec uniform... Was nearly perfect from the floor, making 5 of 6 from the field, including 3 of 4 from behind the arc... Was one of three with multiple steals (Dakarai Allen – 3, Winston Shepard – 2).
