Aztec Softball Wraps Up Regular Season on the Road This Weekend Against Utah, BYU

The San Diego State softball team wraps up its Mountain West Conference regular season on the road this weekend when it takes on Utah and first-place Brigham Young.

The Aztecs (30-22, 6-10 MWC) will meet the Utes (24-23-1, 4-11 MWC) in a doubleheader Thursday in Salt Lake City, beginning at 2 p.m. MT. SDSU will then play the Cougars (37-17, 13-3 MWC) in a pair of solo games at 6 p.m. MT Friday and 2 p.m. MT Saturday in Provo. Friday's game will be televised live on BYU-TV and will be broadcast on The Mtn. at 5 p.m. PT Saturday. As always, both Aztec games can be followed via gametracker on the Internet at www.goaztecs.com.

SDSU went 1-3 against the two schools at home in the opening weekend of conference play. The Aztecs fell to BYU, 4-0 (8 innings) and 4-2, before splitting with Utah (W, 3-0, and L, 0-1 in 10 innings). The Cougars are first in the league, while SDSU and the Utes sit in fifth and sixth, respectively.

Last Week With the Aztecs

The Aztecs went 1-1 last week, splitting a doubleheader at home versus UNLV (W, 5-3 and L, 0-1). SDSU batted .245 over the two games and was led by freshmen Brittany Knudsen (San Diego/Escondido HS) and Lindsey Marquez (Tustin, Calif.), who each went 2-for-5. Sophomore Monica Alnes (Rancho Palos Verdes, Calif.) also added two hits. Junior Christina Ross (Santa Clarita, Calif.) went 0-1 but posted a 0.78 ERA and picked up her second save of the season. She struck out 14 and limited her opponents to a .161 batting average. Sophomore Melissa Owens (San Diego/Christian HS) struck out five and allowed three runs to pick up the victory in Saturday's game.

SDSU outhit UNLV, 8-5, in the game ... LF Brittany Knudsen went 2-for-2 and had what proved to be the game-winning triple in the fourth inning. She reached safely in all four plate appearances ... CF Tamani Wells, RHP Melissa Owens and SS Monica Alnes each singled and scored a run ... 2B Lindsey Marquez had her SDSU season-long 13-game hit streak snapped, but did drive in two runs and walked twice ... RF Dani Sidoti added a single and an RBI ... Owens allowed three runs on five hits to improve to 9-8. She struck out five and did not give up a walk ... LHP Christina Ross tossed two hitless innings of relief with three strikeouts to earn her second second save of the season.

► **UNLV 1, SAN DIEGO STATE 0**

The Aztecs loaded the bases in the bottom of the seventh with one out but was unable to come up with a tying run in a 1-0 loss ... SDSU left eight runners on base, a day after stranding 11 in a win ... RF Lindsey Marquez had two of the Aztecs' four hits in the game, including a double in the second inning ... 2B Amanda Beasley, who was playing her final regular season home game along with DP Christy Hollingshead, added a one-out double in the fifth ... LHP Christina Ross allowed just one run, which came on a two-out double in the first inning, on five hits over seven innings ... She struck out 11 without issuing a walk.

A Look at Utah

Utah is coming into its doubleheader with San Diego State on a bit of a hot streak, having two of its last three games, including an impressive 8-0 victory at New Mexico last Saturday. Diana Phillips leads the squad in batting with a .385 average. She is also tops in runs (38), hits (57), triples (4), walks (28) on-base percentage (.486) and stolen bases (8). Hailey Davenport (.367, 14 HR, 34 RBI) and Kara Foster (.296, 16 HR, 46 RBI) have combined for 30 homers. Meghan Dyer is 16-13 with a 2.28 ERA and a league-high 257 strikeouts. Karina Cannon is 7-9 with a 2.77 ERA in 129 innings. Utah leads the all-time series, 43-24, after the two teams split earlier this year. SDSU won the first game on April 6, 3-0, and the Utes won the Saturday game, 1-0, in 10 innings.

Noting Brigham Young

Brigham Young comes into the weekend as one of the hottest teams in the nation. The Cougars have won 17 of 18 games, 22 of 25 and are undefeated at home at 12-0. They sit atop the league at 13-3 with four games to play. BYU can win the conference outright with a combination of two win or two UNLV losses. Jennifer Whiteley leads the league with a .418 average, and is tops on the squad in hits (69), triples (4) and on-base percentage (.478). Jodi Norton (.354, 22 HR, 55 RBI), Angeline Quiocho (.343, 12 HR, 25 RBI, 15 SB) and Emi Snow (.310, 12 2B, 15 HR, 45 RBI) each have 10-plus home runs. The Cougars lead the all-time series, 16-15, taking two games (4-0 (8 innings) and 4-2) in San Diego earlier this season. The road team has won the last six games in the series.

SDSU Competes With Best in Nation

The Aztecs haven't received a vote in six weeks after struggling in Mountain West play. In the Week 8 ESPN.com/USA Softball poll, the Aztecs had one point, which tied them for 35th with Houston, Kansas and Penn State, a mere 25 points from No. 25 Fresno State. SDSU has gone 7-10 since that week which is baffling considering its tough non-conference schedule leading up to the grind of league action. The Aztecs have certainly made their case for a national ranking and a NCAA tournament bid for the second consecutive season. Consider the following: SDSU is 4-6 against top-25 schools this season with three of its losses coming by one run, the Aztecs have won six games against teams currently ranked or receiving votes in the latest ESPN.com/USA Softball national poll and San Diego State has defeated two top-10 teams.

Head Coach Kathy Van Wyk

Under 11th-year head coach Kathy Van Wyk's leadership, the Aztecs have won three of the last six (2002, 2003, 2006) Mountain West Conference regular-season titles, advanced to the NCAA tournament three times in the past six seasons, including regional runner-up finishes in 2001 and 2006, and compiled a .600 or higher winning percentage in five of the last six campaigns. SDSU has improved its winning percentage in six of the last eight seasons and have been .500 or better in eight of Van Wyk's 10 years.

Under Van Wyk's guidance, the Aztecs had their best season in school history in 2006 with a 34-15 record, culminating with a runner-up finish to host UCLA in the NCAA Regional. En route to its third MWC regular season championship in the last six seasons, SDSU set numerous team records including winning percentage (.694), conference winning percentage (.833), home winning percentage (.769), road winning percentage (.692) and most MWC victories (15).

In addition, despite playing only 49 games (SDSU typically plays around 60 games), the Aztecs set program records in batting average (.293), runs (234), home runs (27), RBI (213), slugging percentage (.410), walks (161) and on-base percentage (.379).

Her accomplishments were rewarded when she was named the 2006 MWC Coach of the Year for the second time in her career (2002 was the other time).

It would be hard to outdue last year's offense as it set school records in batting average (.293), runs (234), home runs (27), RBI (213), slugging percentage (.410), walks (161) and on-base percentage (.379), but the 2007 SDSU offense is definitely making its case. Through 50 games, the Aztecs are batting .301, which would be a school record. SDSU also needs just 15 runs (the Aztecs play four more MWC games) to set a school record in runs ... Despite hitting at sea level while the other five teams hit at elevation (New Mexico - 5,000 feet, Colorado State - 4,800, Brigham Young - 4,553, Utah - 4,500 and UNLV - 2,030), the Aztecs are second in batting average (.301), triples (12) and in stolen bases (65) ... SDSU has reached double-figures in hits on 15 occasions in 52 games, after doing so 15 times all of last season ... The Aztecs, however, have also had nine hits on six other occasions ... Four SDSU players - Brittany Knudsen (.394), Melissa Owens (.352), Lindsey Marquez (.345) and Tamani Wells (.339) - are batting over .300 (min. 100 at-bats) this season. Only two Aztecs (Erin Flores, .388) and Monica Alnes (.379) were over .300 last year.
