### WHAT'S ON TAP THIS WEEKEND IN AZTEC BASEBALL

- ◆ With no mid-week contest this week, San Diego State will next be in action when it hosts a four-game series against Northwestern this weekend.
- ◆ That set of contests gets underway on Thursday, March 10, at 6:00 p.m. at Tony Gwynn Stadium.
- ◆ The Aztecs and Wildcats will hook up for a doubleheader on Friday (March 11) with the first game set to get underway at 2:00 p.m.
- ◆ The series will conclude on Saturday, March 12, with a single game set for a 1:00 p.m. start.

### AZTECS ON THE AIR

- ◆ All four of SDSU's games vs. Northwestern this week will broadcast live on KCR Radio, San Diego State's campus station.
- ◆ KCR will broadcast a total of 17 games this season while seven others will be carried on ESPN 1700 in San Diego.
- ◆ A total of 11 of San Diego State's 30 home games this season will be streamed live on the Mountain Digital Network.
- ◆ Seven contests later in the season will be carried live on local radio on 1700 AM.

### SERIES RECORD

- ◆ SDSU and Northwestern will be meeting for the first time ever on the baseball field this week.

### SCOUTING THE WILDCATS

- ◆ Northwestern's record stands at 4-8 start and the Wildcats will visit Illinois-Chicago for a game Tuesday evening prior to arriving in San Diego.
- ◆ The Wildcats' top hitters include outfielder Matt Hopfner (.386, 4 2B, 5 RBI) and shortstop Jack Dunn (.362, 3 2B, 3 RBI).
- ◆ Northwestern has two pitchers from the San Diego area. Senior lefty Reed Mason attended Torrey Pines HS in Solana Beach while junior right-hander Evan Schreiber graduated from La Costa Canyon HS.
- ◆ The Wildcats are hitting .290 as a team with a 4.71 earned run average.

### NEVAREZ TAKES HIS CHANCE

- ◆ Freshman infielder Dean Nevarez has the team's highest batting average (.391) after appearing in seven of the first 12 games of the season.
- ◆ He has made five starts, both as the designated hitter.
- ◆ He went 5-for-12 with an RBI and two runs scored in last weekend's series vs. Fresno State.
- ◆ Nevarez recorded a season-high three hits in the win over the Bulldogs on Sunday.

### GAME WINNING RBI

- ◆ Second baseman Justin Wylie leads the Aztecs with seven RBI this season.
- ◆ He has recorded the game-winning RBI in each of SDSU's two wins.
- ◆ At UC Irvine on Feb. 23, his RBI double to score Spencer Thornton broke a 2-2 tie in the Aztecs' 4-2 victory.
- ◆ On Sunday (March 13) vs. Fresno State, his bases-loaded RBI single drove home Thornton to put SDSU ahead 5-4 in the won over the Bulldogs

### CALABUIG HITS AWAY

- ◆ After hitting just .111 (3-for-27) over the first eight games of the season, center fielder Chase Calabuig has caught fire at the plate over the past four contests.
- ◆ In those most recent four games he has gone 8-for-15 (.533) with a double, RBI and two runs scored.
- ◆ He has also drawn two walks for a .588 on-base percentage.

### PYATT DEBUTS

- ◆ Redshirt freshman Harrison Pyatt turned in his second impressive start of the season vs. University of San Diego on March 1.
- ◆ In that contest he tossed six innings allowing no runs on a hit with three walks and five strikeouts.
- ◆ Pyatt made his Aztec debut with the start at UC Irvine on Tuesday, Feb. 23.
- ◆ He pitched five innings allowing one run on just three hits while striking out four.
- ◆ In his two starts, he has a 0.82 earned run average (11 IP) while in his two relief stints his ERA is 18.00 (1 IP).
- ◆ Pyatt has struck out 12 in 12 innings and opponents are hitting .154 against him.

## NEW STARTING PITCHERS

- ◆ Two first-year Aztecs made their collegiate starting debuts on the mound last week and both responded well.
- ◆ Freshman Dominic Purpura started the series opener vs. Fresno State on March 4 and tossed 3.1 innings allowing just a hit with two walks and a strikeout.
- ◆ Junior Adrian Orozco made his first start on Saturday (March 5) vs. Fresno State and went 2.2 innings allowing just a hit while striking out four as he retired the first eight batters he faced.

## HELDMAN SAVES

- ◆ Senior Brian Heldman recorded his (and SDSU's) first save of the 2016 season in the win at UC Irvine last week.
- ◆ He tossed the final two innings allowing one hit and hitting a batter to preserve the Aztecs' two-run lead.
- ◆ The save was the second of Heldman's two-year Aztec career.
- ◆ Last season he served primary as a late-inning set-up reliever.

## GOOD START

- ◆ Two Aztec newcomers recorded hits in their first collegiate at bat during the season-opening series vs. No. 14 Oregon.
- ◆ Jordan Verdon singled to right center field in his first plate appearance in Friday night's contest.
- ◆ Fellow freshman Dean Nevarez delivered a single to center in his first plate appearance as a pinch hitter in Saturday's game.

## GOING DEEP

- ◆ Senior left fielder Spencer Thornton hit SDSU's first home run of the season, a two-run shot in the series finale vs. Oregon on Feb. 21.
- ◆ Thornton is leads the Aztecs in runs scored with seven.
- ◆ On March 1 vs. USD he drove in SDSU's first run with a sacrifice fly to center.
- ◆ Last week at UC Irvine, his leadoff double in the eighth inning started SDSU's two-run rally that broke a 2-2 tie and sent the Aztecs to a 4-2 victory.

## DOUBLING UP

- ◆ Sophomore third baseman David Hensley recorded a double in each of the first two games of the season and added a third in the win at Irvine on Feb. 23.
- ◆ Last season he finished with four doubles in 24 contests.

## STREAKS

- ◆ Alan Trejo has the team's longest current hitting streak at eight games.
- ◆ The next best current streaks of four games belong to Chase Calabuig and Dean Nevarez.
- ◆ Spencer Thornton had a seven-game streak come to an end on March 1 in the game vs. San Diego.
- ◆ Trejo has reached base safely (via hit, walk or hit by pitch) in all 12 games this season
- ◆ Trejo also leads the Aztecs with six multiple-hit contests.



### NEW COACHES

- ◆ The Aztecs have added a pair of new coaches to their staff for the 2016 season: Pitching Coach Sam Peraza and Volunteer Assistant Joey Centanni.
- ◆ Peraza arrives at SDSU after two seasons at Florida International. He also had previous experience at Cal State Northridge, Cal State Los Angeles and Eastern Oklahoma State.
- ◆ He is a 2002 graduate of San Diego State, where he pitched during the 2002 season.
- ◆ Centanni played four seasons as a pitcher and first baseman at Pacific, graduating in 2009. After college, he spent one season in the Baltimore Orioles organization before an injury ended his playing career.
- ◆ He later served as an associate scout for the Orioles in the San Diego area and coach locally at Francis Parker High School.

### VETERAN HONOREES

- ◆ Five players who earned individual honors a year ago return for the 2016 season.
- ◆ Second baseman Alan Trejo was named to the all-tournament team at the 2015 NCAA Regional at Lake Elsinore, Calif.
- ◆ Pitcher Jacob Erickson, outfielder Spencer Thornton and designated hitter Justin Wylie earned all-tourney recognition at the 2015 Mountain West Conference Tournament.
- ◆ Outfielder Chase Calabuig was named a Louisville Slugger Freshman All-American and a second-team all-Mountain West selection.

### RETURNING POSITION STARTERS

- ◆ Among the returning starters are two members of the Aztec infield and two outfielders.
- ◆ The infielders include second baseman Alan Trejo (.266, 20 RBI) and first baseman Andrew Brown (.295, 17 doubles, 32 RBI).
- ◆ Brown is likely to begin the 2016 season as the Aztecs' third baseman.
- ◆ Also back are a pair of outfielders: Spencer Thornton (.317, 7 2B, 23 RBI) and Chase Calabuig (.305, 8 2B, 25 RBI).

### RETURNING ON THE MOUND

- ◆ The Aztecs return eight full-time pitchers from last season's staff along with three others who could see time on the mound as well as at positions in the field.
- ◆ In addition to projected starters Marcus Reyes, Cody Thompson and Brett Seeburger, other top returnees includes relievers Jacob Erickson (2-1, 2.64; all-tourney at the Mountain West Tournament) and Brian Heldman (3-1, 3.52, 1 save).
- ◆ Second baseman Alan Trejo, outfielder Chase Calabuig and catcher CJ Saylor could also see spot duty on the mound if needed.

### SAYLOR RETURNS BEHIND THE PLATE

- ◆ Junior CJ Saylor will resume duties at the catching position this season after serving at the Aztecs' closer a year ago.
- ◆ In 2015 he compiled a record of 3-3 with 11 saves and a 5.02 ERA.
- ◆ He began his SDSU as a catcher where he hit .212 in 14 games as a redshirt freshman in 2014.
- ◆ Saylor could see occasional action on the mound this season as well.

### PRESEASON ALL-CONFERENCE

- ◆ Outfielder Chase Calabuig has been tabbed to the Preseason All-Mountain West team in a vote of the league's coaches.
- ◆ Calabuig batted .305 with eight doubles and 25 RBIs as season en route to second-team all-conference honors at the end of the 2015 campaign.
- ◆ He was also named a Louisville Slugger Freshman All-American by *Collegiate Baseball* magazine.

### COLLEGE SPORTS MADNESS ALL-MW

- ◆ *College Sports Madness* also named Calabuig to its All-Mountain West first team while four other Aztecs earned second-team honors.
- ◆ That quartet included outfielder Spencer Thornton and third baseman Andrew Brown along with pitchers Marcus Reyes and Cody Thompson.

### DRAFTED AZTECS

- ◆ Three current members of the SDSU squad have been drafted by Major League clubs.
- ◆ That trio includes junior catcher CJ Saylor (33rd rd. in 2012, Los Angeles Dodgers) along with sophomore outfielder Denz'l Chapman (32nd rd. in 2014, Oakland A's) and freshman first baseman Jordan Verdon (24th rd. in 2015, New York Mets).

### AZTECS PICKED AS CO-FAVORITES

- ◆ San Diego State has been picked as co-favorite along with New Mexico to win the Mountain West title in the conference's preseason baseball poll.
- ◆ In a vote of the seven MWC head coaches, the Aztecs received three first-place votes and tallied 32 points as did the Lobos. Fresno State picked up the remaining first-place vote and tied for third in the poll with Air Force.

### AZTEC NOTES

- ◆ Catcher Hunter Stratton has recorded San Diego State's lone triple of the season, that coming in the game vs. Bryant on Feb. 27.
- ◆ SDSU has scored only one run in the first inning this season (vs. Fresno State on March 4). The Aztecs have scored their most runs (nine) in the eighth.
- ◆ Freshman right-hander Chris Collins has made three relief appearances out of the bullpen and allowed no runs on two hits with a walk and four strikeouts over 3.1 innings pitched.
- ◆ Shortstop Alan Trejo and center fielder Chase Calabuig are the only two players to have started all 12 games this season at the same position.
- ◆ Three Aztecs have started all eight games, but not at the same position each time: Justin Wylie (2B-DH), David Hensley (3B-DH) and Spencer Thornton (LF-RF).

### UP NEXT

- ◆ San Diego State will be on the road for four games next week beginning with a contest on Tuesday, March 15, at Cal State Fullerton at 6:00 p.m.
- ◆ The Aztecs will then fly to Colorado for three Mountain West conference games at Air Force.
- ◆ That series will get underway on Friday, March 18, with a contest at 3:00 p.m. (MT) at Falcon Field.
- ◆ The teams will also play a single games on Saturday, March 19, and Sunday, March 20, at 1:00 p.m. (MT) each day.
