49ERS LOOK TO AVENGE 2010-11 SEASON

OPENING LOSS TO SAN DIEGO STATE: Long Beach State will look to avenge a 2010-11 season-opening 81-65 loss to San Diego State when the two teams play Saturday. The Aztecs broke open a close game with a 15-2 run over the last 5:48 last year to claim the win in front of a record crowd of 5,143 at the Walter Pyramid. T.J. Robinson led LBSU with 19 points, while Casper Ware scored 15.

PHELPS, ROBINSON AND WARE PLAYING IN

100TH GAME AT LBSU: Three of Long Beach State's four long-time starters will take the floor for the 100th time in a 49er uniform on Saturday. Casper Ware, T.J. Robinson, and Eugene Phelps will play in their 100th game. Ware will start his 98th game and Robinson his 84th game, while Phelps will make his 61st start. Larry Anderson, who missed six games with a broken hand last season, will play in his 94th game.

49ERS COMING OFF WIN OVER NO. 9 PITT:

Long Beach State is riding the momentum of an impressive 86-76 win over No. 9 Pitt on Wednesday. The win was the first by the 49ers over a ranked team since they beat No. 25 New Mexico State, 84-83, on Feb. 24, 1994. The victory was also just the second by a non-Big East team in the history of the Petersen Events Center, Pitt's home court.

49ERS FACE ONE OF NATION'S TOUGHEST NON-CONFERENCE SCHEDULES, INCLUDING GAMES AGAINST FIVE OF THE NATION'S TOP 13 TEAMS: Long Beach State's 2011-12 non-league schedule is one that few teams can match. The 49ers, who had the nation's top rated non-conference schedule the last two seasons according to a couple websites, will play five teams ranked in the top 13 of this week's *Associated Press* Top 25 poll. The 49ers will face No. 1 North Carolina, No. 8 Louisville, No. 9 Pittsburgh, No. 12 Kansas and No. 13 Xavier. LBSU will play 11 games before Big West Conference action begins, with those opponents combining for a 273-99 (73.4 winning percentage) record last season. Nine of the 49ers' opponents won at least 20 games, with six winning more than 25 games and two winning more than 30 games.

FOUR 49ERS RANK AMONG BIG WEST'S ACTIVE LEADERS, INCLUDING LEAGUE LEADERS IN POINTS, REBOUNDS, ASSISTS AND STEALS: Long Beach State players are the active Big West leaders in points, rebounds, assists, steals, field goals made, free throws made and minutes played. T.J. Robinson leads three categories--points, rebounds and field goals made. Robinson has scored 1,331 points in three seasons at Long Beach State and leads teammate Casper Ware by 33 points. Robinson has 880 career rebounds and leads teammate Eugene Phelps by 382 boards, while making 507 field goals, 97 more than Ware.

In addition to being second in scoring, Ware is the active leader in four categories--assists, steals, free throws made and minutes. He has 441 career assists and leads teammate Larry Anderson by 157. Ware leads Anderson in career steals by 11, 161 to 150, and has played 308 more career minutes than Robinson. Phelps and Anderson also rank among the active leaders in points and blocked shots, while Anderson is also among the leaders in rebounds, field goals made, free throws made and minutes played. Robinson also ranks in the top five in free throws made and minutes played.

WARE NAMED TO 2011-12 JOHN R. WOODEN AWARD PRESEASON TOP 50 LIST: Senior point guard Casper Ware has been named to the John Wooden Award Preseason Top 50 List released by the Los Angeles Athletic Club. The list was based on last year's individual performance and team records, and the players are early frontrunners for college basketball's most prestigious honor. Ware is the first Long Beach State player in school history to be on the preseason Wooden Award watch list.

Ware received a number of postseason honors last season after leading the 49ers to the Big West Conference regular-season title and a berth in the National Invitation Tournament (NIT). He was an honorable mention All-America pick, while also being selected as both the Big West Conference Player of the Year and the Big West Conference Defensive Player of the Year. He was the first player in Big West history to win both awards in the same season, and is the only returning player in the nation to claim both league honors. Ware also earned a spot on the National Association of Basketball Coaches (NABC) All-District 9 Team, as well as a place on the U.S. Basketball Writers Association (USBWA) All-District IX Team, the 2011 Lefty Driesell Defensive All-America Team, and the 2011 Lou Henson All-America Team (the mid-major All-America team).

In 2010-11, Ware led Long Beach State in scoring (17.2 ppg), assists (150) and steals (56), while also finishing second in 3-pointers made (75). Ware finished the season second in the Big West Conference in scoring, while also ranking second in assists (4.4 apg), fourth in steals (1.6 spg), sixth in free throw percentage (.810), fifth in 3-point field goals made (2.2 per game) and seventh in 3-point field goal percentage (.381). He ranked among LBSU's all-time single-season leaders in free throws made (3rd), free throws attempted (6th), 3-point field goals made (7th), 3-pointers attempted (7th), assists (9th), and steals (11th).

Ware was one of 20 finalists for the Bob Cousy award honoring the nation's best point guard, and he claimed Big West Conference Player of the Week honors once after leading the 49ers to wins at UC Davis and Cal State Northridge. Defensively he spearheaded an attack that, in Big West games, helped limit opponents to 60 points or less on seven occasions, all resulting in 49er victories. LBSU was 12-0 in conference play when it held the opponent under 70 points.

WARE AND ANDERSON NAMED TO LOU HENSON PRESEASON ALL-AMERICA TEAM: Seniors Larry Anderson and Casper Ware have been named to the 2011-12 Lou Henson Preseason All-America Team. Ware and Anderson are among the 25 players named to the team which honors the top Mid-Major players in the country. The 49er duo is the only pair of teammates on the team, as well as being the only players from a Big West Conference school to be honored.

WARE MOVES INTO SECOND ALL-TIME IN ASSISTS AT LBSU AGAINST PITT: Casper Ware handed out six assists Wednesday night at Pittsburgh to move into second all-time at Long Beach State in assists, passing Craig Hodges (1978-82). He needs 67 more to pass all-time leader Billy Walker (1984-88) who finished his career with 507.

WARE CLOSING IN ON TOP 10 IN CAREER ASSISTS IN THE BIG WEST CONFERENCE: Not only is Casper Ware threatening the all-time record in assists at LBSU, the 49er guard is also moving his way up the career list in the Big West Conference. Ware needs 37 more to pass San Jose State's Michael Dixon for 12th-place all-time, and he will crack the top 10 passing UNLV's Freddie Banks (1984-87) and LBSU's Billy Walker (1984-88) with 67 more.

WARE NEEDS THREE STEALS TO MOVE INTO FOURTH ALL-TIME IN STEALS AT LBSU: Casper Ware can move into fourth all-time in steals at Long Beach State with three at San Diego State on Saturday. Ware enters the game with 161 steals and can pass Rasul Salahuddin (1994-96) with three at SDSU. He needs just 40 more to pass Lucious Harris (1989-93) for the most in LBSU history.

WARE NINTH IN CAREER 3-POINTERS MADE, ALSO CLIMBING RECORD BOOKS IN POINTS AND FREE THROWS MADE: Casper Ware passed Ramel Lloyd (1998-01) for ninth on the all-time 3-pointers made list at Long Beach State at Pitt Wednesday. The 49er point guard needs to make two against SDSU to pass Morlon Wiley (1984-88) for eighth.

Ware also enters the SDSU game ranked third in free throws made with 344, needing 53 more to pass James Cotton (1993-97) for second all-time. He is 10th all-time in points at LBSU with 1,298. He needs to score eight to pass Francois Wise (1976-80) for ninth.

WARE EXTENDS DOUBLE-DIGIT SCORING STREAK TO 21 GAMES AGAINST PITT: Casper Ware scored in double digits in the 49ers' first two games this season to run his streak of consecutive double-digit games to 21. He finished the 2010-11 season scoring in double-digits in LBSU's final 19 games. During the on-going streak, Ware has scored at least 20 points 12 times, including a career-high 28 at Pitt. During the stretch, he has averaged 20.3 points per game.

WARE GETS 19TH CAREER GAME WITH 20 POINTS AT PITT: Casper Ware scored 28 points in the 49ers win over No. 9 Pitt to mark the 19th time during his career the senior point guard has scored at least 20 points in a game. Ware has nine 20-point games in his last 14 games, as well as six in his last nine games.

WARE LOOKING TO BECOME FIRST PLAYER IN LBSU HISTORY WITH 100 ASSISTS IN FOUR STRAIGHT SEASONS: Casper Ware handed out 150 assists as a junior marking the third straight year that the 49er point guard broke the century mark in assists. Ware, who finished with a freshman record 122 assists in 2008-09 and 159 assists in 2009-10, joined Billy Walker (1984-88), Craig Hodges (1978-82), and Ed Ratleff (1970-73) as the only four 49ers to have three 100-assist seasons. Walker, the all-time assists leader at LBSU, had 161, 147 and 113 in the three seasons he handed out triple-digit assists. He had 86 assists during his freshman season at LBSU. Hodges, second all-time in assists at Long Beach State, handed out 130, 110 and 103 during his three triple-digit assist years. He had 94 during his freshman season at LBSU. Ed Ratleff, who holds the single-season record with 189 assists, also had 113 and 108 while playing just three seasons (due to NCAA freshmen eligibility rules) at Long Beach State.

WARE JUST FOURTH PLAYER IN LBSU HISTORY TO SCORE 1,000 POINTS AND HAND OUT 400 ASSISTS: Casper Ware joined three of the all-time greats at Long Beach State when he got his 400th career assist during his junior season. Ware joined Ed Ratleff, Craig Hodges and

WARE IS ONLY 49ER WITH THREE OF TOP 20 ASSIST SEASONS IN LBSU HISTORY: Casper Ware cracked the top 20 in single-season assists at Long Beach State for the third time in his career as a junior to become the only 49er in the history of the program to have three of the top 20 assist seasons in 49er history. Ware had 150 to finish in ninth. Ware also has the fifth most assists in a season with 159 as a sophomore and the 19th most with 122 as a freshman.

ROBINSON NEEDS 17 REBOUNDS TO BECOME THE ALL-TIME LEADER AT LONG BEACH STATE: T.J. Robinson will most likely become the all-time rebounding leader at Long Beach State before the end of November. The 49er forward had eight boards at Pitt to run his career total to 880 rebounds. He needs just 17 more rebounds to pass Francois Wise (1976-80) for the all-time lead.

ROBINSON ALSO CLIMBING LBSU CAREER CHARTS IN POINTS, FIELD GOALS MADE AND FREE THROWS MADE: Besides ranking as one of the greatest rebounders in school history, T.J. Robinson is also among the Long Beach State all-time leaders in points, field goals made and free throws made. Robinson scored 11 points in the win at No. 9 Pitt to run his career total to 1,331 points, the eighth most in LBSU history. Robinson needs to score 120 points to pass Morlon Wiley (1984-88) for seventh on the all-time list.

Robinson also heads into the SDSU game seventh all-time in field goals made with 507. He needs to make 32 more to pass Wiley for sixth on the list. He tied John Rambo (1963-65) at Pitt for seventh in free throws made with 308 and needs to make 11 more to pass Ed Ratleff (1970-73) for sixth.

ROBINSON CLOSING IN ALL-TIME BIG WEST REBOUNDING LEAD: T.J. Robinson has a chance to leave Long Beach State as the Big West Conference's all-time leader in rebounding. The forward enters the SDSU game as the ninth leading all-time rebounder in Big West history with 880 boards. He needs 236 more to break the league record of 1,115 rebounds held by Tony Neal (Cal State Fullerton). Robinson can pass Eric Franson (Utah State) for eighth all-time with six rebounds, while needing just 11 to pass Armon Gilliam (UNLV) for seventh. He will move into sixth when he overtakes Francois Wise in the Long Beach State record books.

ROBINSON HAS 14 CAREER 20-POINT GAMES: T.J. Robinson has 14 career 20-point games. The senior forward had a career-high 31 points in one game, 25 points in four games, 24 points in two games, 22 points in four games, 21 points in one game and 20 points in two games.

ROBINSON ONE OF JUST SIX PLAYERS IN DIVISION I BASKETBALL TO AVERAGE A DOUBLE-DOUBLE EACH OF THE LAST TWO SEASONS: T.J. Robinson is in select company when it comes to averaging double-doubles in each of the last two seasons. Robinson is one of just six players who averaged a double-double during both the 2009-10 season and the 2010-11 season. Robinson was joined by Kenneth Faried (Morehead State), Ryan Rossiter (Siena), Chris Gaston (Fordham), George Odufuwa (North Texas) and Keith Benson (Oakland). Robinson enters the 2011-12 season as one of only two players with the chance to run the streak to three seasons. Four of the six players were seniors in 2010-11, while Robinson (junior in 10-11) and Gaston (sophomore in 10-11) are the only two with eligibility left in 2011-12.

ROBINSON HAS 39 CAREER DOUBLE-DOUBLES, INCLUDING ONE ALREADY THIS SEASON: T.J. Robinson added another double-double in the season opener against Idaho to his career list to run the total to 39. He had 16 double-doubles as a junior, 17 during his sophomore season and five as a freshman. His first career double-double came in his first career start at Weber State on Dec. 11, 2008, when he scored 18 points and grabbed 10 boards. Since then he has tallied his total of 39 double-doubles in just 90 games. Robinson also has 10 games in which he has had at least 20 points and 10 rebounds.

ANDERSON NAMED BIG WEST CONFERENCE PLAYER OF THE WEEK: Senior Larry Anderson has been named the Big West Conference Men's Basketball Player of the Week after leading Long Beach State to a season-opening win over Idaho. The player of the week award is the fifth of his career. Anderson scored 16 points and matched a career-high with seven assists in LBSU's 69-61 win over the Vandals. The 49er guard made all four of his field goal attempts, while canning a career-high three 3-pointers, in 27 minutes of action. He also went 5-for-6 from the free throw line, grabbed two rebounds and had a steal.

ANDERSON AMONG CAREER LEADERS IN THREE CATEGORIES AT LBSU: Larry Anderson is among the all-time leaders in three career categories at Long Beach State. Anderson ranks sixth all-time in steals (150), ninth in free throws (301) and 14th in points scored (1,142). Anderson has a legitimate chance to become the all-time steals leader at LBSU. He needs just 50 to match the all-time leader Lucious Harris (200 from 1989-93), but he would have to pass teammate Casper Ware as

well who is 11 ahead of Anderson. Anderson has had 62 and 53 steals the last two seasons.

Anderson, who passed Kevin Roberts (2000-04) for 14th in all-time scoring list at LBSU during the Pitt game, needs only 17 points to pass Bill Florentine (1959-62) for 13th on the all-time scoring list. Anderson also became just the ninth player in school history to make 300 free throws in his career when he moved his total to 301 at Pitt. He is seven behind teammate T.J. Robinson and John Rambo (1963-65) who are tied for seventh.

ANDERSON CLOSING IN ON CAREER LEADERS IN THREE OTHER CATEGORIES:

Larry Anderson should also join the all-time school leaders in rebounds and field goals and could join the list in blocked shots. He needs 114 rebounds to move into the top 10 and his career low is 120 rebounds as a freshman in 2008-09. He is 53 field goals short of the top 10 and has had at least 188 FGs in each of his three seasons at LBSU. Anderson also needs 18 blocks to move into the top 10. He set a career high last season blocking 20 shots.

PHELPS EIGHTH AT LONG BEACH STATE IN BLOCKED SHOTS:

Eugene Phelps moved into eighth in career blocks at Long Beach State during his junior season. He finished the year with 63 total blocks. He had a career-high 27 blocks as a junior, two more than he blocked as a sophomore. He heads to his senior season 65 blocks behind all-time leader Antrone Lee (1997-00).

PHELPS NEEDS 271 POINTS TO JOIN TEAMMATES ANDERSON, ROBINSON AND WARE IN LBSU 1,000-POINT CLUB:

Eugene Phelps combined to score 19 points in 49ers first two games of the season and now needs just 271 points to become the sixth player in the Dan Monson era to score 1,000 career points at Long Beach State. The 49er forward has scored 729 career points in his first three-plus seasons at LBSU and will look to join current teammates T.J. Robinson (1,331), Casper Ware (1,298) and Larry Anderson (1,142) in the LBSU 1,000-point club. Greg Plater (1,029 points) and Donovan Morris (1,025) points are the other two players from the Monson era to score over 1,000 points. A total of 21 players in school history have reached the milestone.

ENNIS COMES UP BIG AT PITT:

Junior James Ennis may have been the key to Long Beach State's 86-76 win at No. 9 Pitt on Wednesday. The junior college transfer affected the game on both ends of the floor for the 49ers, finishing with 19 points (6-of-10 shooting), six assists, five steals and four rebounds. Ennis scored six points against Idaho in his first career game at LBSU, and is now averaging 12.5 points, four rebounds, three steals and 3.5 assists per game. He has made 47.4 percent (9-of-19) of his shots.

Dan Monson has rebuilt the Long Beach State basketball program in his four seasons with the 49ers.

Monson has taken a program that won just six games in his first season at LBSU to a regular-season Big West Conference championship in his fourth season and a berth in the National Invitation Tournament (NIT).

On the heels of the title, Monson was named the Big West Conference Coach of the Year, as well as the All-Region Coach. It was his second career coach of the year honor with the first coming in 1998 in his first season as a head coach at Gonzaga when he was named West Coast Conference Coach of the Year.

Monson built the 2010-11 49er team around a solid nucleus of players he recruited to play at LBSU. His first recruiting class featured Greg Plater, the second-leading all-time 3-point shooter at the school, while his second recruiting class of Larry Anderson, Eugene Phelps, T.J. Robinson and Casper Ware may go down in school history as the best recruiting class of all-time.

All four returners, currently seniors, rank among the all-time leaders in school history in at least one category and all four, along with Plater, earned all-league honors.

Ware has established himself as not only one of the top players in conference, but one of the top point guards in the nation. Named a finalist for the Bob Cousy Award, honoring the top point guard in Division I, midway through last season, Ware went on to become the first player in Big West history to be named both the league's player of the year and its defensive player of the year. His first-team all-league selection made him the third Monson recruit at LBSU to be named first-team all-league. Ware also was an honorable mention All-America pick by the *Associated Press*, and was named first-team All-District 9 by the National Association of Basketball Coaches (NABC) and first-team All-District IX by the United States Basketball Writers of America (USBWA).

Joining Ware on the 2010-11 All-Big West Conference First-Team was Anderson, who earned first-team honors for the second time in his three seasons at Long Beach State.

Robinson, a first-team pick as a sophomore in 2009-10, was named second-team All-Big West as a junior, while Plater and Phelps garnered honorable mention all-conference honors to put all five starters on the all-league team.

Monson's success during the 2010-11 season came after his team nearly broke through in 2009-10. After finishing the season tied for third place in the Big West, the 49ers jelled in the Big West Tournament and advanced to the title game, just missing a berth in the NCAA Tournament after a five-point loss in the championship.

During the 2009-10 season, Monson led LBSU through the toughest schedule in school history and in the process picked up his 200th career win at Cal State Northridge on Jan. 28, 2010. The 49ers faced five teams ranked in the top 25, including the eventual National Champions, Duke, and a Final Four team, West Virginia. Monson also led the 49ers to their first win ever over national-power UCLA and a win over eventual WAC champion Utah State. Long Beach State played eight teams that eventually advanced to the NCAA Tournament.

Monson pushed a young team that featured four sophomore starters to the title game of the league tournament. Robinson, a sophomore, earned first-team All-Big West Conference honors and was a member of the Big West All-Tournament Team. He also became the first player from a "mid-major" to be named to the 76 Classic All-Tournament Team.

Fellow sophomore Ware was named second-team all-league and earned Big West All-Tournament accolades as did Anderson, also a sophomore.

Monson's 2009-10 team became the first team in Big West Conference history to have five different players earn Big West Conference Player of the Week honors in the same season when Robinson, Ware, Anderson, Phelps, another sophomore, and senior Stephan Gilling claimed the award.

During his second season at the helm of the Long Beach State program, Monson may have done the best coaching job of his career.

Picked eighth in the Preseason Big West Conference Coaches Poll after finishing his first season at LBSU 6-25, Monson led a team with four true freshmen in the regular rotation, including three freshmen starters at the end of the season, to a nine-win improvement with a 15-15 record and a second-place finish in the Big West Conference. All this despite losing Donovan Morris, an All-Big West selection after Monson's first season, for a big portion of the conference schedule.

Anderson became the first freshman to be named first-team All-Big West since LBSU's Clifton Pondexter earned the honor following the 1973-74 season. Anderson also became just the third 49er to be named Big West Freshman of the Year joining Lucious Harris (1990) and James Cotton (1994).

Robinson and Ware joined Anderson on the five-player Big West All-Freshman Team to mark the second time three 49ers made the all-freshman team in the same season.

Monson was tabbed as the 16th head coach in Long Beach State men's basketball history on April 7, 2007. He inherited a depleted roster but still managed to be competitive in his first season at LBSU.

Monson has been a Division I head coach for 13 years, during which he has compiled a career record of 230-191 (.546), with eight trips to postseason play, including a trip to the Elite Eight in 1999 with Gonzaga University.

Monson was the head coach at the University of Minnesota for seven-plus years, compiling a 118-105 mark and reaching postseason play in five of his seven seasons.

In 2004-05 he led the Gophers to a memorable year. He engineered the second-best Big Ten turnaround in the previous 20 seasons, finishing with a 10-6 conference mark after posting just three league wins the previous campaign.





His first year as head coach at Gonzaga resulted in a 24-10 mark, as the Bulldogs advanced to the second round of the NIT. Monson had a sparkling 52-17 (.754) record in his two seasons as the head coach of the Bulldogs.

Monson spent 11 years helping build the Gonzaga program. He began at GU as an assistant coach in 1988 and spent six years laying the groundwork. In 1994-95 he was elevated to associate head coach under head coach Dan Fitzgerald.

Three years later he took over full control of the Gonzaga program. He led Gonzaga to a West Coast Conference title in 1998 and was named the WCC Coach of the Year. The squad set a school-record with its 24 wins and Monson was also named the National Rookie Coach of the Year by Basketball Times.

Monson was a key figure in the Bulldogs turnaround in the 1990's. Gonzaga had a record of 223-89 over 10 seasons and he was responsible for recruiting many of the key players in Gonzaga's NCAA Sweet 16 appearances from 1998-2001. From the time Monson was named associate head coach in 1995, Gonzaga averaged 22 wins per season and reached postseason play every year but one.

Prior to joining the Bulldogs' staff, Monson spent two seasons as a graduate assistant coach under Gene Bartow at the University of Alabama-Birmingham.

Monson played one year of football at Idaho, but turned his attention to coaching when a knee injury cut short his gridiron career. He coached the boys' basketball team at Oregon City (Ore.) High School for one year prior to taking the UAB graduate assistant post.

A 1985 graduate of the University of Idaho with a bachelor degree in mathematics, Monson earned his master's degree in education with a concentration on athletic administration from UAB in 1988.

In addition to his 20-plus seasons coaching Division I basketball, as either a head or assistant coach, Monson has served on two coaching staffs for USA Basketball representing the United States in international competition.

Monson gained valuable experience by coaching on the international level with USA Basketball. He was an assistant coach for Kelvin Sampson on the gold medal winning 20-and-Under World Championships for Young Men Qualifying Tournament squad in the summer of 2004 in Halifax, Nova Scotia. He also assisted Oliver Purnell at the 1999 Men's World University Games in Mallorca, Spain where the U.S. won the gold medal. With Team USA, Monson had the opportunity to coach future NBA players Sean May, Brendan Haywood, Bracey Wright, Chris Paul, Michael Redd, Mark Madsen, Kenyon Martin and Charlie Villanueva.

Monson grew up around basketball as his father, Don, was a well-respected collegiate coach. Don was the head coach at Idaho and Oregon and was an assistant coach under Jud Heathcote at Michigan State (1976-78) for two years.

Monson and his wife Darci have four children, a son, MicGuire (11), a daughter, Mollie (9), a son, Maddox (8) and a daughter, McKenna (6).



Minnesota reached the 20-win plateau for the first time since 1992-93 and Monson led the Golden Gophers to the NCAA Tournament for the first time since 1999.

In 2005-06 the Gophers advanced to their fifth postseason appearance in six years. Senior guard Vincent Grier was named All-Big Ten and All-District for the second straight year. In 2002-03 Minnesota went 19-14 and earned the program's first trip to the NIT semifinals in Madison Square Garden.

Monson reached two personal coaching milestones in 2004-05. With a victory over Indiana in the Big Ten Tournament quarterfinals, he earned his 100th victory at Minnesota. When he defeated Purdue on February 26, 2005 he picked up his 150th career head-coaching victory. With 100 victories in his first six years at Minnesota, Monson ranks second all-time at the school behind Jim Dutcher (1975-85) in wins during his first six years as head coach.

Monson stepped into the Minnesota job on the heels of NCAA sanctions against the school. Those NCAA violations during the mid-1990's severely limited scholarships and put strict recruiting sanctions on the program since the summer of 1999, coinciding with Monson's arrival at Minnesota. The summer of 2005 was the first Monson and his staff could recruit on par with every other college basketball program and that season concluded with a trip to the NCAA Tournament, the programs first year off probation.

Prior to accepting the Minnesota job on July 24, 1999, Monson was the head coach at Gonzaga for two years. In 1998-99 he led the Bulldogs to within a breath of the Final Four.

Gonzaga, which went 28-7 on the year and won the West Coast Conference regular season and tournament championships, defeated such notable NCAA powers as Minnesota (75-63), Stanford (82-74) and Florida (73-72) before bowing out to eventual national-champion Connecticut (67-62) in the Elite Eight.




