

San Diego State-Wyoming Postgame Notes

THE BIG NOTE

- Steve Fisher won his 250th game at San Diego State. He trails the school's all-time wins leader, George Ziegenfuss, by 66 wins (316).
- San Diego State defeats Wyoming, a team that entered tonight 16-4 overall and 12-1 at home.
- Sophomore **Jamaal Franklin** tied for game-high honors with 12 points,had a career-high 11 rebounds and posted his fifth double-double in his last seven games.
- The 42 points allowed are the fewest surrendered by the Aztecs in the 70 all-time meetings between the teams.

Streaks

- San Diego State has won 58 games in a row over teams not ranked the USA Today/ESPN Coaches' Top-25 Poll.
- San Diego State has won 25 consecutive games against the current configuration of the Mountain West Conference.
- San Diego State has won 22 consecutive road games against unranked teams.
- San Diego State has won 12 consecutive road games against the current configuration of the Mountain West Conference.
- San Diego State has won 11 straight games, which is the third-longest streak in school history.
- San Diego State has won seven consecutive games played in January.
- San Diego State has won six conference games in a row, which equals the sixth-longest streak in program history.
- San Diego State has won five straight on the road, which matches the fifth-longest road/neutral streak in school history.

Trends

- The Aztecs are 18-2, which is the second-best start in the 91-year history of the program.
- The Aztecs are 4-0 in Mountain West play for just the third time in program history. It is the sixth time SDSU has opened with a 4-0 conference march in its Division I history (1975, 1976, 1985, 2008, 2011, 2012).
- San Diego State is 52-5 since the beginning of the 2010-11 campaign, which is the best mark nationally.
- The Aztecs improve to 41-3 as an AP Top-25 team and 36-3 when in the Coaches' poll.
- SDSU is 38-0 vs. unranked foes as an AP Top-25 club. The Aztecs are 34-0 vs. unranked opponents when in the Coaches' poll.
- San Diego State improves to 19-2 in its last 21 road outings.

Series Notes

- SDSU has won four straight in the series with Wyoming for just the second time, which equals its longest such streak.
- The Aztecs have won two in a row at Arena-Auditorium, which matches their longest streak at the facility.
- San Diego State won at Wyoming for just the eighth time (8-24). Five of those wins have come under Steve Fisher.

Game Notes

- Steve Fisher won his 250th game at San Diego State. He trails the school's all-time wins leader, George Ziegenfuss, by 66 wins (316)
- San Diego State improves to 13-1 this season and has won nine straight games when leading at the half.
- San Diego State held Wyoming to 30.6 percent shooting from the field. The Aztecs have now won 34 consecutive games when holding its opponent to 40 percent or less from the field. Tonight was Wyoming's lowest field goal percentage of the season.
- San Diego State shot 51.2 percent from the floor. The Aztecs have now won 25 straight games and is 8-0 this season when shooting 50 percent or better from the floor.
- San Diego State has won 42 consecutive games when holding its opponent to 60 points or less. Wyoming's 42 points are the lowest total for the Cowboys his season.
- The Aztecs have won 54 consecutive games when owning a better field goal percentage than its opponent.

- The Aztecs have won 63 straight games when leading with five minutes to play.
- San Diego State outrebounded Wyoming, 30-27. The Aztecs are 14-0 this season when owning an edge on the glass.

Jamaal Franklin (game-high tying 12 points, career-high 11 rebounds, 4-7 FGs, 2-4 3FGs)

The sophomore reached double figures for a career-high eighth straight game, 16^{th} time this season and the 17^{th} time in his career... Franklin pulled down a career-high and had a game-high with 11 rebounds... The 11 rebounds tied for the highest total by an Aztec player this season... He records his sixth career double-double and has five double-doubles in his last seven games.

Chase Tapley (game-high tying 12 points, 4 rebounds, 5-10 FGs, 2-4 3FGs)

The senior has scored in double figures a career-high 14 straight games, 18 times this season and 45 time in his career... Tapley has connected on three-point field goals in a career-long 19 consecutive games... He has multiple threes in 12 of his last 14 contests...
