SDSU NATIONAL POSTSEASON HISTORY

The San Diego State University women's tennis team has a long tradition of postseason play. Prior to the inception of the NCAA Tournament in 1982, the Aztecs appeared in the national AIAW team tournament from 1979-81 finishing as high as seventh overall. Since that time, SDSU has been a factor on the national scene.

San Diego State has appeared in the NCAA Tournament in 17 out of the 23 seasons of the tournament's existence. In 1984, the Aztecs achieved their highest ranking with a fourth-place finish. SDSU lost to Trinity College, 5-4, in the consolation match of the finals. The Aztecs have also advanced to the quarterfinals of the NCAA Tennis Championship four times since the 1982 season.

SDSU has sent at least one player to eight NCAA singles or doubles tournaments. The highest finish for an Aztec singles player was Micki Schillig, who lost to Alycia Moulton of Stanford in the finals during the 1984 campaign. Micki Schillig teamed with Cynthia MacGregor in 1983 to form the best doubles team at SDSU. The duo advanced to the semifinals of the NCAA Tournament before losing to Linda Gates and Elise Burgin of Stanford, 6-4, 6-3.

In 2003, San Diego State advanced to the NCAA Tournament for the seventh time in the eight seasons. The Aztecs have officially made 17 trips to the NCAA Tournament, the 12th highest total among all schools.

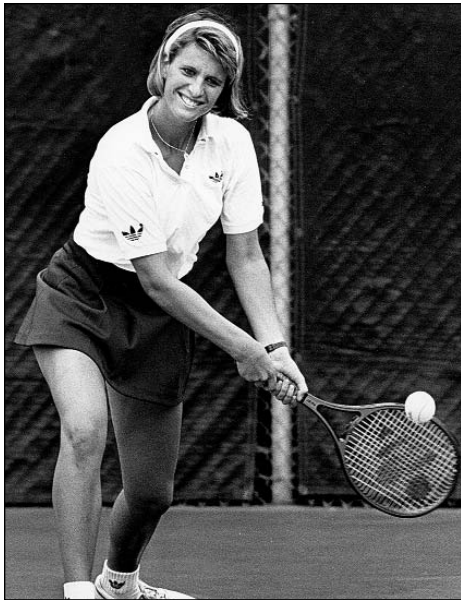
